

APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNALS ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE IMPUGNED SENIORITY LIST ISSUED ON 27.06.2022, STOOD ON 31.12.2021, WHEREIN THE APPELANT WAS WRONGLY PLACED BELOW THE PRIVATE RESPONDENTS FROM 04 TO 26 AND WAS SHOWN JUNIOR TO THEM IN UTTER VOILATION OF RULES & APEX COURT JUDGMENT AND AGAINST NOT TAKING ACTION ON DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT WITHIN STATUTORY PERIOD OF 90 DAYS.

PRAYER:

ON THE ACCEPTANCE OF THIS APPEAL, THE RESPONDENTS MAY KINDLY BE DIRECTED TO PLACE THE APPELLANT ABOVE FROM THE PRIVATE RESPONDENTS 04 TO 26 AND MAY BE DECLARE HIM SENIOR FROM RESPONDENTS NO.04 TO 26 BY RECTIFYING/CORRECTING THE IMPUGNED SENIORITY LIST OF THE LECURERS BPS-17 ISSUED ON DATED 27.06.2022 AS STOOD ON 31.12.2021 AS PER RULES AND JUDGMENT OF APEX COURT. ANY OTHER REMEDY WHICH THIS HON'BLE TRIBUNAL DEEMS FIT AND PROPER MAY ALSO BE AWARDED IN THE FAVOR OF THE APPELLANT.

RESPECTFULLY SUBMITTED;

FACTS:

1. That the KPPSC has issued an Adv No.02/2011 dated 07.04.2011, where posts in different cadres have been advertised, in which the cadre of male instructor/lecturer has also been included. **(Copy of the Adv No. 2/2011 is Annexed as Annexure "A")**
2. That the appellant being eligible for aforementioned post applied for the said post along with other candidates. The appellant after qualifying test & interviews and other codal formalities was recommended on 01.08.2013 on the post of male instructor economics BS-17 vide memo dated 01.08.2013. It is pertinent to mentioned here on the Adv No.02/2011 first recommendation on the post of instructor/lecturer in BS-17 was done on 08.10.2012 of the candidate namely Shamsa Afridi vide memo dated 08.10.2012. **(Copies of Memo dated 01.08.2013 & Memo dated 08.10.2012 "B&C")**
3. That after the completing the recommendation in the cadre of instructor/lecturer BS-17 of Adv No.02/2011, the KP Public Service Commission issued the inter-se-seniority list of the recommended candidates of commerce subject in which the appellant was place at Serial No. 07 in the Inter-se-Seniority list, while a candidate namely Shamsa Afridi who was the first recommendee in commerce of the Adv No.02/2011 was at Serial No. 13 in inter-se-seniority list. **(Copy of the Inter-se-Seniority list is Annexed as Annexure "D")**
4. That the private respondents on the basis of Hon'ble Peshawar High Court Judgment dated 08.03.2012 in writ petition No.1289-P/2010 were regularized under KPK Regularization Act 2009 with immediate effect vide notification dated 31.12.2012. **(Copy of the Notification 31.12.2012 is Annexed as Annexure "E")**
5. That the some of the private respondents file different services appeals before this Hon'ble Tribunal for regularization w.e.f 01.01.2009, which were heard and decided by this Hon'ble Tribunal on 25.04.2019. The Hon'ble Tribunal dismissed the appeals of the private respondents vide the judgment dated 25.04.2019. **(Copy of Service Tribunal Judgment dated 25.04.2019 is Annexed as Annexure "F")**
6. That being aggrieved from service tribunal judgment dated 25.04.2019 some of the private respondents files CPs No. 2647-2744-2766-2838-2839 of 2019 before the Apex Court which were decided on 03.02.2020, similarly the superior court also dismissed the case of the respondents and leave refused. **(Copy of Judgment/Order 03.02.2020 of Apex Court is Annexed as Annexure "G")**
7. That the respondent department issued the tentative seniority list on which the appellant file objection petition, however without removing the objection of the appellant, the respondent department issued final seniority list on 27.06.2022 stood on 31.12.2021 in which the appellant was wrongly place and shown junior to the private respondents No.04 to 26 in the final seniority list of lecturer of BS-17. **(Copy of Tentative**

