Counsel for the appellant present. Learned counsel for the appellant argued that the appellant was promoted from Physical Education Teacher (BPS-9) to Senior Physical Teacher (BPS-16) on 21.02.2013. He further argued that the appellant did Masters in the Physical Education in the year 1998 in 3rd Division and was then eligible for elevation to higher pay scales. He further argued that vide service rules notified in 2014 only those senior PETs were made eligible for promotion as DPE (BPS-17) who were second division Master Degree holders in the physical education. That vide promotion order dated 30.05.2014 officials junior to the appellant were promoted as DPE (BPS-17) but the appellant was ignored despite being senior for no legal reasons. The appellant assailed the said notification vide his representation dated 29.01.2016 which was not responded within the statutory period and hence the instant service appeal on 27.10.2016.

Points raised need further consideration. The appeal is admitted for regular hearing subject to deposit of security and process fee within 10 days where-after notices be issued to the respondents for written reply/comments for 02.01.2017 before S.B.
