

APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNALS ACT, 1974 FOR ANTEDATION OF CONFIRMATION OF THE APPELLANT IN THE RANK OF SUB INSPECTOR FROM 16.04.2016 TO 21.04.2010, THE DATE WHEN HIS JUNIOR NAMEDLY MUSLIM KHAN WAS CONFIRMED IN THE RANK OF SUB INSPECTOR AND FOR INCLUSION HIS NAME IN LIST "F" W.E.F 20.12.2011 THE DATE WHEN THE NAME OF MUSLIM KHAN WAS INCLUDED IN LIST "F" AND FOR FURTHER PROMOTION TO THE RANK OF INSPECTOR W.E.F 29.08.2014 AND TO THE RANK OF DSP W.E.F 13.02.2018, WHEN HIS JUNIOR NAMEDLY MUSLIM KHAN WAS PROMOTED TO THE RANK OF INSPECTOR AND DSP AND AGAINST NOT TAKING ACTION ON THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT WITHIN THE STATUTORY PERIOD OF NINETY DAYS.

**PRAYER:**

THAT ON THE ACCEPTANCE OF THIS APPEAL, THE RESPONDENT MAY KINDLY BE DIRECTED TO ANTE-DATE THE CONFIRMATION OF THE APPELLANT IN THE RANK OF SUB INSPECTOR FROM 16.04.2016 TO 21.04.2010 AND INCLUDE HIS NAME IN LIST "F" W.E.F 20.12.2011 ALONG WITH HIS COLLEAGUE AND JUNIORS BY REVISING HIS SENIORITY AND THE RESPONDENTS MAY FURTHER BE DIRECTED TO PROMOTE THE APPELLANT TO THE RANK OF INSPECTOR W.E.F 29.08.2014 AND TO THE RANK OF DSP W.E.F 13.02.2018, WHEN HIS JUNIOR NAMELY MUSLIM KHAN WAS PROMOTED TO THE RANK OF INSPECTOR AND DSP WITH ALL BACK AND CONSEQUENTIAL BENEFITS. ANY OTHER REMEDY, WHICH THIS AUGUST TRIBUNAL DEEMS FIT AND APPROPRIATE THAT, MAY ALSO, BE AWARDED IN FAVOUR OF APPELLANT.

**RESPECTFULLY SHEWTH:**

**FACTS:**

1. That the appellant joined the FRP during the year 1987 and has passed lower course in the year 1999 and intermediate course at PTC Hangu in the year 2004. The appellant was promoted as officiating ASI on 31.02.2005.
2. That in the year 2007, some of colleagues of the appellant filed writ petition in the Honorable Peshawar Court, Peshawar against the discriminatory treatment of FRP because colleagues of the appellant (petitioners in the writ petition) were not treated as regular police despite of performance duties as such and also against the reversion/demotion in the case of transfer to the District of Domicile. The writ petition was heard and dispose of with certain observations on 20.03.2008. (Copy of judgment dated 20.03.2008 is attached as annexure-A)
3. That after the judgment of august Peshawar High Court, Peshawar, the PPO KP issued a memo/order dated 10.06.2009 in which it was clarified "to give effect to the order of the Honorable High Court" recommended that earlier decision on the DPC should not be applied retrospectively and all official of the FRP be given permanent status and may be confirmed to their rank within their colleagues after completing their probation period as per Rule 13:18 of Police Rules

1934. (Copy of memo/order 10.06.2009 is attached as Annexure-B)

