JUDGMENT

ATIQ-UR-REMHMAN WAZIR MEMBER (E):- Brief facts of the case are that the appellant was working as Assistant in the office of Deputy Commissioner North Waziristan tribal district. Due to serious illness, the appellant applied for invalid retirement from service on medical grounds. The case of the appellant was referred to medical board and the medical board furnished its opinion vide letter dated 05-08-2020, wherein the appellant was declared unfit for further job. The Deputy Commissioner approved his retirement on medical grounds vide order sheet dated 13-08-2020, but due to delay on part of the respondents, his invalid retirement order could not materialize well in time and in the meanwhile, the appellant reached his age of superannuation, hence he was retired on the basis of reaching his age of superannuation and not on invalid retirement. Feeling aggrieved, the appellant filed departmental appeal, which was

rejected vide order dated 17-12-2020, hence the instant service appeal with prayers that the impugned orders dated 10-09-2020 and 17-12-2020 may be set aside and the appellant may be held entitled for retirement on medical grounds, with all consequential benefits.

- 02. Learned counsel for the appellant has contended that the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law, as actions and inactions violate the mandate provided under Article-4 of the Constitution; that respondents are legally bound to treat the appellant in accordance with law, as the appellant is legally entitled for pre-mature retirement on medical grounds; that the medical opinion was not challenged by the respondents within the stipulated timeframe, hence it gained finality, even the Deputy Commissioner approved his retirement on medical ground in light of opinion of medical board, but due to delaying tactics by the office concerned, the appellant was deprived of his right, which is unlawful; that the appellant has been discriminated as similar placed employees was granted retirement on medical ground, whereas the same benefit was not granted to the appellant; that this Tribunal has already granted relief in similar case in Service Appeal No. 558/2019, decided on 21-02-2020 and the same may also be granted to the appellant being an identical case; that the appellant was not consulted nor any correspondence made with the appellant to defend his cause, which is illegal unlawful and contrary to the norms of natural justice; that the respondents had not adopted proper procedure in deciding the departmental appeal, nor the same was referred to the competent authority for decision; that the appellant was fully entitled for pre-mature retirement on medical grounds and denial of the same is totally illegal and contrary to rules, thus indulgence of this tribunal is solicited.
- 03. Learned Deputy District Attorney for the respondents has contended that it is correct that the appellant was declared invalid by the medical board, but his case was not considered due to the reason that the appellant concealed the fact

that his actual date of retirement was near, hence he was retired on reaching his age of superannuation; that in case of invalid retirement, his son would become entitled to be recruited in his place, which would be a great injustice with unemployed youth of the district.

- 04. We have heard learned counsel for the parties and have perused the record.
- 05. In the last leg of his career, the appellant suffered from certain disease and applied for invalid retirement on medical grounds. The respondents duly processed his case and medical board was constituted to examine his fitness or otherwise. The medical board recommended him for retirement on medical grounds, being incapacitated and unfit for further job but the incumbent deputy commissioner refused such retirement under the plea that his son might take benefit of such retirement, which however was not warranted. It was astonishing to note that the respondents processed his case for invalid retirement due to his illness and after lengthy correspondence, medical board was constituted and medical board tendered its opinion, even the Deputy Commissioner concerned approved his case for invalid retirement. Placed on record is a note submitted to the Deputy Commissioner with recommendations that since the appellant can't work anymore and the medical board has also recommended him for invalid retirement on medical grounds, hence he may be retired on medical grounds, whereas the Deputy Commissioner concerned had approved such proposals vide note sheet dated 13-08-2020, but after changes in administrative setup, the respondents took a U turn and refused the already approved case under the plea that his son might take benefit of such retirement, which was pathetic on part of the respondents. Taking action contrary to the opinion of the medical board constituted on their request, would amount to mistrust upon the medical board so constituted. The respondents however were required to take a sympathetic view of the situation, as the appellant served for longer time with the respondents and

denial of benefits already accrued to him amount to injustice, which was not warranted.

