






The appellant in the matter of grievance agitated through this service appeal, firstly approached to the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Abbottabad Bench vide Writ Petition No. 741-A/2010. The said Writ Petition was disposed of on 24.11.2020. It was observed by the Hon'ble High Court in the judgment that the plea urged before the said Honourable Court pertains to the terms and conditions of a civil servant, which can be urged before the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal constituted under Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, having exclusive jurisdiction to adjudicate upon the matter relating to terms and conditions of a civil servant. In furtherance of this observation, the Writ Petition was dismissed being not maintainable but petitioner was given liberty to knock at the door of competent forum for redressal of his grievance, if so desire. Thus, he is here before this forum. The pertinent point of the preliminary arguments in respect of the present appeal emerges that the appellant being in-service teacher was prohibited by condition No. 6 of the advertisement annexed with the appeal at Page 32 (annexure-F) from submitting application for the advertised posts. So the appellant, obviously in-service teacher, could not apply for the advertised posts due to the prohibitory provision in the advertisement. The said condition in the

APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE INACTION OF THE RESPONDENTS BY NOT PROMOTING THE APPELLANT TO THE POST OF S.S (BPS-17) W-E-F 2009 I.E. FROM THE DATE WHEN THE ADHOC/ CONTRACT SUBJECT SPECIALIST (BPS-17) HAVE BEEN REGULARIZED AND AGAINST NO ACTION TAKEN ON THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF APPELLANT WITHIN THE STATUTORY PERIOD

PRAYER:

That on acceptance of this appeal the respondent may kindly be directed to consider the appellant for promotion to the post of Subject specialist (BPS-17) w-e-f. 2009 i.e. the date when the adhoc/ contract S.S (BPS-17) have been regularized with all back benefits including seniority. Any other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit that may also be awarded in favor of the appellant.

R/SHWETH:

ON FACTS:

1. That the appellant is the employee of the respondent department and performing his duty as SCT (BPS-16).
2. That in the year 2004 the respondents asked applications for the post of Subject Specialist (SS) on contract basis. That after appearing in the test conducted through EATA, the appellant was appointed on the post of S.S (BPS-17) on contract basis for a period of six months. Copies of the

3. That it is pertinent to mention here that the contract period was renewed/ extended for another period vide notification dated 24-03-2006. Copy of the notification dated 24-03-2006 is attached as annexure.....**C.**
4. That it is worth to mention here that a notification was issued by the respondent department that in-service teachers appointed on contract basis as SS should get leave without pay and the same was granted to the appellant by the department vide order dated 15-09-2005. Copy of the order dated 15-09-2005 is attached as annexure **D.**
5. That it is pertinent to mention her that the entry with regard to the leave without pay was made on the service book of the appellant. Copy of the service book is attached as annexure**E.**
6. That after the expiry of the contract period the same was once again renewed/ extended vide notification dated 20-10-2007, but the department refused to sanction leave without pay to the appellant and thus the appellant was deprived to continue service as SS.
7. That vide advertisement dated August, 2007 the posts of SS were once again advertised but through this advertisement the in-service teachers were debarred to appear in the test, hence the appellant was also not allowed to be appointed/ selected on the post of SS on contract basis. Copy of the advertisement is attached as annexure**F.**
8. That it is important to mention here that before regular appointment of the contract appointees were regularized vide Notification dated 24-10-2009 and 11-12-2009 and thereby permanently depriving the appellant from appointment on contract basis on the post of SS as well as through this regularization the right of promotion of the appellant to the post of SS was also curtailed. Copies of the regularization Act dated 24-10-2009 and notification dated 11-12-2009 are attached as annexure.....**G&H.**
9. That appellant feeling aggrieved from the action of the respondents and from the impugned regularization dated 24-10-2009 and notification dated 11-12-2009, preferred departmental appeal followed by a writ petition No. 741-A/2010 before the August Peshawar High Court, Abbottabad Bench which was decided on 24-11-2020 with the observation that the matter pertaining to terms and conditions therefore, ***"For what has been discussed***

hereinabove, this petition is dismissed being not maintainable. However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to knock at the door of the competent forum for redressal of their grievance, if so desired." Copies of the departmental appeal, memo of writ petition and judgment dated 24-11-2020 are attached as annexure**I, J&K.**

