#### JUDGMENT

Rozina Rehman, Member(J): Facts gleaned out from the memorandum of appeal are that appellant was appointed as Constable and was transferred to Forensic Science Laboratory Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar. Vacancy of Head Constable fell vacant in Photography Section on 14.01.2011, whereas, appellant was promoted as Head Constable on 29.06.2017 but with immediate effect. He preferred departmental appeal for antedating of his



promotion from occurrence of vacancy which was not responded to, hence, the present service appeal.

- 2. We have heard Fazal Shah Mohmand Advocate for appellant and Asif Masood Ali Shah learned Deputy District Attorney for the respondents and have gone through the record and the proceedings of the case in minute particulars.
- 3. Fazal Shah Mohmand Advocate learned counsel appearing on behalf of appellant, in support of appeal contended with vehemence that the appellant was not treated according to law and rules as he was entitled to be promoted as Head Constable w.e.f 14.01.2011 instead of 29.06.2017 as post of Head Constable fell vacant in Photography Section on 14.01.2011. He contended that the appellant was fit, senior and eligible to antedated promotion as per rules and lastly, he submitted that it has been held by the superior fora that a civil servant is to be promoted from the date when the vacancy in the promotion quota falls vacant, therefore, appellant is also entitled to be promoted as Head Constable from the said date. Reliance was placed on 2010 P.L.C (C.S) 760 and 2019 PLC (C.S) 1252.
- 4. Conversely, learned D.D.A submitted that as per recommendation of D.P.C held on 23.06.2017 appellant was promoted to the post of Officiating Head Constable after fulfilling the prescribed criteria mentioned in the instructions in respect of Forensic Science Laboratory and Finger Print Bureau for promotion to the next higher rank. He contended that the appellant was promoted, the moment vacancy occurred and that now the prayer of appellant is not justified as he was treated in accordance with law and rules.



5. From the record it is evident that appellant was appointed as Constable and was transferred to Forensic Science Laboratory in the year 2009 on Loan Basis with immediate effect. A request for transfer of lien was made by Director Forensic Science Laboratory to the Additional Inspector General of Police as his services were required in Photography Section of F.S.L and accordingly, lien of Constable Abid Jawad the present appellant of Investigation Unit C.P.U was transferred to F.S.L Khyber Pakhtunkhwa on 12.08.2010. Admittedly, one Head Constable Taza Gul was promoted on 14.01.2011 in the Photography Section of F.S.L. therefore, appellant submitted an application requesting therein for promotion to the next rank on the existing vacancy of Head Constable. His application was properly processed. Comments were also invited from the D.S.P (Legal) and transfer of the appellant to Photography Section of F.S.L was recommended in order to enable him to seek his promotion being a qualified candidate. Despite his repeated requests, he was not considered for promotion, therefore, he filed Service Appeal NO.636/2016 and during the pendency of service appeal, he was promoted but with immediate effect. The availability of vacant post is not denied. Retrospective promotion is to be given effect from the day following the day of regular promotion of employee holding the said post. In the instant case, Head Constable Taza Gul got his promotion on 14.01.2011, whereas, the present appellant was promoted on 29.06.2017.

6. In view of the above discussion, this appeal is accepted with direction to the respondents to antedate the promotion of the appellant from the date of occurrence of vacancy i.e. (14.01.2011).

Re-submitted to 2da hat the vacancy of Head Constable fell vacant in Photography Section on 14-01-2015, due to promotion of Head Constable Taza Gul as ASI. (Copy Notification dated 14-01-2011 is enclosed as Annexure B).

- **C.** That the appellant is entitled to be promoted as Head Constable w.e.f 14-01-2011 instead of 29-06-2017, as the post of Head Constable fell vacant in Photography section on 14-01-2011
- **D.** That the appellant is perfectly fit, Senior and eligible to antedated promotion as per the threshold governing the matter.
- **E.** That the appellant was recommended for promotion as Head Constable vide letter dated 01-11-2011, but he was not promoted as per recommendations and instead he was promoted on 29-06-2017. (Copy of letter dated 01-11-2011 is enclosed as Annexure F).
- **F.** That as per the Judgments of the Apex Court, wherein it has been held that "A Civil servant is to be promoted from the date when the vacancy in the promotion quota falls vacant" and the appellant is as such entitled to be promoted as Head Constable from the said date.
- **G.** That even the post of ASI is lying vacant in the Photography Section since 28-06-2018 and if the appellant is promoted as

Head Constable w.e.f 14-01-2011, then he becomes eligible for promotion to the rank of ASI.