06. In view of the foregoing discussion, the instant appeal is accepted. The impugned orders dated 10-09-2020 and 17-12-2020 are set aside and the appellant stands entitled to invalid retirement on medical grounds alongwith benefits accrued thereto. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to record room.

THE **KHYBER** APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE APPELLATE ORDER DATED 17.12.2020 **DEPARTMENTAL** APPEAL WHEREBY RETIREMENT ON MEDICAL GROUND AND AGAINST ORDER DATED 10.09.2020 WHEREIN APPELLANT WAS CONDITIONALLY RETIRED FROM **ATTAINING** THE SERVICE \mathbf{ON} SUPERANNUATION INSTEAD OF RETIREMENT ON MEDICAL GROUND, HAS BEEN REJECTED FOR NO GOOD GROUNDS.

PRAYER:

THAT ON THE ACCEPTANCE OF THIS APPEAL, THE ORDER DATED 10.09.2020 and 17.12.2020 MAY PLEASE BE SET ASIDE AND THE APPELLANT MAY BE HELD ENTITLED FOR RETIREMENT ON MEDICAL GROUND IN LIGHT OF THE OPINION OF MEDICAL BOARD

WITH ALL BACK AND CONSEQUENTIAL BENEFITS.

ANY OTHER REMEDY, WHICH THIS AUGUST

TRIBUNAL DEEMS FIT AND APPROPRIATE THAT,

MAY ALSO, BE AWARDED IN FAVOUR OF APPELLANT.

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:

FACTS:

- 1. That the appellant was working as Assistant in the O/o the Deputy Commissioner, North Waziristan Tribal district.
- 2. That the appellant fell suddenly ill and got medical checkup several time but the illness of the appellant increases with time, Finally due to illness, appellant was not in position to continue his job, therefore, applied for invalid retirement from service on medical grounds on 30.06.2020. copy of medical reports and application is attached as Annexure-A & B.
- 3. That the respondent Deputy Commissioner North Waziristan district referred cased to MS District Head Quarter Hospital North Waziristan for processed the case vide letter dated 17.07.2020. The MS District Head Quarter Hospital North referred the case of DG Health Services KP Peshawar for constitution of the medical board vide letter dated 18.07.2020. Copy of letters are attached as annexure-C.
- 4. That the Director General Health Services Sent case of the appellant to MS polices Services Hospital Peshawar for arranging standing medical board vide letter dated 20.07.2020. Copy of letter is attached as annexure-D.
- 5. That after constitution of medical board the meeting of standing medical board was held and furnished opinion /recommendations on 05.08.2020 wherein appellant was declared unfit for job and permanently incapacitated. The said recommendations of medical board was sent to Deputy Commissioner North Waziristan district for implementation vide letter dated 11.08.2020. the respondent instead of challenged the decision of the medical board within 15 days, approved the same vide approval dated 13.08.2020. Copy of opinion of standing medical board and approval is attached as Annexure-E & F.

6. That the department delayed the case of the appellant and at last issue retirement order dated 10.09.2020 on the age of superannuation which void ab initio. The appellant being aggrieved filed departmental appeal against the order dated 10.09.2020 but the same was rejected vide order dated 17.12.2020 for no good grounds. Hence the present Service appeal on the following grounds amongst others. Copy of impugned order, departmental appeal and rejection order is attached as annexure-G, H & I.

