


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

**PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS: -**

1. That the petitioner has not approached this honorable court with clean hands.
2. That the petitioner has got no locus standii to file the instant service appeal.
3. That the petitioner has been treated in accordance with law/rules/policy.

**Comments for and on behalf of respondent No. 2,3 & 4: -**

1. Pertains to record. The petitioner has been appointed as Naib Qasid, BPS-02 vide the notification No. 9102-5/Acctt: dated 22-12-2008 contrary to being appointed as process server (BPS-02) as contended in the service appeal.
2. Pertains to record.
3. Seniority list of the petitioner as well as other employees was issued from the office of undersigned, inviting objection against all, for redressal/resolution from the office concerned and if need be, are liable to be amended/rectified accordingly. Meanwhile advice was solicited from Planning & Development Department, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, vide this office letter No. 3360-3365/M, dated 06-12-2021, Planning & Development Department, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa vide letter No. SO(E) P&D/4-12/DC/Mohmand/2020, dated 14-12-2021 forwarded the requisite comments and the posts were declared to be on the strength of Deputy Commissioner, Mohmand. In pursuance of the same, tentative joint seniority list was shared by the office of DC Mohmand inviting objections if any, by all the employees. The private respondents No. 5 & 6 were on the top most position from Class-iv strength. It is pertinent to mention here that Petitioner had not filed any objection before the promotion committee assigned to carry out the promotion process of employees. Meanwhile, for the purpose of filling up of the post of senior most class-iv, employee, directions over the applicable rules was also solicited from Commissioner, Peshawar Division Peshawar, vide this office letter No. 15772/Acctt: dated 07-12-2021, over the relevant para. ***"note, for the purpose of promotion, joint seniority list of Qasids, Naib Qasids and process servers including holders of other***

holders of other equivalent posts shall be maintained with reference to the date of their matriculation or appointment whichever is later"). Commissioner, Peshawar Division vide his letter No.6/2/EA/2021/I/14619, dated 08-12-2021 forwarded the same to Senior Member, Board of Revenue, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Senior Member Board of Revenue Department, vide letter No. Estt:II/New/Seniority List/15229, dated 20-01-2022(copy enclosed for ready reference). Hence promotion of class-iv employees was made in light of the notification ibid and no violation of rights of the petitioner has occurred at the hands of the answering respondents.( Relevant Documents are attached)

4. Incorrect. The rights of the petitioner have not been violated, due process of promotion was thoroughly deliberated by all committee members and the private employees No. 5 & 6 being placed on the top most position in the seniority list were promoted against the vacant posts of junior clerk. It is further added that the decision to promote the private respondents No. 5 & 6 was done on unanimous basis and all the eligibility criteria was taken into consideration and given due weightage by the promotion committee.

5. Incorrect. Noteworthy to mention here that the petitioner had filed objection petition against the promotion of private answering respondent No. 5 & 6 on 27-01-2022 against the alleged(contended) illegal promotion of the abovementioned answering respondent and not at the time of Convening of DPC.


6. Incorrect. The petitioner's rights have not been violated and the private respondents No. 5 & 6 have been promoted on the basis of the notification by Department, Promotion Committee please.

**GROUND:-**

A. Incorrect. Department promotion committee has taken into account all the codal formalities while initiating process of promotion of employee and rights of all employees have been ensured.

B- N. The services of the petitioner are present at the disposal of answering respondent and throughout his professional career he has performed his duty, however, promotion of the private respondents is justified and the contention of petitioner is refuted.

In light of the comments on behalf of the answering respondent, the petition in hand may kindly be disposed off please.







- (b) Ten percent by promotion, on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness, from amongst Readers, Muharrirs and Record Keepers (BS-07) with at least five years' service as such

Note: For the purpose of promotion, joint seniority list of Readers, Muharrirs and Record Keepers shall be maintained

- (c) fifty seven percent by initial recruitment from the candidates of the district concerned.", and


- (c) against serial No. 11, after the existing entry, the following Note shall be added, namely:

PROMOTION ON REGULAR BASIS TO THE POST OF ASSISTANT, SENIOR CLERK, JUNIOR CLERK AND MOHARRIR AND CLASS-IV IN THE OFFICE OF DEPUTY COMMISSIONER MOHMAND TRIBAL DISTRICT.

There are total 08 posts of Assistant out of which 02 posts are filled and 06 posts of Assistant are lying vacant due to fresh SNE of 04 Assistants issued by Revenue & Estate Department vide No.SNE/DCS/2021-22/25745 dated 12.10.2021 and 02 Posts of Assistant are lying vacant in the Finance and Planning Department Mohmand Tribal District.