- **H.** That the appellant has been denied due promotion from due date without omission or commission on his part and as per law no one could be punished for the fault on his part.
- I. That the appellant has a long service with Unblemished service record and is perfectly fit for ante-dated promotion from due date.



- 4. During his posting in Photography Section of FSL he passed A-I and B-I examination i.e Photography Courses, Technical Course and Proficient Course pre-requisite for promotion to the Post of HC in Photography Section. (copy enclosed as F/C).
  - F/D) Director FSL Peshawar informed that constable Mukhtiar Khan No. 111 is senior most in Photography Section of FSL however he is matriculate and working as driver. He further informed that lien of FC Abid Jawad was permanently transferred to FSL on 12.08.2010 since then he is working in Photography Section FSL Peshawar he is Post Graduate, literate in Adobe Photoshop, MS Office and qualified Technical courses A-I and B-I pre-requisite for promotion to the Post of Head Constable, therefore recommended for vacant Post of Head Constable in Photography section of FSL.

SERVICE APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNALS ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE IMPUGNED ORDER DATED 31.12.2012 PASSED BY RESPONDENT NO.2 WHEREBY APPELLANT HAS BEEN SURRENDERED FROM THE FSL TO THE INVESTIGATION WING AGAINST WHICH APPELLANT PREFERRED DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL TO THE APPELLATE AUTHORITY BUT THE SAME WAS REJECTED VIDE IMPUGNED APPELLATE ORDER DATED 23.05.2016.

#### PRAYER:

On acceptance of the instant appeal, the impugned original order dated 31.12.2012 issued by Respondent No.2 and the appellate order dated 23.05.2016 may graciously be brushed aside and the Respondents be directed to act in the matter in accordance with law and to allow the appellant to remained posted at Photography Section, FSL being technically qualified and experienced and be also promoted to the post of Head Constable being fit having Adobe Photo Shop and Technical Courses Al and BI meant for the said Section with all back benefits.



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Facts giving rise to the present appeal are as underi-

- 1. That appellant is a qualified Constable holding Master degree from Peshawar University. He has been performing his duties for the last 21 years and presently posted at CPO Peshawar.
- 2. That appellant was transferred from Research Section of CPO to FSL Peshawar vide order dated 26.12.2009 (Annex:-A) on loan basis and then he was adjusted in Photography Section of FSL on temporary basis, and got different trainings in the field of Photography. In this regard due to appellant's knowledge, Photography skills, computer knowledge and qualification, the then Director FSL recommended his name for transfer and permanent lien to Photography Section of FSL, Peshawar vide letter dated 11.08.2010 (Annex:-B).
- 3. That Respondent No.4 transferred the lien of appellant to FSL Peshawar vide order No.7137-40/Inv: dated 12.08.2010 (Annex:-C). Later on appellant submitted an application (Annex:-D) before Respondent No.4 for promotion to the rank of Head Constable on 01.11.2010, which was referred to Respondent No.2 for consideration and comments who submitted the same (Annex:-E) recommending appellant for promotion against the expected vacant post of Head Constable in Photography Section.
  - That to his utter dismay, appellant was informed that in the Seniority List, his name was prescribed on second place and Mr. Mukhtar Ali (Driver Constable) was placed on top of the Seniority List, even when there is no vacancy of the Driver Constable on the strength of FSL nor in FPB and especially in Photography Section. In this regard he put all the requisite rules and regulations according to FSL Manual and submitted to Respondent No.4 on 08.09.2011 (Annex:-F), in continuation of which, appellant's application was endorsed to Respondent No.2 for comments vide letter No.7397/SRC/Invest: dated 31.10.2011 (Annex:-G) in which appellant was again recommended for promotion in Photography Section vide letter No.23404/ dated 01.11.2011 (Annex:-H) of Respondent No2 referring to 02 vacancies of Head Constables one each in Photography Section and Chemical Section.

That in this regard Respondent No.4 made a query for clarification whether the Driver Constable Mukhtiar Ali is a Driver Constable or Constable vide letter



dated 18.11.2011 (Annex:-I) who clarified that "Constable Mukhtiar Ali No.111 of FSL was appointed as Constable in the FRP on 11.12.1994 and later on he was absorbed as Driver Constable on 20.08.1998 in FRP Peshawar vide letter dated 28.11.2011 (Annex:-J).