4. That on the basis of above decision of the committee, the appellant was considered as promoted officiating ASI with effect from 31.05.2005 and confirmed in the rank of ASI and promoted to List-E with effect from 31.05.2007 vide order dated 12.09.2009. (Copy of order dated 12.09.2009 is attached as Annexure-C)
5. That as exact time, the appellant was transferred to Malakand Region along with other colleagues as officiating ASI vide order dated 14.11.2007, but the appellant was reverted to the rank of HC by then DIG Malakand Region-III being officiating officer, but at that time the judgment of the High Court was not in field.
6. That the appellant was again transferred from Malakand Division to Peshawar Range and posted in the office of CCPO. The appellant's name was mentioned in the record of officiating ASI which is totally violation of the order dated 12.09.2009. Even the name of the appellant has not been incorporated in the List-E of the CCPO Peshawar office. The appellant asked about non-inclusion of his name in List-E, he was simply informed by the concerned office that he is still officiating ASI, therefore, the appellant filed departmental appeal and waited for statutory period of 90-days.
7. That after the statutory period of 90 days, the appellant filed service appeal No.1010/2013 in this Honorable Tribunal which was decided on 29.03.2017 in which the Honorable Service Tribunal observed that as the respondents are in a position to decide the grievances of the appellant in accordance with judgments of the august Peshawar High Court Peshawar dated 20.03.2008 and according to their stance taken in the written comments, the same is under consideration in departmental appeal as such the august Service Tribunal directed that the grievances of the appellant be positively decided by the respondents without further loss of time and within a period of one month from the date communication of the judgment, but his departmental appeal was rejected on 28.04.2017. (Copies of judgment dated 29.03.2017 and order dated 28.04.2017 are attached as Annexure-D&E)
8. That after the rejection order dated 28.04.2017, the appellant then again filed service appeal No.225/2018 with the prayer that order dated 28.04.2017 may kindly be set aside and the respondents may be directed to consider the appellant and mentioned him as confirmed ASI w.e.f 31.05.2007 as mentioned in the order dated 12.09.2009. The Honorable Tribunal heard and the decided the appeal of the appellant on 24.01.2022. The Honorable Service Tribunal accepted the appellant of the appellant as prayed for and in the

pursuance of judgment dated 24.01.2022, the appellant was promoted as officiating ASI w.e from 31.05.2005 and confirmed in the rank of ASI in List-E w.e from 31.05.2007 vide notification dated 18.08.2022. **(Copies of judgment dated 24.01.2022 and notification dated 18.08.2022 are attached as Annexure-F&G)**

9. That the appellant was confirmed in the rank of S.I on 24.04.2018 which was revised to 16.04.2016 vide order dated 05.04.2022. One of the colleague of the appellant namely Muslim Khan, who was confirmed as ASI and brought his name in list "E" w.e.from 05.04.2008 and also promoted in the rank of officiating S.I vide notification dated 19.04.2008 and was then confirmed in the rank of S.I on 26.10.2011 vide notification dated 26.10.2011. The name of Muslim Khan was included list "F" and was promoted as Officiating Inspector vide notification dated 20.12.2011 and then confirmed in the rank of Inspector vide notification dated 29.08.2014 and was further promoted to the rank of DSP vide notification dated 13.02.2018 and confirmation in the rank of SI of Muslim Khan was revised to 21.04.2010 from 26.10.2011 in the notification dated 05.04.2022 and as the appellant has confirmed as ASI w.e.from 31.05.2007 on the basis of notification dated 18.08.2022 passed in the pursuance of judgment dated 24.01.2022 of this Honorable Tribunal, which means that the appellant is senior to Muslim Khan and is entitle to be confirmed in the rank of SI w.e.from 21.04.2010 and included his name in list "F"-w.e.from 20.12.2011 and also entitle for further to the rank of Inspector w.e.from 29.08.2014 and DSP w.e.from 13.02.2018, the dates on which junior to the appellant namely Muslim Khan was confirmed in the rank of SI and his name was included in list "F" and was promoted to the rank of Inspector and DSP. **(Copies of notification dated 24.04.2018, notification dated 05.04.2022, notification dated 19.04.2008, notification dated 26.10.2011, notification dated 20.12.2011, notification dated 29.08.2014 and notification dated 13.02.2018 are attached as Annexure-H,I,J,K,M&N)**
10. That as the appellant has confirmed as ASI and included his name in List "E" w.e.from 31.05.2007 on the basis of notification dated 18.08.2022 passed in the pursuance of judgment dated 24.01.2022 of this Honorable Tribunal, while his junior namely Muslim Khan was confirmed as ASI and brought his name in list "E" w.e.from 05.04.2008 and also promoted in the rank of officiating S.I on 19.04.2008 and was confirmed as S.I on 26.10.2011 and included his name in list "F" w.e.f 20.12.2011 and also promoted as officiating Inspector on 20.12.2011 and was the confirmed as Inspector on 29.08.2014 and was further promoted to the rank of DSP on 13.02.2018 and confirmation in the rank of S.I of Muslim khan was revised from 21.04.2010 from 26.10.2011 in the notification dated 05.04.2022, but the appellant was confirmed in the rank of S.I

