

JUDGMENT

ROZINA REHMAN, MEMBER (J): The relevant facts leading to filing of instant appeal are that appellant was appointed as Subject Specialist (Statistics). At the time of appointment, appellant had not qualified B.Ed, however, he completed the same in the year 2012 and all these facts were brought into the knowledge of respondents. Upon the recommendation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service



Commission, his colleagues were promoted, whereas, appellant was deprived from promotion, he, therefore, filed departmental appeal but to no avail. He filed service appeal before this Tribunal and during the pendency of service appeal, the impugned notification was issued, whereby, the appellant was terminated from service. Feeling aggrieved, he filed departmental appeal which was not responded to, hence, the present service appeal.

2. We have heard Muhammad Ayub Khan Shinwari Advocate for appellant and Muhammad Adeel Butt learned Additional Advocate General for the respondents and have gone through the record and the proceedings of the case in minute particulars.


3. Muhammad Ayub Khan Shinwari Advocate counsel appearing on behalf of appellant, inter-alia, contended that the impugned notification is against law and without lawful authority, therefore, ineffective upon the rights of the appellant. He submitted that appellant was not treated in accordance with law, rules and policy and the impugned notification was passed without giving any show cause notice and without giving any chance of hearing to the appellant. Lastly, he submitted that the appellant was condemned unheard.

4. Conversely learned A.A.G submitted that the appellant did not acquire professional qualification i.e. B.Ed at the relevant time as reflected in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission's advertisement. He submitted that he was not professionally qualified and that he was bound to pass B.Ed Examination within 3 years but

he failed to complete the B.Ed Degree within the stipulated time. He argued that those candidates who were holding B.Ed Degree at the time of their appointment, were promoted, whereas, the appellant was not professionally qualified, he was bound to complete B.Ed within 3 years but he failed and as there were no provisions for relaxation of rules, therefore, his services were rightly terminated.

5. Record shows that appellant Irshad Hussain was appointed as Subject Specialist upon the recommendation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission, vide notification dated 19.10.2007. According to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission, advertisement No.07/2004, the academic qualification for the post of Subject Specialist was Masters Degree in the relevant subject with Bachelor of Education or M.Ed or M.A Education from a recognized university. If no suitable candidate possessing the above qualification was available, then the candidate possessing Masters Degree in the relevant subject had to be considered subject to the condition that such appointee shall have to acquire additional qualification of B.Ed or M.Ed within three years from the date of appointment. In the instant case, the appellant was appointed 19.10.2007 and he submitted application for extension of time for qualifying B.Ed Exam on 15.10.2009. this application was kept pending by the respondents for the reasons best known to them. However, the appellant acquired the requisite qualification later on and he has been serving in the Department for the last about 13 years. He was also awarded


certification of appreciation which is available on file. The respondents failed to justify as to why the action which was required to be taken soon after the expiry of three years i.e. 20.07.2010, the time when the appellant was not in possession of the required qualification why this action was taken after a lapse of 13 years and that too, when the appellant had acquired the requisite qualification. If the additional qualification was mandatory as per rules, then why the appellant was appointed with deficient qualification. His colleagues have been promoted upon the recommendation of Provincial Selection Board vide notification dated 16th April, 2015, whereas, the appellant was deprived from promotion, therefore, he filed departmental appeal and then filed service appeal and during the pendency of service appeal, his services were terminated which is against the principle of natural justice as well as against the mandatory provisions of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011.

6. For the foregoing, this appeal is allowed. Appellant stands reinstated into service from the date of impugned order i.e. 2nd March, 2020 with all back benefits. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.




Counsel for the appellant present.

Contends that the impugned order dated 02.03.2020 was passed against the appellant whereby his service was terminated. The reason for termination was noted in terms that the appellant could not acquire additional qualification of B. Ed or M.Ed within three years from the date of his appointment. On the other hand, the appointment order dated 19.10.2007 did not include any such term or condition regarding the additional qualification. It is further stated that before passing of impugned order, the respondents did not care to adopt the prescribed procedure of enquiry etc against the appellant.

Subject to all just exceptions, instant appeal is admitted to regular hearing. The appellant is directed to deposit security and process fee within 10 days. Thereafter, notices be issued to the respondents for submission of written reply/comments on 09.11.2020 before S.B.





