


Learned counsel for the appellant stated at the bar that in light

Counsel for the appellant present. Preliminary arguments heard.

Learned counsel for the appellant while arguing the instant appeal stated that the appellant was appointed as Female Lecturer (BS-17) on 25.09.2017 and on completion of her normal tenure of posting she was transferred from GGDC Umerzai (Charsadda) to GGDC, Bacha Khan Peshawar vide notification dated 26.09.2019. She is aggrieved of the transfer order notified on 06.01.2021 when she was transferred from GGDC Bacha Khan Peshawar to GGDC Darra Adam Khel. However, before completion of normal tenure she was again transferred to GFCW Peshawar vide notification dated 20.01.2021 and yet again transferred from GFCW to GGDC, Shabqadar Charsadda vide impugned order dated 13.10.2021. The appellant preferred departmental appeal to the appellate authority on 14.10.2021 which was regretted vide correspondence dated 04.11.2021. Thereafter jurisdiction of the Service Tribunal was invoked under Section-4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act 1974. Learned counsel for the appellant further contended that non-observance of the specified tenure is not only violation of Clause-xiv of posting/transfer policy of provincial government but is also violation of PLD 2013 Supreme Court 195. Moreover, the appellant is bachelor and living with her parents at Peshawar and thus her fundamental rights have been violated.

The appeal is admitted for regular hearing subject to all just legal objections. The appellant is directed to deposit security and process fee within 10 days. Thereafter notices be issued to respondents for submission of reply/comments. To come up for reply/comments on 11.01.2022 before S.B.

Alongwith memorandum of service appeal, request for interim relief for suspension of the impugned order dated 13.10.2021, has also been made. Operation of the impugned notification dated 13.10.2021 is suspended to the extent of only appellant, till next date



APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT
1974 AGAINST THE TRANSFER ORDERS DATED 13-10-2021 AND THE REGRET OF
APPEAL VIDE 04-11-2021 OF THE APPELLANT WHEREBY SHE HAS BEEN
TRANSFERRED/POSTED PREMATURELY, ILLEGALLY AND WITHOUT LAWFUL
AUTHORITY AND IN CONTRAVENTION OF THE FEMALE UNMARRIED OFFICERS
POLICY, E-TRANSFER POLICY, BAN PERIOD AND ALSO AGAINST THE TENURE POLICY.

The appellant most humbly beg to submit as under:

1. **That** the Appellant is a law-abiding citizen of Pakistan and also hails from a respectable family. **She** is a civil servant who was appointed as a Lecturer in Law vide Notification dated 25-09-2017. She was posted as Lecturer at the Government Girls Degree College Umerzai, Charsadda as her first posting.

Copy of the notification is Annex-A.

2. **That** the applicant remained posted at the GGDC Umerzai Charsadda for two years whereafter she was Government Girls Degree College Bacha Khan Peshawar vide Notification dated 26-09-2019.

Copy of the transfer notification is Annex-B.

3. That the applicant was posted and transferred merely after an year from Government Girls Degree College Bacha Khan Peshawar to Government Girls Degree College Dara Adam Khel vide notification dated 06-01-2021.

Copy of the transfer notification is Annex-C.

4. That again the appellant was transferred vide notification dated 20-01-2021. This time she while being under transfer from GGDC Bacha Khan Peshawar to GGDC Dara Adam Khel, Kohat was transferred against vacant post in the Government Frontier College for Women Peshawar.

Copy of the transfer notification is Annex-D.

5. That the agony of the appellant however wasn't to end as she has again been transferred from the Government Frontier College for Women Peshawar to Government Girls Degree College Shabqadar, Charsadda. And the respondent No. 3 has been transferred against the position as Lecturer at Government Frontier College for Women, Peshawar vide notification dated 13-10-2021.

Copy of the transfer notification is Annex-E.

6. **That** against the afore-mentioned transfer dated 13-10-2021, the appellant moved a representation albeit appeal, which was diarized vide diary no. 14288 dated 15-10-2021.

Copy of the representation is Annex-F

7. That the said representation was ironically regretted with reasons which bewilders any prudent mind vide letter dated 04-11-2021. The said letter clearly states that there is one sanctioned position of law at the Government Frontier College for Women, Peshawar and against

this one post there are three teachers working. And that the tenure of the appellant isn't completed and immature. Yet no decision in respect of the acceptance of the appeal is being made.

Copy of the regret letter dated 04-11-2021 is Annex-~~6~~.