Seniority list, Objection Application and final Seniority list are Annexed as Annexure "H,I,J")

8. That the appellant being aggrieved from the final seniority list has prepared departmental appeal on 05.07.2022 and submitted the same on 18.07.2022 against the final seniority list, however that too wasn't considered within the statutory period of 90 days. (Copy of Departmental Appeal are Annexed as Annexure "K")
9. That the appellant has no other remedy except to file the instant service appeal before this Hon'ble Tribunal for redressal of his grievances on the following grounds amongst others.

GROUND:

- A. That not responding on departmental appeal within the statutory period of 90 days and the impugned seniority list are against the rules, law, illegal, unlawful and violation Apex court judgment, thus not tenable and liable to be rectified/corrected by placing the appellant at his proper place above than the private respondents.
- B. That a batch-mate of the appellant namely Shamsa Afridi was recommended on 08.10.2012 before the regularization date of the private respondents i.e. 31.12.2012 and according to rules & Apex court judgment "the date of recommendation of first batch to the competent authority for appointment shall be considered as the date of recommendation for all which means the appellant recommendation shall also be considered on 08.10.2012 and as such the appellant is senior to the private respondents No. 04 to 26 and is entitled to be placed above in the impugned seniority list.
- C. That the impugned seniority list is against the rules and superior court judgment and is liable to be rectified by placing the appellant above than the private respondents.
- D. That although the appellant was recommended by the KPPSC on 1.08.2013, but first recommendation of his batch mates was made on 08.10.2012 which means that the recommendation of the appellant is also considered as 08.10.2012 as per the Apex court judgment and the appellant is senior to all the private respondents which are regularized on 31.12.2012 and as such the appellant is entitled to be placed above than the private respondents by rectifying/correcting the impugned seniority list.
- E. That according to section-17 of APT Rules 1989, it is the legal right of every civil servant to be properly placed in seniority list according to his

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seniority position, but the appellant was wrongly placed in the impugned seniority, which is the violation of law and rules.

- F. That it is a cherished principal of law, that where a law requires a thing to be done in a particular manner, the same is to be done in that manner and not otherwise.
- G. That the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law and rules by wrongly placed in the impugned seniority list issued on 27.06.2022.
- H. That due to wrongly placed in the impugned seniority list the appellant will be deprive from his legal right of future promotions in due time due to which will suffer irreparable loss in the shape of pension and other monetary benefits.
- I. That the appellant seeks permission of this honorable tribunal to rely on other grounds at the time of arguments and produce any additional document if required in support of instant service appeal.

It is therefore most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.

2. The facts, as noted in the memoranda of appeals, are to the effect that the appellants were appointed to different positions in Directorate of Technical Education FATA on contract basis. Their service as such was extended from time to time. The Provincial Government promulgated Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2009, whereby, the service of all employees who were holding posts on contract basis or ad hoc basis on 31.12.2008, or till the commencement of the act were deemed to have been validly appointed on regular basis provided they had the qualification and experience for a regular post. The appellants applied to the respondents for regularization of their service under the Act *ibid*, however, the needful was not done. The appellants, consequently, filed Writ Petition(s) before the Honourable Peshawar High Court, wherein, the relief claimed was in terms of regularization of their service under the provisions of Act *ibid*. Pertinently, the respondents had stopped payment of salary to the appellants w.e.f 30.06.2010. The Writ Petition(s) were allowed by the Honourable High Court on 08.03.2012 granting the relief to the appellants for regularization of their service under the Act. Pursuance to the judgment, a notification was issued on 31.12.2012 by the respondents, wherein, the services of appellants were regularized with immediate effect. Aggrieved from the contents of notification dated 31.12.2012, the appellants submitted departmental representations which were not responded to, hence the appeal in hand.

