



- 3- That in the light of the above said judgment of this honorable tribunal, the Respondents issued promotion order of the Petitioner but with immediate effect instead of the date when the post of Forester fall vacant, therefore, the Petitioner filed another appeal No. 1356/2012 in this honourable tribunal.

"As a consequent to the above discussion, this appeal is accepted and the appellant is treated as promoted from 19-04-2006 alongwith back benefits"

5- That since then, the appellant/Petitioner time an again requested the respondents for payment of all back benefits and full implementation of the above judgment/order of this honourable tribunal but with no result from there side.(Kindly peruse Annex:-C&D).

6- That recently the respondents has issued a tentative Seniority list of all the Foresters and here too the date of promotion of the appellant has been shown as 16-07-2012 instead of 19-04-2006, which is unjustified and against the judgment/order dated 06-12-2017 of this honourable court.(Copy of the Seniority List is attached as Annex:-E).

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that the respondents be directed to implement the judgment/order dated 06-12-2017 be implemented in toto i.e. payment of all back benefits and giving promotion wef 19-04-2006.

Any other remedy deem proper in the matter and not specifically asked for may also please be given with Costs.

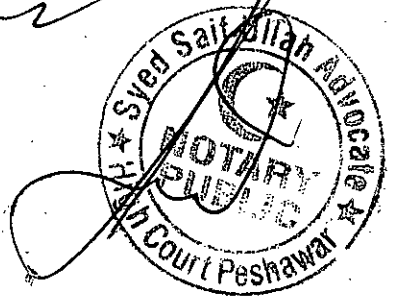

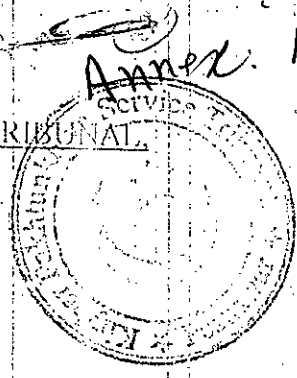

JUDGMENT

QALANDAR ALI KHAN, CHAIRMAN:- On 6.9.2009, Khurshed Ali, Forest Guard, Patrol Squad Division, Mingora, Swat (Appellant) lodged appeal against promotion of Badrud- Din, Forester, Patrol Squad at Mingora, Swat (respondent No. 5) by the DFO, Patrol Squad Division, at Mingora, Swat (Respondent No. 4), vide order No. 19 dated 19.4.2006. The appellant assailed the impugned promotion order of private respondent No. 5 on the grounds that he was holding the post of Forest Guard in Patrol Squad Forest Division since 1993, and that private respondent No. 5 was also appointed as Forest Guard in the said Forest Division in the year 1975, but in 1983, he was transferred permanently to another independent Forest Division i.e Swat Forest Division

where he enjoyed his seniority position and was also awarded Selection Grade but having seen vacancy in Patrol Squad Division he maneuvered his illegal transfer from Swat Forest Division, surreptitiously manipulated a seniority list and got himself promoted as Forster in utter violation of the rules; against which the appellant preferred departmental appeal to the Conservator of Forests, Malakand Circle at Mingora, Swat (Respondent No. 3), and when received no response within the statutory period, this appeal was lodged. The appellant contended that Patrol Squad Division and Swat Forest Division were two independent Forest Divisions having their own DFOs/Competent Authorities and also separate budget allocations and other related matters. He further contended that respondent No. 5 was permanently transferred from Patrol Squad Division to Swat Forest Division where he availed the benefit of Selection Grade on the basis of seniority list issued by the DFO, Swat Forest Division; but the respondent got himself transferred back to the Patrol Squad Division and on the basis of an illegal/disputed seniority list, wherein, the respondent was placed on the top of the list, the respondent managed to get himself promoted in the Patrol Squad Division, though the appellant has been time and again requesting for consideration of his promotion on the basis of his seniority-cum-fitness, but was never considered for promotion despite his vested right for promotion.

2. The appeal was vehemently resisted by all the five respondents who initially filed a joint reply, wherein, several legal as well as factual objections were raised, including, that respondent No. 5 was recruited against the post of Forest Guard in Patrol Squad Division, Swat and later on posted in Swat Forest Division on the orders of competent authority i.e Conservator of Forests, Malakand Circle vide order dated 21.6.1983. The respondents, however, admitted that respondent No. 5 availed the facility of Selection Grade in Swat Forest Division, because he was enlisted in proper place of seniority from the date of his appointment, as he was not transferred from Patrol Squad Division to Swat Forest Division in his own interest but in the public interest. They challenged the seniority list on which the appellant was relying on the ground that the same was not an official authentic document. They disputed claim of the appellant that

due to transfer, seniority status of the parties was disturbed. They claimed that respondent No. 5 was promoted to the rank of Forester on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness. They stated that Conservator of Forests, Malakand Circle, asked DFO Swat, to submit names of those Forest Guards who were willing to perform duty in Patrol Squad Division, but no body was willing except respondent No. 5, who opted to perform duty in the same Division and came back willingly to his parent Division, thereby regaining his seniority. Later on, respondent No. 5 also filed separate reply, wherein, besides other legal and factual objections to the appeal, the respondent raised the plea that not only transfer order of respondent No. 5 dated 5.1.2006 but also seniority list of 30.3.2006 had attained finality as both were not challenged by the appellant. The respondent contended that his appointment date and that of the appellant were relevant for the purpose of promotion as they both were under the administrative control of Conservator of Forests, Malakand Circle, who had issued his transfer order not in his interest but in the public interest. The respondent claimed that his promotion was on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness.

3. After hearing arguments, the appeal was dismissed with costs by a Bench of this Tribunal vide judgment dated 25.5.2009; but the august Supreme Court of Pakistan allowed the appeal, vide judgment dated 12.12.2011, set aside the impugned judgment and sent the case back to the Tribunal for decision afresh after hearing the parties, within two months, however, allowing documents relating to transfer or repatriation of respondent No.5, if not already available on the record, to be brought on the record as additional documents. In the judgment, the august Supreme Court observed that the Tribunal had not decided any issue altogether notwithstanding the entire record was available, therefore, the finding appeared to be vague and indefinite from every point of view and angle of vision. The Service Tribunal, according to judgment, was required to discuss and decide the question calling for determination and that it was required to give finding whether it was a permanent transfer or transfer on deputation.

4. After receipt of appeal on remand, on 24.12.2011, notices were issued to the parties, and they accordingly brought additional documents on record, where-after,

arguments of the learned counsel for the appellant, learned AAG and learned counsel for private respondent No.5 heard, and record perused.

5. In view of the contentions raised in the appeal and written replies of the respondents, the following two issues fall for determination:-

(i) Whether transfer of respondent No.5 from Patrol Squad Division, Mingora, Swat to Swat Forest Division was a permanent transfer or transfer on deputation or else a routine transfer by the competent authority in the same department?

(ii) Whether the impugned promotion order dated 19.4.2006 is proper and according to law/rules?

6. As regards the first issue, suffice it to say that the Forest Department Forest Guards (Divisional) Service Rules, 1962, provide for constitution of service on divisional basis, that is a separate service to be forced for each forest division; and Divisional Forest Officer concerned designated as the appointing authority. Like-wise, the notification dated 26.01.1993 prescribes the method of recruitment/promotion to the rank of Forester as (a) 50% by initial recruitment; and (b) 50% by promotion, on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness, from amongst holders of posts of Forest Guards of the Forest Division where the vacancies occur. Admittedly, Patrol Squad Division, Mingora, Swat and Swat Forest Division are two separate divisions, though under the same Conservator of Forests, Malakand Circle at Mingora, Swat. The record would further show that the department has been treating both Patrol Squad Forest Division and Swat Forest Division as separate divisions and, as such, maintaining separate seniority lists of Forest Guards in both the divisions. It has been proved on record that respondent No.5 got selection grade in BPS-7 on the basis of 33% out of the total strength of 98 Forest Guards of Swat Forest Division vide order dated 7.3.1994. There are documents on record showing grant of promotion and selection grade on the basis of seniority in the respective division; and in the case of Mr. Biland Iqbal, Forest Guard, who was granted selection grade in the Patrol Squad Division, Mingora, on his transfer from Patrol Squad Division, Mr. Muhammad Maaz, Forest Guard was allowed selection grade in BS-7, vide order dated 23.6.1994, wherein,

