Preliminary Objections:-

- 1. That the applicant has no cause of action to file the instant application.
 - 2. That the judgments of August Supreme Court of Pakistan and this Honourable Tribunal have lost their efficacy for the purpose of implementation by clear intendment through sections 1 & 2 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Cessation of Payment of Arrears on Advance Increments on Higher Educational Qualification Act No. IX of 2012.
 - 3. The Act was passed by the Provincial Assembly and assented by the Governor Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The answering respondents are bound to obey the will of the legislature & cannot deviate from any provision of enactment.
 - 4. That the legislator has authority to legislate as they have mandate to do so by a recognize process and services law do not provides the provision of judicial review, hence, application is not tenable.
 - 5. That the applicant was at liberty to join service after due process of law equivalent to his qualification & the Government is not bound to pay advance increment.
 - 6. <u>That this Tribunal has already dismissed the service appeal No. 430/2015 of applicant on 19-10-2017 hence, the Principle of Estoppel is also applicable in the case of applicant.</u>
 - 7. That the instant application is time barred. Hence liable to be dismissed.
 - 8. <u>That the instant application is against the notification dated 27-10-2001</u> whereby, the basis of the claim of applicant stood erased. In the year 2012 the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Cessation of Payment of Arrears on Advance Increments on Higher Educational Qualification Act No. IX of 2012 was promulgated which was made retrospective from 2001. Hence, the instant application is liable to be dismissed on this score alone.
 - 9. That the instant application is not maintainable in its present form.

- 10. That the applicant has filed the present application just to pressurize the respondents.
- 11. <u>That the August Supreme Court of Pakistan suspended the impugned judgment on</u> <u>18-12-2019 regarding the Advance Increments on account of higher qualification in</u> <u>CP No. 397-P/2017, 409-P/2017, 420-P/2017, 72-P/2019 & 733-P/2019.</u>
- 12. That the applicant has not come to this Honorable Tribunal with clean hands.
- 13. That the applicant is estopped to sue due to his own conduct.
- 14. That the instant application is not maintainable due to non-joinder and mis-joinder of necessary parties.
- 15. That the instant application is against the rules and policy of the Government.

On Facts:-

- 1. That para-1 pertains to the service record.
- 2. That analyzing pay rules (National pay scales) introduced w.e.f. 01-03-1972 for civil employees, while for the teaching staff separate national pay scales (NPS) introduced w.e.f. 01-07-1973, it is evident that there are separate advance increment schemes on acquiring higher qualification for teaching and non-teaching staff.
- 3. On the introduction of basic pay scales (BPS) in 1983, 1987 & 1991, advance increment schemes on acquiring higher qualification was separate and different for teaching and non-teaching staff as well.
- 4. Basic pay scale rules of 1983 Notification No. FD(SR-i)1-67/82 dated 24-08-1983, for teaching staff, the advance increments scheme on acquiring higher qualification was separately introduced which continued with some amendments till 30-11-2001 and was discontinued w.e.f. 01-12-2001. "Vide Govt. of NWFP Finance Department (Regulation Wing) letter No. FD(PRC)1-1/2001, dated 27-10-2001 as per para-09: advance increments to school teachers on attaining/ acquiring higher qualification vide No. FD(SR-II)67/83, Govt. of NWFP Finance Department Peshawar, the 24^w August 1983".
- 5. That vide letter No. FD(PRC)1-1/89 dated Peshawar the 7th August 1991, the advance increments sanctioned by FD vide para-09 of its letter No. FD(SR-i)1-67/82 dated 24-08-1983 will not be admissible on acquiring/ possessing qualifications for which higher pay scales are being sanctioned through this notification which was amended vide FD letter No. FD (SR-V)2-123/98 dated 22-03-1999 and FD letter No. SO(R-V)2-123/91 dated 25-09-1995, re-continuing the advance increments only on acquiring higher qualification on which higher scales was not granted earlier.
- 6. That Finance Department Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa vide its letter No. FD(SR-II)2-123/83 dated 31-011998, further clarified in the light of para-6(a) that "it is clarified the order is not applicable to the teachers". Then, vide Notification No FD(PRC) 1-1/89, dated 11-08-1991 as pera-5, grant of advance increments to officials for possessing/attaining higher education qualification:
 - i. From 1-6-1991 onwards advance increments shall be allowed without the condition of 2^{ed} division to the officials in BPS 1-15 for possessing or acquiring higher educational qualification over and above prescribed qualification in the relevant recruitment rules to the extent given below:

This scheme reflects the previous scheme of advance increments for non-teaching staff mentioned in pay revision rules 1987, clearly indicates that the revision of Basic pay scales (BPS) 1991 is also not applicable to teaching staff.