In terms of S: No. 3 of appendix attached with the Government of NWFP Revenue and Estate Department Notification No. 2074/Estt: 1/11/135 SSR amended dated 23.1.2015 (Annex "A") the method for recruitment has prescribed for filling the post of Assistant as following.

"75 % by promotion on the basis of seniority cum fitness from amongst the senior Clerk with at least five years' service as Junior Clerk and Senior Clerk in the Office of the Deputy Commissioner and Political Agent District Concerned.

In light of the above, 04 Posts of Assistant will be filled through promotion from amongst the Senior most Senior Clerks from the Seniority list duly signed by the Deputy Commissioner Mohmand Tribal District (attached as Annexure "B") and 02 Posts will be filled through direct recruitment whereas 02 posts of Assistants are already filled by promotion.

The 04 top most Senior Clerks as per attached Seniority List have the requisite length of service and fit for promotion to the post of Assistant on the basis of their Seniority/ACRs. The synopsis of their ACRs and certificate regarding non-involvement in cooperation/departmental enquires is attached as Annex "C".

PROMOTION OF JUNIOR CLERKS AS SENIOR CLERKS.

There are total 08 Number of Posts of Senior Clerks out of which 04 number of Senior Clerk posts will stand vacant due to promotion as Assistant and 01 post of Senior Clerk already remains vacant from the strength of the Finance and Planning Department and these vacated posts will be filled by promoting the Senior most Junior Clerks.

In the terms of S: No. 5 of appendix attached with the Government of NWFP Revenue and Estate Department said Notification (Annex "D") the method of recruitment has been prescribed for filling up the post of Senior Clerks as following.

"By promotion on the basis of seniority cum – fitness form amongst the holders of the post of Junior Clerk having a least three years' service as such"

The Seniority list of Junior Clerk (BPS-11) duly signed by the Deputy Commissioner Mohmand attached as (Annexure-"E").

The Seniority list of Junior Clerks (BPS-11) duly signed by the Deputy Commissioner Mohmand attached as Annexure-"G" and the top most 04 Junior Clerks will be promoted as Senior Clerks. They have the requisite length of service are fit for promotion to the post of Senior Clerks on the basis of their seniority / ACRs. The Synopsis of their ACRs and certificate regarding non-corruption / Departmental inquiries are attached as Annexure "H".

Advice / guidance over the promotion criteria / case of one Junior Clerk employee of Defunct FATA DC was sent to Home & T.As Department .But reply is still pending ,the seat is thus left vacant till receipt of final directions in the instant matter and is therefore, held in abeyance ,till final directions.

**PROMOTION OF MOHARRIRS AND CLASS-IV AS JUNIOR CLERK.**

There are total 19 Posts of Junior Clerks out of which Nine (9) posts of Junior Clerks are lying vacant due to promotion of 04 Nos Junior Clerks to the post of Senior Clerks and 05 posts of Junior Clerks are already vacant( 02-post in DC Mohmand office and 03 Post of J/Clerks in F&P MTD).

In the terms of S.No.5 of appendix attached with the Government of NWFP Revenue and Estate Department said Notification Estt:1/11/13S/SSRC amended dated 25/06/2019 (Annex-"I") the method of recruitment has been prescribed for filling up the post of Junior Clerk as following :-

1. 33 % by promotion on the basis of seniority cum fitness from amongst the Qasids, Nalb Qasids and Process Server including holders of other equivalent posts in the District concerned with two year service as such, who have passed Secondary School certificate examination from a recognize Board.
2. 10 % by promotion, on the basis of seniority cum fitness, from amongst the Readers, Moharrir and Record keepers with at least five years service as such.
3. 57 % by initial recruitment from the candidate of the District concerned.

In light of the above 04 post will be filled by promotion from amongst the Readers, Moharrir and Class-IV after fulfillment of all codal formalities. The Departmental Promotion Committee / forum will decide promotion from amongst the Moharrirs and Class-IV. 01 post of junior clerk will be filled by appointing the son of Mr.Zahid Ullah who embraced "Shahadat" during service on 06/12/2010 . The remaining 04 posts of junior clerks will be filled through direct / fresh recruitment. Seniority list of Junior Clerks. Seniority lists of Moharrirs and Class-IV duly signed by Deputy Commissioner Mohmand is attached as (Annexure "J" & "K").
