

Precise facts giving rise to filing of the instant service appeal are
that the appellant, who is Associate Professor in Zoology, was
transferred from Government Girls Degree College No. 1
Hayatabad Peshawar to Government Girls Degree College
Rustum (Mardan), vide the impugned transfer order dated
11.06.2021. The appellant challenged her transfer through filing

of departmental appeal, however the same was not responded, hence the instant service appeal.

2. Notices were issued to the respondents, who submitted their comments, wherein they refuted the assertions made by the appellant in the appeal.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant has contended that the appellant is a female and her child is clubfoot, while her husband is also a heart patient but even then the respondents transferred her to a far flung area without following transfer/posting policy; that the child of the appellant is school going and the duty of his pick and drop is upon the shoulder of the appellant, therefore, the presence of the appellant at Peshawar is necessary for proper education of her child at this stage; that almost all the female teachers have been accommodated by posting them within their home districts but the appellant was treated with discrimination; that the impugned order to the extent of transfer of the appellant from Government Girls Degree College No.1 Hayatabad Peshawar to Government Girls Degree College Rustum (Mardan) being wrong and illegal as well as against the fundamental rights of the appellant is liable to be set-aside. Reliance was placed on 1998 TD (Service) 355 and 2003 PLC (C.S) 983.



4. On the other hand, learned Assistant Advocate General for the respondents has contended that in view of Section-10 of Civil Servants Act, 1973, the appellant is bound to serve anywhere in the province and she cannot legally challenge her transfer order; that the appellant remained posted in various colleges of District Peshawar for almost nine years, therefore, she is not justified in alleging that she was treated with discrimination; that transfer order of the appellant was issued in public interest without any malafide on part of the respondents, therefore, the appeal in hand may be dismissed with cost.


5. Arguments heard and record perused.


6. During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the appellant alleged that the departmental appeal of the appellant was

not decided by the appellate Authority. Learned Assistant Advocate General has also not controverted this assertion of learned counsel for the appellant. Copy of departmental appeal of the appellant is annexed with the memo of appeal. In the given facts and circumstances of the case, it deem appropriate that directions be issued to the appellate Authority to decide the departmental appeal of the appellant through a speaking order.

7. In light of the above, the appellate Authority is directed to decide the departmental appeal of the appellant through a speaking order by complying the relevant law/rules within a period of 30 days of the receipt of copy of this judgment. Copy of the departmental appeal alongwith copy of this judgment be sent to the appellate Authority for compliance. The appeal in hand is disposed of accordingly. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.

- A. Against the Notification No .SO(C-1/HE/1-5 /2020/Female Posting -transfer dated 11/6/2021 impugned to the extent of the transfer of the Appellant at serial 51 of the Notification from Government Girls degree college No 1 Hayatabad to Government Girls Degree College Mardan Rustam
- B. and her Departmental Appeal has not been replied so far.

Prayer:-

1. That on acceptance of this Appeal the Notification No .SO(C-1/HE/1-5 /2020/Female Posting -transfer dated 11/6/2021 which is impugned before this Tribunal to the extent of the transfer of the Appellant at serial 51 of the Notification from Government Girls degree college No 1 Hayatabad to Government Girls

Degree College Mardan Rustam and at serial no-50 on her place the private Respondent No 3 is transferred to government Girls Degree College No 1 Hayatabad Peshawar may be set aside and withdrawn being illegal against the fundamental right of the Appellant and against the Transfer Policy.

- 2. That the non reply of the Respondents of the departmental Appeal of the Appellant be declared against the Appeal Rules and tainted malafide and against the good governance.

Respectfully Sheweth: - The need for the instant Appeal arises due to the following facts:

Facts:

- 1. That the Appellant was appointed on the recommendation of the Provincial Public Service Commission as Lecturer in Zoology and as per directions of the Respondents was posted at Government Girls College Dera Ismail Khan w.e. f. 25.06 2001 and took charge on 1.7 2001. (Annexure - A₁)

- 2. That Appellant was transferred from GGDC No 2 Dera Ismail khan to Government Girls Degree College Bannu on 21.1 2004 and was transferred and posted on 12th July 2006 at Govt Girls College Gulshan-e- Rehman, Peshawar and then to Government Frontier College Peshawar on 9.9 2006. (The relevant documents are attached as **Annexure A**).

