Respectfully Sir;

Brief Facts of the execution petition are us under;

- 1. That the appellant was permanent employee of DHQ teaching hospital Dera Ismail Khan and was working in Hospital with full/entire stasifaction of his supervisors.
- 2. That the respondent authorities enrooted the appellant in criminal case FIR No. 972 dated 29/09/2015 malafidely in the PS Cantt DIKHan under section 379/34 for stealing of medicine(Not for Sale). Wherein the appellant have been bailed out.

of the same

- 3. That thereafter the respondent authorities issued show cause notice/charge sheet which was replied by the appellant accordingly.
- 4. That the respondent authorities then terminated the appellant from service vide office order bearing No. 5428-31 dated 19/10/2015.
- 5. That the appellant being dissatisfied in exercise of his rights, having no other option filed a service appeal No. 145/2016 before the KPK Service Tribunal Peshawar.
- 6. The Honorable KP Service Tribunal, Peshawar decided the service appeal in favor of the appellant on date 27/08/2019 at camp court, Dera Ismail Khan and accepted the appeal by setting aside the impugned order and reinstate the appellant into service with the direction to the respondents department to conduct de-novo inquiry within period of 90 days and the issue of back benefits will be subject to the outcome of de-novo inquiry. Attested copy of the judgment dated 27/08/2019 is annexed.
- 7. That later on petitioner/appellant was reinstated by respondent authorities in December 2019 and current salary of the appellant/petitioner was released. Account statement of the appellant is annexed herein. Similarly MTI DHQTH DIKhan constituted inquiry committee for the purpose of conducting denovo inquiry against the petitioner/appellant. The said committee conducted de-novo inquiry against the petitioner/appellant and the committee has investigated the matter thoroughly, written statement were obtained from the witnesses about the incident and the inquiry committee held that;

"it stands clear that the person caught red-handed at hospital's main gate on the of night of 25/09/2015 was not Khurran Masih

EARLAND

(petitioner) and that Mr. Khurram Masih was present on his duty in his concerned unit"

Hence, the de-nove inquiry was decided in the favor of appellant and submitted the same to the respondent authorities (MTI DHQ Teaching Hospital DIKhan). Copy of the inquiry report is annexed herein.

- 8. That the fate of back benefits/arrears was subject to the outcome of the de-novo inquiry and the inquiry is decided in favor of the petitioner/appellant. Hence, the respondent authorities are bound to release the back benefits of the petitioner. Since then the petitioner/appellant has submitted many applications regarding the same and was also visiting respondent authorities for releasing/granting his back benefits but the judgment and directions of the Worthy Service Tribunal are not being honored and implemented till date.
- 9. That after the lapse of considerable time the respondent department is not releasing/granting the back benefits/arrears of the petitioner and is hesitating to release the back benefits of the petitioner. The respondent department vide judgment dated 27/08/2019 of this worthy tribunal is legally bound to release the back benefits of the petitioner after conducting and deciding de-novo inquiry in favor of the petitioner but they are reluctant to show any interest the same. Which is directly effecting the valuable rights of the petitioner/appellant.
- 10. That this learned tribunal has got vast power to entertain the instant petition.
- 11. That the counsel for petitioner may kindly be allowed to raise additional grounds during course of arguments.

It is therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of the instant execution petitioner, in light of judgment of KP Service Tribunal Peshawar, KPK and in light of Inquiry



report, back benefits of the petitioner/appellant may kindly be released/granted.

Any other appropriate relief this Honorable Tribunal may deem fit in the best interest of justice may also be granted to the petitioner.


alongwith his counsel Mr. Muhammad Abdullah Baloch present and submitted Vakalatnama, which is placed on file. Mr. Farhaj Sikandar, District Attorney alongwith Mr. Jamshaid. Chief Clinical Technician for the respondents present. Arguments heard and record perused.

Brief facts of the case as per present appeal are that the appellant was serving as Sweeper in Health Department. He was imposed major penalty of dismissal from service vide order dated 19.10.2015 (wrongly mentioned as 19.04.2015) on the allegation of registration of FIR No. 972 dated 29.09.2015 under section 379/34 PPC Police Station Cantt due to stealing of medicines

from hospital. The appellant filed departmental appeal on 31.10.2015 which was not decided within statutory period hence, the present service appeal.