GROUNDS

- A. That the impugned order dated 10.09.2020 and 17.12.2020, the impugned actions and inactions violate the mandate provided under article 4 of the constitution of Pakistan.
- **B.** That respondent are legally bound to treat the appellant in accordance to law and he is entitled for pre mature retirement on medical grounds.
- C. That the deptt: has a remedy under FR rules to challenge the medical board opinion within 15 days and review the same but the deptt: not do so, the opinion of the medical board attained finally which should be implemented.
- **D.** That after medical board opinion and approval for the retirement on medical ground but the deptt inordinately delayed the matter till the superannuation of the appellant. Which is malafide on the part of the deptt.
- E. That earlier vide letter dated 17/07/2020 respondent no 3 by himself referred appellant case before standing medical board and accordingly appellant appear before the standing medical board and valid constituted medical board declare appellant unfit for government service but the appellant was not retired on medical grounds, which is totally illegal and against the rule and regulation.
- F. That respondent vide letter dated 13/08/2020 respondent no.3 approved the premature retirement on medical grounds and after production of all the required documents issuance of the impugned letter dated 10/09/2020 is totally illegal, against the law and thus liable to be stuck down.
- G. That the similar placed employee was retired on medical ground on the basis of standing medical board opinion but the appellant was discriminated which is great injustice with the appellant and violation of superior court judgments and constitution. Copy of the order is attached as annexure-J.
- H. That in the same nature case titled as Shaher Bano *VS* Govt: of KP appeal no:558/2019 decided on 21.02.2020 the Hon'able Tribunal granted relief to the employee, so being similar nature person the



appellant, also needs the same treatment under the principle of consistency. Copy of judgment is attached as annexure-K

- I. That no proper opportunity of hearing has been provided by the respondent to the appellant hence he has been condemned unheard and the case has been decided in a mechanical manner without application of judicious mind.
- J. That nor the fundamental rules nor the CSR has been taken into consideration while deciding the case of appellant.
- K. That respondent has not adopted proper procedure in deciding the departmental appeal /representation nor the same has been refer to proper competent authority. Similarly no opportunity of hearing has been provided to appellant to explain her stance and law on subject.
- L. That because the impugned actions and inactions are against the principles ordained under article 25 of the constitution of Islamic republic of Pakistan.
- M. That because the impugned actions and inactions are blatantly against all norms of justice and principles of reasonability based on victimizations and discrimination.
- N. That the appellant by his own sweet will is not willing to proceed on retirement but his poor health problem not allowed him to continue his job therefore the directions issued vide impugned letter is totally illegal and violation of the basis fundamental rights of appellant.
- O. That appellant has been arbitrary treated and he being qualified for the retirement on medical ground but has accrued rights are denying by the respondents without any just cause contrary to the clear cut provision of law.
- P. That the appellant is fully entitled for the pre-mature retirement on medical grounds and denial of the same by the respondent is totally illegal void against the rules and regulations thus indulgence of this hon'ble tribunal is required.
- Q. That appellant also seeks permission of this hon'ble forum to raise additional point at the time of arguments.

It is therefore respectfully prayed that on accepting this service appeal;

- A) The impugned order dated 10.09.2020 and 17.12.2020 may graciously be set aside by declaring it illegal, void, unlawful, without authority based on mala fide, void ab-initio and thus not sustainable and the appellant is entitled for retirement on medical grounds.
- B) The respondent may please be direct to act in accordance with law and the actions and inactions of the respondent in



not finalizing appellant retirement case on the basis medical grounds is unconstitutional, unlawful, illegal without lawful authority and direction may please be issued to respondent to finalized the pre-mature retirement case on medical grounds as per decision of the standing medical board.

C) Any administrative orders which are against the rules and regulation may please be declare ultra varies to the constitution of the Islamic republic of Pakistan and service law and thus liable to be struck down.

- 2. That on 18/01/2020 the appellant fell suddenly ill and did medical check-up (annex-A).
- 3. That not feeling well the appellant again did medical check-up on 19/02/2020,(annex"B").
- 4. That the illness of the appellant increased and on 15/05/2020 got check-up from another physician (annex-"C").

That the appellant accordingly applied for invalid retirement from service on Medical Board's grounds on 30-06-2020, (annex- "D".)

That the respondent i.e. Deputy Commissioner, North Waziristan District referred the application to Medical Superintendent. District Headquarter Hospital North Waziristan for processing the case of the applicant to the quarter concerned for needful action vide etter No. 3467/ PS / DC NWTD dated 17-07-2020, (annex-"E".)

That accordingly Medical Superintendent DHQ, NWTD Miran Shah referred the case of the applicant to Director General Health Services KPK Peshawar for constitution of the required Medical Board vide letter 4281 dated 18-07-2020.(annex-"F").

