





Preliminary arguments heard and case file perused. The impugned order dated 28.07.2016 passed by the Assistant Political Agent Khar/Dy: Commandant Bajaur Levies according to which 50 officials including the appellant appearing at Sr. 37, were "Reinstated in service with immediate effect at the bottom of seniority with no back benefits etc". The impugned order was challenged before the appellate authority i.e Political Agent/Commandant Bajaur Levies and the appellate authority vide order dated 24.02.2017 dismissed the same where-after they approached for redressal of their grievance before the Federal Service Tribunal. The Federal Service Tribunal vide order dated 25.04.2017 declared that the order dated 28.10.2016 stands implemented and the petition has become infructuous. Thereafter, Federal Service Tribunal vide order 06.12.2019 "remanded all pending appeals to the respective competent authority to treat them as pending departmental appeals and decide them afresh after giving the appellant opportunity of personal hearing". Secretary Home being the respective competent authority decided the case of appellant and dismissed his departmental appeal on 03.11.2020. Consequent upon the dismissal of his departmental appeal, the appellant submitted the instant service appeal under Section-4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 on 02.12.2020 which is within the statutory period.

Points urged need consideration. Service appeal is admitted subject to all legal objections. Appellant is directed to deposit security and process fee within 10 days. To come up for arguments on 29.06.2021 before S.B.





SERVICE APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNALS ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE IMPUGNED ORIGINAL ORDER DATED 28.07.2016 AND THE IMPUGNED FINAL APPELLATE ORDER DATED 03.11.2020 OF RESPONDENT NO.2 WHEREBY DEPARTMENTAL REPRESENTATION OF THE APPELLANT WAS UNLAWFULLY DISMISSED.

PRAYER:

On acceptance of the instant appeal, by modifying the impugned original order dated 28.07.2016 and setting aside the impugned final appellate order dated 03.11.2020, the appellant may be reinstated into service with effect from 20.03.2008 with all back benefits.

Respectfully Sheweth,

Facts giving rise to the present appeal are as under:-

1. That the appellant alongwith others were appointed as Sepoys in the Respondent Department. Since the date of taking over charge appellant was not

proceeded against departmentally and was not subjected even to any minor penalty thus, rendered meritorious service to the department to the entire satisfaction of the high-ups.

2. That while discharging his duty against the said post, all of sudden vide order dated 20.03.2008 appellant alongwith others were visited with major penalty of dismissal from service, against which they availed the departmental remedy followed by the Service Appeals before the Federal Service Tribunal, Islamabad. Since all the appeals were almost identical in their characteristics, having similar facts involving common question of law, therefore, the same were disposed off jointly through a consolidated judgment dated 11.05.2015 (*Annex:-A*). The operative part of the judgment is reproduced herein below:-

“15. Consequently upon what has been discussed above, we are of the considered view that the impugned orders whether verbal or written, are not sustainable in the eyes of law as they are in violation of the dictum laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan. The impugned orders are, therefore, accordingly set aside and resultantly the instant appeals are accepted and the appellants are ordered to be reinstated into service from the date of impugned orders. However, the question of back benefits shall be decided by the competent authority in accordance with the instructions contained at Serial No. 155, VoI.II of Civil Establishment Code (Estacode, 2007 Edition), and the dictum of law as laid down in judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan, reported as 2010 SMCR 11.”

3. That Respondent/Department being dissatisfied from the Judgment assailed the same before the Hon'ble Apex Court by way of filling CPLAs which came up for final adjudication on 20.10.2015 and the Apex Court was pleased to uphold (*Annex:-B*) the Judgment dated 11.05.2015 of the learned Federal Service Tribunal by directing the Respondents to hold an inquiry as per the law and proceed to take appropriate action after issuance of notices to the Respondents/Appellants. It was further maintained that after the inquiry if any adverse action is taken against the Respondents/appellant they may approach the appropriate forum with further directions that the issue of back benefits of the respondents/appellants shall be depended upon the inquiry conducted and the result thereof.
4. That pursuant to which Respondents/Department reinstated the appellant into service with immediate effect vide office order dated 08.12.2015 and thereby

constituted Inquiry Committee to probe into the matter. It is clarified that in continuation of the order *ibid*, another office order dated 11.12.2015 was issued whereby it was held that the reinstatement order of the 242 Levies/Khasadar personnel is only for the purpose of conducting of proper inquiry and till finalization of the inquiry none of them will be entitled for any financial or other benefits including back benefits.

5. That eventually, the Inquiry Committee conducted the inquiry and submitted its Findings (*Annex:-C*) to the competent authority which are as under:-

- i. The competent authority may take action/ decision in the light of available record which is placed in the main file on serial numbers as mentioned in the notification *ibid* and which is also summarized in Para No.7/N above and remove/dismiss those who remained absent from duty.*
- ii. The Competent Authority may keep in consideration the pervious precedents where some other Levies personnel who were dismissed/removed alongwith the Levy personnel who are now under subject inquiry, the earlier had already been reinstated into service within pervious year or two.*
- iii. The Competent Authority may also keep into notice the situation prevailed during 2007 to 2010 which also pertinent from their written statements and expressed in their personal hearing that it was next to impossible to compete with huge number of miscreants with almost no resources in such a situation, sympathetic consideration may be given to theses 242 Levy personnel and to be reinstated in service with immediate effect subject to the certification of the superior officers wherein each and every person may be passed through verification process, necessary refreshing course/training and probation period.*
- iv. The Competent Forum/ Authority may take any other decision in light of the above points if agreed and which is best public interest."*

Pursuant to which appellant alongwith other though were reinstated into service vide impugned original order dated 28.07.2016 (*Annex:-D*) but with immediate effect with further burden to keep them at the bottom of the seniority list which is not only against the recommendation of the Inquiry Committee but also unlawful and discriminatory.