3. We have heard learned counsel for the appellants in all the appeals, learned counsel for private respondents and learned Deputy District Attorney on behalf of the respondents. We have also gone through the available record.

Learned counsel for the appellants contended that the judgment of Honourable Peshawar High Court, passed in favour of the appellants while deciding Writ Petition No. 1289/2010 and connected Writ Petitions No. 1145/2010, 1252/2010, 2639/2010, 1870/2011, 2992/2011, 3244/2011, 3285/2011 and 46/2012, it was held that the petitioners shall be deemed to be regular and permanent employees of respondents' No. 1 & 2 department within the meaning of N.W.F.P. (Regularization of Services) Act, 2009 while the respondents were directed to issue requisite notification of regularization within a period of one month. The Notification pursuantly issued on 31.12.2012 was however, given immediate effect which was not in accordance with the judgment of the Honourable High Court. He further contended that no appeal against the said judgment was ever preferred by the official or private respondents, therefore, the same attained finality. On the other hand, a petition under Section 12(2) CPC was preferred in the year 2015 in respect of judgment in favour of the appellants which was decided in negative by the Honourable High Court on 10.01.2019. Learned counsel for the appellants further contended that the regularization of service of appellants, from the date of notification, had put in jeopardy the seniority of appellants and also they were deprived of due monetary benefits from the date of promulgation of Act *ibid* i.e. 24.10.2009.

On the other hand, learned counsel for private respondents attacked the appeals on the grounds that there was no original or appellate order which was questioned in the appeals, therefore, the same were not competent under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974. He further maintained that in the departmental appeals submitted by the appellants prayer was distinct than that in the service appeals and, for that reason too, the appeals were not

maintainable. It was also the argument of learned counsel that the notification dated 31.12.2012 was not questioned by the appellants and their purported grievance was pertaining to the same. The relief prayed for, therefore, could not be granted.

Learned Deputy District Attorney adopted the arguments of learned counsel for the private respondents.

4. It is a matter of record that the prayer in all the appeals is "to treat the appellants as regular from 1st January, 2009 and to release them the salary from 1st January, 2009 till the issuance of the notification dated 31.12.2012, and accordingly determination of their seniority". In the memoranda of appeals it is, inter-alia, noted that the appellants were entitled to regularization of their service from commencement of the N.W.F.P Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2009 and also entitled to the pay and other benefits from 01.01.2009.

It is abundantly clear from the appeals as well as arguments of learned counsel for the appellants that their grievance was essentially caused by the issuance of regularization notification dated 31.12.2012, with immediate effect. The payment of salary for the crucial period and determining seniority of the appellants are only the consequences of the notification.

5. It is also a matter of record that except the notification dated 31.12.2012, there is no other document/order of respondents which is impugned by the appellants nor any reference is contained to other documents, whereby, the right of the appellants has allegedly been infringed. In the said context, we have found that the departmental appeals/representations were submitted by the appellants on 21.03.2013 in Appeals No. 1085/2013, 1048/2013, 1074/2013, 1075/2013,

1076/2013, 1077/2013, 1086/2013, 1087/2013, 1089/2013, 1090/2013, 1091/2013, 1093/2013, 1094/2013, 1095/2013, 1096/2013, 1097/2013, 1098/2013, 1100/2013, 1101/2013, 1106/2013 and 1107/2013. Similar representations were preferred on 02.04.2013 in Appeals No. 1178/2013, 1179/2013, 1180/2013, 1181/2013, 1182/2013, 1183/2013 and 1197/2013. In Appeal No. 1039/2013 and 1040/2013 the date of submission of departmental representation was 05.03.2013 while in Appeal No. 1049/2013 it was 07.03.2013. In Appeals No. 1088/2013, 1093/2013 and 1099/2013 the departmental representations were preferred on 20.03.2013. Noticeably, Copy of the notification dated 31.12.2012 was duly forwarded to the appellants under the endorsement at S.No. 16. Their departmental representations/appeals were clearly barred by time in view of the above facts and Rule 3 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appeal) Rules, 1986. The said rule prescribed a maximum period of thirty days for the purpose. It is held in judgments of the Apex Court reported as 2012-SCMR-195 and 2006-SCMR-453 that time barred appeal before the departmental authority rendered the appeal before Service Tribunal as incompetent.

