

APPEAL UNDER SECTION-4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 FOR ENHANCEMENT OF 30% PROMOTION QUOTA ALLOCATED FOR THE CADRE OF APPELLANT IN THE IMPUGNED SERVICE RULES DATED 15.04.2022 WHILE FOR THE OTHER CADRES 75% QUOTA HAS BEEN RESERVED FOR PROMOTION TO THE NEXT HIGHER SCALE AND AGAINST THE 10% QUOTA ALLOCATED FOR PROMOTION OF SENIOR CLERKS IN THE APPELLANT'S CADRE AND AGAINST NO ACTION TAKEN ON THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF APPELLANT WITHIN THE STATUTORY PERIOD OF NINETY DAYS

PRAYER:

That on acceptance of this appeal the action and inaction of the respondents by not enhancing the promotion quota of the cadre of appellant and illegal and unlawful allocation of 10% quota for promotion of senior clerks to the post of Assistant Superintendent Jail (BPS16) mentioned in Serial No. 5, column No.6 of the impugned Service Rules Notified on 15.04.2022 may kindly be declared as Ultra Vires, illegal, unconstitutional and ineffective upon the rights of the appellant. That the respondents may kindly be directed to amend the impugned Service Rules by enhancing 30% quota of the appellant's cadre similarly to the other employees and 10% quota of the Senior Clerks be removed. Any other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit that may also be awarded in favour of the appellant.

R/SHEWETH:

ON FACTS:

- 1- That the appellant was appointed as Warder in the Prison Department on 21.08.1993. That during service the appellant has got promotion to the rank of Head Warder and subsequently promoted to the rank of Chief Head Warder (BPS-11). Copy of seniority list is attached as annexure A.
- 2- That appellant since the date of appointment till date is serving the respondent department quite efficiently, whole heartedly and up to the entire satisfaction of his superiors and during the entire service, the appellant has neither committed any illegality nor any complaint whatsoever been received to the high ups against the appellant.
- 3- That the respondent Department issued Notification dated 15-04-2022 whereby proper service structure for the employees of the respondent Department has been approved/ notified and according to the said service structure the employees serving on the strength of respondent No.5 i.e. I.G Prisons, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar have been categorized in different cadres for the purposes of seniority and their prospects of promotions.
- 4- That, in the above mentioned service rules/structure the posts of Assistant Superintendent Jail shown at Serial No.5 of the appendix has been given the method of promotion under Column No.6 which is as under:
- (a) *(Thirty percent by promotion, on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the holders of the posts of Chief Head Warders, having Secondary School Certificate or its equivalent qualification from a recognized Board with at least five years service as head Warder and Chief Head Warder, subject to:-*
- (i) *Successful completion of promotion course prescribed for Assistant Superintendent Jail; and*
- (ii) *Clearance of mandatory departmental examination prescribed for Assistant Superintendent Jail;*
- (b) *Ten percent by promotion, on the basis of senior-cum fitness, from amongst the holders of the posts in service Senior Clerks, who possess minimum qualification or eligibility criteria prescribed for initial recruitment, with at least five years service as Junior Clerk and Senior Clerk, Subject to:-*
- (i) *Successful completion of promotion course prescribed for Assistant Superintendent Jail; and*
- (ii) *Clearance of mandatory departmental examination prescribed for Assistant Superintendent Jail". Copy of the Notification/Service Rules & letter for mandatory promotion course are attached as annexureB & C.*
- 5- That according to the above mentioned service rules 30% quota for the cadre of the appellant i.e. Head Warder/Chief Head Warder has been allocated for promotion to the post of Assistant Superintendent Jail (BPS-16) while the other cadres have granted 75% quota for promotion to the next higher scale.

- 6- That it is pertinent to mention that the cadre of Senior Clerk has also been granted/allowed 10% promotion quota in the cadre of appellant while as per Serial No.35, Column-6 the Senior Clerks have 75% quota for promotion to the post of Assistant (BPS-16) and 75% quota to the post of Accountant (BPS-16) in their own cadre.
- 7- That it is also pertinent to mention here that the appellant is belonging to the Uniform Cadre and the post of Assistant Superintendent Jail (BPS-16) purely falls in the Uniform Cadre and as such the cadre of Senior Clerk totally different and not related to the cadre of appellant. That the seniority of both the cadres is also maintained separately, therefore, the senior clerks have no right to be promoted to the post of Assistant Superintendent Jail (BPS-16).
- 8- That as per strength of the post of Assistant Superintendent Jail (BPS-16) the cadre of appellant is fully entitled to be enhanced promotion quota similarly to the other cadres who have been granted/allowed 75% promotion quota to the next higher scale which is evident from the service rules of the respondent Department.
- 9- That the appellant feeling aggrieved from the impugned service rules dated 15.04.2022 preferred departmental before the concerned authority but no reply has been received so far. Hence the present appeal on the following grounds amongst the others. Copy of the departmental appeal is attached as annexure.....D.