6. That appellant being aggrieved from the impugned original order dated 28.07.2016, moved a Representation to the Respondents/Department on 29.07.2016 which was not responded thus the appellant filed Service Appeal before the Federal Service Tribunal, Islamabad which was disposed of with directions to Respondents to pass an appropriate order upon the pending Departmental Representation of the appellant strictly in accordance with law but not later than one month. Respondents failed to comply with the direction of the Federal Service Tribunal hence, appellant alongwith other again filed Service Appeal before the Federal Service Tribunal, Islamabad wherein during pendency of their respective appeals the counsel for the Respondents apprised the Tribunal in respect of the office order dated 24.02.2017 (*Annex:-E*) therein Departmental Representation of the appellant alongwith other were dismissed, when counsel for the appellant was confronted he intended to have challenged the same through fresh appeals, resultantly the Service Appeal was disposed off vide order sheet dated 25.04.2017 (*Annex:-F*).
7. That thereafter having no other efficacious and adequate remedy appellant alongwith other invoked the jurisdiction of the Federal Service Tribunal, Islamabad by preferring their respective Service Appeals. In the meantime, Federal Government through 25th Constitutional Amendment, passed in May, 2018 paved the way for merger of FATA in the Province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. As a result the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa issued an Ordinance-I of 2019. Furthermore, on 12.03.2019 the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa promulgated two Ordinances whereby the Federal Levy Force and Khassadar Force, stood Provincialized. Therefore, by virtue of judgment dated 04.12.2019 (*Annex:-G*) which lead to Review Petitions remanded back to the Competent Authority/Respondent No.2 to treat the same as Departmental Appeals and decided fresh after giving the appellants opportunity of personal hearing.
8. That after obtaining the attested copies of the judgment *ibid* appellant provided the same alongwith other relevant record to the Respondent No.2 for further legal remedies, who vide impugned final appellate order dated 03.11.2020 (*Annex:-H*) turned down the relief sought without giving appellant a meaningful chance of personal hearing and that too with applying judicial mind.
9. That appellant, being aggrieved of the impugned appellate order *ibid*, files this appeal, *inter-alia*, on the following grounds:-

Grounds:

- A. That Respondents have not treated appellant in accordance with law, rules and policy on subject and acted in violation of Article 4 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 and unlawfully issued the impugned appellate order and refused to allow the back benefits to the appellant, which is unjust, unfair and hence not sustainable in the eye of law.
- B. That the appellant was dismissed from service on account of the charge of alleged absence from duty. The appellant's absence from duty till the date of reinstatement was neither willful nor deliberate rather appellant was unlawfully shown absent from duty as he had been performing his duties during that days as is evident from the Affidavit (*Annex:-I*). It is momentous to apprise that dismissal orders of appellant and others was/were set aside by the Federal Service Tribunal by reinstating them into service from the date of impugned orders which were maintained by the Hon'ble Apex Court. It is further adduced that as per contents of the verdict *ibid*, the question of the back benefits had to be resolved in accordance with the instructions contained at Serial No.155, Vol.II of Civil Establishment Code (Estacode, 2007 Edition) and the dictum as laid down in judgment of the Hon'ble Apex Court reported in **2010 SCMR 11**. Therefore, this crucial aspect of the matter was outright discarded by the Appellate Authority/Respondent No.2 without conducting an inquiry into the matter that whether during that period appellant was running any business or otherwise hence, the Respondents were supposed to conduct an inquiry into matter as per the directions of the Hon'ble fora.
- C. That clear contravention of Section-17 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Acts, 1973 has been made which caters for:- *“Provided further that where a civil servant has, under an order which is later set aside, been dismissed or removed from service or reduced in rank, he shall, on setting aside of such order, be entitled to such arrears of pay as the authority setting aside such order may determine.* The learned Federal Service Tribunal, Islamabad left no room for any uncertainty regarding the seniority of the appellant as he was reinstated into service from the date of imposition of major penalty of dismissal from service. Furthermore, during that period appellant had got no other employment or engaged in any profitable business as is evident from the Affidavit (*Annex:-J*) which was also provided at the time of personal hearing to the Appellate Authority/Respondent No.2 but the same was not appreciated.