10. That having no other remedy the appellant preferred the instant appeal on the following grounds amongst others.

GROUND:

- A- That by not promoting the appellant to the post of S.S (BPS-17) w-e-f 2009 i.e. the date when the adhoc/ contract S.S (BPS-17) have been regularized with all back benefits including seniority is against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and materials on the record hence not tenable and liable to be modified/rectified to the extent of the appellant be promoted w-e-f 2009 with all back benefits including seniority.
- B- That appellant has not been treated by the respondent Department in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- C- That, the treatment meted out to the appellant is clearly based on discrimination and malafide and as such the respondents violated the principle of natural justice.
- D- That appellant is fully entitled to be promoted to the post of S.S (BPS-17) w-e-f 2009 i.e. the date when the adhoc/ contract S.S (BPS-17) have been regularized with all back benefits including seniority in light of the section 9 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant Act, 1973 read with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989.
- E- That appellant is also entitled for his promotion w-e-f 2009 with all back benefits.
- F- That respondents violated Article 38(e) of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973, according to which state is bound to eliminate disparity in the income and earning of individuals including persons in the services of the Federation, thus in light of the above quoted Article of the Constitution the respondents are duty bound to promote the appellant to the post of S.S (BPS-17) w-e-f 2009 i.e. the

date when the adhoc/ contract S.S (BPS-17) have been regularized with all back benefits including seniority.

- G- That appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may very graciously be accepted as prayed for, please.

Terms and Conditions of their Appointments

- The candidates will enter into an agreement with the Government and their services will be governed by the terms and conditions mentioned in such agreement.
- Their salary is subject to execution of agreement deed containing the terms and conditions of the contract.
- They will get pay in BPS-17 plus usual allowances as admissible under the rules.
- The initial period of their appointment shall be six months or till the arrival of the selectees of the NWFP Public Service Commission which ever is earlier. This order will automatically stand terminated after 180 days from the date of issue.

5. Their services will be liable to termination without assigning any reason during the currency of this agreement. In case of resignation without prior notice, their one month pay plus allowances shall be forfeited in favour of Government.
6. The appointees shall join their posts within 15 days of the issuance of this order. The EDOs (S and L) shall furnish a certificate to the effect that the appointees have joined the posts or otherwise, after 15 days of the issuance of this order.
7. Their services can be terminated at any time in case their performance is found un-satisfactory. In case of misconduct they will be proceeded against under the Removal from Service (Special Power) Ordinance 2000 and E and D Rules, 1973.
8. They shall be required to furnish attested copies of all their certificates/degrees to EDO (S and L) concerned. The EDO concerned should check their original certificates/degrees.
9. The appointment is School specific and non-transferable during the currency of contract period.
10. The In-Service candidates shall not be allowed to join and shall not be handed over charge by the EDO concerned.

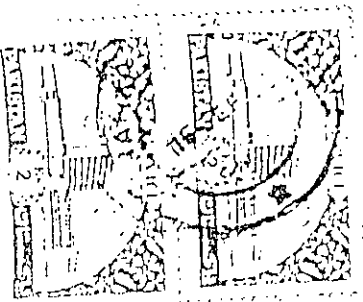

I am directed to refer to the appointment orders of the Subject Specialists (B-17), on contract basis for a period of six months or till arrival of the nominee of the Public Service Commission whichever is earlier. One of the terms and conditions mentioned in the appointment orders is that in-service candidates shall not be allowed to join and shall not be handed over the charge by the EDOs concerned. However the condition mentioned above has created confusion as some of the in-service candidates are trying to join the post despite the fact that they are regular employees and the post in question is a contract one.