- 3. That the Respondents promoted the Appellant to the post of Assistant Professor in Zoology on 19.1 2009 through a notification issued by a competent Authority with immediate effect in the public interest along with others and on 24.2 2009 was again transferred to Government Girls College Bannu (**The relevant documents are attached as Annexure B**).

- 4. That the Appellant was transferred to Government Frontier College for woman Peshawar on 7th January 2010.... (**Annexure C**).

5. That the Appellant got married on 7.2.2010 with a person who is a permanent resident of Peshawar and is settled in Hayatabad in his own house in Phase -7 meaning thereby she is now considered to be domiciled of Peshawar..... (*The Nikah Nama and CNIC of the husband is attached as Annexure D*).

6. That the husband of the Appellant went to Saudi Arabia for service and the Appellant in order to accompany him applied for Ex- Pakistan Leave on 5.5 2011 and was granted five years leave till 10 .5 2016 therefore this period shall not be considered by the Respondent service in Peshawar.

(*Annexure E*)

7. That when she returned , was post at GGDC Hayat Abad Peshawar the place from which she went on Ex Pakistan Leave and was serving there with best satisfaction of the concerned till 10. 10. 2018..... (*Annexure F*).

8. That the Respondents as per turn made promotions policy of the eligible was promoted along others to the post of Associate professor BPS-19 but again was transferred from Peshawar i.e. from her home station to *Government Girls Degree College KDA Kohat through order dated 10.10.2019*.

(*Annexure G*).

9. That the Appellant filed a Departmental Appeal against it and when was not replied by the Respondents the Appellant challenged the delay in deciding the appeal of the Appellant and the Tribunal was kind enough to suspend the impugned order and ordered the Respondents to decide the appeal of the appellant within 30 days which is not decided till today.(*Annexure H*).

10. That the Appellant transferred if not cancelled may be adjusted and even detailed or posted to any other college near to her home so that she may look after her family with satisfaction.

11. That the Appellant filed a departmental Appeal against the impugned order dated 11.6.2021 before the competent Authority but no reply is given so far in writing but is orally informed that your departmental Appeal is rejected and the Respondent is not willing to give something in writing..... **(Annexure-I)**.

Being aggrieved hence this Appeal inters alia is preferred on the following grounds:

Grounds:-

- A. That the notification issued by the Respondent No 1 to the extent whereby the Respondents transferred the appellant from her home district to far away being a female and guardian of children and husband is discriminatory and against the Principle of law.
- B. That it is established and recognized policy of the Government that female staff as much possible be posted in her own home district but in the case of the appellant this policy is violated.
- C. That the child of the Appellant is under treatment for clubfoot and for his treatment even she went to Canada hence with ailing child it is difficult for the Appellant to serve outside the home district. Needless to mention that the husband of the Appellant is a heart patient, is jobless and is in home and even she is undergoing treatment for different diseases. ***(All the relevant prescription are attached as Annexure J)***
- D. That child of the appellant is admitted in school and she is personally picking and dropping him so in such circumstances she cannot afford to leave her alone. ***(Annexure K)***.
- E. That if the transfer notification dated 11.6.2021 is perused almost all the female teachers are accommodated within the home district but the Appellant is treated discriminately.

F. That it is believed that the Post of Associate professor are lying vacant on the promotion and transfer of teachers in the relevant subject .

G. That the Respondents are under the law bound to keep in mind the Couple Policy, the sex of the civil servant and even right to life of the Appellant but for un known reasons is not doing it.

H. That with the transfer of Appellant the family life of her and her family is going to be disturbed.

Therefore it is prayed that the appeal of the Appellant be accepted with the prayer as above.


Learned counsel for the appellant present.

The appellant has filed the present service appeal against the posting transfer order dated 10.10.2018 to the extent of her transfer from Government Girls Degree College No.1 Hayat Abad to Government Girls Degree College KDA Kohat.

Learned counsel for the appellant argued inter-alia that the appellant was appointed as Lecturer in Zoology in the year 2001; that she was promoted to the post of Assistant Professor in the year 2009 and then Associate Professor vide order dated 10.10.2018; that she remained posted at D.I.Khan, Bannu and Peshawar; that in the year 2010 the appellant got married with permanent resident of Peshawar settled in Hayat Abad; that vide the impugned posting transfer order the appellant has been transferred out from her home district Peshawar whereas the child of the appellant is under treatment for clubfoot and for his treatment she also went to Canada with the ailing child, more so husband of the appellant is a heart patient and the appellant is also undergoing treatment for different diseases therefore it is difficult for the appellant to serve outside her home district Peshawar. Next contended that vide the same posting transfer order dated 10.10.2018 other colleagues of the appellant have been accommodated in their home districts but discriminatory treatment was met out to the appellant. Next contended that while issuing the impugned transfer posting order of the appellant, the respondent department has not considered the spouse policy, the gender and the family life of the appellant. Next contended that the appellant can easily be adjusted in district Peshawar. Next contended that the appellant has preferred the departmental appeal against her transfer to District Kohat however the appellate authority has not decided the same so far and as such there is