- D. That the appellant is entitled to back benefits as the other colleagues of the appellant similarly placed were reinstated into service as mentioned in the findings of the Inquiry Committee and they were also allowed the same. Therefore, the impugned final appellate order dated 03.11.2020 is against the principle of consistency and equality before law and thus is not sustainable.
- E. That as per Article-13 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973 read with Section-26 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 "*No person shall be prosecuted or punished for the offence more than once,*" therefore, appellant by means of impugned final appellate order dated 03.11.2020 was not only denied the arrears but was also subjected to lower position in seniority hence, the same amounts to *double jeopardy* and is thus ultra vires of the Constitutional mandate and as such is liable to be struck down.
- F. That the refusal to the appellant of the same relief which has already been granted to the other colleagues of the appellant is an act of utter discrimination in violation of Article-25 read with Article-27 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan-1973 and therefore cannot be maintained under the law of the land.
- G. That Article-10A of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 read with Section-16 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973 provides for the right of fair trial as per prescribed law and Rules. Even the meaningful opportunity of personal hearing was not provided to appellant and issued the impugned final appellate order dated 03.11.2020 and dismissed the Departmental Appeal of the appellate that too without any cogent reasons hence appellant was condemned unheard, thus the impugned appellate order is void, ab-initio as well as against the principle of natural justice. Furthermore, Rule-5 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant (Appeals) Rules, 1986 stipulates that:-

"5.(1) The appellate authority, after making such further inquiry or calling for such information or record or giving the appellant an opportunity of being heard, as it may consider necessary, shall determine-

- (a) Whether the facts on which the order appealed against was based have been established.*
- (b) Whether the facts established afford sufficient grounds for taking action; and*

(c) *Whether the penalty is excessive, adequate or inadequate.*

Therefore, the mandatory requirements of the cited Rule have been bypassed by the appellate authority/Respondent by issuing impugned final appellate order dated 03.11.2020 which is clear negation of the set procedure.


- H. That the bare reading of the Section-17 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant Act, 1973 reveals that the word "may" has been used which makes the Competent Authority/Respondent No.2 responsible to exercise the discretion fairly and in structured manner as prescribed by the law. Under the law when something is required to be done in a manner then the same must be done in the required manner.
- I. That as per Section-16 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant Act, 1973 "*A civil servant shall be liable to prescribed disciplinary action and penalties in accordance with the prescribed procedure.*" Procedure has been embodied in the Government Servants (Efficiency and Discipline) Rules, 1973. Moreover, a civil servant cannot be treated against the prescribed procedure/law, until and unless he contravenes the provision of Rule-2(4) which defines "misconduct". The Respondents have imposed upon the major penalties upon the appellant by way of impugned final appellate order dated 03.11.2020 irrespective of the fact that the same does not cover the definition of the misconduct. Thus the penalty imposed upon the appellant does not come within the ambit of Rule- 4 of the Rules *ibid*.
- J. That the appellant was not issued any Charge Sheet, Statement of Allegations and Show Cause Notice which are mandatory requirements of law for imposition of any penalty upon the civil servant. Thus without wriggling out the conditions as prescribed by law, the impugned appellate order is highly arbitrary, unlawful and hence cannot be sustained under any canons of law, justice and fair-play.
- K. That period of absence from duty has already been treated as extraordinary leave without pay meaning thereby that the said period has been regularized and when the civil servant is considered on leave then he could not be treated absent from duty, therefore, the impugned appellate is illegal, unlawful and hence not sustainable in the eye of law.

- L. That there is no provision in the law, rules regulating the seniority of the Levies/ Khassadar Force which provide placing of an employee at the bottom of the Seniority List on his reinstatement in service with effect from the date of imposition of penalty. It is inalienable right of the appellant under the law to be dealt with under the law, therefore, the impugned appellate order of the Respondents of placing appellant at the bottom of the Seniority List is contravention of the above provisions.
- M. That appellant would like to offer some other grounds during the course of arguments.

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that the instant appeal may graciously be accepted as prayed for above.

Any other relief as deemed appropriate in the circumstances of case not specifically asked for, may also be granted to appellant.

1. Whereas, the above captioned appeals along with Miscellaneous Petitions having identical question of Law and facts have been clubbed together.
2. And whereas, Appellants have impugned orders of Political Agent/Commandant Levy Force Bajaur dated 29.04.2016, 14.06.2016 and 28.07.2016, regarding placement of their services at the bottom of seniority list and withholding of back benefits.
3. And whereas, during militancy in Bajaur Agency, 242 personnel of Levy/Khassadars including appellants were removed from service due to absconding/desertion from duties. In compliance with Supreme Court of Pakistan Judgment dated 20.10.2015, appellants were reinstated and a Departmental Enquiry was conducted vide order dated 08.12.2015. Consequent upon recommendation of the Enquiry Committee, appellants reinstated in service with immediate effect and placed them at the bottom of Seniority with no Back Benefits etc vide order dated 29.04.2016, 14.06.2016 and 28.07.2016. The intermission period in between their termination and reinstatement was treated as leave without pay.

4. And whereas, aggrieved from the order of Political Agent, the appellants filed appeals in the Hon'ble Federal Service Tribunal, Islamabad. Federal Service Tribunal vide judgment dated 04.12.2019 remanded Appeals/Misc: Petitions/Review petitions to the Competent Authority to treat it as Departmental Appeals and decide it afresh after giving the appellant opportunity of personal hearing

5. And whereas, appellants were called for hearing by the Committee on 20.10.2020 and heard in person. the record of the case perused

6. And whereas, after merger of erstwhile FATA with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa the Home & Tribal Affairs, Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has been entrusted with the affairs of the Levies & Khassadars.

7. And whereas, appellants assailed the orders of the Political Agent Bajaur dated 29.04.2016, 14.06.2016 and 28.07.2016 and argued that respondent department has placed them at the bottom of seniority list and also withheld Back Benefits. They further contended that imposition of two penalties simultaneously are unlawful and needs to be cancelled.