- 7. The scheme of advance increments was wrongly extended to teaching staff which created the confusion resulted in distress to the department. It is a settled law that ill-gotten gain cannot be made a precedent.
- 8. In the Supreme Court of Pakistan verdict/judgment in case of Abdul Haq Khan & others Vs Haji Ameer Zada & others reported as PLD 2017 Supreme Court PP 105, "It is otherwise settled by now that courts of law have no jurisdiction to add or subtract to the clear words of a statute"
- Basic pay scales rules 24-08-1983, advance increments detail on higher qualification, Finance Department letter, clarification dated 31-01-1988, revision of basic pay scale 1991 and Finance Department letter dated 12-01-1995 are hereby annexed as (A,B,C & D).
- 10. That at this stage, the claim of the appellant cannot be entertained in the light of Section-ii of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa cessation of payment of arrears on advance increments on higher educational qualification Act, 2012 by virtues of which the instant petitions may be graciously be allowed. There is plethora of judgments of the Apex Court of Pakistan in this regard. Reliance is placed on un-reported judgment of this court dated 07-12-2018 in CPs No. 172-P & 173-P/2013. Judgment Annexed as (E).
- 11. That in the instant case the appellant is seeking arrears on the basis of Notification dated 11-08-1991 and in the light of Section-2 of the Act of 2012, his claim cannot be entertained and is not justifiable. Reliance is placed on unreported judgment of this court dated 29-08-2013 passed in Civil Petition No. 360/2013. The petitioners have not challenged the virus of the Act. Therefore,, these petitioners stand abated under Act of 2012, as a result leave to appeal is declined and these petitions are dismissed.
- 12. That para-8 is incorrect to the extent to file appeal by the appellant to the respondent because no such appeal was available in the office record of the respondent.
- 13. Incorrect and denied. Detailed reply has already been submitted in forgoing paras. The instant Service Appeal may dismissed inter alia on the following grounds:-

ON GROUNDS:

- A. This para is related to Articles of constitution no comments, while the appellant intend to misconstrue, mislead the said Article of the constitution, hence, denied.
- B. Incorrect. The statement of the appellant in this para is misleading one and against the facts. The Govt. had already discontinued the scheme of advance increment w.e.f. 27-10-2001 as mentioned in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa cessation of payment of arrears on advance increments on higher educational qualification Act, 2012.
- C. Incorrect. The Govt. had already discontinued the scheme of advance increment w.e.f.

- D. Incorrect. The appellant has been treated in accordance with law.
- E. Incorrect. The said Act is not discriminative one, the same is enacted by the Provincial Assembly i.e. representative of the people including the appellant hence, denied.
- F. Incorrect. The Act No.IX of 2012 does not violate the constitution of Pakistan.
- G. The scheme of advance increments was wrongly extended to teaching staff which created the confusion resulted in distress to the department. It is a settled law that III-gotten gain cannot be made a precedent. In the Supreme Court of Pakistan verdict/judgment in case of Abdul Haq Khan & others Vs Haji Ameer Zada & others reported as PLD 2017 Supreme Court 105, "It is otherwise settled by now that courts of law have no jurisdiction to add or subtract to the clear works of a statute" basic pay scales rules 24-08-1983, advance increments detail on higher qualification, Finance Department letter, clarification dated 31-01-1988, revision of basic pay scale 1991 and Finance Department letter dated 12-01-1995.

SCHEME OF BASIC PAY SCALES AND FRINGE BENEFITS OF PROVINCIAL CIVIL SERVANTS (1983).

Sir,

In pursuance to the decision of the President of Pakistan, the Governor, N.W.F.P has been pleased to sanction, with effect from Ist July, 1983, a scheme as detailed below, of the Basic Pay Scales, Allowances and other Fringe Benefits, 1983 for the Provincial Civil Servants:-

PART-I BASIC SCALES AND ALLIED MATTERS.

2. <u>Basic Scales of Pay:-</u> The Basic Scales of Pay, 1983 as shown in Annexure-I to this circular letter shall replace the existing revised National Scale of Pay (RNPS). The Basic Scales shall not be regarded as "grades" and shall not be referred to as grades in official communications. Officials shall henceforth be appointed/promoted to posts and not in grades.

3. <u>Initial Fixation of Pay:-</u> (i) The initial pay of an existing employee, i.e., an employee, who has been in Government Service since before the Ist of July, 1983, shall be fixed at the stage in the relevant Basic Pay Scales which is as many stages above the minimum as the stage occupied by him above the minimum of the existing revised National Pay Scales provided that where the pay so determined does not give the employee concerned a minimum advantage of 10% of his existing Basic Pay plus Dearness Allowance over and above the present emoluments drawn by him, his pay shall be fixed at the lowest stage in the Basic Scale that gives him that advantage; provided further that the maximum of the relevant Basic Scale shall not be exceeded in any case. In this fixation formula, " emoluments" would mean the sum of pay, Dearness Allowance and Local Compensatory Allowance, if any.

