When confronted with the situation, the appellant was fair and frank enough that the private respondents have not been so far served and he requested that their service was previously directed to be made through all ordinary means including a direction to the Director General Prosecution but service of the private respondents could not be made through all such ordinary means. He requested for publication of notice for service of private respondents in the national newspaper. Therefore, the respondents shall be served through publication in the Urdu "Daily Mashriq Peshawar", the expenses of which be deposited by the appellant within seven days. Simultaneously the District Attorney, present in the Tribunal, is also directed to contact the DG Prosecution to whom earlier direction was given by the Tribunal to serve notice upon the respondents. The learned Deputy District Attorney shall seek a report of the DG in writing regarding compliance of the direction of the court for notices upon the respondents. To come up on 20.03.2023 before S.B at camp court D.I.Khan. P.P given to the parties.