it was clearly laid down that the selection grade will be confined to service in Patrol Squad Division only. On the other hand, the West Pakistan Forest Department Delegation of Powers Rules, 1962, would show Conservator of Forests as the transferring authority for Forest Guards within the circle. Therefore, respondent No.5 along with three others was transferred from Patrol Squad Forest Division to Swat Forest Division by the Conservator of Forests, Malakand Circle, Mingora, vide order dated 21.6.1983. There is, however, nothing in the said transfer order to indicate that the transfer is either permanent or on deputation. In the like manner, there have been a number of transfers of Forest Guards in the circle by the Conservator of Forests from one division to another, and even re-transfer to the original division in a routine manner, without any difficulty or objection raised by any quarter: but re-transfer of respondent No.5 to the Patrol Squad Division at a particular juncture when vacancy for promotion to the rank of Forester was available and the appellant, being on the top of the seniority list of Forest Guards of Patrol Squad Division, was denied promotion, gave rise to dispute, which necessitated decision of the department on the representation/appeal of the appellant for determination of the question of seniority after transfer and re-transfer of Forest Guards from one division to another. The department, having failed to address this issue at the appropriate time, provided space for litigation between two contenders for promotion. The department can, under no circumstances, absolve itself of the responsibility to settle this issue, once for all, in the light of departmental appeal of the appellant, which is being sent to the appellate authority i.e. respondent No.3 for determination of status of transfers and retransfers made by him, in the light of relevant law/rules, along with determination of question of seniority, amongst the incumbents in such a situation.

7. So far issue No.II is concerned, the record made available would reveal that after remaining in the Swat Forest Division for almost 23 years and availing selection grade on the basis of his seniority in that Division, the respondent was transferred back to the Patrol Squad Forest Division in the year 2006 and within no time placed at the top of seniority list of Patrol Squad Division as it stood on 30.3.2006, and also within days

promoted to the rank of Forester vide impugned order dated 19.4.2006. It may be noted that before re-transfer of the respondent to the Patrol Squad Division, the appellant had moved application for promotion to the DFO, Patrol Squad Forest Division on 18.4.2005, but received unfavourable reply from the authority. In the meantime, the respondent moved application for his transfer from Swat Forest Division to Patrol Squad Division for the purpose of promotion against a vacancy of Forester lying in the Patrol Squad Division, which was accepted, and the respondent was transferred back to Patrol Squad Division, where-after the process of promotion was accelerated, and after bringing the respondent on the top of the seniority list of Forest Guards in the Patrol Squad Division, he was promoted to the rank of Forester vide the impugned order. The record would show that before the seniority list in-question dated 30.3.2006, name of the respondent did not figure in the seniority list of Forest Guards in the Patrol Squad Division, and his name appeared in the seniority list of Forest Guards in Swat Forest Division, which was, indeed, taken into consideration at the time of granting him selection grade. The sudden appearance of the name of the respondent on the seniority list in-question was obviously aimed at paving way for promotion of the respondent; but the seniority list was not revised in accordance with the procedure prescribed for revision of the seniority lists, as neither tentative seniority list was circulated/ published for inviting objections thereon, nor objections, if any, were settled before preparation of the seniority list. Therefore, the appellant or any other person aggrieved of the seniority list had no chance of challenging the same, which was going to affect their rights, and also placed the respondent in an advantageous position. The impugned promotion, based on this seniority list, as such, will not be sustainable in law. The issue is accordingly decided in the negative.

8. As a sequel to the foregoing discussion, the appeal is partially accepted and by setting aside the impugned promotion order dated 19.4.2006, the departmental appeal of the appellant, still pending with the appellate authority i.e. respondent No.3, is referred to him again for appropriate decision, on the respective seniority positions of the appellant and private respondent No.5, in the light of above discussion/observations, within

reasonable time, but not later than two months of the receipt of this judgment, where-after the aggrieved party can avail remedy available to him under the law. There shall, however, be no order as to costs.

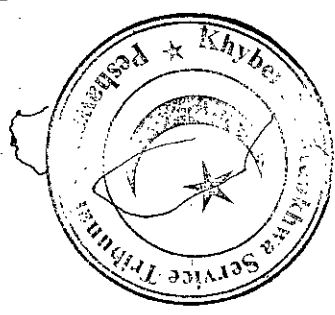

JUDGMENT

NIAZ MUHAMMAD KHAN, CHAIRMAN: Arguments of the learned counsel for the parties heard and record perused.