8. Now therefore, the appellants did not performed duty during period of their termination and reinstatement, hence it would be unfair/injustice to treat them at par with those Levy/Khassadar personnel who performed duties perfectly and remained on front line with the Security Agencies in war against terrorism and offered sacrifices for the Nation. Therefore, orders of the Political Agent dated 29.04.2016, 14.06.2016 and 28.07.2016 are upheld and instant appeals are dismissed.

JUDGMENT

SYED RAFIQUE HUSSAIN SHAH, MEMBER: - Since all the titled appeals are almost identical in their characteristics, having similar facts and involving common questions of law, therefore, we intend to dispose them off jointly through this single judgment, to be recorded in the instant appeal No.16(P)CS/2014.

2. Briefly, the appellants started their career as Sepoy in Bajaur Levies, Bajaur Agency, Khyber Pukhtoonkhwa. The period spreading over 2007 onward was very turbulent for the said region and the whole area remained under the constant raids and attacks of the miscreants who had taken shelter in the neighbouring Afghanistan. The life of the people of the area became so unsafe that majority of them migrated to down districts for the protection of their life, property and honour. The personnel of security forces i.e. local levies, etc. also remained under threat and attacks of the militants. Suicide attacks, bomb blasts and abduction for ransom became fashion of the day. The people of the area had to face great hardships and miseries. The Levy personnel who are normally not well-equipped used to come under the attack of the militants as they were deployed on front line at different security posts spreading alongwith the boarder.

3. It is alleged that the Levy Force could not properly resist the onslaught of the militants and did not fight the miscreants with courage rather they surrendered to the miscreants after laying down their arms to display their cowardice. On this allegation quite a large number of Levy personnel were terminated from their service. So many persons were sent home through verbal orders while so many others were terminated from service without conducting proper inquiry against them.

4. In this background, the affectees firstly approached their authority for reinstatement in service, denying the allegations of cowardice

against them. But on failure to get relief from the authority, they knocked the door of this Tribunal where their grievances were redressed accordingly on the ground that the authority proceeded against them without following the procedure required for dismissal of civil servants. In so many cases the concerned department of government failed to get the verdict of the Federal Service Tribunal reversed. In all those cases it was laid down that a civil servant could not be imposed major penalty of dismissal from service without holding a regular inquiry. So many cases were sent back to authority for conducting *denovo* inquiry against the accused officials but the directions of the Tribunal were not followed in letter and spirit. The authority on the strength of its might again repeated similar orders. So, for quite some time legal battle between the poor Levy personnel and the mighty political authority continued.

5. The titled appeals were also filed in the above-mentioned backdrop.

6. While assailing the authenticity, validity and legality of the impugned orders whereby the appellants were terminated / dismissed from service, the appellants submitted that the said orders were illegal because they were issued without any show cause notice to them and without conducting proper inquiry into the matter. It was further alleged by the appellants that neither the statement of allegations were issued to them nor charge sheets were served upon them and, as such, the dismissal orders were unlawful, arbitrary, void ab initio and ineffective against their rights. The appellants also made reference to identical cases *vide* which their colleagues were reinstated into service by this Tribunal. The judgments of this Tribunal dated 12.03.2013, 17.11.2011, 16.07.2010 and 15.02.2012 were cited by the appellants in support of their claim. It was categorically submitted by the appellants that in view of the judgment of the August Supreme Court of Pakistan reported as 1996SCMR 1185, they were entitled to the same benefits of the judgment, passed in favour of their colleagues.

7. The respondents vehemently contested the appeals filed by the appellants. In their parawise comments the respondents described the appeals as time barred and alleged that the appellants deserted and abandoned the important posts to the militants and in this way they

displayed cowardice and; thus, they were dismissed from service. The respondents, however, in their paravise comments admitted that show cause notice could not be issued to the appellants because after their desertion they disappeared and despite repeated calls they did not appear before the competent authority.

8. We have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the case file.

9. We have also perused the judgments of this Tribunal dated 01.03.2013 passed in Appeals No.184 to 190, 196, 197, 200, 201, 227 to 234, 241 to 245, 247, 256 to 267, 318, 340 to 345, 366, 367, 402 to 414, 419 to 438, 438-A, 439 to 443, 446 to 454(P)CS/2012 and judgment, dated 12.02.2015 delivered in Appeals No.197, 198, 200 to 203 & 120(P)CS/2011.

10. Mr. Misbahullah Khan and Mrs. Samreen Akhtar, Advocates appeared on behalf of the appellants and addressed their arguments mainly stressing upon the point that it was settled principle of law that where nature of charges were serious and where these charges were denied by the accused officials, then holding of a regular inquiry was mandatory and without holding such inquiry no major punishment could be awarded. In this respect the learned counsel for the appellants placed reliance on 2004 SCMR 316, 2004 PLC (CS) 524, 2002 SCMR 57, 2001 SCMR 1566, 2000 SCMR 1321 & 1868, 1994 PLC (CS) 1717 and 1993 SCMR 603. It was next argued by the learned counsel for the appellants that the appellants were neither issued any show cause notice nor they were provided any opportunity of personal hearing and, as such, in this view of the matter the impugned orders lost their authenticity, legality and validity. They made reference to judgments of August Supreme Court of Pakistan reported as 2000 SCMR 1034 and 1994 SCMR 2232 in this connection. The learned counsel for the appellants further pointed out that the dismissal orders had made large number of people jobless thereby depriving them of the means of livelihood without considering their viewpoint, which was against the constitutional guarantee imposed upon the State regarding promotion of social justice. Reference in this respect was made to 1994 SCMR 2232.