6. There is yet another aspect of the appeals in hand. The grievance of appellants revolved around the effective date of regularization notification dated 31.12.2012. The contents of the notification No. SOS-III(IND)TE/3-9/2012, unequivocally suggest that it was issued in pursuance to the judgment of Honourable Peshawar High Court Peshawar passed in Writ Petition, No. 1289/2010. In the said context, it is also useful to refer to proceedings initiated before the High Court by way of Contempt of Court (No. 96-P/2013 and 97-P/2013) in Writ Petition No. 1289/2010 and Writ Petition No. 1145-P/2010,

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
respectively. The said petitions were brought by the appellants wherein, on 03.09.2014, the matters were dismissed on the ground that the appellants stood regularized. It was also noted in the order that the grievance of petitioners was that they should be regularized w.e.f. 01.01.2009, however, the Honourable High Court did not prefer to take any further proceedings in the matter of C.O.C. Having stated so, we must note that the appellants knocked the door of Honourable High Court in its constitutional jurisdiction initially with the prayer for regularization of their service under Act, 2009. The issue was laid to rest by the court through an exhaustive judgment, wherein, it was held that the appellants shall be deemed to be regular and permanent employees of respondents No. 1 & 2 department within the meaning of N.W.F.P Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2009. The respondents were directed to issue notification of such regularization within a period of one month. In view of the appellants the judgment of High Court was not given effect in true sense of the words by the respondents who preferred to issue the notification with immediate effect. That being the case it was only the Honourable High Court which could implement/execute its judgment in case it was not done in proper manner by the respondents.

In the said regard it shall also be appropriate to refer to Rule 23 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Rules, 1974. The provisions contained in the rules make it obligatory upon the Tribunal not to entertain any appeal in which the matter directly and substantially in issue had already been finally decided by a Court or a Tribunal of competent jurisdiction. In the appeals in hand the violation/infringement of any term or condition of service of appellants also carries a question mark.

7. For what has been discussed above, we are of the considered view that the appeals in hand are not competent. The same are, therefore, dismissed hereby.



ORDER

Gulzar Ahmed, C.J.- Petitioners filed writ petitions in the Peshawar High Court, Peshawar which were decided vide common judgment dated 8.3.2012 in which the following relief was granted to them:-

"We, therefore, issue writ in favour of petitioners and against the respondents to the effect that petitioners shall be deemed to be regular and permanent employees of respondents' No.1 and 2 Department within the meaning of NWFP (Regularization of Services) Act, 2009 and the respondents are directed to issue notification of their regularization within a period of one month."

By notification dated 31.12.2012 the petitioners' services were regularized with immediate effect. The petitioners made application for contempt of Court seeking implementation of the judgment of the High Court w.e.f. 1.1.2009. The High Court did not allow the same vide order dated 3.9.2014. The petitioners then filed a service appeal before the KP Service Tribunal which by the impugned judgment, came to be dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners should have been granted regularization from 1.1.2009 i.e. the date from which the KP Employees (Regularization of Service) Act, 2009 was made applicable. We are not persuaded with such submission of the learned counsel for that the petitioners approached the High Court with prayer for their

regularization in service and the learned counsel when asked to show the prayer in the writ petition, he could not show the same as copy of the same has not been brought on the record. As noted above, the High Court vide order dated 8.3.2012 had given directions, compliance of which has been made by the respondent vide notification dated 31.12.2012 whereby the services of the petitioners were regularized with immediate effect. This notification came to be challenged in the service appeal and the learned Service Tribunal, after considering all the aspects of the matter, including previous litigation between the parties, came to the conclusion that such notification does not suffer from any illegality. Nothing has been shown to us, on the basis of which, the impugned judgment of the Tribunal could be found to be suffering from any illegality, perversity or impropriety. Even otherwise, no substantial question of law of public importance in terms of Article 12(3) of the Constitution is raised in these petitions. The same are, therefore, dismissed and leave refused.

