MAY GRACIOUSLY BE DIRECTED TO REGULARIZED THE SERVICE OF THE APPELLANT W.E.F THE DATE OF HIS INITIAL APPOINTMENT I.E 04 JANUARY, 2007 WITH ALL SERVICE BACK BENEFITS. ANY OTHER RELIEF WHICH THIS HONOURABLE TRIBUNAL DEEMS APPROPRIATE IN THE CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE CASE MAY ALSO BE GRANTED TO THE APPELLANT.

Respectfully Sheweth: -

That the facts forming the background of the instant service appeal are as follows;-

1. That the appellant was initially appointed in Skilled Development Center Khaki, on contract basis as Office Boy w.e.f 04 January 2008 and thereafter, the contract was extended from time to time without any break. Copy of appointment order is attached as Annexure "A".

2. That the appointment order and contract service as mentioned above was extended from time to time by the competent authority. Copies of time to time extension in contract to service is appellant is annexed as Annexure "B".
3. That finally the appellant has been appointed/ adjusted as Naib Qasid vide appointment order dated 07/02/2014. The services of the appellant were converted into regular service on 07/02/2014. Copy of appointment order of the appellant on regular basis is annexed as Annexure "C".
4. That some other similarly placed employees whose services were terminated by respondent No. 3 filed writ petition No. 382-A/2014 before Honourable Peshawar High Court, Bench Abbottabad which was decided in favour of the petitioner vide judgment dated 06/09/2016. Copy of judgment of similarly placed is annexed as Annexure "D".

5. That the appellant also filed writ petition No. 306-A/2013 before this Honourable Peshawar High Court Abbottabad Bench, which was decided in favour of the appellant. Copy of the judgment dated 25/04/2013 is attached as Annexure "E".

6. That the Honourable Peshawar High Court, Bench Abbottabad in their judgment 06/09/2016 held that "the instant writ petition is accordingly allowed and respondents are directed to regularized the services of the petitioners forthwith against their working positions with their salary since September, 2013 onwards and not to make any attempt under the garb of transfer or otherwise to deprive the appellants form legal/ fundamental rights". Hence, respondents department appointed the appellant on regular basis with all back benefits from the date of their initial appointment vide appointment order dated 10/05/2018. Copy of appointment order of order dated 10/05/2018 is annexed as Annexure "F".

7. That feeling aggrieved, the appellant filed departmental appeal respondent No. 2 for regularization of their service w.e.f the date of their initial appointment. Copy of departmental appeal of appellant is annexed as Annexure "G". Hence, feeling aggrieved the instant service appeal is filed inter-alia on the following grounds:-

GROUND:-

- (a) That conduct of respondents towards the appellant is discriminatory, perverse, against the law and the appellant has not been treated on the principle of equality under the mandate of Article 25 of the constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- (b) That once appoint of law is decided by the service tribunal or apex court, that must be made applicable to all the employees were similarly placed in

this regard judgment of Supreme Court of Pakistan 1996, SCMR-1185, 2005, SCMR-100 and 2009 SCMR-1 refer.


- (c) That the employees in pursuance of judgment 06/09/2016 of Peshawar High Court, Bench Abbottabad, have been regularized from the date of their initial appointment all service back benefits the said employees as well as the appellant was/ is sailing in the same boat and is similar and similarly placed employee. Hence, on the analogy of judgments of the apex court referred above, appellants are entitled to be treated alike and their service are to be regularized w.e.f the date of their initial appointment with all service back benefits.

- (d) That it is a settled principle of law that when the law prescribed something which is to be done in a particular manner that must be done in that

manner and not otherwise. The service law on the subject has also clarified that the previous service followed by regular service is to be counted towards present service.

- (e) That though the appellant is serving under the authority but their services have been declared civil service and the appellant is a civil servant being a transferred employee and the matter regarding terms and conditions of service are to be dealt with by this Honourable Tribunal.
- (f) That there is no prompt and efficacious remedy available to the appellant except the invocation the jurisdiction of this Honourable Tribunal.
- (g) That other grounds shall be urged at the time of arguments, with the permission of this Honourable Tribunal.



IKRAMULLAH KHAN, J.- Through the instant writ petition under Article 199 of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 the petitioners have made the following prayer: -

"It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that by acceptance of instant writ petition respondents may graciously be directed to regularize petitioners against their working positions with their salaries since September, 2013 onwards and not to make any attempt under the garb of transfer or otherwise to deprive the petitioners from their legal / fundamental rights."

