Obviously, the respondents have challenged the judgment before the August Supreme Court of Pakistan through CPLA which was dismissed. It is the contention of the petitioner that judgment of this Tribunal has got finality and it needs compliance in letter and spirit. The copy of notification dated 07.01.2021 meant as withdrawal of the promotion of respondent No. 3 consequent upon the judgment passed by the August Supreme Court of Pakistan in CPLA which disclose compliance with first part but in respect of the second relief regarding filling up the vacancies of Junior Clerks, action is still awaited on the part of the respondents. The respondents are directed to ensure the compliance of the judgment to the extent of latter part of the relief as discussed above before the next date. 



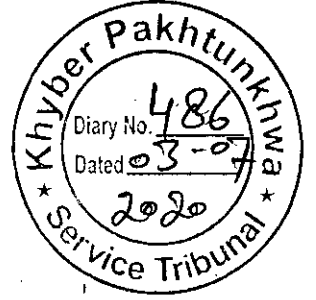

***"10. In the light of above, the impugned promotion order dated 01.03.2017 is set aside and the official respondents are directed to fill up the vacancies of Junior Clerks in the Provincial / Regional Transport Authority, in accordance with the relevant recruitment, promotion rules/criteria. Since the private respondents are not found at fault in procuring their appointments as Junior Clerk, thus the salaries of the post of Junior Clerks already paid to them could not be recovered (2020 SCMR 88)".***

2. That it will be not out of place to mention here that the respondents have not assailed the same before the Supreme Court of Pakistan, as such, the judgment has got finality.
3. That the stated judgment has remitted to the respondents through an application dated 11.06.2020. (Annexed "B"), of course, for compliance and implementation in letter and spirit; the letter for implementation and compliance has also been sent by the worthy Registrar, KP Service Tribunal, Peshawar.

4. That the respondents are under legal obligation to implement the judgment of this Hon'ble Tribunal in letter and spirit but they failed to do so, hence this petition.
5. That appellant seeks leave of this Hon'ble Tribunal to urge additional grounds at the time of arguments.

*It is, therefore, prayed that the Judgment dated 10.03.2020 of this Hon'ble Tribunal be implemented in letter and spirit without any further delay.*

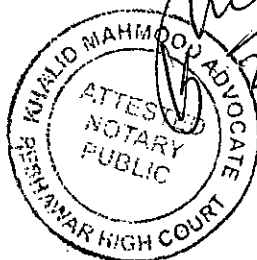



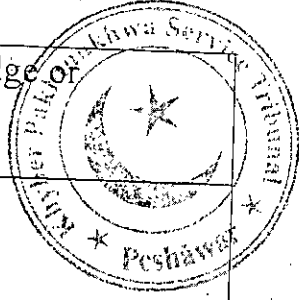

service appeal shall also dispose of service appeal bearing No.798/2017 filed by Wasim Khan, being identical in nature having arisen from the similar facts and circumstances.


3. The appellant (Chowkidar) has filed the present service appeal being aggrieved against the order dated 01.03.2017 whereby Saqib Khan Naib Qasid and Inam Ullah Naib Qasids (private respondents) were promoted to the post of Junior Clerk.

4. Learned counsel for the appellant argued that the appellant was appointed as Chowkidar in RTA Department Mardan on 19.11.2013; that vide impugned order dated 01.03.2017, two Class-IV (Naqib Qasids) namely Saqib Khan and Inam Ullah (private respondents) who were junior to the appellant were promoted as Junior Clerks while ignoring the appellant, hence the impugned order is illegal and against the norms of justice; that feeling aggrieved against the impugned promotion order the appellant filed departmental appeal but to no avail. Further argued that the impugned promotion order is against the settled law hence liable to be reversed; that the impugned promotion order is the result of political motivation.

5. As against that learned AAG assisted by learned counsel for private respondents, defended the impugned promotion order on the ground that under the general rules of Establishment & Administration Department, 33% quota by promotion is reserved for Class-IV Staff against the post of

AAG and learned counsel for the private respondents therefore could not defend the impugned promotion order in view of the relevant recruitment/promotion criteria of the Provincial/Regional Transport Authority, available on file.

10. In the light of above, the impugned promotion order dated 01.03.2017 is set aside and the official respondents are directed to fill up the vacancies of Junior Clerks in the Provincial/Regional Transport Authority, in accordance with the relevant recruitment, promotion rules/criteria. Since the private respondents were not found at fault in procuring their appointments as Junior Clerk, thus the salaries of the post of Junior Clerks already paid to them could not be recovered (2020 SCMR 188).

11. The captioned service appeal and the connected service appeal as mentioned in Para-02 of this judgment are partially accepted to the extent as noted above. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.



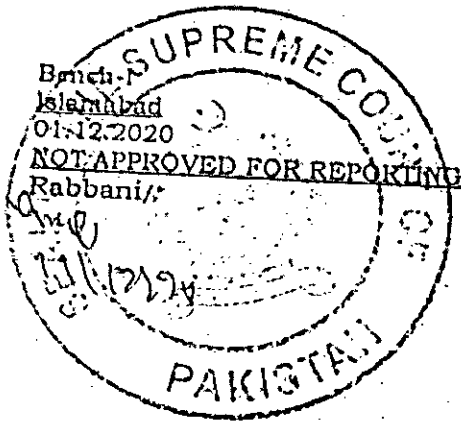
**GULZAR AHMED, CJ.-** We have heard the learned Additional Advocate General, KP. He contends that it is the case of the petitioner itself that the post of Junior Clerk has to be filled through initial appointment and is not a post of promotion. Respondents No.2 & 3 were granted promotion as Junior Clerk from the post of Naib Qasid and Respondent No.1 having challenged the same, the same was set aside by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar (the Tribunal) vide impugned judgment dated 10.03.2020. The learned Additional Advocate General was unable to show as to how in the wake of petitioner's own stand under the rules, the promotion as Junior Clerk

**DECISION:**



02. As per decision of the committee members **Mr. Touqer Albert** Sweeper (BPS-03) has been promoted to Junior Clerk (BPS-11).