- 6. That later on an uncalled for observation was made that the appellant had two liens. In this regard appellant has submitted the relevant rules (*Annex:-K*) to meet the observation but inspite of the same it was suggested through a letter to CPO for comments which is still pending duly signed by Respondent No.4.
  - That vide impugned order dated 31.12.2012 (Annex:-L) passed by Respondent No.2, appellant was unlawfully surrendered to the CPO on the ground of being over and above sanctioned strength of FSL/FPB. Since the order was illegal, unfair and unjust inas much as the case of the appellant for promotion was already in the process, therefore, appellant preferred a departmental Representation (Annex:-M) to the Appellate Authority but the same was not disposed of within the statutory period of 90 days, hence Service Appeal No.620/2013 was filed before this Hon'ble Tribunal wherein the Respondents filed their parawise comments (Annex:-N) and thereafter, Rejoinder (Annex:-O) was also submitted.
- 8. That vide order dated 21.12.2015 (Annex:-P), this Hon'ble Tribunal disposed of the appeal in the following terms:-

"This may be observed that in the said scenario the learned counsel for the appellant has worked out prima facie case on the ground of discrimination, hence, the Tribunal is constrained to remit the case of the appellant to Respondent Department to consider his appeal and provide the same benefit to him, if his case is similar with the case of the said Hameedullah. The appeal is disposed off accordingly."

In the post remand proceedings, without hearing the appellant vide impugned appellate order dated 23.05.2016 (Annex:-Q) the appeal of the appellant was rejected on quite untenable grounds, hence this appeal inter-alia on the following grounds:-

### <u>Grounds:</u>

That Respondents have not treated appellant in accordance with law, rules and policy on subject and acted in violation of Article 4 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 and unlawfully issued the impugned orders instead of



considering the appellant for promotion to the next higher grade, which are unjust, unfair and hence not sustainable in the eye of law.

- B. That as a matter of fact the impugned order passed by Respondent No.2 was then forwarded to the competent authority i.e. Respondent No.1 who did not agree therewith and filed the same vide letter dated 18.04.2013 (Annex:-R) and thereafter not only Hameedullah but all others were also readjusted as the FSL who are still serving there.
  - C. That the reason mentioned in the impugned appellate order is not sustainable because all the employees serving in the FSL are drawing their salaries from the Investigation because the FSL is a Wing of the Investigation Branch.
    - D. That previously the name of the appellant was taken out from the Photography Section and placed in the general Section in the Seniority List of FSL employees as stood on 31.12.2012 (Annex:-S) without any concept of general section in the FSL upon which appellant then filed an application (Annex:-T) to Respondent No.2 whereafter againsthe Seniority List was rectified vide letter dated 06.11.2012 (Annex:-U) and the name of the appellant was restored to Photography Section.
      - That the impugned orders are the result of arbitrary exercise of powers in as much as appellant has remained in the FSL for considerable period of time and during this period has developed his skills in the Photography and his sending back will result into the futility of his skills obtained during the course of time.
        - That when once the case of promotion of the appellant was processed considering the appellant as the permanent employee of the FSL then surrendering him being over and above is beyond comprehension, therefore, the impugned orders are void, ab-initio, without lawful authority, therefore, not maintainable.

That the case of the appellant was a clear case of discrimination as other five persons mentioned in the impugned order were subsequently re-adjusted in the persons mentioned in the impugned order were subsequently re-adjusted in the FSL after the approval was not accorded by Respondent No.1 including Hameedullah and for that very reason on the ground of clear discrimination to the appellate authority to do substantial justice but violated was remitted to the appellate authority to do substantial justice but violated appellate order but once again the issue was left unresolved which against the law.

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- H. That appellant has been condemned unheard in as much as the impugned order has been passed at his back which is against the principle of natural justice.
- I. That appellant will also beg to submit other grounds at the time of arguments.

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that the instant appeal may graciously be accepted as prayed for above.

Any other relief as deemed appropriate in the circumstances of case not specifically asked for, may also be granted to appellant.





#### <u>GENERAL.</u>

All sealed parcel shall be received by the Reception Officer of rank not below of SI. The Head Clerk will then dispatch it to the quarter concerned through Reception Officer in sealed envelopes by registered post or through representative of the sending agency. Copy of each opinion shall be retained in the record room under the supervision of Director FSL.




promoted against the post of Soil Conservation Assistant on 29.05.2018 with immediate effect. In the instant appeal the appellant has come up with the prayers that his promotion to the post of Soil Conservation Assistant BPS-17 may antedated w.c.f 13.05.2015 insteadwith immediate effect on the grounds mentioned in the appeal.