11. Mrs. Samreen Akhter, Advocate further pleaded the case of Gulab Khan and ten others regarding their claim of pension and contended that the said appellants were quite entitled to pensionary benefits.

12. On the contrary, the learned counsel M/s Iqbal Durrani and Iqbal Waheed, Advocates while appearing on behalf of the respondents gave much stress on the point that the appellants were Levy personnel and they were duty bound to resist the militants to their hilt but instead they showed cowardice in the discharge of their duties, hence, they were rightly sent home by the authority because there was no place of such coward people in the Force. In view of the learned counsel for the respondents the retention of the appellants in the Levy Force was not in the interest of the Force as their presence could demoralize the other Force. The learned counsel for the respondents, however, did not deny the fact that the appellants were not issued show cause notice and that no regular inquiry was held against them. According to their contention since the appellants were not available and had gone in desertion, it was not possible for the authority to send them show cause notices or to hold regular inquiry against them.

13. We deem it appropriate to mention here that in the judgment of this Tribunal in Appeals No. 197, 198, 200 to 203 & 120(P)CS/2011, dated 12.02.2015 the question of jurisdiction of this Tribunal had been settled, holding that this Tribunal had got jurisdiction to entertain and adjudicate upon the appeals of such nature. So, we feel it unnecessary to discuss the jurisdictional issue.

14. Admittedly, the appellants were charged for displaying cowardice, surrendering to the militants and deserting from their places of duty. These charges, no doubt, were very serious and of factual nature, which were denied by the appellants, hence, oral evidence was needed to be recorded to prove these allegations, onus of which was totally upon the authority (prosecution). In the instant appeals, no record of any inquiry has been produced rather it has been admitted by the respondents in their comments that no inquiry was conducted because the appellants were not available. To prove that the respondents had issued notices to the appellants in any shape, whatsoever, nothing has been brought on the file

to substantiate the said version. There is no record available on the file to show that disciplinary proceedings were initiated against the appellants but they could not be completed due to non-availability of the appellants. We find no record of any inquiry on the file which was conducted prior to the imposition of the major penalty. Needless to explain that as per consistent view of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan major penalty cannot be imposed without holding a regular inquiry. In this regard we may respectfully refer to the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan reported as 2008 SCMR 1362 wherein it has been declared that regular inquiry should have been conducted to unveil the reality and major penalty of removal / dismissal from service should not have been imposed, being too harsh, in view of the nature of allegations, which could not be substantiated without adducing any cogent and concrete evidence. It may not be out of place to mention here that the Political Agent / Commandant Bajour Agency as well as Secretary FATA Peshawar have already reinstated a number of officials of Bajour Levies against whom similar allegations of desertion from duty were leveled. In this respect orders of the authority dated 23.12.2008, 06.08.2009, 12.01.2010 and 20.04.2009 were referred to by the appellants whereby certain officials of Bajour Levies were reinstated into service by the Political Agent / Commandant and Secretary FATA Peshawar. For this reason too the appellants deserved equal treatment because discriminatory treatment against them is violative of Articles 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973.

15. Consequent upon what has been discussed above, we are of the considered view that the impugned orders whether verbal or written, are not sustainable in the eyes of law as they are in violation of the dictum laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan. The impugned orders are, therefore, accordingly set aside and resultantly the instant appeals are accepted and the appellants are ordered to be reinstated into service from the date of the impugned orders. However, the question of back benefits shall be decided by the competent authority in accordance with the instructions contained at Serial No.155, Vol.II of Civil Establishment Code [Estacode, 2007 Edition], and the dictum of law as laid down in judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan reported as 2010 SCMR 11.

MIAN SAQIB HISAR, J. Having considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, we are of the view that before the imposition of major penalty upon the respondents qua dismissal, regular inquiry should have been conducted in the matter and this is also what has been stated by the learned Tribunal. Thus the petitioners shall after issuance of notice to the respondents hold an inquiry as per the law and proceed to take appropriate action. This, however, shall in no manner be considered to be waiving off of the objection of the petitioners regarding the jurisdiction of learned Tribunal which according to the petitioners' case is lacking on account of the bar contained in Article 217 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973. However, after the inquiry if any adverse action is taken against the respondents, they may approach the appropriate forum available to them under the law. The back benefits of the respondents shall be dependent upon the inquiry completed and the result thereof. The inquiry should be completed within six months from today. Limitation is condoned in those cases which are barred by time. All these matters are disposed of accordingly.