2. Brief facts as spelt out from the petition are that the petitioners were appointed in the prescribed manner on different posts at Skill Development Center, established after the disastrous earthquake of 2005 by the Government of Pakistan, at Khaki (District Mansehra) and Kuza Banda (District Battagram) for a period of one year which was later on

extended to 31st March 2011. The centers were funded by Pakistan Industrial Development Corporation (PIDC) and were executed by Technology Up-gradation and Skill Development Company (TUSDEC) while Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa was responsible for provision of land, however, in the year 2006 both the Federal as well as Provincial governments decided through an agreement that TUSDEC will hand over these centers to the Province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in functional position. The Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa took over the charge of these centers on 18.01.2011 but, prior to that the Finance Department created posts in regular budget for these centers, however, the Provincial Government instead of regularizing the existing staff, advertised such posts in the newspaper, which act of the provincial government was challenged by the petitioners through writ petition bearing No.534/2011, being illegal, and this court had granted status-quo in the case and the advertisement was stopped, however, later on the petitioners preferred another writ petition bearing No. 306/2013 wherein two questions were taken (i) Regularization of the petitioners and (ii) Payments of salaries and finally the salaries were paid to them on the direction of this court by the Federal Government while the matter of regularization was referred to PIDC and TUSDEC for consideration with direction to make a

decision within forty (40) days after receipt of the order, which was not decided within the stipulated period rather the centers were once handed over to Provincial Government vide agreement dated 03.09.2013 and it was held that the decision of employees has to be decided by the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa as per policies.

3. The Provincial Government after taking over the charge of the Institutions was supposed to run affairs smoothly as required by law and to decide the fortune of the petitioners at the earliest but, instead created irrationality as on one hand it had regularized eighteen (18) colleagues of the petitioners vide order dated 07.02.2014 while, on the other hand, the petitioners

have been left.

4. On 31.01.2014, despite visit of the representative of Provincial Government for physical verification at Khaki District Mansehra and Kuza Banda District Battagram centers, after being satisfied, handed over the equipments to the concerned petitioners on 18.12.2013, Assistant Director Budget & Accounts vide letters dated 03.04.2014 and 17.04.2014 directed Incharge / Principal Khaki Center and Incharge / Principal Kuza Banda Center respectively to open government account in Bank on their own names, hence, the petitioners, being aggrieved of the discriminative behavior of the respondents which entails lack of legal rights of the

petitioners and transfer orders bearing No. 2033(1-116) dated 24.04.2014 and 2139(1-6) dated 17.04.2014, being based on malafide besides fake and fictitious, have been prayed for indulgence of this court through the instant constitutional petition.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners argued that the petitioners are serving in the Institution since last seven (07) years without receiving salaries and remunerations after September, 2013; that the petitioners are well qualified and have gained vast experience in their respective fields, who are well conversant with the affairs of Institution; that the petitioners have already completed their prohibition period successfully without any stigma and are serving devotedly, thus, cannot be expelled as approximately eighteen (18) colleagues of the petitioners have already been regularized through appointment letters and petitioners have been left aside, who are also entitled to be regularized in the same fashion; that since September, 2013 the petitioners have not been paid their salaries which is utter violation of the human rights and that the stakeholders of the government have visited so many times these centers and the petitioners were informed that they will be regularized against their working position very soon, hence, the petitioners are very much entitled to be regularized on their respective posts.

6. On the other hand, learned Assistant Advocate General appearing on behalf of the Provincial Government as well as the learned Deputy Attorney General appearing on behalf of the Federal Government though resisted the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioners but in rebuttal could not brought any document on record to show the reason that why the petitioners have been left out while similarly placed employees, who were colleagues of the petitioners, have been adjusted / regularized.

7. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners, the learned Assistant Advocate General and the learned Deputy Attorney General and gone through the entire file with their valuable.

8. Record reveals that the petitioners were appointed on different posts in the year 2007 through proper orders, issued by the Project Director, Skill Development Center some thirteen (13) years back for a period of one year on the basis of terms and conditions provided therein which period was further extended from time to time, however, after negotiation between TUSDEC and the Provincial Government when the centers were handed over to the latter, it advertised the posts for fresh appointment despite the fact that old employees were waiting for their bright future i.e. regularization of their services.

9. Without dilating upon other merits of the case, suffice

to say that not only this court but the Hon'ble Supreme Court of

Pakistan too in number of cases have repeatedly held that keeping in view Section 3 of the North West Frontier Province (now Khyber Pakhtunkhwa) Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2009 a contract or adhoc employee shall be regularized, which reads as follows: -

"3. Regularization of Services of certain employees. All employees including recommendees of the High Court appointed on contract or adhoc basis and holding that post on 31st December, 2008, or till the commencement of this Act shall be deemed to have been validly appointed on regular basis having the same qualification and experience."

10. The aforesaid section of the Act reproduced hereinabove clearly provides for the regularization of the employees appointed either on contract basis or adhoc basis and were holding contract appointments on 31st December, 2008 or till the commencement of this Act. Admittedly, the petitioners were appointed on one year contract / project basis which period of their appointments was extended from time to time and were holding their respective posts on the cut-of-date provided in Section 3 ibid).

11. Besides the above Section 4-A of the Act ibid expressly excludes the application of any other law and declares that the provisions of the Act will have overriding effect, being a special enactment. In this background, the cases of the

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petitioners squarely fall within the ambit of the Act ibid and their services were mandated to be regulated by the provisions of the aforesaid Act.