Learned counsel for the appellant argued the case of the appellant in the instant appeal and contended that the appellant was on the top of the seniority list circulated by the competent authority in the year 2015. A post of the Soil Conservation Assistant in (BPS-17) became vacant due to the retirement of one Aziz Ullah khan vide notification dated 20.02.2015. Further contended that according to the Service Rules 25% quota of the post of Soil Conservation Assistant reserved for promotion of Conservation Inspector on the basis of Seniority-Cum-Fitness and atleast 10 years total service experience at his credit as Field Assistant and Soil Conservation Inspector. Further contended that the appellant was appointed as a Field Assistant on 11.08.1982 and was promoted as Soil Conservation Inspector vide order dated 27.03.2014 w.e.f. 01.01.2012 and as such the appellant was illegible for promotion being the senior most on the seniority list as well as fulfilling the 10 year service experience as required by the service rules of the post at the time when the post of Soil Conservation Assistant BPS-17 became vacant due to the retirement of one Mr. Aziz Ullah Khan. The learned counsel for the appellant relied upon the judgment of August Supreme Court of Pakistan reported as 2006 SCMR 1938 and the judgments of the Service Tribunal Appeal No. 1398/2010 Fazal Hussain vs Government and Service Appeal No. 1655/2010 Syed Masood Shah Vs Government. Learned counsel for the appellant also contended that the appeal may kindly be accepted with the prayers.


The Learned Deputy District Attorney contested the facts, grounds of





the appeal and argument of the learned counsel for the appellant and contended that the respondent department ordered the promotion of the appellant against the post of Soil Conservation Assistant BPS-17 as directed by this Tribunal in its judgment dated 10.01.2018 & 29.03.2018. He further explained that vide judgment of 29.03.2018 the Tribunal made correction of Typographical mistake in its previous judgment on 10.01.2018, however in the said judgment the Tribunal did not issued any directions regarding the promotion of the appellant with back date. He further contended that the respondents department ordered the promotion of the appellant in accordance with the provision of the Civil Servant Act, and Rules made their under wherein appointment by promotion is always made with immediate effect as such the appeal may be dismissed with the cost as the same is devoid of any merit.

- 6. Arguments heard. File perused.
- 7. After the detailed scrutiny of the documents on record, arguments and counter arguments of the learned counsel of the appellant and the learned Deputy District Attorney this Tribunal observed that theappellant was on the top of the seniority list as circulated by the competent authority in the year2015. A vacant post became available due to the retirement of one Mr. Aziz Ullah Khan vide notification dated 20.02.2015. The respondent department did not objected nor contradicted the availability of the vacant post during the arguments of the instant appeal as well as during the arguments of a previous appeal No.569/2016. Similarly it was also not challenged the eligibility of the appellant on the basis of qualification and the requisite service experience as prescribed in the service rules for the post of Soil Conservation. Assistant. This Tribunal in its previous judgment in the appeal No. 569/2016 observed in its concluding portion of the judgment that "We are of the view that it is a clear cut case of



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arbitrary use of official authority, injustice and the appellant is being denied the right of promotion on flimsy grounds."

- 8. The questioned before this Tribunal is that had the respondents No.2 &3 processed the case of promotion of the appellant to the competent forum of Provincial Selection Board (PSB) immediate after the vacant post became available for his promotion. This Tribunal seeks guidance from the judgment of August Supreme Court reported as 2006 SCMR 1938.
- 9. In view of the above discussion the appeal is accepted with the direction to the respondents to antedate the promotion of the appellant from the date of occurrence of vacancy for the purpose of Pay Fixation. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record toom.

#### JUDGMENT

which the appeal of the respondents was allowed and it was directed as follows:--

"Appellant's promotion to the post of Associate Professor (ENT) having been kept in abeyance till 3-12-1998 has affected his vested right of seniority vis-a-vis respondents Nos.3 and 4. I, therefore, accept the appeal, direct the respondents to consider the case of the appellant for promotion to the post of Associate Professor (ENT) in BS-19 w.e.f. the date when the vacancy, in his quota, became available and thereafter a joint seniority list of the officers directly recruited and those promoted shall be issued according to the rules".

Facts briefly stated are that respondent Dr. Israr Ahmad was appointed as Assistant Professor (ENT) in the Health Department on 13-1-1992. Admittedly as per the relevant rules 33% of the posts of Associate Professor were to be filled through direct recruitment and 2/3 by way of promotion. Respondents became eligible for promotion to the post of Associate Professor in February, 1997 when four posts were available in the promotion quota. However, the department did not consider his case for promotion till 3-12-1998 when he was promoted. He filed a representation and even that was not considered whereafter he approached the Service Tribunal. In the meanwhile, in June, 1998, the Punjab Public Service Commission had conducted interviews for two posts of Associate Professor, in which both the appellants were selected whereas respondent could not qualify. The Punjab Service Tribunal allowed respondent's appeal mainly on the ground that since substantive post against promotion quota was available in 1997 and respondent was eligible to be considered, his promotion as Associate Professor should reckon from the date, the substantive post in the said quota was available.

