Respondent department submitted office order bearing Endst. No. 4797-4801/P.B dated 02.12.2022 whereby the petitioner has been reinstated in service with immediate effect subject to the outcome of CPLA pending before the august Supreme Court of Pakistan. Learned counsel for the petitioner raised observation on the office order, stating that the judgement was delivered by Service Tribunal on 12.01.2022 whereas the petitioner has been reinstated in service with immediate effect i.e. after about eleven months of the judgement. He was required to have been reinstated in service from the date of Service Tribunal judgement.
