APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974, AGAINST THE ORDER DATED 16.02.2021, WHEREBY THE APPELLANT HAS BEEN AWARDED THE MAJOR PENALTY OF DISMISSAL FROM SERVICE VIDE OFFICE ORDER DATED 16.02.2021 COMMUNICATED TO THE APPELLANT ON 02.03.2021 AGAINST WHICH HIS DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL DATED 31.03.2021 HAS BEEN REJECTED VIDE ORDER DATED 21.06.2021 AND WAS UPHELD VIDE REVISIONAL ORDER DATED 29.07.2021 COMMUNICATED TO THE APPELLANT ON 30.07.2021.

Prayer in Appeal: -

On acceptance of this appeal the impugned orders dated 16.02.2021, 21.06.2021 & 29.07.2021, may kindly be set aside and the appellant may be re-instated into service with all back benefits and wages of service.

Respectfully Sheweth,

The appellant humbly submit as under.

1. That appellant was appointed as Foot Constable in the Respondent Department in the year 2009.



- 2. That ever since his appointment, the appellant had performed his duties as assigned with zeal and devotion and has never given any chance of complaint whatsoever regarding his performance.
- 3. That while performing his duties in the said capacity the appellant suffered from illness in the month of June, 2020. The doctor advised complete bed rest to the appellant till his recovery. Initially he recovered from ailment, he wanted to join his duty, however, his deteriorated condition did not permit him to join his duty. It is pertinent to mention here that he duly applied for leave on each occasion and the department assured he would be granted leave of kind due and it was the reason neither any charge sheet nor any show cause notice was served upon him. (Copies of medical prescriptions & report are attached as annexure A).
- 4. That while the appellant was on bed rest, he was proceeded departmentally for absence from duty in his absentia. Charge sheet dated 28.07.2020 though issued, however never communicated to the Appellant. (Copy of charge sheet dated 28.07.2020 is attached as annexure A-1).
- 5. That thereafter reportedly show cause notice dated 28.1.2021 was also issued, however, the same was also not communicated to the appellant containing the baseless allegations of willful and deliberate absence from duty. (Copy of Show Cause Notice dated 28.01.2021 is attached as annexure B).

- 6. That on 19.02.2021 the appellant, though, got recovered, but his mother was also ill and he had to take care of his mother and had to take his mother to doctor as such he was busy in her mother treatment. On 29.02.2021 when he went to report for duty, he was informed that he has already been dismissed from service on 16.02.2021. Thereafter the appellant requested for the provision of dismissal order and the disciplinary proceedings (if any) which were provided to him on 02.03.2021. (Copies medical prescriptions and dismissal order dated 16.02.2021 is attached as annexure C and C-1).
- 7. That the appellant submitted his departmental appeal dated 31.03.2021, However the same has been rejected vide order dated 21.06.2021. (Copy of departmental appeal dated 31.03.2021 & rejection order 21.06.2021 are attached as annexure D&E).
- 8. That feeling aggrieved from the rejection order dated 21.06.2021, revision petition dated nil to the respondent No. 01, however the same was also dismissed and regretted vide revisional order dated 29.07.2021 communicated to the appellant on 30.07.2021. (Copies of revisional order dated 29.07.2021 is attached as annexure F).
- 9. That the impugned orders dated 16.02.2021, 21.06.2021 & 29.07.2021 are illegal unlawful against the law and facts hence liable to be set aside inter alia on the following grounds:

GROUNDS OF APPEAL.

- A. That the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law hence his rights secured and guaranteed under the law are badly violated.
- B. That no procedure has been followed before his dismissal from service. He has never been served any charge sheet and statement of

allegations nor any regular/ impartial inquiry has been conducted to dig out the facts before passing the impugned order of dismissal, thus the impugned order is defective in the eyes of law.

- C. That the appellant has not been provided proper opportunity of personal hearing before awarding him the penalty hence the appellant have been condemned unheard.
- D. That no charge sheet or statement of allegations as prescribed under the law and rules has been served upon him hence the appellant have not been provided fair opportunity to defend his self against the charges leveled. The impugned order is thus passed in violation of the principles of natural justice.
- E. That the appellant has never committed an act or omission which could be termed as misconduct, albeit he has been awarded the penalty. His absence was never willful but was due to his prolonged illness, which forced him to remain away from his duty.
- F. That it has been consistently held by the superior courts that punishment must commensurate to the magnitude of guilt.
- G. That it is also pertinent to mention here that the inquiry report (if any) has never been provided to the appellant, thus whole proceedings before the imposition of penalty are defective in the eye of law.
- H. That the appellant has at his credit a spotless service career, the penalty imposed upon him is harsh and liable to be set aside.

- I. That the appellant is jobless since his illegal dismissal from Service.
- J. That the appellant seeks the permission of this Honorable Tribunal to rely on additional ground at the hearing of this appeal

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ORDER.

This order will dispose-off the departmental appeal preferred by Ex-Constable Kashif Muhammad No. 935 of Nowshera District Police against the order of District Police Officer, Nowshera, whereby he was awarded major punishment of dismissal from service vide OB; No. 176 dated 16,02,2021. The appellant was proceeded against departmentally on the allegations that he while posted at Police Station Misri Banda District Nowshera, absented himself from lawful duty vide Defly Diary No. 14 dated 06.06,2020 till the date of dismissal from service without any leave or prior permission from his senior omcers.