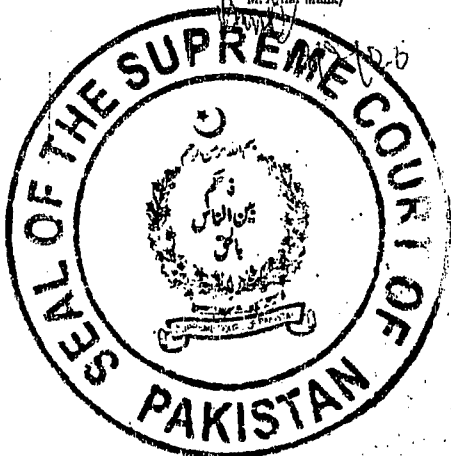

Reference to the subject, it is hereby requested to correct the tentative seniority issued dated 31/12/2021 on following grounds:

- i. That I was recommended from the commission as Lecturer (Instructor) in Economics dated 01/08/2013 from the advertisement number 02/2011 and placed at serial no.30 of tentative seniority issued dated 31/12/2021. (See Annex A my recommendations)
- ii. That my batch (from Advertisement no. 02/2011) consist 10 Lecturers in the tentative seniority, recommended on different dates.
- iii. That in the seniority issued, I am placed below to the lecturers regularized under the regularization act of 2009. They were regularized by the department with immediate effect dated 31/12/2012 and placed junior to the person already working in the department while their seniority was bound to follow the Section 04, of regularization act 2009 (See Annex B office order of fata). Section 04 of Regularization Act 2009, states that “

“The employees whose services are regularized under this Act or in the process of attaining service at the commencement of this Act shall rank junior to all civil servants belonging to the same service or cadre, as the case may be, who are in service on regular basis on the commencement of this Act, and shall also rank junior to such other persons, if any, who, in pursuance of the recommendation of the Commission made before the commencement of this Act, are to be appointed to the respective service or cadre, irrespective of their actual date of appointment”.

- iv. That they joined the department before my recommendation from commission and is after the commencement of the act, under which their services were regularized but the date of recommendation of Miss Shamsa Afridi is well before their date of regularization.
- v. That section 04 also ranks the “regularized employee” junior to the one whose recommendation of the commission is made before the commencement of the Act, irrespective of their actual date of appointment.
- vi. That In this case Miss Shamsa Afridi shall be ranked senior to the person regularized under the Act of 2009 because she was recommended from the commission before the commencement of the Act(See Annex C Miss Shamsa Recommendations). Further, Miss

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

With high reverence, utmost obeisance, and due deference, the Appellant very humbly solicits the instant Departmental Appeal to your good-self office, to the following effect;

1. That the Appellant is a naturally born bona-fide citizen of Islamic Republic of Pakistan & hails from a respectable family.
2. That the KP public service commission, for filling up the posts of Lecturers (BPS-17), made an Advertisement No. 02/2011 therein. (Copy of Advertisement Dated 30-04-2009 is Annexed herewith as Annexure "A").
3. That the Appellant being qualified in all quarters concerned, possessing M.Sc Economics with M.Phil, made an apply to the post and after being envisaged with the ordeals and inquisitions of selection process, the Appellant got recommended as Lecturer (BPS-17) vide Office Order No.PSC/SR 70412 dated 1-08-2013

from the batch of Advertisement No.02/2011 along with other colleagues of the same batch i.e Advertisement No.02/2011. **(Copy of the Recommendation Office Order No. PSC/SR 70412 is Annexed herewith as Annexure "B")**

4. That even presently, the Appellant is serving as Lecturer (BPS-17) at Government College of Commerce Peshawar in his own pay scale and always remained a punctual and dutiful fellow and have never left any stone unturned in performance of his duties and have always won felicitations and appreciations of his high-up's at certain junctures. During the course of his employment, no complaint written or otherwise has ever lodged or moved against the Appellant.

