

APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE IMPUGNED NOTIFICATION DATED 24-07-2014 WHEREBY THE 4% PROMOTION QUOTA RESERVED FOR PET CADRE HAS BEEN DONE AWAY IN VIOLATION OF SECTION 09 OF THE CIVIL SERVANT ACT 1973 READ WITH RULE-7 OF THE APT RULES, 1989 AND AGAINST NO ACTION TAKEN ON THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT WITHIN THE STATUTORY PERIOD OF NINETY DAYS.

PRAYER:

That on acceptance of this appeal the impugned notification dated 24-07-2014 may very kindly be rectified/modified in the light of the notification dated 13.12.2012 to the extent of allocation of quota for the cadre of the appellant i.e. PET cadre may kindly be restored and the appellant may kindly be considered for promotion to the post of SST BPS-16 with all back and consequential benefit. Any other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit, may also be awarded in favor of the appellant.

R/SHWETH:

ON FACTS:

1. That the appellant was appointed against the post of PST BPS-07 vide order dated 24.06.1997 and was subsequently promoted to the post of Physical Education Teacher (PET) BPS-15 vide order dated 31.10.2011 and has been performing his duties with devotion and up to the entire satisfaction of his superiors. Copy of the initial appointment order dated 24.06.1997 and Promotion Order dated 31.10.2011 is attached as Annexure..... A.

2. That other colleagues of the appellant belonging to other cadres have been promoted to the post of SST BPS-16 while the appellant was ignored. Having no prospects of promotion given by the department through the impugned rules dated 24.07.2014. Copy of the impugned rules and promotion notification dated 08.12.2020 are attached as AnnexureB & C.
3. It is pertinent to mention here that as per notification dated 13.11.2012 there was four (4) percent quota reserved for PET cadre in the promotion of SST BPS-16 with at least 5 years of service and having qualification in column 3 of the appendix to the service rules i.e. second class bachelor degree with two subjects as chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Physics, Mathematics, Statistics, Humanities and other equivalent groups from a recognized university; or M.A in education or Bachelor degree in Education from a recognized university. Copies of the old rules dated 13.11.2012 is attached as Annexure.....D.
4. That the appellant fulfills the above mentioned criteria and the petitioner has the requisite qualification to be promoted to the post of SST BPS-16 under the old rules dated 13.12.2012 but to the ibid impugned notification the promotion quota has been done away in violation of section 9 of the civil servant act 1973 read with rule-7 of the APT Rules, 1989. Copy of the Educational Testimonials is attached as AnnexureE.
5. That the appellant feeling aggrieved from the impugned notification dated 24.07.2014, preferred departmental appeal dated 16.07.2022 to the competent authority but in vain. Copies of the Departmental Appeal and Registry Receipt are attached as annexure.....F.
6. That the appellant feeling aggrieved and having no other remedy filed the instance service appeal on following grounds inter alia,

GROUND:

- A- That the impugned notification dated 24-07-2014 whereby the 4% promotion quota reserved for PET cadre that has been done away by the respondents is against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and materials on the record hence not tenable and liable to be modified/rectified.
- B- That appellant has not been treated by the respondents Department in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- C- That impugned notification dated 24-07-2014 whereby the 4% promotion quota reserved for PET cadre has been done away by the respondents is also violative of Section 24(a) of the General Clauses Act, 1897.

- D- That, the treatment meted out to the appellant is clearly based on discrimination and malafide and as such the respondents violated the principle of natural justice.
- E- That the respondents acted in arbitrary and malafide manner while issuing the impugned notification.
- F- That not allocating promotion quota to the post of SST (BPS-16) to the cadre of the appellant is violative of section-9 of the Civil servant Act, 1973 read with rule 7 of the APT rules, 1989.
- G- That the action and inaction of the respondents is violative of Article 38 (e) of the Constitution of Pakistan, 1973.
- H- That appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may very graciously be accepted as prayed for, please.



CONDITIONS

1. They will be governed by such rules or regulations as may be prescribed by the Govt. from time to time for the category of the Govt. servant which they belong.
2. Their service will be liable to termination on one month notice from either side in case of resignation without notice one month pay will be forefeited in lieu thereof.
3. They should join the post within one month of the issue of this notification.
4. Their extreme seniority will be determined in accordance with the merit of Departmental Selection Committee.
5. Charge report should be submitted to all concerned.
6. They shall be posted for a period of two years and will have to pass Departmental examination. In case the candidate failed to qualify the Departmental Exam, he will be given one more chance. If he fails again, then his services will be terminated. On arrival/availability of trained teacher the services of untrained teacher occupies the post will be terminated.
7. Their original certificates/Degree should be checked and verified from the concerned University/EBSE/RDE, and Islamic Madrasas concerned before handing over charge.
8. Service books of the teacher must be prepared complete in all respects before handing over charge.
9. The declaration of assets should be obtained from them immediately & bi-monthly record.
10. They are required to produce health & eye certificate from the Medical Authorities concerned before him taking over charge.
11. Charge should not be given to the over candidate. His case for relaxation has went to the concerned quarters.
12. For the transfer before the completion of tenure will dis-qualify him from the service.
13. No PA/Da is allowed.
14. An undertaking shall be obtained from teacher to remain holder upto the date that they will be posted in Deptt. for atleast 5 years unless he/they are selected by Public Service Commission for any post.
15. In case of person appointed as an untrained teacher he will have to pass requisite training examination within a period of 4 years failing which his services will be terminated.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Respected Sir,

The following facts are submitted for perusal and sympathetic consideration:-

That the appellant was initially appointed against the post of PTC BPS-07 and promoted to the post of Physical Education Teacher (PET) BPS-15 vide order dated 31/10/2011. That other colleagues of the appellant belonging to other cadres have been promoted to the post of SST (BPS-16) due to promotion quota while the appellant was Ignored, having no prospects of promotion given by the department in the impugned rules dated 24/7/2014.

That previously as per Notification dated 13-12-2012 there was 4% quota reserved for PET cadre in the promotion of SST (BPS-16) with at least five years service as such and having qualification in column 3 of appendix to the service rules i.e. 2nd class Bachelor Degree with two subjects as Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Physics, Mathematics, Statistics, Humanities and other equivalent groups from a recognized University; OR MA in Education or Bachelor's Degree in Education from a recognized university. That the appellant fulfills the above mentioned criteria and thus deserves to be promoted to the post of SST (BPS-16) under the old rules but to the ibid impugned Notification the promotion quota has been done away in violation of Section 9 of the Civil Servant Act, 1973 read with rule 7 of the APT rules, 1989.

Forgoing in view, it is humbly requested that on acceptance of this departmental appeal the Impugned notification dated 24/7/2014 may kindly be modified/rectified to the extent of allocation of quota for the cadre of the appellant i.e. PET cadre may kindly be restored and the appellant may kindly be consider for promotion to the post of SST (BPS-16) with all back benefits.




