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ORDER:

By this order, we intend to settle a point of conflict arising from two judgment of this Tribunal in relation to jurisdiction in the case of Selection Grade.

There is an order dated 18.01.2018 in the above tilted Ó2. Service Appeal No. 1107/2016 disclosing that when it come up for hearing before the DB at Camp Court Abbottabad, it was observed with reference to an argument that in some cases, this Tribunal had denied relief of Selection Grade on grounds of jurisdiction; as pressed on behalf of the appellant; and there was certain other judgment of this Tribunal wherein Selection Grade was granted to the civil servants. The counsel for the appellant in the said appeal was directed to search all such judgments and was given opportunity from time to time but he could not be able to bring on record copies of the conflicting judgments. In the meantime, similar point was raised in other appeals involving the claim of Selection Grade and were sent for decision of Larger bench. Similarly, vide order dated 27.11.2018, the above titled appeal was sent to the Larger Bench for hearing alongwith appeals No. 1427/2011, 67/2012, 406/2013. The said appeals and others because of similarity of the subject-matter as having been referred for hearing of the larger bench vide different orders in respective appeals, are listed below:-

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enumerated above were clubbed for hearing by the Larger Bench to settle the point of conflict in the similar matter having occurred in two judgments of this Tribunal, copies whereof are available on file. One was passed in Service Appeal No. 01/2016 on 07.08.2017 by a D.B comprising of Mr. Niaz Muhammad Khan, Chairman and Mr. Gul Zeb Khan, Member of this Tribunal; and the other judgment was passed in Service Appeal No. 467/2012 on 2.09.2017 by the D.B comprising of Mr. Niaz Muhammad Khan, Chairman and Mr. Muhammad Amin Khan Kundi, Member. By the judgment dated 07.08.2017, appeals respectively bearing No. 08/2016 and No. 02/2016 to 04/2016 claiming entitlement of the Selection Grade were accepted for grant of the Selection Grade as prayed for from the dates not later than the dates their juniors were awarded Selection Grades. By the judgment dated 20.09.2017, it was concluded that this Tribunal in number of cases involving the issue of Selection Grade, returned the appeal. for want of jurisdiction on the basis of some judgment of august Supreme Court of Pakistan including Khan Totis's case reported as 2016 SCMR 1206 and another judgment reported as 1990 SCMR 1106. It was further observed therein that it had clearly been laid down that fixation and re-fixation of pay is a matter which falls within purview of the Civil Courts. Consequently, the appeal was returned to the appellant for want of jurisdiction.

4. In the *Khan Toti's* case, the petitioner and proforma respondents were employees of the District Judiciary Swat who

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being aggrieved of some deductions from their salaries or pensions had instituted a civil suit and somehow, the case reached to the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Mimgora Bench through a Civil Revision Petition, and the Hon'ble High Court after setting aside the judgment and decree of civil court, remanded the case to it with further directions to return the plaint to the petitioners-plaintiffs to approach the Provincial Service Tribunal. The august Supreme Court of Pakistan dealt with the question of jurisdiction of this Tribunal in relation to particular status of the employees of the District Judiciary under control of the Peshawar High Court, Peshawar and granted the relief to the petitioners invoking the jurisdiction conferred upon the august Supreme Court under Article 184(3) of the Constitution. There is no ruling in the said judgment relating to exclusion of jurisdiction of this Tribunal in issue of Selection Grade of the Government Servants. Similarly, the pronouncement in the case of "Province of Punjab through Collector, Bahawalpur-vs- Ghulam Rasool and other" (1990 SCMR 1106) dealt with a different factual position. According to the facts noted in the said judgment, the respondents in two civil petitions (Civil Petitions Nos.9 and 10 of 1984 before the august Supreme Court of Pakistan) had filed two separate civil suits for declaration that their pays had been fixed incorrectly; and that they were entitled to re-fixation of their pay in the proper scale and arrears of salary. The suits were decreed by the Senior Civil Judge at Bahawalpur. Provincial Government did not care to file appeals against the judgments and decrees of

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the Trial Court. However, during the course of execution proceedings, an objection was raised that the respondents were not entitled to the scales to which they had been held entitled under that decrees. The objection was rejected by the executing court followed by failure of appeal before the District Judge and the revision before the High Court. Consequently, leave was sought to appeal from the august Supreme Court of Pakistan. The said court while dismissing the petitions for leave to appeal observed as noted below:

> "The contention which the learned Additional Advocate General wishes to raise in support of these petitions relates to the propriety of the decrees passed in favour of the respondents. It is well-settled that an executing Court cannot go behind the decree. It is no longer disputed that the Civil Court had the jurisdiction to entertain the suits of the respondents. We would, therefore, dismiss these petitions."