Brief but relevant facts of the case are as follows:

1. That the appellant is a bonafide resident of Parachinar, Distt Kurram and has qualified M. Sc (Statistics), Master of Education (M. Ed) and Bachelor of Education (B. Ed). (Copies of the certificates are filed herewith and annexed as Annex-A)
2. That consequent upon the recommendation of the KP Public Service Commission, the appellant was appointed as Subject Specialist (Statistics) by the competent authority vide Notification dated 19-10-2007. Ever since his appointment, the appellant has served the Department to the entire satisfaction of his superiors and has been awarded excellent performance certificate. (Copy of the appointment order and certificate is filed herewith and annexed as Annex-B & C)

3. That at the time of appointment, the appellant had not qualified the B. Ed Degree, the appellant completed his B. Ed Degree in the year 2012. It is pertinent to mention here that due to law and order situation, the main Thall Parachinar Road was blocked in November, 2007. The road was reopened from 18th November, 2008 till 23 February, 2009 and was blocked again for traffic. The said fact is evident from the letter dated 15-07-2009 issued by the Political Agent. Furthermore due to the suspension of mobility and road blockage, the appellant was deployed to work at Govt Post Graduate College, Parachinar vide order dated 19-10-2009. Due to the said facts, the appellant qualified the B. Ed in the year 2012. The appellant brought all these facts in the knowledge of respondents. (Copy of letter, Order and application is filed herewith and annexed as **Annex-D, E & F**)
4. That consequent upon the recommendations of Provincial Selection Board, the respondents promoted the colleagues of the appellant vide Notification dated April 16, 2015, whereas the appellant was deprived from promotion. (Copy of Notification is filed herewith and annexed as **Annex-G**)
5. That feeling aggrieved of the aforesaid Notification, the appellant filed Departmental Appeal but in vain. The appellant than filed Service Appeal No 1562/2019 before this Honorable Tribunal which was admitted for hearing. During the pendency of the service appeal, the respondents issued impugned Notification dated 02-03-2020 whereby the appellant is terminated from service. (Copy of impugned Notification is filed herewith and annexed as **Annex-H**)
6. That feeling aggrieved of the aforesaid Notification, the appellant filed departmental appeal which has not been decided yet. The statutory time for deciding the departmental appeal has lapsed. (Copy of Departmental Appeal is filed herewith and annexed as **Annex-I**)

Hence, the title Service Appeal on the following amongst other grounds:

Grounds:

- a. That, the impugned Notification is against the law, illegal, unlawful, without lawful authority, void and ineffective upon the rights of the Appellant, thus calling interference of this Honorable Tribunal.
- b. That the Appellant is not treated in accordance with the law, rules and policy which is his inalienable right under Article 4 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 and also the same is against the principle of natural justice.
- a. That impugned Notification is passed without holding any inquiry, without giving any show cause Notice, without giving any chance of hearing to the

Appellant, without giving any final show cause Notice to the Appellant, without recording any evidence in utter disregard of the mandatory provisions of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency and Discipline) Rules, 2011.

- c. That the impugned Notification is against the principles of natural justice as the Appellant is condemned unheard and it is a well settled principle of law that any order which violate the principle of *audi alteram partem* is nullity in the eye of law.
- d. That, the Respondents are violating all the basic Fundamental Rights and protections given to the Appellant in the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973.
- e. That the impugned Notification is against the principles of administrative law, based on colorful exercise of powers and against the dictums of the August Supreme Court of Pakistan.
- f. That the Appellant craves permission of this Honorable Tribunal to rely on other grounds at the time of arguments and produce any additional document if required in support of his Service Appeal.

It is, therefore, prayed that on acceptance of the instant service appeal, the impugned Notification dated 02-03-2020 may kindly be set aside and the appellant may kindly be re-instated in service with all back benefits.

Any other relief which has not been specifically prayed for and deemed fit and appropriate by this Honorable Tribunal in the circumstances may graciously be granted.