w.e.from 24.04.2018 which was revised to 16.04.2016 in notification dated 05.04.2022 without further promotion to the rank of Inspector etc, therefore the appellant filed departmental appeal on 13.09.2022 for confirmation in the rank of S.I w.e.from 21.04.2010 and for further promotion to the rank of Inspector w.e.from 29.08.2014 and DSP w.e.from 13.02.2018, the dates on which the junior to the appellant namely Muslim Khan was confirmed in the rank of S.I and was promoted to the rank of Inspector and DSP, which was not responded within the stipulated period of ninety days. **(Copy of departmental appeal is attached as Annexure-O)**

11. That the appellant has no other remedy except to file the instant appeal in this Honorable Tribunal for redressal of his grievance on the following grounds amongst others.


**GROUND:**

- A) That not confirming the appellant in the rank of S.I w.e.from 21.04.2010 "the date on which his junior Muslim Khan was confirmed as S.I" and not included his name in list "F" with batchmates and juniors and not promoting him in the rank of Inspector w.e.from 29.05.2014 and DSP w.e.from 13.02.2018 and not taking action on the departmental appeal of the appellant within the statutory period of ninety days are against the law, facts, norms of justice and material on record, therefore, not tenable.
- B) That the appellant was confirmed in the rank of SI on 24.04.2018, which was revised to 16.04.2016 vide order dated 05.04.2022 and his junior namely Muslim Khan was confirmed as ASI and brought his name in list "E" w.e.from 05.04.2008 and also promoted in the rank of officiating S.I on 19.04.2008 and was confirmed in the rank of S.I on 26.10.2011 and promoted as Officiating Inspector on 20.12.2011 and was then confirmed in the rank of Inspector on 29.08.2014 and was further promoted to the rank of DSP on 13.02.2018 and confirmation in the rank of SI of Muslim Khan was revised to 21.04.2010 from 26.10.2011 in the notification dated 05.04.2022 and as the appellant has confirmed as ASI w.e.from 31.05.2007 on the basis of notification dated 18.08.2022 passed in the pursuance of judgment dated 24.01.2022 of this Honorable Tribunal, which means that the appellant is senior to Muslim and is entitle to be confirmed in the rank of S.I on 21.04.2010 and also entitle for further promotion to the rank of Inspector w.e.from 29.08.2014 and DSP w.e.from 13.02.2018, the dates on which his junior namely Muslim Khan was confirmed in the rank of S.I and was promoted to the rank of Inspector and DSP respectively.



- C) That due to not confirming the appellant in the rank of S.I from the date i.e 21.04.2010 when his junior was confirmed as S.I will deprive him from his legal right of further promotion to the rank of Inspector and DSP w.e.from 29.08.2014 and 13.02.2018 respectively, which is against the norms of justice and fair play.
- D) That by not confirming the appellant in the rank of S.I from the dated i.e 21.04.2010 when his junior was confirmed as S.I will deprive him from his legal right of further promotion to the rank of Inspector w.e.from 29.08.2014 and DSP w.e.from 13.02.2018, which will cause irreparable loss to the appellant in the shape of pension and other monetary benefits.
- E) That the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law and rules and has been deprived from his legal right of confirmation as S.I from due date i.e 21.04.2010 and from promotion to the rank of Inspector and DSP by the arbitrary acts of the respondents.
- F) That the appellant seeks permission of this Honorable Tribunal to advance others grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is, therefore most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.

MUHAMMAD RAZA KHAN, C. J.- This order shall also be

deemed to be an order in the connected Writ Petitions No.1616 and  
1617 of 2007 as the identical questions are involved in all these cases.