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE INQUIRY COMMITTEE:

- i. The Competent Authority may take action/ decision in light of available record which is placed in the main file on serial numbers as mentioned in the notification ibib and which is also summarized in Para No. 7/N above and remove/ dismiss those who remained absent from duty.
- ii. The Competent Authority may keep in consideration the previous precedents where some other levy personnel who were dismissed/ removed along with the levy personnel who are now under the subject inquiry, the earlier had already been reinstated into services within previous year or two.
- iii. The Competent Authority may also keep into notice the situation prevailed during 2007 to 2010, which is also pertinent from their written statement and expressed in their personal hearing that it was next to impossible to compete with huge number of miscreants with almost no resources. In such a situation, sympathetic consideration may be given to these 242 Levy personnel and to be reinstated in service with immediate effect subject to the satisfaction of the Superior Officers wherein each and every person may be passed through verification process, necessary refresher courses/ training and probation period.

This is also surprising to note that when they (242 Levies Personnel) were dismissed/ removed from their services because of their absentees from duty or because of some miscreants attacked on a levy piquet or Civil Colony Nawagai which was entrusted to them for protection, or either they were frightening from the militants activities and left the duty places or they remained away from their duty because they were shifting their families to a safe places during the period to 2007 to 2010; the question is why they remained disinterested for such a long time to be reinstated. Explanation: A Levy personnel dismissed from his service in 2007, 2008, 2009 or in 2010 and he did not struggle to submit his appeal/ application for his reinstatement into service to his competent forum/ authority but intentionally remained reluctant from initiative shows their irresponsible attitude and kept themselves aloof from the affairs and they were waiting for godot"

vi. Keeping in view the judgment of the honourable Supreme Court of Pakistan and Para ii and iii of the general recommendation of the inquiry committee, all the 50 personnel mentioned above are recommended for re-instatement, please.




Being aggrieved of the order dated 28/07/2016, Said Habib Jan Sepoy Bajaur levies filed representation dated 29/07/2016 to secretary SAFRON which is now received to this office for passing an order.

Said Habib Jan Sepoy was summoned for hearing who attended this office on 21 /02/2017, he was questioned to explain his 08 Days, 04 Months and 08 years absence from duty without permission and to explain whether during absence he was involved in any beneficial business/Services, and to also explain the service break for the stipulated period.

The appellant/applicant did not explained his unauthorized absence from duty and he admitted that during the aforementioned period of his absence he had not turned to attend his duty nor has filed any departmental appeal before the political Agent/Secretary Law & Order FATA Secretariat Peshawar while according to the secret inquiry conducted established that he was running a Health clinic at Salarzai and then he went for business to Karachi till his re-instatement into service.

The appellant heard and record perused. The services of the levies personnel is governed by levies service rules and according to rule 14, there is only 10 days long leave provision in the levies service rules that too with the permission of the competent authority. In service discipline he can earn leave on his own right, but for its grant, he must have followed proper procedure provided under the rules. He was not supposed to avail any kind of leave entirely in his discretion and choice in departure to the rules and service discipline. Absence from duty without leave, even if not willful, but same being an act of disorder in service would constitute gross misconduct. His absence from duty was converted into extra ordinary leave without pay. It is well established fact that extra ordinary leave without pay causes break in service, more so during that period such person does not render service to Government, nor it can be treated as qualifying service for the purpose of pension and gratuity involving financial implication to the Govt, and it cause unnecessary illegal loss to public treasury.

In such like situation his services shall not be treated at par with those personnel who performed their duties perfectly, without break and regularly, and they should not be suffered and disturbed for a person who did not care of his service. Thus I am not inclined to interfere or modify order dated 28/07/2016, therefore, his representation/Appeal is hereby dismissed.



JUDGEMENT

RAJA HASAN ABBAS, MEMBER:-

These appeals and petitions can be categorized into appeals, implementation petitions and review petitions.

2. Appellants are ex-employees of Federal Levies Force. The Competent authority imposed major penalty of dismissal from service in most of the cases on charge of misconduct, whereas in some other cases they were retired. Aggrieved by these orders instant appeals were filed before Federal Service Tribunal which are pending decision. Notices were issued to the respondents i.e. M/o SAFRON, FATA Secretariat through Additional Chief Secretary, FATA and the concerned Political Agent/Commandant.



Comments/objections were received partially and in most of the cases notices were being issued for submission of the same. In the meantime, Federal Government through 25th Constitutional Amendment Act passed in May, 2018 paved the way for merger of FATA in the province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. As a result thereof Government of KPK issued Ordinance I of 2019 (later passed as an Act), in order to allow Federal Levies Force to continue their functions and to regulate and maintain them under the administrative control of Government of KPK. The force was renamed as Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Levies Force under Section 3 of the Act, comprising the Director General, the Deputy Director General, Commandant and all existing strength of members of the Levies Force, working in the merged Districts and Sub-divisions. Above mentioned Officers would be the Officers from Police. Section 9 of the Act provided for absorption of the members of Federal Levies in the Police. Section 9 (2) stipulates that "until their absorption in the police, the members of the Levies Force shall be governed by their existing terms and conditions of service under Federal Levies Force (Service) Rules, 2012.

3. It is important to refer to a letter from M/o SAFRON dated 24th April, 2019 addressed to Secretary Home & Tribal Area Department, Government of KPK on the subject pertaining to service matters regarding Levies/Khassadars, admitted in Federal Service Tribunal, Islamabad. It is imperative to reproduce para 2-3 of the letter:-

"2. It is stated that consequent to the 25th Constitutional Amendment, the erstwhile PATA and FATA have been merged into the province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Furthermore, on 12th March, 2019 the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has promulgated two Ordinances whereby the Federal Levy Force and Khassadar Force, stand provincialized. We had already written to the concerned Registrars of Courts and Service Tribunals to delete the name of Secretary, SAFRON from the array of respondents.