5. The reliance as placed upon the reported judgment (1990 SCMR 1106) in the judgment dated 20.09.2017 of this Tribunal is not befitting for its attraction in the present appeal due to distinguishable facts. Similarly, the cited pronouncement of august Supreme Court of Pakistan includes the jurisdiction of civil court in the matter of pay fixation of a civil servant but the same is not stretchable to exclude the jurisdiction of this Tribunal in issues of Selection Grade. Even otherwise, the conditions for grant of Selection Grade include the condition of seniority-cum-fitness and in turn, it stands linked with terms and conditions of service. Learned counsels representing the respective appellants in the above listed appeals also made their submissions in favor of the assumption of jurisdiction by the Tribunal in cases of Selection Grade. We are also persuaded to hold that in absence of any express bar on jurisdiction of this Tribunal in issues of Selection Grade, the ouster of jurisdiction in such issues cannot be presumed by the Tribunal itself through inference; and particularly when it may not be possible to delink the Selection Grade from terms and conditions of a civil servant due to its having nexus with seniority-cum-fitness, as far as selection process for its grant is concerned.

6. For what has been discussed above, we hold that judgment dated 07.08.2017 of this Tribunal passed in Service appeal No. 01/2016 will hold the field as precedent notwithstanding its conflict with the judgment dated 20.09.2017 in Service Appeal No. 467/2020. Copy of this order be placed on files of all the above listed appeals and they be detached and put in the course for their individual hearing on respective merits and dates of hearing be fixed in proper routine.







OVERPAYMENT OF Rs. 22,499,701, DUE TO UNAUTHORIZED AWARD OF SELECTION GRADE TO PTC TEACHERS.

7:

In the office of SDEO (M) Primary, Charsadda, Selection Grade was awarded in 1991 to 339 PTC Teachers, over and above the prescribed percentage of sanctioned strength (viz 33%), involving overpayment of Rs. 22,499,701.

The overpayment has been continuing since 1991, in spite of being pointed out by Audit time and again. An enquiry into the matter was conducted by the Department itself in November, 1998, which also confirmed the audit's point of view that these Teachers were not entitled to Selection Grade. But unfortunately, the stale-mate continued till 29.06.2000, when the DEO issued formal orders for the withdrawal of Selection Grade from these Teachers as well as the recovery of past overpayment was ordered. Even thereafter no tangible step was taken by the Department till the last date of audit (viz 31.07.2000) for enforcing the recovery.

The local office stated that the recovery will be started shortly and it will be shown to Audit.

There is need for proper enquiry at appropriate level, to pinpoint responsibility for the lapses involved, which led to the continuance of the overpayment for almost a decade, in spite of being brought to notice from time to time; specially for neglecting the matter even after the findings of the departmental enquiry in November, 1998. Since a huge amount of more than Rs.22 millions is at stake, there is a need for firm assurance from the top level that the recovery will be started without any further delay, and that too in suitable installments, so as to complete recovery within a reasonable time.

Annexed Open

When the DEO issued formal orders for withdrawal of selection grade from these teachers as well as the recovery of past overpayment. Even thereafter no tangible step for enforcement of recovery was taken be the Department till the last date of order. (Viz-31.07.2000).

When pointed out by audit in July 2000 the local office stated that the recovery would be started shortly and it would be shown to audit. In the special DAC meeting held in May 2001, the Department produce documents, showing that a recovery of Rupees 817578 /had since been made. It was decided that the Para should stand till completion of recovery.

In the year 2002 an order awarding Selection Grade to the senior most teachers was again issued vide No.6256-87 Dated 20.04 2002 and Endst: No.11806-12 Dated 04.06.2003 respectively. The 339 teachers which were previously declared as not entitled for Selection Grade from the date of their award of Selection Grade, have also been considered and Selection Grade was awarded from the date from which they were actually entitled. It is crystal clear from the record that recovery of overpayment from the teachers has been adjusted and nothing is outstanding of any overpayment against the effected teachers. As the audit has worked out over payment against each teacher right from 12/1988 till the date of audit i.e. up o 07/2000, but actually due to reaward of Selection Grade to the teachers the overpayment was for the lesser period than that worked out by the audit. (Calculation is as under). 