5. That it is pertinent to mention here that one Shamsa Afridi has also been recommended as Lecturer (BPS-17) vide Office Order No. KPK/PSC/SR.41612 Dated 08-10-2012 via Advertisement No. 02/2011. Keeping in view that Shamsa Afridi being a batch mate of the Appellant is junior to the Appellant in tentative seniority & final seniority list (as stood on 31-12-2021) however she has been recommended prior i.e. 08-10-2012, to those who have been regularized via Regularization Act 2009 Dated 31-12-2012, meaning hereby without violating Rule 35(3) of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission Regulation 2003, Miss Shamsa Afridi shall be rank senior to all those who have been regularized via the said Act 2009. **(Copies of Shamsa Afridi's Recommendation Office Order No.PSC/SR 70412 Dated 08-10-2012 & KPPSC Regulations 2003 are Annexed herewith as Annexure "C & C-1")**.

6. That while preparing the impugned seniority list by the department, with mala-fide intentions and violating the contents of *Sec-4 of Act*

2009 placed the Appellant junior to those, regularized via said Act 2009, however their seniority shall be reckoned under Sec-4 of the Act 2009.

7. That the Appellant has moved an application against the tentative seniority list with same prayer, however same was not considered in any way, regularization of regularize lecturers under Regularization Act 2009, is not the point of theme of discussion over here, but the discrimination, which meted out to the Appellant since his induction into seniority lists of the department, the Appellant was placed at S.No.30 in an illegal, unjust and void manner. **(Copy of the Application & Seniority List as stood on 31-12-2021 is annexed herewith as Annexure "D & D-1")**
8. That the grievance, the solace and redressal of which, the Appellant is seeking from your good-self office without disturbing the inter-se-seniority is that the Appellant shall considered and ranked senior to all those lecturers who have been Regularized via Regularization Act 2009, who were regularized far later than Miss Shamsa Afridi's recommendation, but discriminative approach has been made to deal the Appellant.
9. That from the supra-mentioned episode, the grievances, that comes into existence, the Appellant approaches your good-self office for ranking at right place in seniority list upon the following grounds, inter-alia;

GROUND:

- A. That the impugned seniority list Notification No. SO(CE&MS)HED/1-23/360(1-2) Dated 27/06/2022 (as stood on 31-12-2021) is wrong, mala-fide, grudgeful, immeritorious, and unlawful and is liable to be rectified / modified.


- B. That the impugned seniority list has prepared with mala fide intention in order to keep the Appellant junior to those who have been recommended on the basis of Regularization Act 2009, and avoid to follow the codal formalities and due process of law by the Higher Education Department KP.
- C. That laws of the civil servants on the subject matter is very much clear from its very face that “.....In recommendation to the department it shall be made clear that the inter-se-seniority of the recommendee is linked with other subjects and the overall merit position and zonal adjustment will be intimated on the compilation of interview in all subjects.....”.
- D. That it is a cherished principal of law, that where a law requires a thing to be done in a particular manner, the same is to be done in that manner and not otherwise.
- E. That the law and courts of the country have always encouraged and preferred that rules are to be followed and have deplored, discoursed and depreciated any violation or variation therein.
- F. That from all prospective, the impugned order is wrong and void and is liable to be modified and rectified and the Appellant has been ranked senior in seniority list to all those lecturers who are regularized via Regularization Act 2009 .of the Appellant be upgraded to BPS-18.

It is therefore most humbly prayed that on acceptance of the instant Departmental Appeal, the impugned Seniority List Dated 28-06-2022 be rectified / modified & by doing so, the

Appellant may kindly be place senior to all those lecturers who are regularize via Regularization Act 2009.