Respectfully Sheweth: -

Preliminary Objections:-

1. That the appellant has got no cause of action/locus standi to file the instant Service appeal.
2. That the appellant has not come to this Honourable Tribunal with clean hands and is trying to conceal material facts.
3. That the instant service appeal is time-barred.
4. That the instant Service Appeal is not maintainable as the appellant did not file any departmental appeal which is mandatory under section 4 of the Service Tribunal Act.
5. That the appellant has served in district Peshawar for more than her requisite tenure.
6. That the spouse policy does not apply in the case of the appellant as her husband is jobless as narrated by her in Para "C" of grounds.

Facts: -

- 1) Correct to the extent that the appellant was appointed as Lecturer through Public Service Commission in Higher Education Department, rest of Para pertains to record.
- 2) Correct.
- 3) Correct. That the appellant is domicile holder of Bannu and on promotion to BPS-18 she was adjusted at her domicile area. (**Annex-A**)
- 4) Correct. That after spending one year at her domicile area the appellant was again adjusted at district Peshawar upon her request. (**Annex-B**)
- 5) Incorrect. As per Govt; policy;
"Women Govt; Servant acquire domicile of husband if married before entry into Govt; Service such servant if married after entry into Govt; service however, retain her original domicile i.e one hold at the time of entry into service".(**Annex-C**) Moreover, the appellant did not attach CNIC, Domicile of husband to prove that her husband is domicile holder of district Peshawar.
- 6) Correct to the extent that Ex-Pakistan leave was granted to the appellant.
- 7) Correct to the extent that after availing Ex-Pakistan leave the appellant joined her duties at Govt; Girls Degree college, Hayatabad, Peshawar.

- 8) Correct to the extent that the appellant upon promotion from BPS-18 to BPS-19 was transferred from Govt; Girls Degree College, Hayatabad to Govt; Girls Degree College, KDA Kohat vide notification dated: 10-10-2018. **(Annex-D)**
- 9) That the appellant is trying to mislead the Hon'ble Tribunal. The appeal of the appellant was not considered due to non-availability of vacant post of BPS-19 at any Girls College of District Peshawar but when post became vacant the appellant was retained at Govt; Girls Degree College, No.1, Hayatabad Peshawar. **(Annex-E)** and during the intervening period, she was performing her duties at Govt; Girls degree College No. 1 Hayatabad **(Annex-F)** and was drawing her salary from Govt; Girls Degree College, KDA Kohat. It is pertinent to mention here that the appellant is transferred from Govt; Girls degree College No. 1 Hayatabad to Govt; Girls Degree College, Rustam Mardan vide Notification dated: 11-06-2021 in best public interest. **(Annex-G)**
- 10) That as per service history the appellant has spent almost 9 years at District Peshawar. Moreover, Transfer/Posting at one's own choice is not the vested right of any civil servant.
- 11) Incorrect. That no such departmental appeal is available on record.



Grounds: -


- A. Incorrect. That the Notification dated 11-06-2021 is in accordance with Law/Rules.
- B. Incorrect. That no such policy is available. Section 10 of Civil servant Act 1973, is read as under:
"Every civil servant shall be liable to serve anywhere within or outside the Province in any post under the Federal Government, or any Provincial Government or local authority, or a an corporation or body set up or established by any such Government".
- C. Pertains to record.
- D. Pertains to record. Needs no comments.
- E. Incorrect. As already explained in preceding Paras. It is pertinent to mention here that majority of resident of District Peshawar/domicile holder of Peshawar are working in colleges of other districts due to non-availability of vacant post in District Peshawar.
- F. Incorrect. Post of BPS-19 in the subject of appellant is not vacant in any college of District Peshawar.
- G. Incorrect. That spouse policy is for the employees of Govt; where both the husband and wife are Govt; servant and the policy is also subject to best public interest. But this policy is not applicable to the appellant as she herself narrated in Para "C" that her husband is jobless.
- H. Needs no Comments.
