



Learned counsel for the appellant present. Preliminary arguments heard.


Learned counsel for the appellant while opening her arguments at the stage of preliminary hearing, apprised that this is a case of pro-forma promotion of the appellant. She referred to the impugned order dated 05.08.2021 whereby private respondents No. 6, 7, 8 & 9 being junior to the appellant on seniority list, were promoted to the post of Professor BS-20 (Technical Subjects). The appellant feeling aggrieved of the impugned order submitted departmental appeal on 09.08.2021 which was not decided/responded within the stipulated statutory period hence the instant service appeal was filed on 13.12.2021. It was further argued that the appellant has been discriminated despite being senior to private respondents No. 6 to 9 with total disregard to the seniority list and the impugned order is not according to law and natural justice. The appellant is therefore entitled for proforma promotion from the date when post in BS-20 was available, alongwith arrears and other back benefits, she concluded.

Points raised need consideration. The appeal is admitted to regular hearing, subject to all just and legal objections. The appellant is directed to deposit security and process fee within 10 days. Thereafter, notices be issued to the respondents for submission of written reply/comments. To come up for reply/comments before the S.B on 22.07.2022.
