## Respectfully Sheweth:

- 1. That appellant was enrolled as Constable in District Police Haripur on 21-08-2009, thus has rendered more than 11 years service in the police department.
- 2. That appellant while posted at Police Post TIP Haripur was served with a Charge Sheet dated 19-06-2019 by the



District Police Officer Haripur which was duly replied explaining all facts of the matter in detail and denying the allegations being incorrect and baseless. (Copy of reply to the Charge Sheet is attached as "A").

- 3. That appellant was given a Final Show Cause Notice dated 01-08-2019 which was also replied and the allegations were flatly refused being incorrect and baseless. Copy of the Final Show Cause Notice is attached as "B").
- 4. That appellant was awarded with penalty of "Dismissal from service" vide order dated 18-09-2019 by the District Police Officer, Haripur without any reason and proof. (Copy of order dated 18-09-2019 is attached as "C").
- 5. That in fact during his posting at PP TIP for a period of about 7/8 months, there had been no complaint against the appellant from any corner.
- 6. That during the said period the appellant alongwith his seniors arrested many criminals and booked them to face the trial and taking legal action against criminals huge quantity of illegal weapons and narcotics/contraband were recovered.
- 7. That the allegations as mentioned in the Charge Sheet and Final Show Cause Notice on the basis of which the appellant was awarded major penalty are incorrect, baseless and concocted ones communicated to the DPO Haripur with malafide intention by the persons having enmity toward appellant due to their arrest and booking

to the law at the hands of appellant otherwise there was nothing correct in the allegations.

- 8. That alongwith appellant 2/3 other police officials (HC Saeed Shah, LHC Asad Saeed-297 and Constable Saddique-669) were also attributed with the same allegation who were subsequently let-off for the reason best known to respondents but the appellant was awarded with major penalties by the DPO Haripur vide impugned order by exercising discrimination.
- 9. That no proper departmental inquiry was conducted to prove the allegations against appellant. Not a single witness was ever called for to appear before the inquiry officer in presence of appellant to record his evidence nor was he ever provided with the chance to cross-examine such witness. Copy of inquiry report, if any, was never provided to him. Even opportunity of personal hearing was afforded to the appellant rather he was condemned unheard.
- 10. That appellant aggrieved of the impugned order of dismissal from service appealed against and the appellate authority the RPO Hazard Region Abbottabad while partially accepting appeal converted the penalty of DISMISSAL from service into punishment of TIME SCALE CONSTABLE vide order dated 31-01-2020. (Copies of departmental Appeal and order 31-01-2020 are attached as Annexure-"D & E").
- 11. That thereafter the appellant filed a **MERCY APPEAL** before the Provincial Police Officer, KPK, Peshawar under



Rule-16: 32 of Police Rules 1934 which was rejected vide order dated 04-03-2021 delivered on 10-03-2021 (Copies of Mercy Appeal and order dated 04-03-2021 are attached as Annexure "F &G").

#### **GROUNDS:**

- a). That orders dated 18-09-2019, 31-01-2020 and 04-03-2021 of respondents are illegal, unlawful, against the departmental rules & regulation, issued in a cursory, whimsical and arbitrary manner and are liable to be set aside.
- b). That no proper departmental inquiry was conducted. Copy of inquiry report was also not provided. Even opportunity of personal hearing was not afforded to the appellant and he was condemned unheard.
- c). That the penalty awarded to the appellant is illegal, against the law, departmental rules and regulations hence liable to be set aside.
- d). That the appellant has seriously been discriminated while awarding the major penalties by the respondents and that too without any reason, justification & proof.
- e) That the appellate authorities have also failed to abide by the law and even did not take into consideration the grounds taken in the memo of appeal. Thus the impugned order of appellate

authority is contrary to the law as laid down in Police Rules read with section 24-A of General Clause Act 1897 and Article 10A of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.

f) That instant service appeal is well within time and this honorable Service Tribunal has got every jurisdiction to entertain & adjudicate upon the lis.