Through these Constitutional Petitions the petitioners have challenged  
the letter dated 16.2.2007, whereby the suggestion relating to the  
promotion order of Frontier Reserve Police (FRP) literate officials,  
moved by the Commandant FRP, was considered by the DPC and it  
was held that under Chapter 13 of the Police Rules no constable/head  
constable can be admitted to list 'D' unless he is thoroughly efficient in  
all the branches of duties of the Constable/Head Constable. The  
reasons advanced in the impugned letter for declining the proposal, was  
that FRP is a transit force and the officials are transferred to their  
Districts of domicile after five years.

2. In the comments the respondents No.1, 2 and 3 have  
admitted that some of the employees of FRP were erroneously  
promoted and when the matter came to the notice of the concerned  
authorities they placed it before the DPC where the said order was

passed which is in accordance with the police rules applicable to the police establishment. (11)

3. The petitioners contend that they had been appointed in the reserve police and they had been serving for a period ranging between 15 to 20 years and that their colleagues have been upgraded and promoted to senior positions, but the refusal to place them in 'D' list and to promote them, shall adversely affect their service interest amounting to discrimination. It was claimed that their colleagues in FRP have been given accelerated promotion and most of them are presently working as ASIs and SJs despite the fact that they were recruited alongwith the petitioners.

4. We feel that apparently the FRP is now a regular establishment and no more a transit force and there is no proof that the personnel working therein was temporarily posted for five years, therefore, the discriminatory treatment, meted out to them, is violative of the fundamental rights, particularly when, they will be placed at an extra-ordinary junior position if transferred to the Districts and enlisted there on the basis of their length of service and experience in all branches of police force. In any case, since the petitioners have not been transferred out of the Frontier Reserve Police within the prescribed period of five years, as stated in the impugned order, therefore, a mistake on the part of the concerned authorities cannot put the petitioners in an adverse situation and they cannot be penalized for the fault of the others. Moreover the decision to rectify a wrong practice shall definitely operate prospectively and it cannot be applied to the

petitioners retrospectively who had been recruited in FRP and had been continuously serving the department for over fifteen years.

We, therefore, direct that the case of the regularization, promotions and opportunities for enlistment in the intermediate course etc., shall be re-examined at a higher level under the supervision of the Provincial Police Officer and the decision dated 16.2.2007 may be re-considered by the concerned DPC so that nobody should be discriminatively deprived of his legal rights and that no decision be made operative retrospectively damaging the members of the discipline force who have to perform extra-ordinary duties and who deserve to be adequately compensated and encouraged. The re-consideration process be finalized within a period of two months and the result thereof be communicated to the petitioners and a report may be forwarded to the Registrar of this Court. With these observations these petitions are disposed of.

The promotion case of FRP Personnel has been examined in DSC meeting held on 07.05.2009 and agreed to the recommendations submitted by Committee constituted for the purpose which is reproduced below:

The Committee after due deliberation and in order to give effect to the orders of the honourable High Court recommends that earlier decision on the DPC should not be applied retrospectively and all officials of the FRP be given permanent status and may be confirmed in their rank with their colleagues after completing their probation period as per PR 13.18.

Benefit received by the officials in the FRP till decision of DPC and their repatriation to the Districts of their domicile be kept in tact so that they should not be deprived of any right as per decision of the Court.

All these officials may be dealt strictly according to standing order No. 3/99. Literate officials may be treated as per Police Rules whereas cases of illiterate officials may be treated as per criteria in the Standing Orders. Seniority of literate officials be fixed in each list of the basis of course undergone and criteria fixed under Police Rules Chapter 13.