GROUND:

- A- That the impugned notification/service Rules issued vide dated 15-04-2022 are Ultra Vires, against the facts, law, norms of natural justice and materials on the record hence not tenable and liable to be modified/amended.
- B- That appellant has not been treated by the respondent Department in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article 4 and 25 of the constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973:
- C- That the treatment meted out to the appellant is a clear violation of the Fundamental Rights of the appellant as enshrined in the Constitution of Pakistan 1973.
- D- That, the appellant has been discriminated by the respondents on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated the Principle of Natural Justice.
- E- That the impugned Notification dated 15.04.2022 due to which the promotion quota of the appellant has been divided between the cadre of appellant and Senior Clerk is not tenable under the law and rules and would certainly affect the promotion quota of the appellant.

- F- That according to Article-38 (e) of the Constitution of Pakistan 1973, the State is bound to reduce disparity in the income and earnings of individuals including persons in the services of the Federation. That in light of the mentioned Article the appellant is on strong footing.
- G- That the respondents acted in arbitrary and malafide manner while issuing the impugned Notification dated 15.04.2022.
- H- That the cadre of Senior Clerk belonging to the clerical in nature and as such they have already 75% quota for promotion to the post of Assistant (BPS-16) and 75% for promotion to the post of Accountant (BPS-16), therefore, granting 10% quota to the Senior Clerks in the cadre of appellant is violation of the principle of natural justice and also violative of legal right of the appellant cadre.
- I- That the impugned Notification dated 15.04.2022 of the respondent department is violative of Section-9 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973 read with Rule-7 of the Appointment, Promotion and Transfer Rules, 1989.
- J- That the petitioner seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may kindly be accepted as prayed for.



Departmental appeal for Enhancement of Promotion quota allocated for Assistant Superintendant Jail in Inspector General of Prisons, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa similarly to the other employees who 75% quota for promotion in the same department

R/Sir,

With due respect, the following few lines are submitted for your kind consideration:

- i. That the applicant is the employee of Prison Department and is serving as Chief Head Warder (BPS-11) quite efficiently and upto the entire satisfaction of his superiors.
- ii. That the Service Rules of the post of Assistant (BPS-16) vide Notification of Establishment Department bearing No.SOE.IV(E&AD)/1-35/2012, dated 06.12.2012, provides for the promotion quota for Assistant (BS-16) at 75% while for initial recruitment @ 25%. **(Flag-A)**
- iii. That the Service Rules for Directorate of Reclamation and Probation issued by Home and Tribal Affairs Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa vide Notification No. SO(P&R)/1-8/2017 dated 04.10.2017, has fixed the promotion quota for the Assistant (BS-16) is 75% and 25% for initial recruitment. **(Flag-B)**
- iv. That the Service Rules for Inspectorate of Prisons, issued by Home & Tribal Affairs Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa vide Notification No. SO(P&R)/1-33/2021 dated 15.04.2022, has fixed the promotion quota for the Assistant (BS-16) at S.No. (35), is 75% and 25% for initial recruitment. **(Flag-C)**
- v. That while, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Act, 2017 in Chapter IV, Section 30 provides 75% quota for the promotion of Inspector (BS-16) and 25% for Fast Track Promotion. **(Flag-D)**
- vi. However, the Home & Tribal Affairs Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa vide same Notification at (Flag-C), at S.No.(5) Column No.6 allocated the Promotion quota for Assistant Superintendant Jail (BS-16) on @ 30% and as such ten percent promotion quota has been allocated for Senior Clerks to the post of Assistant Superintendant Jail (BS-16) while the post of Senior Clerk is totally different category/cadre from the category/cadre of the applicant.
- vii. That it is pertinent to mention here that the post of Senior Clerk is belonging to the clerical cadre in nature and they have no right to be promoted to the post of Assistant Superintendant Jail (BPS-16) which is the sole right of the Uniform employees, therefore, the 10% quota allocated for the post of Senior Clerk is against the law and the same is liable to be modified/rectified.

viii. That it is also pertinent to mention that the 75% promotion quota has already been allocated for the cadre of senior clerk to the post of Assistant/Accountant (BPS-16) at Serial No.35 column-6 of the Service Rules.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this Departmental appeal the impugned service rules notified on 15.04.2022 may very kindly be modified/rectified to the extent of enhancement of 30% quota allocated for promotion of Chief Head Warder (BPS-11) to the post of Assistant Superintendent Jail (BPS-16) similarly to the other cadres in the same department who have 75% quota for promotion to the next higher scale and the 10% quota of Senior Clerks for promotion to the post of Assistant Superintendent Jail (BPS-16) be removed allocated in the category of the applicant. Any other relief which your good self deems fit that may also be awarded in favor of the applicant.