- 3. Respondents were summoned who contested the appeal by filing of written reply/comments.
- 4. Learned counsel for the appellant contended that the appellant was appointed as Sweeper in Health Department in the year 2007. It was further contended that he was performing his duty regularly. It was further contended that the appellant was imposed major penalty of dismissal from service due to registration of FIR No. 972 dated 29.09.2015 under section 379/34 PPC Police Station Cantt. It was further contended that the allegation in the FIR against the appellant and others was of stealing of medicines from hospital. It was further contended that the appellant faced the trial of the aforesaid criminal case in the competent court but the Trial Court has stopped the proceeding in the aforesaid criminal case against the appellant due to none appearance of witnesses in the court against the appellant. It was further contended that neither charge sheet, statement of allegation was served upon the appellant nor a proper inquiry was conducted therefore, the appellant was condemned unheard which has rendered the whole proceeding illegal and liable to be set-aside and prayed for acceptance of appeal.
 - 5. On the other hand, learned District Attorney for the respondents opposed the contention of learned counsel for the appellant and contended that the appellant was caught red handed on the spot while stealing medicines from the hospital. It was further contended that the appellant was issued show-cause notice and after providing full opportunity of personal hearing, the competent authority has rightly imposed major penalty of dismissal from service upon the appellant. It was further contended that all the codal formalities were fulfilled therefore, the appeal has no force and prayed for dismissal of appeal. **ATTESTED**



Perusal of the record reveals that the appellant was serving in Health Department as Sweeper. He was imposed major penalty of dismissal from service on the allegation of registration of criminal case vide FIR No. 972 dated 29.09.2015 under section 379/34 PPC Police Station Cantt. The record further reveals that there is nothing on the record to show that the appellant was convicted by the competent court in the said criminal case rather it was claimed by learned counsel for the appellant that the proceeding in the said criminal case has been stopped by the competent court due to none appearance of witnesses against the appellant. The record further reveals that the appellant was imposed major penalty of dismissal from service but neither charge sheet, statement of allegation was served upon the appellant nor proper inquiry was conducted nor the appellant was associated in any inquiry proceeding therefore, the appellant was condemned unheard which has rendered the whole proceeding illegal and liable to be set-aside. As such, we partially accept the appeal, set-aside the impugned order and reinstate the appellant into service with the direction to respondent-department to conduct de-novo inquiry in the mode and manner prescribed under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of copy of this judgment. The issue of back benefits will be subject to the outcome of de-novo inquiry. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.

Reference your office letter No.9679-82 dated 23.09.2019.

The Enquiry Committee has investigated the matter thoroughly.

The concerned person Khuram Masih was working as sweeper at night duty in emergency department on the night of incident i.e 25.09.2015.

Written statements were obtained from the witnesses about the incident. They were labeled as under:

- 1. Mr. Said Rasool, Mr. Sharaf Hussain & M. Ramzan, (CT Pharmacy) were labeled as witness 1,2 & 3 respectively. (Annexure-A-BN respectively)
- 2. M. Shakeel, (Ward Orderly) on duty in Casualty Department with labeled as witness-4. (Annexure-D)
- 3. Mr. Nacem Abbas, Night Chowkidar at Main Gate of Hospital labeled as witness -5. (Annexure-E)

According to the witnesses 1,2 & 3 who always remain alert and awake during their duty in the night of emergency department, Mr. Khurram Masih was present on his duty during the whole night (especially when a criminal was caught red-handed at the Main Gate. Similar was the statement of witness-4 Mr.Shakeel-Ward Orderly who is supposed to be present on the entrance of casualty department. According to him, Khurram Masih was present with him in the Casualty Department on the night of 25.09.2015 when a suspect was arrested on the Hospital's Main Gate.

The most crucial statement was that of witness-5 (M. Naee a Abbas, Gate Keeper at Hospital's Main Gate who identified and verified that the person, who was arrested with a bag of medicines on that particular night, was someone else and not Mr. Khurram Masih.