2. In this connection it is clarified that according to sub Section 1(b) of Section 2 of the NWFP Civil Servant Act 1973 a person employed on contract, or on work charged basis or is paid from the contingency is not a Civil Servant. Hence the lien of Civil Servant cannot either be transferred or retained if they joined the post on contract basis. In view of the above the in-service candidates who wish to join the post of Subject Specialists, on contract basis may be allowed subject to the condition that either they shall resign from their existing post or got leave without pay. However, charge shall only be handed over after the sanction of leave without pay.

Facts of the appeal are as under:

1. The appellants are working in Education Department on regular basis
2. The appellants were considered successful in the test and interview conducted for the posts of subject specialists on contract basis by the departmental selection committee (ETA).
3. The appellants were appointed on their respective posts of subject specialist on contract basis for the period of six months through notification No. SOG/SL/SS apptt/2005 dated 10-09-2005. Annex (A)
4. The appellants got leave without pay from the Department and joined the posts. Annex(B)
5. The contract of the appellants was renewed vide notification No. SOG (SL)-85/04/SS apptt: contract dated 24-03-2006. Annex (C)
6. The appellants again got the leave without pay and continued their service on contract basis. Annex(D)
7. The contract of the appellants was again renewed vide notifications No. SOG/S&L/1-85/2007, SS (contract) dated 20-10-2007 but the Department refused to sanction leave without pay and hence the appellants were deprived of their right Annex (E)
8. The appellants once again submitted their online application in July 2008 but the Department refused to consider in service teachers Annex(F)
9. The appellants even bore the loss of annual increment and regular service.

Grounds:

Feeling aggrieved, an appeal has already been launched to your office dated 10-11-2009 and is again presented to your honour for the second time on the following grounds:

1. The appellants have the right to be restored to their post of subject specialists.
2. The decision of depriving them from right on the basis of being in service teachers is unlawful, arbitrary and against the norms of justice.

Prayer:

By accepting this appeal, the appellants may very kindly be restored to the posts of subject specialists in their respective subject.

of natural justice, hence, liable to be set-aside on the following grounds inter-alia others:-

GROUNDS: -

- a) That the petitioners who were already employed in the Education Department were and are qualified for the posts of SS⁽³⁾ as required by their service rules but by the illegal and void acts of respondents have been deprived of their vested right ordained by the constitution, without any fault on petitioners' part.
- b) That initially imposing of ban on regular employees and then regularizing outsiders on SS⁽³⁾ posts by violating legal procedure of requirement through Public Service Commission or Departmental Promotion Committee speaks loudly the malafide on the part of respondents which is the example of sheer discrimination on part of respondents. This act shows pre-plan of respondents to accommodate their favourites and that of persons in power. Had the respondents given chance to the petitioners to compete with the

adhokees, the petitioners would have succeeded in the competition being more experienced, highly qualified and capable in their field. The act of respondents barring the petitioners from their legal right of applying for higher post of SSU tantamount to sheer discrimination and violation of fundamental rights of the petitioners which has been guaranteed in the constitution.

c) That due to the illegal act of respondents, a large number of inexperienced and unqualified teachers have been permanently inducted out of turn, thus, the seniority of the petitioners has been seriously disturbed. Temporary employees have been given preference over permanent employees, which fact is violative of service rules and violative of fundamental right of promotion.

d) That the act of respondents is against the principle of natural justice, arbitrary, discriminatory and in violation of Articles 4 & 25 of the Constitution.