Fixation of Pay on Promotion: - The existing provision regulating the fixation of way in case of promotion of employees from a lower to a higher post shall continue to apply.

Hove-Over: - The Existing provision regulating the concession of Nove-over without promotion to the next higher pay scale of employees in revised National Pay Scale-I(B-1) to revised National Pay Scale-IG(B-16)shall continue to he applicably in this scheme.

The existing concession of "Move-Over" of employees from 6. . revised National Bay Scale-16 to ravised Hational Bay Scale-17 (B-17) and RHES-17(1-17) to RNES-18(B-18) shall be extended up to H-20 and regulated as under:-

- (e) Normal promotion procedure as is observed in cases of promotion through the Competent Authority, e.g S&GAD/Selection Board shall be followed in allowing Move-over to Basic Scales 19 & 20.



The advance increments sanctioned under the Finance Department's letter No.FD (SR-I)1-67/83, dated 24.08.1983 as clarified in the Finance Department's Notification No.Fd (PRC) 1-1/89, dated 7.8.1991 are not admissible to those who have been granted higher pay scales on the basis of higher specified qualifications in atleast 2nd Division, The advance increments in term of FD's letter dated 24.8.1983, referred to above are still admissible to those who could not get higher pay scales for not possessing/acquiring the specified higher qualifications in 2nd Division.

JUDGMENT

Syed Mansoor Ali Shah, J. - The facts of the case are that petitioners in both the petitions were appointed as Primary School Teachers ("PST"). Manzoor Ahmad, petitioner in Civil Petition No.172-P/2013 ("Petitioner No.1"), however, retired from service on 01.02.2016, while Yasmeen Akhtar, petitioner in Civil Petition No.173-P/2013 ("Petitioner No.2") is still in service.

ASTESTED These petitions pertain to their claim regarding advance Assistant Registrimerements on the basis of acquiring higher educational qualification while in preme Court of Pakistan Peshawar. service. Petitioner No.1 was given five advance increments under Notification dated 24.08.1983 while petitioner No.2 was given three advance increments under the same Notification plus a move-over to BPS-09. Petitioners claim that as per subsequent Notification dated 11.08.1991 issued by the Finance Department, Government of KPK, petitioner No.1 ought to have been given 12 advance increments for obtaining higher educational qualification of F.A, B.A and M.A, while petitioner No.2 be given six advance increments, as per the same Notification for obtaining the qualification of F.A and B.A. It is submitted <u>CP No.172-P/2013, et</u>

that the petitioners were appointed as PSTs when the qualification for the said post was matriculation.

3. Arguing the case for himself and for petitioner No.2, Mr. Manzoor Ahmad submitted that they were initially granted advance increments vide Notification dated 24.08.1983, however, subsequently through the Notification dated 11.08.1991, the number of advance increments were increased, inasmuch as, it was also granted for obtaining higher educational qualification of M.A. He submits that the said notification is applicable to PSTs and placed reliance on an unreported judgment of this Court dated 09.07.2007, passed in Civil Petition No.525/2007, as well as, the subsequent notification issued in the light of the said judgment i.e. Notification dated 13.05.2009, issued by the Elementary and Secondary Education Department, Government of KPK. The above cited judgment extends the benefit of Notification dated 11.08.1991 to teachers.


Learned Additional Advocate General, KPK representing the of Pakistan Government, submits that the case of the petitioners is governed by Notification dated 24.08.1983, issued by the Finance Department, Government of KPK and as per clause 9 of the said notification, petitioner No.1 is entitled to five advance increments for obtaining F.A. and B.A., whereas, petitioner No.2 is entitled to three advance increments as she has already been granted the benefit of move-over to higher pay scale as per Notification dated 07.08.1991, X issued by the Finance Department, Government of KPK. Learned law officer has placed reliance on an unreported judgment of this Court dated 08.9.2011, passed in Civil Petition No.1425/2011, which discusses the mode of calculation of advance increment granted for higher educational qualification. In this case, it was held that advance increment can only be granted for the highest educational qualification obtained, as advance increments for the degrees leading up to the final degree stand merged into advance increment prescribed for the highest qualification. In other words, advance increments for obtaining F.A (two advance increments) and B.A (four advance increments including two $\,
m \,$

advance increments granted for F.A) stand merged into advance increments granted for obtaining M.A (six advance increments), therefore, providing two advance increment for each higher educational qualification.