3. It is requested that these alongwith future appeals in connection to the Federal Levy Force and Khassadar Force, may now be addressed at your end while ensuring that reports/comments are submitted to Honorable Federal Service Tribunal, Islamabad on the scheduled date of hearings.

Another Memorandum from M/o SAFRON dated 18th March, 2019 addressed to Chief Secretary, KPK, Advocate General, KPK and Additional Chief Secretary, Merged Areas Secretariat states as under:-

"Now, therefore all the administrative, legal and ancillary matters, including service appeals, promotions and litigation in respect of both the forces i.e. Levies Force and Khasadar Force have been transferred to the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and its relevant forums from 12th March, 2019, the date of the issuance of above said Ordinance.

It is clarified that Ministry of States and Frontier Regions (SAFRON) has ceased to be the controlling authority in respect of Levies Force and Khasadar Force working in erstwhile FATA & PATA. All concerned commandants and others Forums may kindly be informed accordingly".

4. It was in this back drop that we had issued Notices to the learned Attorney General for Pakistan in accordance with Orders 27 Rule 1 of CPC to assist the Tribunal with regard to the point of jurisdiction as well s 25th Constitutional Amendment including interpretation of Levies Amendment Rules, 2013. After hearing the learned Deputy Attorney General and counsels of the appellants on 30.07.2019 a detailed order was passed. Relevant portion is reproduced:-

"7. We have carefully considered the arguments. Notwithstanding, the submissions made by the learned counsels, fact of the matter is that Government of Pakistan Ministry of States and Frontier region has made a formal request for their deletion from the list of the respondents in all these appeals with a further request that these matters may now be addressed to Secretary, Home and Tribal Areas Department, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

8. By operation of the Ordinance supra and 25th Constitutional Amendment, employees of the Federal Levies and Khassadar Force have become provincial Government employees. In several implementation petitions, which are pending at the moment before the Tribunal, provincial Home and Tribal Area Department have been issued notices of appearance, however, they have shown very lukewarm response. This is despite the fact that notices were served through Chief Secretary, KPK. We are cognizant of the fact that Constitutional and legal provisions allow continuation of proceedings before the Tribunal, however, we are concerned

about the practical aspects of the issue. Since the petitioners have become provincial Government employees, no proceedings can move unless the respondent Provincial Government discharges its legal responsibilities.

9. It is therefore, imperative and prudent to direct Secretary Ministry of States and Frontier Region to depute an officer not below the rank of J.S to appear and assist the Tribunal in the matter.


10. Chief Secretary KPK Government is required to direct Secretary Home and Tribal Areas Department to depute an officer not below the rank of Additional Secretary (BS-19) to appear in the pending proceedings before the Tribunal.

11. Advocate General KPK is directed to depute a law officer to appear and assist the Tribunal in the matter on the next date".

5. Since then Provincial Government of KPK has been represented twice by learned Assistant Advocate General. He was not present today nor on 18.11.2019. We have not received any written statement on behalf of Government of KPK since 30.07.2019 despite clear direction vide order dated 18.11.2019.

6. Today we have heard learned Counsels of the appellants who are also present in large number. Learned Counsels of the appellants stated that the appellants are poor low paid employees. Since their dismissal in 2007-2008, they have been running from pillar to post for getting justice. The constitutional amendment and subsequent legislation has further complicated matters for them. However, the Tribunal is still vested with the jurisdiction as already determined vide order dated 30.07.2019 and the appeals may be decided on merits of each case.

7. We are conscious of the fact that the appellants are facing hardship on account of prolonged judicial proceedings. It is however, more dismaying that the respective provincial authorities are not paying due attention to these matters, pending before us. There is an attitude of indifference towards these proceedings. We are afraid even if the pending issues are decided on merit, their implementation would be still more complicated as is the case even now. No meaningful proceedings can take place in the absence of a positive response from Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

8. We have apprised the learned Counsels of the practical aspects/difficulties and with their consent remand all the pending appeals to the respective competent authority to treat them as pending departmental appeals and decide them afresh after giving the appellants opportunity of personal hearing. These appeals are disposed of in the above terms.



Above Misc. Petitions were filed seeking implementation of judgement dated 11.05.2015 and 30.10.2017. Whereas vide order dated 30.10.2017 direction were given for deciding pending departmental appeals, vide judgment dated 11.05.2015 directions were given for reinstatement of the appellants. However, for the question of back benefits it was directed to decide the same in accordance with instructions contained in Sl. No. 155 of ESTACODE (Edition 2007 Volume-II). The Petitioner have been reinstated however, through these petitions the issue of implementation of the order for determination of back benefits was raised. The respondents, despite repeated notices failed to respond and provide the latest status about implementation of the judgement.

10. These petitions are also remanded to the competent authority for implementation in the light of the direction of the Tribunal in Judgements dated 11.05.2015 and order dated 30.10.2017. A compliance report be furnished to the Registrar of the Federal Service Tribunal by first week of February, 2020. The petitions stand disposed of.


This brings us to the above titled review petitions which were disposed of vide order dated 20.05.2019.