12. It is also an admitted fact that the petitioners were appointed on contract basis on Project posts but the said Project was first funded by the Federal Government and later on by the Provincial Government after allocating regular budget prior to the promulgation of the Act. Almost all the Projects were brought under the regular Provincial Budget Schemes by the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and summaries were approved by the Chief Minister of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for operating the Projects on permanent basis.

13. Apart from the above, it is also crystal clear that the petitioners were appointed as project employees and were in employment / service for long nine (09) years and that too from September 2013 onward without receiving salary and the Projects on which they were appointed have also been taken on regular budget of the government, therefore, the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa was also obliged to treat the petitioners at par as it cannot adopt a policy of cherry picking to regulate their colleagues by leaving the petitioners, similarly placed employees.

14. Reliance is placed on the case law enunciated by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the cases titled "Province of Punjab

Ahmad Hussain" (2013 SCMR 1547).

15. Apart from the above, the Hon'ble Apex court while deciding twenty four (24) Civil Appeals, involving identical questions of law, reported as "Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa through Secretary Agriculture and others Vs. Adnanullah" (2016 SCMR 1375) has held that the respondents were appointed on contract basis and were in employment / service for several years, and Projects on which they were appointed have also been taken on the regular budget of the Government, therefore, their status as project employees has ended once their services were transferred to the different attached government departments, in terms of Section 3 of the Act. The government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa was also obliged to treat the respondents therein at par, as it cannot adopt policy of cherry picking to regularize the employees of certain Projects while terminating the services of other similarly placed employees. The case in hand is not distinguishable from that of the aforementioned civil appeals, hence, on the same analogy

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the petitioners too are entitled to the same relief.

16. As the provisions of Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 embodies the concept of equality before law and equal protection of law and save citizens from arbitrary / discriminatory law and actions by the Governmental authorities, therefore, every public functionary is supposed to function in good faith, honestly and within the precincts of its power so that persons concerned should be treated in accordance with law as guaranteed by Articles ibid.

17. It is now well settled law that the object of good governance cannot be achieved by exercising discretionary powers unreasonably or arbitrarily and without application of mind but objective can be achieved by following the rules of justness, fairness and openness in consonance with the command of the Constitution enshrined in different Articles including Articles 4 and 25.

18. Not only from the facts and circumstances of this case but keeping in view the golden principles of law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the cases, mentioned above, we feel no hesitation to allow this petition. Hence, the instant writ petition is accordingly allowed and the respondents are directed to regularize services of the petitioners forthwith against their working positions with their salaries since September 2012.

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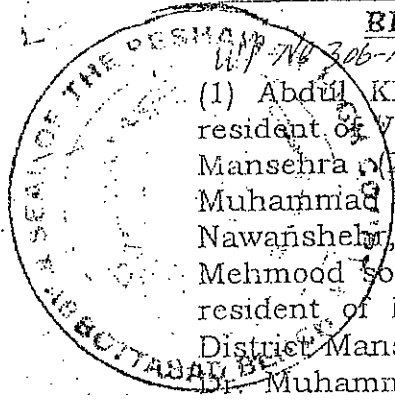

3- The brief facts, as mentioned in the petitions, are that petitioners were appointed in 2007 in TUSDEC projects for a period of one year and all the petitioners were carrying out their duties for about four years. After negotiation between TUSDEC and the Provincial Government, the Provincial Government advertised the posts for fresh appointment. The Government of KPK did not make the centers functional, therefore, the Govt. of Pakistan reverted the said centers to PIDC. Pakistan Industrial Development Corporation addressed a letter to Chief Executive Officer Technology Up-gradation and Skill Development Company for preparation of monthly wise break of salaries of instructors / staff and verification and necessary action. Hence, this writ petition.

4- Learned counsel for petitioners mainly argued that on completion of 6 months' probation period the petitioners were entitled to confirmation / regularization and after handing over of Centre to KPK they have not been paid the salaries. It was also argued that after reversion of centre to PIDC the salaries of petitioners have not been released.

5- In essence, the petitioners seek regularization of their services and payment of salaries. As factual controversy in the matter is involved, therefore, this Court would not pass any order and deem it proper to refer the matters to the respondents to consider the case of petitioners and decide the

same within a period of 40 days, on receipt of judgment of this court, and decision in writing may be communicated to the petitioners. It is however observed that the petitioners have served the project for about six years and have gained sufficient experience and the similarly placed employees stood regularize but the petitioners despite successfully completing their probation period are still working as temporary / contract employees. In addition to above, it is also observed that the appointment letter is neither on contract basis nor seems to be on temporary basis rather it specifically contains the condition that the incumbent shall be on probation for a period of six months and on satisfactory completion the probation period, services shall be considered confirmed.

6- In the light of the above, the three petitions stand disposed of accordingly.