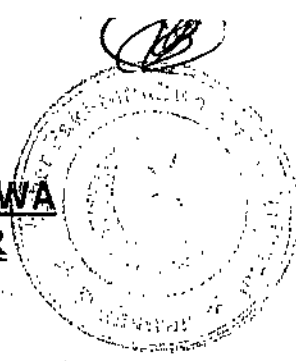

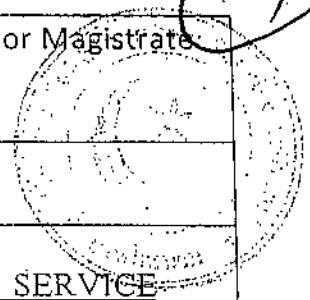

ORDER

In pursuance of judgment order dated 29.03.2017 passed by Honorable Service Tribunal in service appeal No. 1010/2013 filed by Maqbool Jehan officiating ASI No. 4481 CCP Peshawar to the effect that "grievances of the appellant be positively decided by the respondents without further loss of time and within a period of one month from the date of communication of this judgment in case they failed to decide the said grievances of the appellant within the specific period of one month then it shall be deemed that they have accepted the stance and the entitlement of appellant and in which eventuality he shall be considered as officiating ASI w.e.f. 31.05.2005 and confirmed w.e.f. 31.05.2007" The appeal is disposed of in the above terms.

At the very outset, it is worth to clarify that appellant was enlisted in Frontier Reserve Police (FRP) NWFP, Peshawar was transferred to his domicile district Bunir, in pursuance of orders endst; No. 14377/E-I dated 10.06.2009 that all literate officials of FRP be transferred to their domicile districts. The appellant then managed to transfer himself from district Bunir to CCP Peshawar vide CPO order endst; 31737-38/E-II dated 26.11.2008. So later on his lien was detached from district Bunir and attached to CCP Peshawar vide NO. 4141-43/E-II dated 16.02.2009 wherein it was ordered that he (appellant) will accept his bottom seniority. As such his name was placed in the bottom of "D" list Head Constable in conformity with lien rules/policy and no discrimination was done with appellant.

The appellant having in knowledge/factum of the case, unlawfully claimed seniority of FRP and preferred representation which was thoroughly examined and filed by the competent authority, information thereof was intimated vide letter No 3334/ E-III, dated 10.11.2015. However to avoid irregularity if any occurred in the past, the entire relevant record minutely re-examined and after observing the same, no illegality was noticed to have been occurred with appellant. Hence no need to interfere in earlier correspondence, acceptance the stance of the appellant would definitely amount to injustice with his colleagues/batchmates who had undergone Intermediate College Course in the same terms from Police Training College Hangu. His appeal with regard to claiming seniority is therefore rejected/filed being devoid of merits.

**JUDGMENT**

**ATIQU-UR-REHMAN WAZIR MEMBER (E):-** Brief facts of the case are

that the appellant joined Frontier Reserve Police(FRP) as Constable in the year 1987 and was promoted as Officiating ASI vide order dated 31-05-2005 and confirmed in the rank and promoted to E list with effect from 31-05-2007 vide order dated 12-09-2009. In the meanwhile, the appellant was transferred to Malakand region alongwith other colleagues vide order dated 14-11-2007 and was later on transferred to Peshawar, but name of the appellant is still mentioned in the record as Officiating ASI. Name of the appellant was also not incorporated in the list E of the CCPO Office Peshawar, against which the appellant filed departmental appeal dated 11-01-2013, followed by Service Appeal No. 1010/2013 with prayers to include his name as confirmed ASI as well as inclusion

of his name in promotion list E with effect from 31-05-2007 as mentioned in order dated 12-09-2009 passed on the strength of judgment of Peshawar High Court dated 20-03-2008. This tribunal accepted his stance vide judgment dated 29-03-2017 and remanded his case to the respondents to decide departmental appeal of the appellant. departmental appeal of the appellant was examined by the respondents and was rejected vide order dated 28-04-2017, hence the instant service appeal with prayers that the impugned order dated 28-04-2017 may be set aside and the appellant may be considered as confirmed ASI with effect from 31-05-2007 as mentioned in order dated 12-09-2009.