12. It is contended that the appellants were given to understand that with the promulgation of 25th Amendment, Federal Service Tribunal had been divested of jurisdiction. The provincial authorities were not inclined to listen to their grievances and it would be travesty of justice if they are left without any forum to seek justice.

13. Strictly legally speaking the petition could not be entertained because of the limitation of scope of review. However, keeping in view the facts that finer legal aspects of the issues arising out of the merger of tribal areas and their administrative setup in KPK were beyond their comprehension and they might not have got the necessary assistance to pursue their appeals, we are inclined to *accept* these review petitions. As a result thereof the appeals are restored to their original numbers. The directions in para 8 of the judgement would apply mutatis mutandis in these appeals also.


14. Copies of the orders be sent to Chief Secretary KPK, Secretary, Home KPK, Commandant Levies Force, KPK for ensuring implementation of the judgment and submission of a report within three months to Registrar of the Federal Service Tribunal. Copy of the judgment be also sent to Secretary, M/o SAFRON and Secretary, Establishment Division.

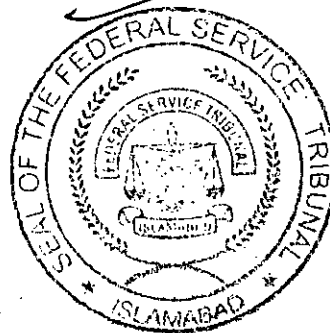

1. Whereas, the above captioned appeals along with Miscellaneous Petitions having identical question of Law and facts have been clubbed together.
2. And whereas, Appellants have impugned orders of Political Agent/Commandant Levy Force Bajaur dated 29.04.2016, 14.06.2016 and 28.07.2016, regarding placement of their services at the bottom of seniority list and withholding of back benefits.
3. And whereas, during militancy in Bajaur Agency, 242 personnel of Levy/Khassadars including appellants were removed from service due to absconding/desertion from duties. In compliance with Supreme Court of Pakistan Judgment dated 20.10.2015, appellants were reinstated and a Departmental Enquiry was conducted vide order dated 08.12.2015. Consequent upon recommendation of the Enquiry Committee, appellants reinstated in service with immediate effect and placed them at the bottom of Seniority with no Back Benefits etc vide order dated 29.04.2016, 14.06.2016 and 28.07.2016. The intermission period in between their termination and reinstatement was treated as leave without pay.

And whereas, appellants assailed the orders of the Political Agent Bajaur dated 29.04.2016, 14.06.2016 and 28.07.2016 and argued that respondent department has placed them at the bottom of seniority list and also withheld Back Benefits. They further contended that imposition of two penalties simultaneously are unlawful and needs to be cancelled.

8. Now therefore, the appellants did not performed duty during period of their termination and reinstatement, hence it would be unfair/injustice to treat them at par with those Levy/Khassadar personnel who performed duties perfectly and remained on front line with the Security Agencies in war against terrorism and offered sacrifices for the Nation. Therefore, orders of the Political Agent dated 29.04.2016, 14.06.2016 and 28.07.2016 are upheld and instant appeals are dismissed.

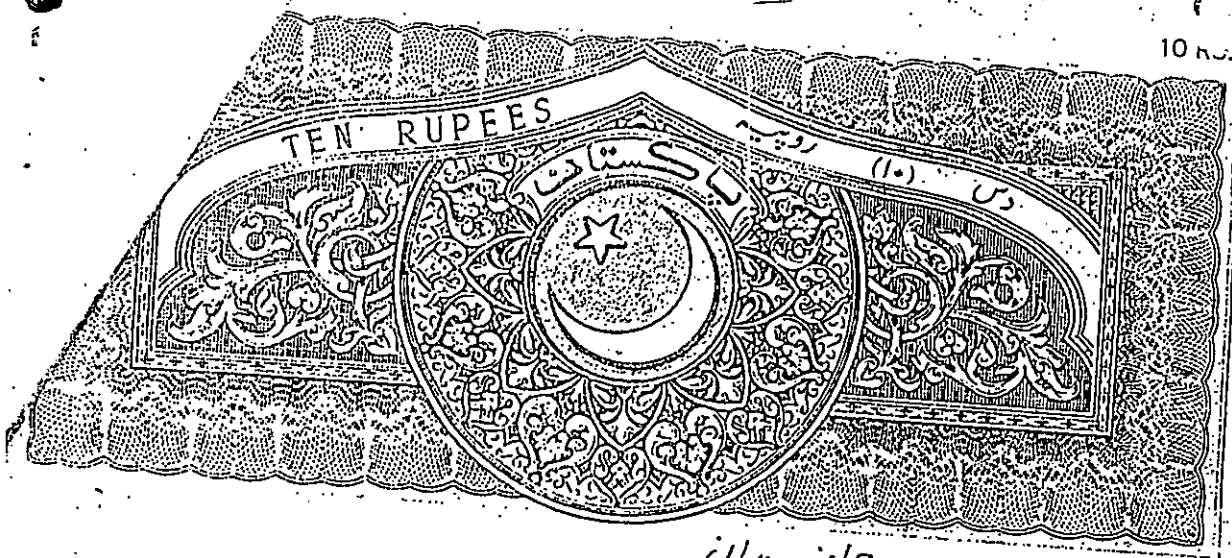