FACTS

2. The appellant had challenged the promotion of one Badrudin forester in a service appeal No. 776/Neem/2006 decided on 12.03.2012. The case of the appellant was that he was senior to said Badrudin and the promotion of Badrudin be ~~was~~ set aside and instead the appellant be promoted. This Tribunal vide judgment dated 12.03.2012 accepted the appeal by declaring the order of promotion of said Badrudin illegal and directed the appellate authority to decide the departmental appeal of the appellant within reasonable time but not later than



two months of the receipt of that judgment. The department instead of setting aside the promotion of said Badrudin and deciding the appeal of the appellant transferred said Badrudin on 24.04.2012 and promoted the appellant against the vacant post of Badrudin on 16.07.2012 with immediate effect. The appellant being aggrieved from the word "immediate effect" filed departmental appeal on 15.08.2012 which was not responded to and thereafter he filed the present service appeal on 13.12.2012.

### ARGUMENTS

3. Learned counsel for the appellant argued that this Tribunal in the judgment dated 12.03.2012 clearly set aside the promotion of said Badrudin (the then respondent No. 5) and had directed the appellate authority to decide the departmental appeal of the appellant on merits. That the department instead of demoting the respondent No. 5 and promoting the appellant in his place adopted a novel way of transferring the said Badrudin out of the cadre and promoted the appellant. Learned counsel for the appellant argued that in such situation when this Tribunal had accepted the appeal of the appellant and directed the department to decide the appeal of the appellant regarding his seniority qua said Badrudin the department was duty bound to have acted accordingly within the stipulated time. That the department promoted the appellant which means that there was no impediment in the way of appellant for promotion. He next relied upon certain judgments of the superior courts in order to augment his arguments that in cases where a civil servant is deferred or not considered for promotion for no fault of his then he must be given antedated promotion along with back benefits. In this regard


he relied upon certain judgments reported as 1997 PLC CS 1210, 2000 PLC CS 1324, 1985 SCMR 1158 amongst others.

4. On the other hand the learned District Attorney argued that the appellant was promoted as per the direction of this Tribunal and that he could not be given antedated promoted on the basis of promotion policy of the Provincial Government. In this regard he relied upon a notification dated 31.03.1990.

### CONCLUSION

5. The judgment of this Tribunal dated 12.03.2012 had vividly and categorically set aside the promotion of said Badrudin. At that time the issue was in between appellant and said Badrudin who was made party to the said appeal. In the said judgment the respondents were clearly directed to decide the departmental appeal within a period of two (02) months regarding the seniority of appellant and Badrudin. But the department by evading the issue of seniority transferred Badrudin out of the cadre in order to save him and then promoted the appellant on 6.07.2012. The conduct on the part of the department speaks a lot by not demoting the said Badrudin. The decision of the department dated 24.04.2012 shows disregard for the order of this Tribunal. The department had saved Badrudin from demotion by interpreting justice in their own way. In such situation when no impediment was pointed out in the way of promotion of the appellant in decision dated 24.04.2012 then no fault lay with the appellant for not being promoted from 19.04.2006 when said Badrudin was promoted. The appellant did make said Badrudin as party in the said case as he was aggrieved only from Badrudin and which was decided in his favor. Now the position is that the appellant should have been placed in the position of Badrudin as no other deficiency or lacuna or any

impediment has been shown by the department not to promote the appellant. Judgments relied upon by the learned counsel for the appellant speak about such situation and in such cases the courts have granted antedated promotion to the aggrieved civil servant.

6. Coming to the notification referred to above by the learned District Attorney the same is not applicable to the case of the appellant. That notification is applicable only when promotions are being made as a routine under the promotion policy. This notification does not cover the case of those persons who are left out of the promotion despite their entitlement and when the courts restore their entitlements. Otherwise, too, the restoration of entitlement should be from the date when the aggrieved person was denied his entitlement.

7. As a consequent to the above discussion this appeal is accepted and the appellant is treated as promoted from 19.04.2006 along with back benefits. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.