02. Learned counsel for the appellant has contended that the order dated 28-04-2017 and not considering the appellant as confirmed ASI as per order dated 12-09-2009 are against law, facts and norms of natural justice; therefore not tenable and liable to be set aside; that the appellant has been confirmed ASI with effect from 31-05-2007 as per order dated 12-09-2009, which was passed on the direction of Peshawar High Court, therefore, the same benefit cannot be taken away from the appellant; that the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law, hence his rights secured under the law has badly been violated; that the orders dated 10-06-2009 and 12-09-2009 are still in field, therefore the appellant cannot be refused benefits of such orders; that as mentioned in the rejection order dated 28-04-2017 of the departmental appeal of the appellant that the name of the appellant was placed at the bottom of D list of head constables on transfer from Buner to CCPO Peshawar, but as per FRP Standing order No 4, the seniority of constables so transferred shall be determined on the basis of entry into service and they will not be placed at the bottom of the list of constables; that the appellant has been discriminated as all his colleagues who stood confirmed and regularized on the basis of Peshawar High Court judgment, who still enjoy their ranks, whereas the appellant has been given a rank of officiating ASI, which is grave injustice meted out to the appellant.

03. Learned Additional Advocate General for the respondents has contended that the appellant had already agitated the same issue before this tribunal in service appeal No 1010/2013, which was decided vide judgment dated 29-03-2017 and his case was remanded to the respondents for deciding his departmental appeal; that the respondents examined his appeal but was found devoid of merit, hence was rejected vide order dated 28-04-2017; that the appellant was received as incharge head constable and not as ASI, hence was correctly fixed in his cadre in accordance with law.

04. We have heard learned counsel for the parties and have perused the record.

05. Record reveals that the appellant joined FRP in the year 1987 and had gone through the process of promotion, was promoted as officiating ASI on 31-05-2005, confirmed as ASI on 31-05-2007. Since the FRP was not treated at par with regular police in respect of promotion and other allied issues, hence other colleagues of the appellant filed Writ Petition No. 1615-07/2007, which was decided in their favor, vide judgment dated 20-03-2008. In light of the judgment *ibid*, the provincial police officer vide order dated 10-06-2009 had advised the Commandant FRP that benefits received by officials be kept intact, in case they are repatriated to the districts of their domicile and they should not be deprived of any right as per decision of the High Court. In light of order of provincial police officer, the commandant FRP vide order dated transferred the appellant to regular police and regularized according to Rule-13:18 of Police Rules, 1934 and his services handed over to Peshawar police being promoted as officiating ASI on 31-05-2005 and confirmed as ASI as well as promoted to list E with effect from 31-05-2007 vide order dated 12-09-2009. On arrival to Peshawar police, he was placed as officiating ASI, which was challenged by the appellant in this tribunal vide Service Appeal No. 1010/2013, which was decided by this Tribunal vide judgment dated 29-03-2017, operative part of which is reproduced as under:-

"The respondents are in a position to decide the grievance of the appellant in accordance with the judgment of the august High Court Peshawar dated 20-03-2008 and according to their stance taken in the written statement, the same is under consideration in departmental appeal as such we direct that the grievance of the appellant be positively decided by the respondents without further loss of time and within one month, in case they fail to decide the said grievance of the appellant within the specified period of one month then it shall be deemed that they have accepted the stance and entitlement of the appellant and in such eventuality he shall be considered as officiating ASI with effect from 31-05-2005 and confirmed ASI in list E with effect from 31-05-2007."

06. Keeping in view the judgment cited above coupled with the judgment of Peshawar high court dated 20-03-2008, which had emphasized that the benefits already availed in FRP cannot be taken away, in case the appellant is transferred to his home district. Case of the appellant also falls under the category, which is evident from his transfer order dated 12-09-2009 and refusal of the same benefits would amount to negation of their own order dated 10-06-2009 as well as to the orders of Peshawar High Court in judgment dated 20-03-2008. This Tribunal had already admitted stance of the appellant in judgment dated 29-03-2017, whereas the respondents did not produce any solid reason of refusing such benefits to the appellant, hence we are constrained to accept the instant appeal as prayed for. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to record room.