Dr. Abdul Basit, learned counsel for the appellants in Civil Appeal No.384 of 2003 made the following submissions:

- That it is admitted position that in terms of the Punjab Health Department (Medical and Dental Teaching Posts) Service Rules, 33% of the posts are to be filled in through direct recruitment and the remaining 2/3rd by promotion. appellants along with respondents Dr. Israr Ahmad applied through Public Service Commission against the posts reserved for direct recruitment, the appellants qualified the test and interview in 1998 and on the recommendation of the Punjal Public Service Commission, they were selected against the post of Associate Professor whereas the respondent could not qualify
  - (ii) that there is no cavil with the proposition that the posts

Associate Professor in the promotion quota were available and the meetings of the Departmental Promotion Committee (D.P.C.) did take place on 11-5-1993, 17-8-1995, 1-10-1996 and on 3-9-1997 but since neither the appellants nor the respondent were qualified to be appointed as Associated Professors by the said date, they were not so appointed. Since respondent did not challenge the act of the department of not promoting him in time, he could not raise his claim for pro forma promotion at a belated stage particularly when he failed to qualify the examination conducted by the Punjab Public Service Commission for appointment of Associate Professors against the posts reserved for direct appointment; and

- (iii) that section 8 of the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974 was amended by Act III of 2005 and under the amended provision, no civil servant can claim pro forma promotion as of right.
- 4. Learned Additional Advocate-General adopted the arguments of learned counsel for the appellants (in Civil Appeal No.384 of 2003) and made following additional submissions:—
  - (i) That the impugned judgment is violative of section 8 of the Punjab Civil Servants Act and cannot be sustained;
  - (ii) that respondent Dr. Israr Ahmad was duly promoted on 3-12-1998 and although the post fell vacant earlier but the delay occurred due to procedural and unavoidable causes because the department sent the case for respondent's promotion only on the receipt of requisite documents; and
  - (iii) that the respondent appeared along with appellants (in the connected appeal) before the Punjab Public Service Commission for appointment against the posts reserved for direct appointment wherein the former failed but appellants were declared selected. That being so, it was not open for the respondent to claim seniority over the appellants after having not being selected by the Commission.
  - 5. Learned counsel for the respondent Mr. Shoab Shaheen who assisted the Court on behalf of respondent at the asking of the Court, submitted as under:—
    - (i) That although the post for direct recruitment as Associate Professor fell vacant in February, 1997, and the case of respondent's promotion against the said post was pending decision in the department, yet, in the meanwhile the posts were filled through selectees of Punjab Public Service Commission on

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27-7-1998 and respondent was promoted later on 3-12-1998 which was unfair, mala fide and discriminatory; and

- that respondent had a right to be considered for promotion against the post reserved for promotion quota as soon as the substantive vacancy was available and respondent could not have been condemned for inaction of the State functionaries. In support of the submissions made, learned counsel relied on Government of N.-W.F.P. v. Buner Khan 1985 SCMR 1158, Government of the Punjab v. Rana Ghulam Sarwar Khan 1997 SCMR 515 and Muhammad Iqbal v. Executive District Officer (R) Lodhran 2007 SCMR 682.
- We have heard learned counsel for the appellants, learned Additional Advocate-General as also Mr. Shoab Shaheen, Advocate Supreme Court who assisted the Court on behalf of respondent at the asking of the Court.
- In accepting respondent's appeal, the learned Service Tribunal considered the availability of substantive posts in the promotion quota, the eligibility of respondent to be considered in February, 1997 and the unreasonable delay caused by the department in processing his case. The Court found as follows:--

"In the comments submitted by respondent No.2, it was submitted that the post of Associate Professor (ENT) to be filled through promotion, when became available, the department started moving for filling the post by gathering documents from on the the prospective candidates and it was only after clearance that being the competent authority, appellant was promoted as Associate to wi Professor (ENT) on regular basis w.e.f. 3-12-1998. It is said that the delay which occurred, if any, was procedural and unavoidable because the case was prepared on receipt of documents from different quarters. Explanation given is hardly convincing. It means that spade work which commenced in February, 1997 ended in December, 1998 playing with the right of civil servant in such an arbitrary manner is not only unpardonable but wholly unconsciousable. Appellant suffered and felt aggrieved, undoubtedly when the post of Associate Professor (ENT) was not being filled but the last nail was drived the coffin on 27-7-1998 when the recently arrayed and 4 were inducted through direct respondents Nos.3 recruitment as Associate Professors (ENT)."

