In response it was received vide letter No. 250 dated 24-01-2019, that "if the case of the appellant was fit as per letter No. FD (SOSR-II)/4-36/2018 dated 05-09-2018 then the DPO should himself do the needful." The subject case along with the received legal opinion from CPO Peshawar was send to RPO Bannu vide DPO Office letter No. 7600 dated 23-04-2019. In response the RPO Bannu after Perusal of the case, filed the subject case vide RPO Office letter No. 1963/EC dated 13-05-2019.

D. Incorrect, as per Sl: No. 02 (section 19- Civil Servants Act, 1973) page No. 911 of ESTA CODE is clear and reproduced below:

"Government Servents right to retire with pension on completion of 25 years service qualifing of pension- Subject to the provisions of Essential Servecies Maintenance Act, All Govt. Servants shall have the right to retire on a retiring pension after completing 25 years qualifing servecies; provided that a Govt. Servants, who entends to retire before attaining the age of superannuation, shall, at least three months before the date on which he intends to retire, submit a written intimation to the auyhority which appointed him, indicating the date on which he intends to retire such an intimation once submitted shall be final and shall not be allowed to be modified or withdrawn"

there is no such rules to rejoin the duty once a person availed LPR. Furthermore, as the Appellant has proceeded on Pension from the respondent department with effect from 01-08-2019 vide respondent Office notification No.9795-9801 dated 30-07-2018 (copy annexed in annexure -A), therefore he cannot rejoin.

E. Pertains to record however according to GOVT: Rules, Essential Service Maintenance Act vide relevant Para, instruction in respect of LPR/Retirement, cannot be modified /changed (copy annexed).

F. Respondents department may kindly be allowed to advance any other grounds & material as evidence in time of arguments.

PRAYER:

In view of the above Para wise comments, it is most humbly prayed that the Petition of the Petitioner may kindly be dismissed with cost.