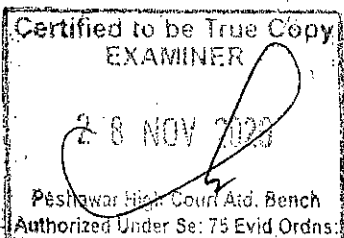

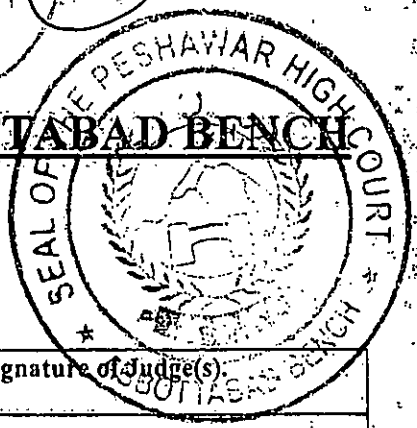

for appointment as subject specialist in response to advertisement published by the Education Department; that the petitioners qualified the requisite EATA test and consequently they were appointed as Subject Specialist on contract basis for a period of six months; that the contract of the petitioners was extended on 24.03.2006; that during the said period, a Notification was issued by the department that in service teachers appointed as SS can obtain leave without pay, as such, the petitioners obtained leave without pay; that on 20.10.2007 the contract was further extended, however, the department refused to grant leave without pay, which constrained the petitioners to quit their contractual service; that since 2006 the petitioners were deprived from annual increment due to leave without pay and when the posts of SS were advertised for appointment on regular bases, the petitioners being in service teachers were debarred to apply for the posts. Hence, this petition.

3. It was mainly contended by the learned counsel for the petitioners that after a fair competition, petitioners were appointed as Subject Specialist (BPS-16) on contract basis as a stopgap arrangement. Ultimately, they left the service on 20.10.2007 due to refusal of the department to sanction the leave without pay; that during service on contract basis the petitioners were not granted increments; that in the year, 2008, posts of subject specialist were advertised, but the petitioners were debarred to apply for that posts; that the petitioners were appointed as subject specialist that in the meanwhile due to Notification dated 24.09.2009, the services of the contract/temporary employees appointed as SS or SST were regularized; that after assuming the charge in their parent department the petitioners became junior to their colleagues and their seniority was also liable to be rectified.

4. As against that learned AAG appearing on behalf of respondents argued that the grievance of the

petitioners regarding seniority and grant of increment relates to terms and conditions of a civil servant and petitioners being civil servants can urge their plea before the Service Tribunal and this writ petition is not maintainable, in view of embargo placed under Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973.

5. Arguments heard. Record perused.

6. Perusal of record reflects that the petitioners were the permanent employees of the Education Department. They were serving in different categories. They were initially appointed on contract basis for a period of six months vide Notification dated 10.09.2005, on the terms and conditions mentioned therein. However, the contractual employment of the petitioners was extended on 24.03.2006. It is pertinent to mention here that the petitioners have joined the contractual employment after obtaining leave from their department, however, on 20.10.2007 the department refused to grant leave to the petitioners without pay and ultimately they left their contractual employment and joined their parent department. In the meanwhile, on the promulgation of the North-West Frontier Province Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2009, the service of the contractual employees were regularized in terms of section 3 of the ibid Act.

7. The only grievance of the petitioners urged before us is that after joining their previous service, they have become junior to their colleagues and they were not only deprived of their promotion but also from the annual increments during the period of their contractual employment. Admittedly, the plea urged before us pertains to the terms and conditions of civil servant, which can be urged before the Service Tribunal constituted under Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, which has exclusive jurisdiction to adjudicate upon the matter relating to



JOINT PARAWISE COMMENTS FOR & ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENTS No: 1-3.

Respectfully Sheweth :-

The Respondents submit as under:-

Preliminary objections

- 1) That the appeal is not maintainable and incompetent in the eyes of Law in the present form.
- 2) That the appellant is estopped due to his own conduct to file this appeal.
- 3) That the appellant has got no cause of action and locus standi to file instant appeal.
- 4) That the appellant has not come to the Tribunal with clean hands and has suppressed all relevant facts.
- 5) That the appeal is bad for mis-joinder and non-joinder of necessary parties.
- 6) That the appeal filed by the Appellant is pre mature and the appellant has concealed the material facts from Honorable Tribunal.
- 7) That the Honorable Service Tribunal has no jurisdiction to entertain the instant appeal in its present form.
- 8) That the appeal has been mis-oriented, mis-constructed and mistakenly drawn and is incompetent in its present frame and context, and is liable for Rejection.
- 9) That the appeal is weak having no force, fabricated, fictitious, based on ill will, malafide and having no footings in the eyes of law.
- 10) That the Order Impugned has been acted upon and compliance has been made, therefore, the instant appeal is infructuous.
- 11) That proceeding with the instant appeal would be a futile exercise and just wastage of the precious time of this Honorable Tribunal.
- 12) That as stated in the objections supra, the appeal is bereft of cause of action and is liable for dismissal.
- 13) That the matter in hand was decided by the Honorable Peshawar High Court in **WP No. 2905-P/2009. (Annexure A).**