We specifically asked the Additional Advocate-General as to whether the respondent was eligible to be considered for promotion against the promotion quota by 3-2-1997, to which his answer was in the

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In Sarwar Ali Khan v. Chief Secretary to Government of Sin-1994 PLC (C.S.) 411, the appellant was working as a Superintende (BS-16) in the Sindh Labour Appellate Tribunal when the said post w converted into that of Deputy Registrar in BS-17. However, the post w upgraded on the recommendation of the Departmental Promoti Committee. On 1-7-1988, the post of Registrar (BS-18) fell vacant a on 5,7-1988 he was appointed to the post in his own pay and stat Ultimately, he was promoted on regular basis to the post of Regist (BS-18) on the recommendation of the Departmental Promot Committee vide notification dated 30-6-1991. He applied for salary BS-18 from the date when he was posted against the post of Registra his own pay and status i.e. 5-7-1988. His appeal was dismissed by Service Tribunal merely on the ground that he did not challe notification dated 5-7-1988 in time, that the Departmental Selec Board had not cleared his case for promotion and that he had t compensated by the grant of special pay. This Court allowed the ap on the ground that his claim cannot be rejected merely on the groun being time-barred; that there was no valid reason for the Selection B to withhold clearance for regular promotion and in absence of any explanation, it was not fair and equitable to refuse the prayer.

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Education Department could not carry out a fairly simple exercise within a reasonable period."

11. In Government of N.-W.F.P. v. Buner Khan 1985 SCMR 1158, the facts briefly stated are that 75% of the posts in Grade 18 in Provincial Education Department were to be filled in by promotion from among the Grade 17 officers of the said department and 25% by direct recruitment. However, no proper rotation of the vacancies for the purpose was maintained. The petitioners before this Court were directly recruited in BPS-18 on 30-12-1980 and 1-9-1982, whereas the respondents (who were promotees) were promoted to the said grade on 12-5-1984 and no joint seniority list in the said grade was notified with the result that some of the direct recruits were promoted to Grade 19 without the promotees being considered for the said promotion. The Tribunal allowed the appeal of the promotees and directed the Government to promote them in Grade 18 w.e.f. the date when the vacancies were available and a joint seniority list be issued accordingly. This judgment was challenged both by the Government and those who were directly recruited. This Court maintained the judgment of the Service Tribunal with a slight modification i.e. instead of direction by the Tribunal, "to promote", this Court directed that "the promotees shall be considered for promotion to Grade-18 post with effect from the dates when vacancies in their quota became available and that thereafter a joint seniority list of the officers directly recruited and those promoted shall be issued according to the rules."

2 In Luquan Zareen v. Secretary Education N.-W.F.P. 2006 SCMR 1938, several school teachers were allowed pro forma promotion w.e.f. the date when the substantive vacancies were available but they were not considered on account of, "the usual apathy, negligence and bureaucratic red-tapism which had deprived the petitioners of the fruits that they deserved. The petitioners could not be permitted to be punished for the faults and inaction of others."

13. In Ch. Muhammad Siddique v. Director, Special Education 1998 SCMR 88, the civil servant who was a lady teacher was granted pro forma promotion because her case was not considered when the substantive post was available for no fault of her own. The Court held as follows:--

> "It has not been denied that the case of the respondent was placed before the D.P.C. on 23-7-1987 and was deferred due to certain deficiencies but she was later promoted on 15-5-1988. That being so, she was entitled to ask for promotion with effect from the date the post became available and/or the date when her case was deferred by D.P.C. The judgment of the Service

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Tribunal, in our view, is quite just and fair and does not suffe from any illegality."

- 14. Considering the case of the respondent in the light of th judgments of this Court, to which reference has been made above, w find that it is nobody's case that respondent was not eligible to t considered for promotion when substantive vacancy in the promotic quota was available. That being so, the impugned judgment directing the appellants to consider the case of respondent's promotion to the post Associate Professor in BPS-19 w.e.f. the date when the vacancy in h quota was available is unexceptionable.
- 15. So far as the argument of learned Additional Advocate-Gener with reference to section 8 of the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974 (VI of 1974) which was amended in terms of Act III of 2005 is considered the same would be of no avail to the appellants because there is nothing in the amended provisions which makes it retrospective in effec Reference to the amended provision would be in order which reads under:-
  - "8. Promotion!--- (1) A civil servant shall be eligible to 1 considered for appointment by promotion in the service or cad to which he belongs in a manner as may be prescribed; provide that he possesses the prescribed qualifications.
  - (2) Promotion including pro forma promotion shall not be claim by any civil servant as of right.
  - Promotion shall be granted with immediate effect and actualized from the date of assumption of charge of the high post, and shall in no case be granted from the date of availabili of post reserved for promotion.
  - A civil servant shall not be entitled to promotion from an earli date except in the case of pro forma promotion.
  - A retired civil servant shall not be eligible for grant promotion or pro forma promotion.
  - A post referred to in subsection (1) may either be a selection post or a non-selection post to which promotion shall be made follows:--