#### PRAYER:



That Constable Majid Ali along with HC Saeed Shah, LHC Assad Saeed No.297, Muharrar PP Pind Munim; and Constable Saddique No.669, PS Hattar, intentionally involved in corruption and corrupt practices, helping drug peddlers, took bribe/illegal gratification from the accused involved in different criminal activities and facilitated them. The acts and omissions of defaulter police official were misconduct under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, police efficiency and discipline rules 1975. Therefore, He was served with charge sheet and statements of allegations, vide this office Endst No.356-58/PA dated 19.06.2019.

To probe the allegations, Mr. Nasir Mahmood, ASP/Ghazi, District Haripur, was appointed as enquiry officer, who conducted proper departmental enquiry and submitted his finding, vide his office Memo No.236 dated 30.07.2019. #### ORDER

This order is hereby passed to dispose off departmental appeal under Rule 11-A of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Rules, 1975 submitted by Constable Majid No. 179 of district Haripur against the order of punishment i.e. Dismissal from service awarded by the District Police Officer, Haripur vide OB No. 601 dated 18-09-2019.

Facts leading to the punishment are that he while posted at PP TIP Haripur, it came in the notice of DPO Haripur during preliminary enquiry conducted by ASP Saddar, Haripur that Constable Majid Aii No.179, HC paeed Shah alongwith, LHC Asad Saced No.297, Muharrar PP Pind Munim PP TIP and Constable Saddique No.669 PS Hattar intentionally involved in corruption helping drug peddlers, took bribe/illegal gratification from the accused involved in different criminal activities and facilitated them.

After receiving his appeal, comments of DPO Haripur were obtained and examined/ perused. The undersigned called the appellant in OR, heard him in person. Keeping in view his explanation and financial position. I take lenient view and the punishment awarded by DPO Haripur i.e. "Dismissal from service is hereby converted into time scale constable". with immediate effect. Moreover the official is barred from Haripur district for rest of carrier and transferred to district Abbottabad.

Mercy Appeal by Majid Ali Constable No.179 District Police Abbottabad

MERCY APPEAL UNDER RULE 16-32 OF POLICE RULES-1934 AGAINST ORDER DATED 18-09-2019 OF THE DPO HARIPUR WHEREBY APPELLANT WAS DISMISSED FROM SERVICE AND GRDER DATED 31-01-2020 OF THE RPO, HAZARA REGION, ABBOTTABAD WHEREBY WHILE PARTIALLY ACCEPTING HIS DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL THE PENALTY OF DISMISSAL HAS BEEN CONVERTED INTO TIME SCALE CONSTABLE.

PRAYER: ON ACCEPTANCE OF INSTANT MERCY APPEAL BOTH THE ORDERS DATED 18-09-2019 AND 31-01-2020 MAY KINDLY BE SET ASIDE AND THE APPELLANT BE RE-INSTATED IN SERVICE AS CONSTABLE WITH HIS PAY DRAWING AT THE TIME OF DISMISSAL ON 18-09-2019 AND WITH ALL CONSEQUENTIAL SERVICE BACK BENEFITS.

Respected Sir,

With most reverence and humble submission the following few lines are laid down before your Highness for kind consideration and favorable order please:-

- 1. That appellant while posted at Police Post TIP Haripur was issued with a Charge Sheet dated 19-06-2019 by the District Police Officer Haripur with some general type allegations having no concern with reality. The Charge Sheet was duly replied explaining all facts and circumstances of the matter in detail denying the allegations leveled against the appellant being incorrect and baseless. (Copies of Charge Sheet and its reply are attached as "A&B").
- 2. That thereafter the appellant was served with a Final Show Cause Notice dated 01-08-2019 with the same allegations as earlier which was duly replied explaining all facts and circumstances of the matter in detail and the allegations as incorporated therein were flatly refused being incorrect and baseless. Copies of Final Show Cause Notice and its reply are attached as "C&D").
- 3. That without taking into consideration the reply submitted by appellant to the Charge Sheet as well as Final Show Cause Notice the District Police Officer Haripur imposed upon him the penalty of dismissal from service vide order OB No. 601 dated 18-09-2019 without any reason and proof. (Copy of order dated 18-09-2019 is attached as "E").
- 4. That the aforementioned order of the District Police Officer Haripur was appealed against through departmental appeal dated -10-2019 before the Regional Police Officer Abbottabad which was partially accepted vide order dated 31-01-2020 converting the penalty dismissal into Time Scale Constable. Though the appellant

was taken on duty but copy of the same was issued to him on 16-02-2020, bence this appeal. The appellant was transferred to Abbottabad and he is performing his duty in a far flung hilly area of Police Station. If and due to extensive duties during the corona disease the appellant could not have time for filing this mercy appeal. Instant Mercy Appeal was, if late, the delayed period may graciously be condoned for the reasons stated above. (Copies of departmental appeal and order dated 31-01-2020 are attached as "F&G").