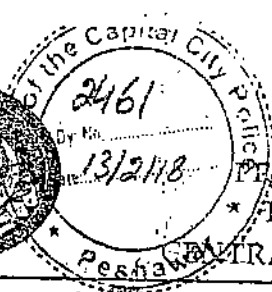

Respected sir,

1. That the appellant joined the FRP during the year 1987 and has passed lower course in the year 1999 and intermediate court at PTC Hangu in the year 2004. The appellant was promoted as officiating ASI on 31/02/2005.
2. That in the year 2007, some colleagues of the appellant filed writ petition in the Peshawar High Court, Peshawar against the discriminatory treatment of FRP because colleagues of the appellant (petitioners in the writ petition) were not treated as regular police despite of performance duties as such and also against the reversion/demotion in the case of transfer to the District of Domicile. The writ petition was decided on 20/3/2008.
3. That after the judgment of the Peshawar High Court, Peshawar, the PPO KP issued a letter dated 10/6/2009 in which it was clarified "to give effect to the order of the Honorable High Court" recommends that earlier decision on the DPC should not be applied retrospectively and all official of the FRP be given permanent status and may be confirmed to their rank with their colleagues after completing their probation period as per Rule 13:18 of Police Rules 1934.
4. That on the basis of above decision of the committee, the appellant was considered as promoted officiating ASI with effect from 31/5/2005 and confirmed in the rank of ASI and promoted to List-E with effect from 31/5/2007 vide order dated 12/9/2009.
5. That as exact time, the appellant was transferred to Malakand Region along with other colleagues as officiating ASI vide order dated

14.11.2007, but the appellant was reverted to the rank of H.C by the then DIG Malakand Region-III being officiating officer.

6. That the appellant was again transferred from Malakand Division to Peshawar Range and posted in the office of the CCPO. The appellant's name was mention in the record as Officiating ASI which is totally violation of the order dated 12.09.2009. Even the name of the appellant has not been incorporated in the List-E of the CCPO Peshawar office. the appellant asked about non-inclusion, he was simply informed by the concerned office that he is still officiating ASI, therefore the appellant filed departmental appeal and waited for statutory period of 90 days.
7. That after the statutory period of 90 days, the appellant filed service appeal No.1010/2013 in the KP Service Tribunal, which was decided on 29.03.2017 in which the Service Tribunal directed the respondent to decide the departmental appeal in accordance with the judgment of the august Peshawar High Court dated 20.03.2008, but his departmental appeal was rejected on 28.04.2017.
8. That after the rejection order dated 28.04.2017, the appellant then again filed service appeal No. 225/2018 with the prayer that order dated 28.04.2017 may be set aside and the respondents may be directed to consider the appellant and mentioned him as confirmed ASI w.e.from 31.05.2007 as mentioned in the order dated 12.09.2009. The service appeal of the appellant was accepted as prayed on 24.01.2022 and the in the pursuance of judgment dated 24.01.2022, the appellant was promoted as offg: ASI w.e from 31.05.2005 and confirmed in the rank of ASI in list "E" w.e.from 31.05.2007 vide notification dated 18.08.2022.
9. That the appellant was confirmed in the rank of SI on 24.04.2018 which was revised to 16.04.2016 vide order dated 05.04.2022. One of the colleague of the appellant namely Muslim Khan, who was confirmed as ASI and brought his name in list "E" w.e.from 05.04.2008 and also promoted in the rank of Officiating SI on 19.04.2008 and was then confirmed in the rank of SI on 20.10.2011. Muslim Khan was then promoted as Offg: Inspector on 20.12.2011 and was confirmed in the rank of Inspector on 29.08.2014 and was further promoted to the rank of DSP on 13.02.2018 and confirmation in the rank of SI of Muslim Khan was revised to 21.04.2010 from 20.10.2011 in the notification dated 05.04.2022 and as the appellant has confirmed as ASI w.e.from 31.05.2007 on the basis of notification dated 18.08.2022 passed in the pursuance of judgment dated 24.01.2022 of the KP Service Tribunal, which means that the appellant is senior to Muslim Khan and is entitle to be confirmed in the rank of SI on 21.04.2010 and also entitle for further promotion to the rank of Inspector w.e.from 29.08.2014 and DSP w.e.from 13.02.2018, the dates on which his junior namely Muslim was

confirmed in the rank of SI and was promoted to the rank of Inspector and DSP.