- (a) revive anything not in force of existing at the time at which the repeal takes effect; or
- affect the previous operation of any enactment so repealed of anything duly done or suffered thereunder; or
- affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under any enactment so repealed; or
- affect any penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed against any enactment so repealed; of
- affect any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty. forfeiture, or punishment as aforesaid;
  - and any such investigation, legal proceeding or remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced and any penalty, forfeiture or punishment may be imposed as if the repealing Act or Regulation had not been passed.
- In Idrees Ahmed v. Hafiz Fida Khan PLD 1985 SC 376, the import of section 6 of the General Clauses Act came under consideration and the Court held as follows:--

"Unless different intention appears from repealing enactment, repeal ipso facto not to affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired; accrued or incurred under any enactment so repealed; nor to influence any investigation, legal proceedings of remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeitures or punishment to be imposed as if repealing enactment having not been passed."

18. For what has been discussed above, we do not find any merit in v. Fed these appeals which are dismissed, with to order as to costs.

which the appeal of the respondents was allowed and it was directed as follows:--

"Appellant's promotion to the post of Associate Professor (ENT) having been kept in abeyance till 3-12-1998 has affected his vested right of seniority vis-a-vis respondents Nos.3 and 4. I, therefore, accept the appeal, direct the respondents to consider the case of the appellant for promotion to the post of Associate Professor (ENT) in BS-19 w.e.f. the date when the vacancy, in his quota, became available and thereafter a joint seniority list of the officers directly recruited and those promoted shall be issued according to the rules".

Facts briefly stated are that respondent Dr. Israr Ahmad was appointed as Assistant Professor (ENT) in the Health Department on 13-1-1992. Admittedly as per the relevant rules 33% of the posts of Associate Professor were to be filled through direct recruitment and 2/3 by way of promotion. Respondents became eligible for promotion to the post of Associate Professor in February, 1997 when four posts were available in the promotion quota. However, the department did not consider his case for promotion till 3-12-1998 when he was promoted. He filed a representation and even that was not considered whereafter he approached the Service Tribunal. In the meanwhile, in June, 1998, the Punjab Public Service Commission had conducted interviews for twee posts of Associate Professor, in which both the appellants were selected whereas respondent could not qualify. The Punjab Service Tribunal allowed respondent's appeal mainly on the ground that since substantive post against promotion quota was available in 1997 and respondent was eligible to be considered, his promotion as Associate Professor should reckon from the date, the substantive post in the said quota was available.

Dr. Abdul Basit, learned counsel for the appellants in Civil Appeal No.384 of 2003 made the following submissions:

- (i) That it is admitted position that in terms of the Punjab Health Department (Medical and Dental Teaching Posts) Service Rules, 33% of the posts are to be filled in through direct recruitment and the remaining 2/3rd by promotion. appellants along with respondents Dr. Israr Ahmad applied through Public Service Commission against the posts reserved for direct recruitment, the appellants qualified the test and interview in 1998 and on the recommendation of the Punjah Public Service Commission, they were selected against the post of Associate Professor whereas the respondent could not qualify
  - (ii) that there is no cavil with the proposition that the posts of

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Associate Professor in the promotion quota were available and the meetings of the Departmental Promotion Committee (D.P.C.) did take place on 11-5-1993, 17-8-1995, 1-10-1996 and on 3-9-1997 but since neither the appellants nor the respondent were qualified to be appointed as Associated Professors by the said date, they were not so appointed. Since respondent did not challenge the act of the department of not promoting him in time, he could not raise his claim for pro forma promotion at a belated stage particularly when he failed to qualify the examination conducted by the Punjab Public Service Commission for appointment of Associate Professors against the posts reserved for direct appointment; and