Proper departmental enquiry proceedings were initiated against him. Hewas issued Charge Sheet alongwith Statement of Allegations and Sub Divisional Police Officer (SDPO) Pabbl, Nowshera was nominated as Enquiry Officer. The Enquiry Officer after fulfilling codal formalities, submitted his findings wherein he reported that the appellant was contacted time and again to appear before the enquiry Officer, but he failed and remained absent, which showed that he was no more interested in Police Service. He recommended the appellant for ex-parte action.

He was issued Final Show Cause Notice on 04.02.2021, but neither did he submit his reply nor did he assume the duty rather remained absent prience he was awarded major punishment of dismissal from service from the date of absence

Feeling aggrieved from the order of District Police Officer, Downshera, the appellant preferred the instant appeal. He was summoned and heard in person in Orderly Room held in this office on 16,06,2021

From the perusal of service record of the appellant, it has been found that the allegations leveled against the appellant have been proved beyond any shadow of doubt. During the course of enquiry the appellant did not bother either to join enquire proceedings or report his arrival which clearly depicts his disinterest towards his official duties. His period of absence is 360 days which cannot be ignored. Hence, the verconduct of appellant is unbecoming of a disciplined Police Officer. Moreover, the appellant approached this forum at a belated stage by filling the instant appeal which time barred by one month and sixteen days without advancing and organic reasoregarding such delay. Hence, order passed by the competent authority does not warran any interference.

Keeping in view the above, I, Yaseen Harood, PSP Regional Polic therefore, the same is rejected and filed, being time barred mentioned above.

Respectfully Sheweth: -

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS: -

- 1. That the appellant has got no cause of action and locus standi to file the appeal.
- 2. That the appeal is badly barred by law and limitation.
- 3. That the appellant is estopped by his own conduct to file the instant appeal.
- 4. That the appeal is not maintainable in its present form.
- 5. That the appellant has not come to the Honourable Tribunal with clean hands.
- 6. That the appeal is bad for mis-joinder and non-joinder of necessary and proper parties.

Reply on Facts: -

- 1. Para pertains to record.
- 2. Incorrect. Performance of appellant was not satisfactory, as service record of the appellant is tainted with bad entries. (Detail of bad entries is annexure "A").
- Incorrect. Plea of appellant regarding his alleged illness is not plausible, because he remained absent from duty for almost 08 months but during this time he did not bother either to apply for leave or to join his duty. It is worth to mention that appellant while posted at Police Station, Misri Banda remained absent from duty without any leave/permission of the competent authority vide Daily diary No. 14 dated 06-06-2020 Police Station, Misri Banda.

In order to scrutinize conduct of the appellant, enquiry was conducted through DSP Pabbi. As per daily diary No. 18 dated 29-09-2020, during the course of enquiry appellant was contacted several times, on his cell phone No. 0313-9534234, but he did not bother to appear before the enquiry officer. On 17-09-2020, appellant was informed through Police Station, Misri Banda while on 21-09-2020 appellant was contacted on his contact number and informed to collect his charge sheet from the office of DSP Pabbi. Similarly, on 25-09-2020, appellant was informed through incharge Police Post, Kheshgi, who (I/C PP) met the appellant at his house situated at Sheikh Shahbaz Baba, Kheshgi, where appellant assured him that on 28-09-2020 he will attend the office of DSP Pabbi

but each time appellant did not pay any heed to the orders of high ups and intentionally avoided appearing before the enquiry officer and collecting his charge sheet. (Copy of daily diary No. 18 of PS Pabbi is annexure "B").

- 4. Incorrect. Appellant intentionally avoided to join his duty as well as to join enquiry proceedings. When appellant was informed, time and again, to collect his charge sheet and statement of allegations, he turned a deaf ear to the same. Moreover, appellant neither submitted medical documents nor applied for any medical leave. Appellant took this plea, regarding his so called illness, only to give covering to his prolong absence.
- 5. Incorrect. Before awarding punishment, appellant was issued Final Show Cause Notice, which was duly received by the appellant himself. To this effect his signature, as token of receipt, was also obtained, on the back side of the Show Cause Notice. (Copy of Final Show Cause Notice is annexure "C").
- 6. Incorrect. Only to give covering to his prolong absence i.e 08 months, appellant gave this sorry/lame excuse of his own illness and then the illness of his mother.
- 7. Correct to the extent that appellant moved departmental appeal before the appellate authority, however, the same was rejected/failed being badly time barred. (Copy of rejection order is annexure "D").
- 8. Correct to extent that appellant moved revision petition before respondent No. 01 but the same was filed. (Copy of order is annexure "E").
- 9. Incorrect. Orders dated 16-02-2021, 21-06-2021 and 29-07-2021 are in accordance with law/rules, hence, are liable to be maintained inter alia on the following grounds: -

Reply on GROUNDS

- A. Incorrect. Appellant was treated in accordance with law and no right of the appellant has been violated.