ON FACTS

- 1) Para pertains to the employment of appellant as SST in the respondent department, hence no comments.
- 2) Para pertains to the advertisement of Subject Specialist BS-17 posts in the year 2004. The posts of Subject Specialist BS-17 were advertised on contract basis for a period of six months, hence need no comments.
- 3) Para pertains to the extension of the contract for further six months in the light of Notification dated 24.03.2006. Hence need no comments.
- 4) That as per terms and conditions of the advertisement of the year 2004. As per advertisement that in-service teachers were not allowed to apply against the post of six month contract being regular employee of the department. The aim of this advertisement is to give a chance to the jobless people. Later on permission had been given to them with the condition that they will take leave without pay. It is further added that as per leave rule; the Leave without Pay show gap in the service of an employee.
- 5) As the appellant was regular employee of the respondent department and working as CT teacher. This para is related to the appellant Leave without Pay entry in his service book for the period of six month. The special entry had been made in the service book of appellant by the DDO concern.
- 6) Incorrect / not admitted. That six month contract posts were once again advertised in the year 2007. It is also worth mentioned that in the advertisement of the year 2007, that in-service employees were not allow to apply against these contract posts. Therefore, appellant was not entitled for appointment against the said advertisement. It is further added that no permission was granted by the then Government to the in-service teachers/employees to apply against the said advertisement. Hence appellant has got no cause of action.
- 7) Incorrect / not admitted. The post of Subject Specialist BS-17 and SST BS-16 were advertised for six month contract. The candidates were directed to apply through official email / internet. All the in-service employees were not allowed to apply against the said advertisement. Further government did not give permission to the in-service employee to apply against the six month contract post. No test was conducted and all the applied candidates were selected for the six month contract period.

- 8) That the services of all the online appointees were regularized through **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Employee Regularization of Services Act 2009**. As per said Regularization Act 2009, all the contract employees were regularized w.e.f 01.01.2009. It is further added that through said Act not only employees of E&SE Department were regularized; the employees of other departments were also regularized.
- 9) Incorrect / not admitted. As the appellant was not an aggrieved person. The representation to the worthy Secretary E&SE Department did not reflect any date and signature. Hence such appeal does not confer any useful right to the appellant. The **writ petition No. 741-A/2010** of the appellant was dismissed by the Honorable Peshawar High Court. It is worth mention that the same matter was also decided by the Honorable Peshawar High Court Bench Peshawar in **Writ Petition No. 2905-P/2009 titled as Atta Ullah and other Vs Chief Secretary KPK and others** decided on 26.01.2015 by the then **Honorable Chief Justice Peshawar High Court**. In the petition cited above the Honorable Chief Justice was pleased to dismissed all the writ petition of the in-service employees with the remarks as under;

“The Act, XVI of 2009, commonly known as (Regularization Of Services) Act, 2009 is held as beneficial and remedial legislation, to which no interference is advisable hence, upheld.

(ii) Official respondents are directed to work out the backlog of the promotion quota as per above mentioned example, within 30 days and consider the in service employees, till the backlog is washed out, till then there would be complete ban on fresh recruitments. (Annexure B)

- 10) Incorrect / not admitted. The service appeal of the appellant is an exercise in futility. Further proceeding in this regard would bear no fruit. It is, therefore, requested to this Honorable Tribunal to dismiss the Service Appeal of the appellant with cost because the matter in hand was also decided by the Honorable Chief Justice Peshawar High Court.