10. That as the appellant has confirmed as ASI w.e.from 31.05.2007 on the basis of notification dated 18.08.2022 passed in the pursuance of judgment dated 24.01.2022 of the KP Service Tribunal, while his colleague namely Muslim Khan was confirmed as ASI and brought his name in list "E" w.e.from 05.04.2008 and also promoted in the rank of Officiating SI on 19.04.2008 and was confirmed as SI on 20.10.2011 and promoted as Offg: on 20.12.2011 and was then confirmed as Inspector on 29.08.2014 and was further promoted to the rank of DSP on 13.02.2018 and confirmation in the rank of SI of Muslim Khan was revised to 21.04.2010 from 20.10.2011 in the notification dated 05.04.2022, but the appellant was confirmed in the rank of SI w.e.from on 24.04.2018 which was revised to 16.04.2016 vide order dated 05.04.2022 without further promotion to the rank of Inspector etc, therefore the appellant wants to file this departmental appeal on the following grounds for confirmation in the rank of SI w.e.from 21.04.2010 and for further promotion to the rank of Inspector w.e.from 29.08.2014 and DSP w.e.from 13.02.2018, the dates on which his junior namely Muslim was confirmed in the rank of SI and was promoted to the rank of Inspector and DSP.

**GROUND:**

- A) That not confirming the appellant in the rank of SI w.e.f 21.04.2010 "the date on which his junior Muslim Khan was confirmed as SI" and brought his name in list "F" with batchmates and juniors and not promoting him in the rank of Inspector w.e.f 29.08.2014 and DSP w.e.from 13.02.2018 are against the law, rules, facts, norms of justice and material on record, therefore, not tenable.
- B) That the appellant was confirmed in the rank of SI on 24.04.2018 which was revised to 16.04.2016 vide order dated 05.04.2022 and his colleague namely Muslim Khan was confirmed as ASI and brought his name in list "E" w.e.from 05.04.2008 and also promoted in the rank of Officiating SI on 19.04.2008 and was confirmed in the rank of SI on 20.10.2011 and promoted as Offg: Inspector on 20.12.2011 and was then confirmed in the rank of Inspector on 29.08.2014 and was further promoted to the rank of DSP on 13.02.2018 and confirmation in the rank of SI of Muslim Khan was revised to 21.04.2010 from 20.10.2011 in the notification dated 05.04.2022 and as the appellant has confirmed as ASI w.e.from 31.05.2007 on the basis of notification dated 18.08.2022 passed in the pursuance of judgment dated 24.01.2022 of the KP Service Tribunal, which means that the appellant is senior to Muslim Khan and is entitle to be confirmed in the rank of SI on 21.04.2010 and also entitle for further promotion to the rank of Inspector w.e.from 29.08.2014 and DSP w.e.from

13.02.2018, the dates on which his junior namely Muslim was confirmed in the rank of SI and was promoted to the rank of Inspector and DSP.

- C) That due to not confirming the appellant in the rank of SI from the date i.e 21.04.2010 when with his junior was confirmed as SI will deprive him from his legal right of further promotion to the rank of Inspector and DSP w.e.from 29.08.2014 and 13.02.2018 respectively, which is against the norms of justice and fair play.
- D) That by not confirming the appellant in the rank of SI from the date i.e 21.04.2010 when with his junior was confirmed as SI will deprive him from his legal right of further promotion to the rank of Inspector and DSP which will cause irreparable loss to the appellant in the shape of pension and other monetary benefits.

It is therefore, most humbly requested that on acceptance of this departmental appeal, the confirmation of the appellant in the rank of SI may kindly be antedated w.e.from 21.04.2010 by modifying his confirmation dated 16.04.2016 and was further promoted to the rank of Inspector w.e.from 29.08.2014 and to the rank of DSP w.e.from 13.02.2018 ie. When his junior was confirmed in the rank of SI and was promoted to the rank of Inspector and DSP with all back and consequential benefits.