Shaheed Nadeem Hussain Higher Secondary School, Shalozan, Kurram Agency. (Copies of the certificates are filed herewith and annexed as **Annex-A**)
2. That consequent upon the recommendation of the KP Public Service Commission, I was appointed as Subject Specialist (Statistics) by the competent authority vide Notification dated 19-10-2007. Ever since my appointment, I have served the Department to the entire satisfaction of my superiors and have been awarded excellent performance certificate. (Copy of the appointment order and certificate is filed herewith and annexed as **Annex-B & C**)
3. That at the time of appointment, verbally without any written order I was given three years time to qualify B. Ed within three years i.e., upto 2010. But due to the law and order situation in FATA, I could not complete my B. Ed Degree upto 2010 and qualified the same in the year 2012. It is pertinent to mention here that due to law and order situation, the main Thall Parachinar Road was blocked in November, 2007. 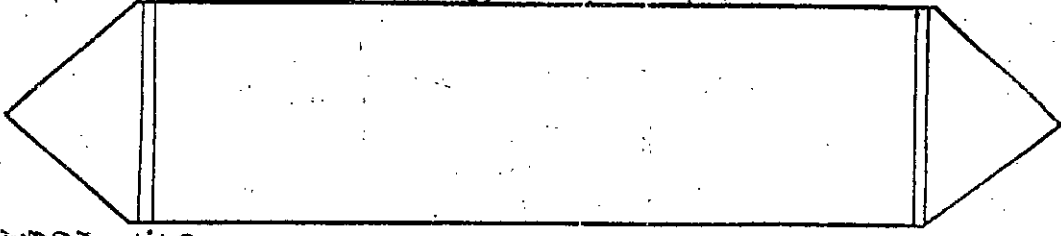

PARAWISE COMMENTS FOR & ON BEHALF OF THE RESPONDENTS 01 TO 3.

Respectfully Sheweth:

The Respondents submit as under:-

Preliminary Objections

1. The appellant has got no cause of action/locus standi.
2. The instant appeal is badly time barred.
3. The appellant has concealed the material facts from this Hon'able Service Tribunal, hence is liable to be dismissed on this score.
4. The appellant has not come to this Hon'able Service Tribunal with clean hands.
5. The appellant has filed the instant appeal with malafide intension just to pressurize the Respondent for gaining illegal service benefits.
6. The present appeal is liable to be dismissed fro mis-joinder & non joinder of necessary parties.
7. The instant appeal is against the prevailing law & rules.
8. The appellant is stopped by her own conduct to file the instant appeal.
9. The instant appeal is not maintainable in its present form and also in the present circumstances of the issue.
10. That the Notification dated 02-03-2020 is legally competent and is liable to be maintained in favour of the Respondent.
11. That the appellant has been treated as per law, rules and discretionary powers conferred upon Respondent No.1, under section-10 of Civil Servant Act 1973.
12. That this Hon'able Tribunal has got no jurisdiction to entertain the instant service appeal.
13. That the Appellant is not an aggrieved person under the relevant Article-212 of 1973 Constitution of Pakistan.

FACTS.

1. Para-01 pertains to record of the appellant, however, the appellant did not acquired the professional qualification i.e. B.Ed at the relevant time as reflected in the Public Service Commission advertisement.
2. That Para – 02 pertains to record of the appellant, hence no comments.
3. Correct to extent that the time of appellant recommendation by the Public Service Commission and his subsequent appointment on 19.10.2007, the appellant was not professionally qualified i.e had no B.Ed degree.(F/A) According to the Public Service Commission Advertisement-No. 7/2004 (F/B), the appellant was bound to pass B.Ed Examination within three years (i.e upto 18.10.2010) but the appellant failed to complete B.Ed degree within the stipulated time and completed his B.Ed in the year 2012.

4. Correct that those candidates holding B.Ed degrees at the time of their appointment were promoted (F/C), whereas the petitioner was not professionally qualified i.e had no B.Ed degree, according to Public Service Commission advertisement and service rules, the appellant was bound to complete B.Ed degree within three years i.e upto 2010, but he failed to complete his B.Ed degree within the stipulated time.
5. Correct. That the appellant filed departmental appeal however, there are no provisions for relaxation of rules and appellant was not entitled for promotion. It is also correct that Competent Authority vide Notification dated 02.03.2020 (F/D) terminated the services of the appellant under rule 10(3) of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules 1989 which stipulate that "*a candidate for initial appointment to a post must possess the education qualification or technical qualifications and experience as provided in the rules framed for the purpose of relaxation of age limit, must be within the age limit as laid down for the post.*" (F/E)
6. Correct to the extent that the appellant filed departmental appeal against the Notification 02.03.2020 on 27.03.2020. During the pendency of departmental appeal the appellant filed service appeal No. 8484 on 13th October, 2020 against the respondents in the Hon'able Service Tribunal, hence the instant Service Appeal to be dismissed inter alia on the following grounds.