8. That aggrieved of the said transfer dated 13-10-2021 and the letter dated 04-11-2021, the appellant has no alternate remedy but to approach this honorable tribunal amongst others on the following grounds:

Grounds:

- a. **Because** the transfer/posting order is based in malafide and is inherently illegal, unlawful and without jurisdiction on the score of the ill-will involved in the order of transfer/posting and is thus liable to be set-aside.
- b. **Because** The Rules designate certain posts as 'tenure posts' (rule 22 read with Schedule IV of the Rules) and prescribe a period of three years for an incumbent to serve on such posts. Such prescribed tenure may therefore be categorized as the ideal duration for which a civil servant should serve at a particular post. The post of the appellant is a tenure post, yet she has been transferred from her posting before the tenure was complete. Thus, the appellant having not been allowed to complete her normal tenure and thus the order impugned is violation of transfer posting policy of the Government and the judgment of the apex court reported in PLD 1995 SC Page No 530 and PLD 2013 Supreme Court Page No 195.
- c. **Because** the recently the august Supreme Court of Pakistan has in its Judgment reported in 2013 PLD SC 195, decided a point of law and while committing upon the transfer and posting and other related matters of service held as under:-

- (i) **Appointments, Removals and Promotions:-** Appointments, removals and promotions must be made in accordance with the law and the rules made there under; where no such law or rule exists and the matter has been left to discretion, such discretion must be exercised in a structured, transparent and reasonable manner and in the public interest.
- (ii) **Tenure, posting and transfer:** When the ordinary tenure for a posting has been specified in the law or rules made there under; such tenure must be respected and cannot be varied, except for compelling reasons, which should be recorded in writing and are judicially reviewable.
- (iii) **Illegal Orders:** Civil servants owe their first and foremost allegiance to the law and the Constitution. They are not bound to obey orders from superiors which are illegal or are not in accordance with accepted practices and rule, based norms; instead, in such situations, they must record their opinion and; if necessary, dissent.

(iv) **O.S.D Officers** should not be posted as OSD except for compelling reasons, which must be recorded in writing and are judicially reviewable. If at all an Officer is to be posted as OSD, such posting should be for the minimum period possible and if there is a disciplinary inquiry going on against him, such inquiry must be completed as the earliest.

Relying upon the Judgment of the Supreme Court of Pakistan the Respondents are duty bound to have follow the law, judgment of the superior courts, and posting and transfer should not have been influenced in any manner whatsoever.

d. **Because** the Supreme Court of Pakistan in CP No. 2812/2017 clearly directed in the following terms:

“.....The issues raised in this petition are substantial questions of law of public importance in terms of Article 212(3) of the Constitution, which we have dilated upon and which were left unattended by the learned chairman and members of the Tribunal. The Tribunal also did not take into account the referred to judgments of this Court. The Tribunal referred to a judgment of this Court, Zaka Ullah Bajwa v Chief Secretary, Government of the Punjab (2005 SCMR 13), which held that a civil servant, “is required to serve anywhere against the post to which he is transferred”, however, that does not mean a civil servant can be made to serve under his subordinate or for a very brief period of time or that the minister can undermine the authority of the secretary of the department”.

It was further observed in the said judgment that:

“The Chief Secretary and the secretaries of the departments of the Government are directed not to act pursuant to any notification, order and/or instruction whereby a minister orders the posting/transfer of a civil servant.”

e. **Because** Section 10 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act states as follows:

“Every civil servant shall be liable to serve anywhere within or outside the province in any post under the Federal Government, or any Provincial Government or local authority, or a corporation or body set up or established by any such Government:

Provided that nothing contained in this section shall apply to a civil servant recruited specifically to serve in a particular area or region:

Provided further that where a civil servant is required to serve in a post outside his service or cadre, his terms and conditions of service as to his pay shall not be less favorable than those to which he would have been entitled if he had been so required to serve.”

The aforesaid section does not empower the Government to cut short the normal tenure of a posted/transferred civil servant, and particularly without assigning any reason. In the case of Mahmood Akhtar Naqvi (Anita Turab case) (above) this Court held: “16. In the Hajj Corruption Case, the court reiterated its earlier ruling in Zahid Akhtar v. Government of Punjab (PLD 1995 SC 530), where it had been held that

“The normal period of posting of a Government servant at a station, according to Rule 21 of the Rules of Business is three years, which has to be followed in the ordinary circumstances, unless for reasons or exigencies of service a transfer before expiry of the said period

becomes necessary in the opinion of the competent authority." Furthermore, with regard to transfers of civil servants, this Court has stated that transfers by political figures which are not legally sustainable. Farrukh gulzar v. Secretary Local Government and Rural Development Department, Lahore and 2 others (1998 SCMR 2222). These are principles of law enunciated by this court and are to be followed in terms of Article 189 of the Constitution. We, however, repeatedly come across violations of such principles. This unnecessarily leads to litigation which, in turn, clogs Courts and Service Tribunals."