- 8. That the Director General Health Services KPK Peshawar sent case of the appellant to MS Police Services Hospital Peshawar for arranging standing Medical Board vide letter No. 4047-48/ Medical / SMB dated 20-07-2020. (annex-"G")
- 9. That in the light of Director General Health Services KPK Peshawar vide para 8 above Medical Superintendent Police Services Hospital Peshawar after arranging Standing Medical Board furnished opinion / recommendations dated 05-08-2020 vide which the

appellant was declared unfit for Government job and incapacitated sent to DC NWTD (Respondent) vide letter No. 2451-52/ MS /SMB/2019-20 dated 11-08-2020. (annex"H").

- 10. That the respondent accede to the recommendations of Standing Medical as per approval dated 13-08-2020. (annex '#")
- 11. In light of the above facts Respondent was required to issue retirement orders of the applicant on Medical Ground as per recommendation of Standing Medical Board as appellant was not able to continue further service but it was inordinately delayed and the Respondent issued impugned order on attaining the age of superannuation subject to the final decision of the apex court i-e 63 years age (annex "J")

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that the impugned order No.166-72/EA dated 10-09-2020 may very graciously be set-aside and the respondent department may be directed to retire the appellant on Medical Grounds as with effect from 05-08-2020 as per recommendations of the Standing Medical Board.

3. The learned counsel for the appellant argued that the respondent No.2 referred the appellant for standing medical board vide letter dated 03.08.2018. The appellant was called for the medical board by the DG health vide letter dated 10.08.2018 to be appearing before standing medical board on 12.09.2018. The appellant appeared before the board on 15.09.2018 and vide letter dated 27.09.2018 report of standing medical board to the office of respondent No.2 on 10.08.2018 by the DG health office. Again the respondent No.2 directed the respondent No.4 vide letter dated 27.09.2018 for processing the case of the appellant for premature retirement on medical ground by furnishing all the requisite documents. Further contended that the office of respondent No.2 changed his previous stance contrary to the case in process the respondent No.4 was directed vide the impugned order of 22.01.2019 to resubmit the

retirement case of the appellant on the basis of the completion of qualitying service for ordinary premature retirement on the basis of medical ground. The appeal of the appellant dated 11.02.2019 was not considered and vide letter dated 17.04.2019 the respondent No.4 was informed that the application of the appellant along with others has been rejected and they should apply for premature/superannuation retirement whichever is applicable in their individual cases. The learned Assistant Advocate General contested the facts, arounds of the appeal and arguments of the learned counsel for the appellant and argued that her request/appeal for premature retirement on medical ground has been rejected in the view of the order dated 11.12.2018. As she has completed her qualifying service for premature retirement. He further stated that the appellant has been dealt in accordance with the law and rules. No fundamental rights has been violated of the appellant while directing her to apply for fresh ground on premature retirement on the basis of qualifying service instead of medical grounds, hence the appeal may be dismissed with costs.

- 5. Arguments heard. File perused.

appears that the impugned inaction on the part of respondent No.2 to submit the case to the approving authority is not covered under the law as the appellant has been denied her right for opting retirement on medical ground as provided in FR 10-A. Moreover, the denial of invalid pension and service benefits as required under SR 4 AA is not covered under the law and the instructions issued by the finance department under circular letter dated 1st December 1998.

In view of the above discussion we are of the considered opinion that the instant appeal carries merit and is approved with setting aside the orders adverse to the interest of the appellant and the respondents are directed to process the case of the appellant for retirement on medical ground and grant her invalid pension with effect from the date she has been relived from the duty. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:

Preliminary Objections:

(1-4) All objections raised by the respondents are incorrect and baseless. Rather the respondents are estopped to raise any objection due to their own conduct.

