An inquiry committee constituted by DHO Malakand to probe into the matter regarding Mst. Wajahat Hassan LHV who was absent for a long period. The inquiry committee comprising of the following members

- Mr. Gohar Ayoub PHC Tech (MP)

Fact Finding

The inquiry committee visited the DHO Office and checked the personal file of Mst. Wajahat Hassan LHV.

The personal file reveals that Mst. Wajahat Hassan was transferred to BHU Narai Oba on 30/01/2017 vide order No-1641-46 Dated 30/01/2017, Copy of the order is hereby attached as Annexure-A. Consequently she was relieved by the concerned Medical Officer BHU Ashakai. Copy of the relieving letter is hereby attached as Annexure-B.

Record shows that she neither joined her duty at BHU Narai Oba nor she claims. In this regard the inquiry committee couldn't find any clue that she has joined her duty in BHU Narai Oba. Copies of attendance registers of BHU Narai Obu were also present in DHO office, which were checked. The Attendance register of HU Narai Obu reveals that Mst. Wajahat Hassan has never joined her duty at BHU Narai Obu.

No arrival report or any evidence regarding joining of the duty at BHU Narai Oba is present.

She was called notice vide order No-3095-98 dated 08-03-2017

she was again called vide notice order 3944-47 dated 14/04/2017 and the same was sent to by registry ID-1565 dated 14/04/2017 on her home address as well as on Duty stations but no response from her side is present on file.

she has been issued another notice vide office order No-3095 Dated 12/06/2017 and the same was sent to her by registry ID-1565 dated 14/04/2017 on her home address as well as on Duty stations but no response from her is present on record.

On date 25/08/2017 vide order No-8484-87 charge sheet has been issued to her and has been communicated to her by the same address. She has replied this time vide letter date 15/09/2017. INQUIRY REPORT

An inquiry committee constituted by DHO Malakand to probe into the matter regarding Mst. Wajahat Hassan LHV who was absent for a long period. The inquiry committee comprising of the following members

- Dr. Muhammad Nawaz Children Specialist
- Dr. Inyat Safi Ms THQ Dargai
- Mr. Gohar Ayoub PHC Tech (MP)

Fact Finding

The inquiry committee visited the DHO Office and checked the personal file of Mst. Wajahat Hassan LHV.

The personal file reveals that Mst. Wajahat Hassan was transferred to BHU Narai Oba on 30/01/2017 vide order No-1641-46 Dated 30/01/2017, Copy of the order is hereby attached as Annexure-A. Consequently she was relieved by the concerned Medical Officer BHU Ashakai. Copy of the relieving letter is hereby attached as Annexure-B.

Record shows that she neither joined her duty at BHU Narai Oba nor she claims. In this regard the inquiry committee couldn't find any clue that she has joined her duty in BHU Narai Oba. Copies of attendance registers of BHU Narai Oba were also present in DHO office, which were checked. The Attendance register of BHU Narai Oba reveals that Mst. Wajahat Hassan has never joined her duty at BHU Narai Oba.

No arrival report or any evidence regarding joining of the duty at BHU Narai Oba is present.

She was called notice vide order No-3095-98 dated 08-03-2017

she was again called vide notice order 3944-47 dated 14/04/2017 and the same was sent to by registry ID-1565 dated 14/04/2017 on her home address as well as on Duty stations but no response from her side is present on file.

she has been issued another notice vide office order No-3095 Dated 12/06/2017 and the same was sent to her by registry ID-1565 dated 14/04/2017 on her home address as well as on Duty stations but no response from her is present on record.

On date 25/08/2017 vide order No-8484-87 charge sheet has been issued to her and has been communicated to her by the same address. She has replied this time vide letter date 15/09/2017. She has just complained in her letter about her transfer to BHU Narai Oba. This letter do not show any claim about performing duty anywhere.

On Date-02/10/2017 Honorable Court has granted status quo on the charge sheet with the direction to Mst. Wajahat Hassan to join her duty at BHU Ashakai, in compliance of Court order DHO has issued an order No-26017 dated 17/11/2017 with the direction to Mst. Wajahat Hassan to join her duty at BHU Ashakai. Her arrival report is present and shows that she has started her duty at BHU Ashakai on 17/11/2017. Copy of arrival report is hereby attached as **Annexure-C.**

On date 04/12/2017 Honorable Court has passed an order and has suspended order dated 30/01/2017 with the direction that this suspension would mean that the position before 30/01/2017 be restored. In light of this Order DHO Has directed her to perform Duty at BHU Narai Oba vide order Dated 07/12/2017. She was supposed to be in Narai Oba but in spite she performed her duty in BHU Ashakai on her own well.

On date 22.01.2018 In-charge Medical Officer BHU Ashakai has informed Office of the DHO Malakand vide letter No-29-30 that from 15/01/2018 Mst. Wajahat Hassan is coming to BHU Ashakai but she is not marking her attendance in the attendance register.

On date 09/02/2018 In-charge Medical Officer BHU Ashakai has informed DHO Office vide letter No -31-32 dated 09/02/2018 that Mst. Wajahat Hassan is absent from 1st February 2018 and onward.

On Date 28/01/2019 Honorable Court has decided that she will perform duty at BHU Ashakai.

She has submitted arrival report and has started duty again.

Visit to BHU Ashakai

The inquiry committee visited the BHU Ashakia on 15/8/2020 Time 10:00 am initially the enquiry committee checked the attendance register.

The attendance register shows that she has been relived on 03/02/2017. She has marked her attendance up to 02/02/2017.

She has marked her attendance in attendance register on 14/11/2017 up to 13/12/2017.

From 1st January 2018 she has again marked her attendance up to 13/01/2018.

From 13/01/2018 she remained absent up to 05/03/2019.

Statement of Mst. Wajahat Hassan.

During the course of visit of the inquiry committee Mst.Wajahat Hassan was present at her place of duty and has marked her attended in the attendance register. The inquiry committee called Mst.Wajahat Hassan to Medical Officer Office, in order to record her statement.

She was reluctant to come to M.O office, then the inquiry committee got permission to her office. In order to record her statement but she refused to record her statement in written or verbal. In this regard the inquiry committee recorded a statement of the present staff in written that she is not giving her statement. Copy of the statement is hereby attached as **Annexure-D**

On 25/08/2020 one of the inquiry committee member Dr. Inayat Safi MS. THQ Hospital Dargai received a letter vide ID- 2763608984 which was addressed to DHO Malakand via inquiry officer. The letter is a photo copy and is having signature of the Mst. Wajahat Hassan with the date 18/08/2020 She explain in this letter that she was regularly attending the BHU (her job station) but the contending party with the help of the In-charge Doctor were barring the her to mark her attendance in the attendance register.

She has not mentioned the duty station that where she was performing her duty. She further claims that she has filed many written complaints and has attached copies with her letter, but the inquiry committee could neither find one of these letters in her personal file, nor the same have been received from DG Health office or DC Malakand office.


Conclusion facts


Respectfully Sheweth: - The need for the instant Application arises due to the following facts:


