

On perusal of the order sheet dated 02.11.2021, learned counsel for the petitioner had been directed to produce copies of the underlying judgements where under relief already extended to similarly placed employees by the Tribunal. Learned counsel for the petitioner was again directed on 20.12.2021 to do the needful to avoid dismissal of this execution petition for non compliance of the order. Whereas last order sheet (19.10.2022) reveals that the respondents have been burdened with the cost of Rs. 20000/- for non implementation of the Service Tribunal judgement. The respondent department could not deposit the cost of Rs. 20000/- and submitted application for remission of the same amount.

In view of the above, the instant execution petition may be posted before the Bench presided by the Hon'ble Chairman. Adjourned. To come up for further proceedings before the S.B on 28.11.2022.