GROUND:

- A. Incorrect and not admitted. The impugned Notification whereby the appellant has been terminated is in accordance with law, legal, with lawful authority and effective. The Appellant has been treated in accordance with law and no right of the Appellant has been violated. Hence denied.
- B. Incorrect and not admitted. The Appellant has been treated in accordance with law, rules & Policy. No right of the Appellant has been violated. Hence denied.
- C. Incorrect and not admitted. The appellant was not professionally qualified i.e had no B.Ed degree, according to Public Service Commission advertisement and service rules, the appellant was bound to pass B.Ed exam within three years i.e upto 2010, but he failed to complete the B.Ed degree within the stipulated time period. There is no need of inquiry in the subject case under E&D rules as he couldn't complete the condition of B.Ed degree within the given time.
- D. Incorrect and not admitted. The Appellant has been treated in accordance with law and no right of the Appellant has been violated. Hence denied.
- E. Incorrect and not admitted. The impugned Notification is in accordance with principles of Administrative law and with lawful authority. The Appellant has been treated in accordance with law and no right of the Appellant has been violated.
- F. The Respondents also seek the permission of this Hon'able Tribunal to adduce more grounds and proofs at time of arguments.

In view of the above made submissions, it is therefore, most humbly prayed that this Hon'able Tribunal may very graciously be pleased to dismiss the appeal with cost in favour of the Respondents.



GENERAL CONDITIONS

- (i) Age in all cases will be reckoned on 31.12.2004. Govt. servants having rendered four years service shall be allowed Ten years relaxation in upper age limit or to the extent of service whichever is less. Three years age relaxation allowed to Zone-1 and 3 candidates. However, only one age concession shall be allowed to the candidates claiming concession under various categories whichever is more beneficial to the candidates.
- (ii) Degrees / Diplomas / Experience Certificates / Testimonials of unrecognized Institution are not accepted. Only regular degrees / certificates are accepted. However, the candidates can apply on provisional certificate signed by the Controller of Examination of the respective Institution but candidates shall produce original degrees / certificates before their selection. Detail Marks Certificate for all the examination shall necessarily be required and these should be attached with the application forms.
- (iii) Allocation of vacancies in BPS-17 and below shall be strictly in accordance with the Zonal Allocation as indicated against each post(s). The applications of the candidates other than the specified zone shall be ignored except for posts reserved for Merit quota. No zonal reservation stands for posts allocated to disabled quota and also for the posts in BPS-18 and above. All such posts shall be filled in on Open Merit.

Govt. reserves the right not to fill any or fill more or less than the advertised post(s). Candidates who have already availed three chances after 12.01.1985 by physical appearance before the Commission and have failed for the post(s) having one and the same qualifications and scale of pay shall be ineligible.
- (viii) The candidates already appointed on contract basis in consequence to their selection by the departmental selection committees on any one of the above advertised posts shall have to apply to the Commission. In case they could not be recommended by the Commission, their services shall be liable to termination on the arrival of the selectees of Public Service Commission.
- (ix) Experience wherever prescribed shall be counted after the minimum qualifications for the post(s), if not specifically provided otherwise against the advertised post(s).
- (x) In cases where the number of applications received for post(s) are disproportionately higher than the number of available vacancies, shortlisting of the candidates may be done in any one of the following manner:
 - (a) Written Test in the Subject.
 - (b) General Knowledge or Psychological General Ability Test.
 - (c) Academic and / or Professional record as the Commission may decide.



47**Statutory provision regarding Appointment.**

Section 5 of Civil Servants Act, 1973 - Appointment to a civil service of the Province or to a civil post in connection with the affairs of the Province shall be made in the prescribed manner by the Governor or by a person authorised by the Governor in that behalf.