5. He further submits that at this stage the claim of the petitioners cannot be entertained in the light of section 2 of the <u>Khyber Pakhtunkhwa</u> <u>Cessation of Payment of Arrears on Advance Increments on Higher</u> <u>Educational Qualification Act, 2012</u> ("Act of 2012"), by virtue of which the instant petitions cannot proceed and stand abated. He placed reliance on an unreported judgment of this Court dated 29.8.2013, passed in Civil Petition No.360/2013.

6. We have heard the parties at some length and have gone through the record of the case. While the argument of the petitioners might have some merit with regard to grant of <u>one advance increment</u> in the case of petitioner No.1 and <u>four advance increments</u> in case of petitioner No.2 in the light of Notification dated 11.08.1991, read with the unreported judgments of this Court dated 09.7.2007 passed in Civil Petition No.525/2007 and dated 08.9.2011 passed in Civil Petition No.1425/2011. However, before going into the merits of the case, we need to first examine the justiciability of the claims in the light of Act of 2012. The preamble of Act of 2012 provides as under:-



"The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Cessation of Payment of Arrears on Advance Increments on Higher Educational Qualification Bill 2012 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa on 8th May, 2012 and assented to by the Governor of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa on 11th May, 2012 is hereby published as an Act of the Provincial Legislature of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Whereas advance increments have been granted to certain Provincial Government employees on the basis of acquiring or possessing higher educational qualification over and above the prescribed educational qualification from time to time;

And whereas the Provincial Government vide Notification No.(PRC)1-1/2001, dated 27-10-2001, had already discontinued the scheme of advance increments on higher educational qualification;

And whereas due to financial constraints, it is not possible for Provincial Government to pay the claimed and unclaimed arrears accrued from the said increments;

It is hereby enacted as follows:--" (emphasis supplied)

While section-2 reads as under:-

"2. Cessation of payment of arrears on advance increments on higher educational qualification.---(1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any decision, judgment and order of any Tribunal or court including High Court or Supreme Court of Pakistan, for the purpose of any claim for payment of arrears on account of advance increments on higher educational qualification sanctioned in pursuance of any order, letter, office memoranda, notification, instructions and other instruments issued before 1-12-2001, such orders, letters, office memoranda, notifications, instructions and other instruments shall be deemed to be non-existent, ceased or revoked and no further claim whatsoever on the basis of these instruments shall be entertained and all cases in respect of such claims pending in any court or Tribunal including High Court and Supreme Court of Pakistan shall stand abated.

(2) Any order made, instruction issued, decision, judgment or order of any court or Tribunal including a High Court or the Supreme Court, implemented immediately before the commencement of this Act, shall be deemed to have been validly made, issued and implemented by the date of commencement of this Act, and any amount already paid there-under on account of advance increments or arrears thereof shall be deemed to have been validly paid and hall not be recoverable from the recipient Government employees." prems Court of Pakistan Port

Plain reading of the above provisions show that the claim of 7. advance increments on obtaining higher educational qualification was discontinued by the Provincial Government on 27.10.2001. Section-2 of the Act of 2012 provides that claim for payment of arrears of advance increments shall be deemed non-existent and no further claim whatsoever on the basis of these instruments shall be entertained and all cases in respect of such claims pending in any Court or Tribunal including High Court and Supreme Court shall stand abated. Sub-section 2 provides that any amount of advance increment or arrears thereof already paid before the commencement of the Act of 2012 shall be deemed to have been validly paid and shall not be recoverable from the recipient government employees.

The scope of Act of 2012 is that after the promulgation of the Act 8. i.e. w.e.f. 11.05.2012, no government employee can claim arrears on account of advance increments for higher educational qualification and advance ψ CP No.172-P/2013, etc

increments and arrears already paid shall not be recoverable from the recipient government employee. "Arrears" includes payment of a debt or the discharge of an obligation¹. In this case, claim of the petitioners for advance increment under Notification dated 11.8.1991 is an outstanding arrear. Reference to the deeming commencement date under section-1(3) of the Act is simply to identify the cutoff date for the purposes of tabulating arrears as mentioned in section-2, which, if outstanding on 11.5.2012, will not be payable and no claim relating to the same can be entertained.

In the instant case petitioners are seeking arrears on the basis of 9. Notification dated 11.08.1991 and in the light of section-2 of the Act of 2012, their claim cannot be entertained and is not justiciable. Reliance is placed on unreported judgment of this Court dated 29.08.2013 passed in Civil Petition No.360/2013. The petitioners have not challenged the vires of the Act, therefore, these petitions stand abated under Act of 2012, as a result leave to appeal is declined and these petitions are dismissed.