Objections on Grounds

- a. Incorrect / not admitted. The appellant does not come in the domain of the Employee Regularization Act XVI of 2009. The section 3 of this act is reproduced as under;

“All employees including recommenders of the High Court appointed on contract or adhoc basis and holding that post on 31st December, 2008 or till the commencement of this Act shall be deemed to have been validly appointed on regular basis having the same qualification and experience for a regular post”

According to this Act all those employees were regularized who were working on contract / adhoc basis, but the appellant was already regular employee of the respondent department and did not working as contract / adhoc employee. Therefore, appellant does not come in the domain of this Act. Hence the act of the respondents was according to law, rules and policies, based upon the natural principle of justice.

- b. Incorrect and not admitted. Strongly denied. The appellant was treated by the respondent department as per law. The action of respondent department was according to the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973 but the claim of the appellant was against the law, rule and policies of the government.
- c. Incorrect / not admitted. Strongly denied. The respondents department treated the appellant according to law, rule and policies of the government as the appellant does not come in the domain of the Employee Regularization of Service Act 2009, hence appellant lack the locus standi.
- d. Incorrect / not admitted. The appellant was regular employee of the respondent department. Appellant was given promotion from CT to SST and all kinds of financial benefits according to law, no discrimination had been made with the present appellant. Therefore, the present service appeal is liable to be dismissed with cost.
- e. Incorrect, hence strongly denied. The stance of the appellant is having no truth and is totally false and fictitious. This act of the respondents cannot be declared against the law on any ground whatsoever but the straight away rejection of Service Appeal.
- f. Incorrect / not admitted. The Honorable Peshawar High Court was pleased to uphold the Employees Regularization of Services Act XVI of 2009; hence present service appeal is liable to the dismissed with cost.
- g. The counsel for respondents may kindly be allowed to raise additional grounds at the time of arguments.

PRAYER.

In view of the above made submissions, it is requested that this Tribunal may very graciously be pleased to dismiss the instant service appeal with cost in favor of the Respondent Department.

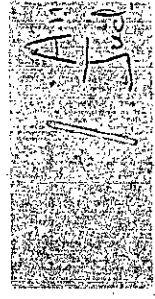

WAQAR AHMAD SETH,J:- Through this single judgment we propose to dispose of the instant Writ Petition No.2905 OF 2009 as well as the connected Writ Petition Nos.2941, 2967,2968,3016. 3025.3053,3189,3251,3292 of 2009,496,556,664,1256,1662,1685,1696,2176,2230,2501,2696, 2728 of 2010 & 206, 355,435 & 877 of 2011 as common question of law and fact is involved in all these petitions.

trustee with complete transparency as per requirement of law, so that no person who is eligible and entitled to hold such post is excluded from the purpose of selection and is not deprived of his any right.

18- Considering the above settled principles we are of the firm opinion that Act, XVI of 2009 is although beneficial and remedial legislation but its enactment has effected the in service employees who were in the promotion zone, therefore, we are convinced that to the extent of in service employees/ petitioners, who fall within the promotion zone have suffered, and in order to rectify the inadvertent mistake of the respondents/Department, it is recommended that the promotion rules in field be implemented and those employees in a particular cadre to which certain quota for promotion is reserved for in service employees, the same be filled in on promotion basis. In order to remove the ambiguity and confusion in this respect an example is quoted, " If in any cadre as per existence rules, appointment is to be made on 50/50 % basis i.e 50 % initial recruitment and 50 % promotion quota then all the employees have been

regularized under the Act in question be calculated in that cadre and equal number i.e remaining 50 % are to promoted from amongst the eligible in service employees, other wise, eligible for promotion on the basis of sonority cum fitness."

19- In view of the above, this writ petition is disposed of in the following terms:-

(i) "The Act, XVI of 2009, commonly known as (Regularization Of Services) Act, 2009 is held as beneficial and remedial legislation, to which no interference is advisable hence, upheld.

(ii) Official respondents are directed to workout the backlog of the promotion quota as per above mentioned example, within 30 days and consider the in service employees, till the backlog is washed out, till then there would be complete ban on fresh recruitments.

Order accordingly.