- f. **Because** in-fact there exist no exigencies of service nor can the order of transfer be termed as in the public interest rather the same has been issued in violation of the transfer and posting policy and in ban period.
- g. **Because** the Appellant has been treated illegally, unlawfully and against the spirit of the law.
- h. **Because** the unmarried female policy and protection and safeguarding thereof of the same has been disregarded in its totality vide the transfer orders.
- i. **Because** the mechanism provided under Article 212 is attracted for the reason of the order being corum non judice and illegal for the entrenched malice on part of the Respondents in the case.
- j. **Because** the Appellant has been seriously discriminated in line with the spirit of Article 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, as there is a blanket ban imposed on transfers of teaching faculty within the province, yet in order to settle score with the Appellant, there has been a dispensation sought and granted without even a remote reference as to how or why such dispensation was sought and granted by the competent authority. There has been no reason given. The record is clear that there is no reason other than the clear political pressure being exerted on the appellant.
- k. **Because** the actions on part of the respondents seriously are in the negation of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 and the Civil Servants Act.
- l. **Because** before taking the impugned action, no due process of law has been adopted by the Respondents.
- m. **Because** the Fundamental Rights of the Appellant have been violated in relation to Article 4, 8, 9, 18 & 25 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973. The said rights flow out of the Constitution the terms and conditions of service of the Appellant and this Honorable Court being the custodian of the Fundamental Rights of citizens of Pakistan, as well as the protection afforded by the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973, is why the Appellant seeks the redress of their grievances and to end the ordeal the Appellant is going through due to the illegal, unlawful and unjust acts and inaction of the Respondents.
- n. **Because** the actions and inactions of the Respondents proclaim their own mala fide.
- o. **Because** the Appellant has got the fundamental right of being treated in accordance with law but the treatment meted out to the Appellant is on consideration other than legal and he has been deprived of his rights duly guaranteed to him by the constitution of Pakistan.

- p. **Because** the Respondents cannot be allowed under the law to pass any illegal order.
- q. **Because** the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law, hence his rights secured and guaranteed under the Law are badly violated.
- r. **Because** the Appellant crave for leave to add further grounds at the time of his oral arguments before this Hon'ble Tribunal highlighting further contraventions of the provisions of the Constitution & Laws which adversely affected the Appellant.

PRAYER:

In view of the above, it is humbly prayed that this honorable Tribunal may graciously be pleased to declare that the transfer order dated 13-10-2021 by virtue of which the appellant has been transferred be declared to be illegal, unlawful, against the norms of justice and corum non judice and to Direct the respondents to forthwith withdraw the impugned transfer/posting orders of the Appellant. Any other relief deemed appropriate in the circumstance of the case may also be granted.

Interim Relief:

May it please this Honorable Tribunal to suspend the posting/transfer of the Appellant till the final disposal of the appeal, and that no adverse action be taken against her.

Sir

I, Zarlakhta Farhat Lecturer in Law takes this opportunity to bring to your kind notice that I am a permanent resident of Hayatabad Peshawar for the last over twenty six years. But having Charsadda as my father's domicile, I was posted to GGDC Umerzai Charsadda where I served for over two years. After that I was posted to GGDC Bacha Khan Peshawar whereby I merely served for a period of one year and was posted out at GGDC Darra Adam Khelon January 06, 2021. Later I was adjusted at the present college in GFCW Peshawar and now again after a period of eight months, I am cross posted with Ms. Shehla Ashraf Lecture in Law from GGDC Shabqadar Charsadda who had been posted there vide same notification through which I stood posted to GFCW about eight months.

It may not be out of place to mention that the same Ms. Shehla Ashraf was posted to Shabqadar College Charsadda after spending a period of seventeen years (without a break) at GGDC No.1 Hayatabad College. Her grounds may be too compassionate that the competent authority posts her back to Peshawar but I too hereby approach your kind honour to reconsider my request on the following pleas.

- 1) I am an unmarried female living with my father at Hayatabad Peshawar. KPK Civil Servants Act 1973 provides that such

female unmarried officers will be treated with compassion for postings /transfers to out station.

2) I already spent a period of over two years in my domiciled district Charsadda(Umerzai).Posting out back to the same district after a few months calls for strong reconsideration by the authorities. Posting out of an employee prematurely after about eight months does not fall even with legality of the matter. I am entitled to serve for two years at the present station / positioned. It has not only happened now but its the third consecutive time in last eight months time that such orders have been passed to uproot me. Thus subjecting me to mental / psychological and physical stress .According to Section 10 clause (iv) of KPK Civil Servants Act 1973 rules an officer must spend a period of two years in settled area and one and a half year tenure in remote area in case of a transfer.

In view of the above I request that my case for cancellation of the above notification be reconsidered and I be allowed to perform my duties at the current station.