- 5. That in fact during his posting at PP TIP for about 7/8 months, the appellant always performed his duties efficiently and 'honestly. There has been no complaint, what-so-ever, against the appellant from public as well as his officers. The appellant alongwith his seniors arrested many criminal heads and huge quantity of illegal weapons and narcotics contraband was recovered.
- 6. That appellant never involved himself in corruption, helping drug peddlers, took bribe/illegal gratification from accused involved in criminal activities or facilitated them as has been falsely incorporated in the Charge Sheet and Final Show Cause Notice rather he performed his assigned duties with devotion, dedication and honesty. The allegations were never proved against the appellant through any means. The allegations as mentioned in the Charge Sheet and Final Show Cause Notice and were made the base of punishment were incorrect and concocted ones communicated to the DPO Haripur with malafide intention by the persons having biasness and enmity toward appellant. Otherwise there was nothing correct in the allegations.
- 7. That two other police officials beside appellant were also involved in the same case and inquiry initiated against them but they were later on let-off but the appellant was awarded major penalty of dismissal from service by the DPO Haripur exercising discrimination against the appellant.
- 8. That appellant has rendered more than 11/12 years service in the police department. Throughout his long service the appellant was never issued even with a single explanation. He has clean and unblemished meritorious service record. He always performed his assigned duties with devotion, dedication and honesty and on occasions for tremendous service he was awarded with the commendation certificates and cash rewards by his High-Ups.
- 9. That no proper departmental inquiry was conducted to prove allegations against the appellant. Not a single witness was ever called for to appear before the inquiry officer in presence of appellant to record his evidence nor was he ever provided with the chance to cross-examine such witness, if any. Copy of inquiry report was also not provided to him. Even opportunity of personal hearing was afforded to appellant rather condemned unheard.

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- 10. That in view of the facts narrated here above by no stretch of imagination the appellant can be held responsible for the allegation as leveled against him due to which the appellant has been awarded with the punishment without any reason.
- 11. That if the appellant is afforded with the opportunity of personal hearing he will really prove him as innocent by adducing credible facts of the matter.

Sir, in view of the facts adduced here above, it is earnestly prayed that on acceptance of this MERCY APPEAL the impugned orders dated 18-09-2019 and 31-01-2020 may kindly be set aside and the appellant be reinstated in his service with pay as he was drawing at the time of his dismissal with grant of all consequential service back benefits. Thanking you sir in anticipation.

## ORDER

This order is hereby passed to dispose of Revision Petition under Rule 11-A of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Rule-1975 (amended 2014) submitted by Constable Majid No. 179. The petitioner was dismissed from service by District Police Officer, Haripur vide OB No. 601, dated 18.09.2019 on the allegations that he while posted at PP TIP Haripur, it came in the notice of District Police Officer, Haripur during preliminary enquiry conducted by ASP/Saddar, Haripur that Constable Majid No. 179, HC Saeed Shah alongwith LHC Asad Saeed No. 297, Muharrar PP Pind Munim PP TIP and Constable Saddique No. 669 PS Hattar intentionally involved in corruption helping drug peddlers, took bribe/illegal gratification from the accused involved in different criminal activities and facilitated them. The Appellate Authority i.e. Regional Police Officer, Hazara converted his dismissal from service into time scale Constable vide order Endst: No. 3553-55/PA, dated 31.01.2020.

Meeting of Appellate Board was held on 21.01.2021 wherein petitioner was heard in person. Petitioner denied the allegations leveled against him.

Petitioner failed to advance any plausible explanation in rebuttal of the charges. Since he has already been granted relief by Regional Police Officer, Hazara. His revision petition is also time barred. Therefore, the Board decided that his petition is hereby rejected.