FACTS:

- 1 Para-1 is admitted correct by the endorsed department.
- 2 Incorrect. While Para-2 of the appeal is correct as mention in the main appeal of the appellant. Moreover, appellant has never concealed any facts from the respondent and it is also responsibility of the respondent no.3 to consult the service record of the appellant which was in his custody, before referring appellant to medical board. Moreover, the deptt: preferred CPLA against the judgment of the Peshawar High Court Peshawar, wherein the age of retirement of was modified as 63 year, meaning thereby the age of the retirement was 63 years at that time and appellant never concealed any fact from the deptt:. Further it is added that the appellant never mentioned his wrong date of retirement so the plea of the respondent is baseless. The appellant has been denied his right for opting retirement on medical grounds as provided under FR 10-A. moreover the denial of pension and services benefits as required under SR 4AA, is against the law on Pules.

- In para-7 of the reply respondent's department admitted First portion of para-7 of the appeal as correct hence no comments, while the rest of the para-7 of the reply is incorrect, hence denied, While Para-7 of the appeal is correct. Moreover, the appeal of the appellant was rejected on flimsy grounds.

GROUNDS:

A. Incorrect. While Para-A of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant. Moreover, the impugned order were against the law, facts and norms of justice.

- B. Incorrect. While Para-B of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant. Moreover, The appellant has been denied his right for opting retirement on medical grounds as provided under FR 10-A. moreover the denial of pension and services benefits as required under SR 4aa is not covered under the law
- C. Incorrect. While Para-C of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant.
- D. Incorrect. While Para-D of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant.
- E. Incorrect. While Para-E of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant. Moreover as explained in above para-2 & para-5. Further it is added that, the department not denied the fact regards the approval of medical board opinion and delay in process of retirement on medical grounds.
- F. Incorrect. While Para-F of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant. Moreover as explained in para-2 & para-5. Further it is added that, the department not denied the fact regards the approval of medical board opinion and delay in process of retirement on medical grounds in whole comments.
- G. Incorrect. While Para-G of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant. Moreover, the respondent no.3 violated the procedure provided under Fr-10 A and Sr 4AA by issuing the retirement order of the appellant after considerable delay which speaks malafide on the part of the deptt. According to law after medical board opinion and further approval in black and white form, the appellant should boarded out on medical ground immediately and granted invalid pension under SR-4 AA. The same principal is also held Serive Tribunal in its judgment dated 21.02.2020 in appeal no: 558/2019. Further it is added that the departmental appeal of the appellant was rejected on flimsy grounds.
- H. Incorrect. While Para-H of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant.

- I. Incorrect, hence denied. While Para-I of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant. Moreover the departmental appeal was submitted to respondent no.2 and not to respondent no.1.
- J. Incorrect. While Para-J of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant. Moreover, the order issued by the respondent is not based on facts rather contrary to the material and approval on record.
- K. Incorrect. While Para-K of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant.
- L. Incorrect. While Para-L of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant. Moreover, appellant was discriminated which is violation of Article 2-A, 4 & 25 of the constitution because the respondent no:3 recently issued order dated 14.05.2021. wherein Mr abdur Rashid was retired on medical grounds vide order dated 05.07.2018 just before 28 days from the actual retirement. Gul Muhammad retired on medical grounds vide order dated 29.12.2016 just before three months and Rashid gul retired on medical grounds vide order dated 29.07.2021 just before 10 days only.
- M. Incorrect. While Para-M of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant. Moreover, malafide of the respondent is clear from the orders issued against the facts on record.
- N. Incorrect. While Para-N of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant. The respondents take shelter of the future developments which is not permissible in the eye of law. Moreover, rules 10-4 is provided under the APT rules 1989 and which are still intact, further there is no such provision is available in law to predict the future development and applied it in fanciful manner to deprive the civil servant from the due right. It is pertinent to mentioned here that the appellant is also belonged to North Waziristan and the son of the appellant is educated well qualified and part of the youth of the North Waziristan. Cut it short all the plea taken by the respondent is flimsy.

- O. Incorrect. While Para-O of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant.
- P. Incorrect. While Para-P of grounds of the appeal is correct as mentioned in the main appeal, of the appellant.