**THE NORTH-WEST FRONTIER PROVINCE
CIVIL SERVANTS (APPOINTMENT, PROMOTION &
TRANSFER) RULES, 1989.**

PART-I

GENERAL

1. **Short title and commencement:** - (1) These rules may be called the North-West Frontier Province Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989.
(2) They shall come into force at once.
2. **Definitions:-**(1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-
 - (a) "Appointing Authority" in relation to a post, means the persons authorized under rule 4 to make appointment to that post;
 - (b) "Basic Pay Scale" means the Basic Pay Scale for the time being sanctioned by Government, in which a post or a group of posts is placed;
 - (c) "Commission" means the North West Frontier Province Public Service Commission;
 - ²⁹(d) "Departmental Promotion Committee" means a committee constituted for making selection for promotion or transfer to such posts under a Department, or offices of Government, which do not fall within the purview of the Provincial Selection Board;
 - ³⁰(dd) "Departmental Selection Board" means a Board constituted for the purpose of making selection for initial recruitment /appointment to posts under a Department or office of Government in Basic Pay Scale 17 not falling within the purview of the Commission:
Provided that more than one such committees may be constituted for civil servants holding different scales of pay".
 - (e) "Departmental Selection Committee" means a committee constituted for the purpose of making selection for initial appointment to posts under a department, or office of Government [in Basic Pay Scale 17 and below not falling within the purview of the Commission];
 - (f) "Post" means a post sanctioned in connection with the affairs of the Province, but not allocated to all Pakistan Unified Grades ; and
 - ³¹(g) "Provincial Selection Board" means the Board constituted by Government for the purpose of selection of civil servants for promotion or transfer to posts in respect

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whereof the appointing authority under rule 4 is the Chief Minister and shall consist of such persons as may be appointed to it by Government from time to time.

(2) Words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meanings as are assigned to them in the North-West Frontier Province Civil Servants Act, 1973 (N.W.F.P act XVIII of 1973) or any other statutory order or rules of Government for the time being in force.

3. **Method of Appointment:-** (1) Appointment to posts shall be made by any of the following methods, namely:-

- (a) by promotion or transfer in accordance with the provisions contained in Part-II of these rules; and
- (b) by initial recruitment in accordance with the provisions contained in Part-III of these rules.

(2) The method of appointment, qualifications and other conditions applicable to a post shall be such as laid down by the Department concerned in consultation with the Services and General Administration Department and the Finance Department.

4. **Appointing Authority:-** The authorities competent to make appointment to posts in various basic pay scales shall be as follows:-

3. Posts in Basic Pay Scales 3 to 15.

(a) In the case of civil Servants borne on ministerial establishment of Civil Courts subordinate to High Court, the officer authorized as such by the Chief Justice; and

(b) In other cases

(i) an officer declared under the relevant Delegation of Powers Rules, which shall to this extent be deemed as operative; or

(ii) Where no such appointing authority has been declared, the Secretary to Government or the Head of an Attached Department/ Office, as the case may be.

4. Posts in Basic Pay Scale 1 and 2. Deputy Secretary incharge of Administration or office, as the case may be.

5. ³³Departmental Promotion & Selection Committee/Board - (1) In each Department or office of Government there shall be one or more Departmental Promotion Committee and Departmental Selection Committee ³⁴(or, as the case may be, Departmental Selection Board), the composition of which shall be determined by the Services and General Administration Department or the Department in consultation with the Services and General Administration Department.

(2) Each such Committee (or the Board, as the case may be), shall consist of at least three members, one of whom shall be appointed as Chairman.

Procedure when recommendation is not accepted:- When an appointing authority for Basic Pay Scale 17 or below does not accept the recommendation of a Departmental Promotion or Selection Committee, or the Departmental Selection Board, as the case may be, it shall record its reasons and obtain order of the next higher authority.

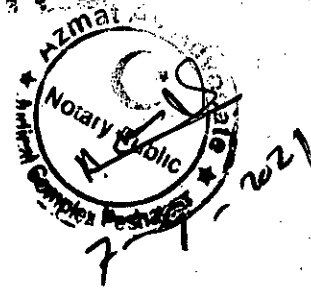

Dear Sir,

I am directed to refer to Govt of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Elementary & Secondary Education Department letter No. SO(SM)E&SED/4-24/2016/Appeal/Irshad Hussain SS/HM dated 28.09.2020 on the subject noted above and to observe that:-

- i. No such rules have been provided to confirm that after appointment as SS (Statistics), acquiring additional qualification of B.Ed/M.Ed is mandatory.
- ii. If the additional qualification was mandatory as per rules, then why the appellant was appointed with deficient qualification.
- iii. The action was required to be taken soon after the expiry of three years i.e 20.07.2010, the time where the appellant was not in possession of required qualification, however, the action was taken after a lapse of thirteen years and that too where the appellant had acquired the requisite qualification.
- iv. The terms & condition described in the appointment order dated 19.10.2007 is also silent regarding the facts of acquiring additional qualification.
- v. Neither penalty of "termination" has been prescribed in Rule 10(3) of APT Rules, 1989 nor does the said penalty exist in the E&D Rules or any other rules.
- vi. The appointment made in violation of any rules, falls within the meaning of "misconduct" as defined in sub clause (vi) of Clause (I)