- (iii) that section 8 of the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974 was amended by Act III of 2005 and under the amended provision, no civil servant can claim pro forma promotion as of right.
- 4. Learned Additional Advocate-General adopted the arguments of learned counsel for the appellants (in Civil Appeal No.384 of 2003) and made following additional submissions:--
  - (i) That the impugned judgment is violative of section 8 of the Punjab Civil Servants Act and cannot be sustained;
  - (ii) that respondent Dr. Israr Ahmad was duly promoted on 3-12-1998 and although the post fell vacant earlier but the delay occurred due to procedural and unavoidable causes because the department sent the case for respondent's promotion only on the receipt of requisite documents; and
  - (iii) that the respondent appeared along with appellants (in the connected appeal) before the Punjab Public Service Commission for appointment against the posts reserved for direct appointment wherein the former failed but appellants were declared selected. That being so, it was not open for the respondent to claim seniority over the appellants after having not being selected by the Commission.
  - 5. Learned counsel for the respondent Mr. Shoab Shaheen who assisted the Court on behalf of respondent at the asking of the Court, submitted as under:—
    - (i) That although the post for direct recruitment as Associate Professor fell vacant in February, 1997, and the case of respondent's promotion against the said post was pending decision in the department, yet, in the meanwhile the posts were filled through selectees of Punjab Public Service Commission on

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27-7-1998 and respondent was promoted later on 3-12-1998 which was unfair, mala fide and discriminatory; and

- (ii) that respondent had a right to be considered for promotion against the post reserved for promotion quota as soon as the substantive vacancy was available and respondent could not have been condemned for inaction of the State functionaries. In support of the submissions made, learned counsel relied on Government of N.-W.F.P. v. Buner Khan 1985 SCMR 1158, Government of the Punjab v. Rana Ghulam Sarwar Khan 1997 SCMR 515 and Muhammad Iqbal v. Executive District Officer (R) Lodhran 2007 SCMR 682.
- 6. We have heard learned counsel for the appellants, learned Additional Advocate-General as also Mr. Shoab Shaheen, Advocate Supreme Court who assisted the Court on behalf of respondent at the asking of the Court.
- In accepting respondent's appeal, the learned Service Tribunal considered the availability of substantive posts in the promotion quota, the eligibility of respondent to be considered in February, 1997 and the unreasonable delay caused by the department in processing his case. The Court found as follows:--

"In the comments submitted by respondent No.2, it was submitted that the post of Associate Professor (ENT) to be filled through promotion, when became available, the department started moving for filling the post by gathering documents from the prospective candidates and it was only after clearance that being the competent authority, appellant was promoted as Associate Professor (ENT) on regular basis w.e.f. 3-12-1998. It is said that the delay which occurred, if any, was procedural and unavoidable because the case was prepared on receipt of documents from different quarters. Explanation given is hardly convincing. It means that spade work which commenced in February, 1997 ended in December, 1998 playing with the right of civil servant in such an arbitrary manner is not only unpardonable but wholly unconsciousable. Appellant suffered and felt aggrieved, undoubtedly when the post of Associate Professor (ENT) was not being filled but the last nail was driven the coffin on 27-7-1998 when the recently arrays respondents Nos.3 and 4 were inducted through direct recruitment as Associate Professors (ENT)."

We specifically asked the Additional Advocate-General as to whether the respondent was eligible to be considered for promotion against the promotion quota by 3-2-1997, to which his answer was in the

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4th April, 2010.

Education Department could not carry out a fairly simple exercise within a reasonable period."

11. In Government of N.-W.F.P. v. Buner Khan 1985 SCMR 1158, the facts briefly stated are that 75% of the posts in Grade 18 in Provincial Education Department were to be filled in by promotion from among the Grade 17 officers of the said department and 25% by direct recruitment. However, no proper rotation of the vacancies for the purpose was maintained. The petitioners before this Court were directly recruited in BPS-18 on 30-12-1980 and 1-9-1982, whereas the respondents (who were promotees) were promoted to the said grade on 12-5-1984 and no joint seniority list in the said grade was notified with the result that some of the direct recruits were promoted to Grade 19 without the promotees being considered for the said promotion. The Tribunal allowed the appeal of the promotees and directed the Government to promote them in Grade 18 w.e.f. the date when the vacancies were available and a joint seniority list be issued accordingly. This judgment was challenged both by the Government and those who were directly recruited. This Court maintained the judgment of the Service Tribunal with a slight modification i.e. instead of direction by the Tribunal, "to promote", this Court directed that "the promotees shall be considered for promotion to Grade-18 post with effect from the dates when vacancies in their quota became available and that thereafter a joint seniority list of the officers directly recruited and those promoted shall be issued according to the rules."

In Luquan Zareen v. Secretary Education N.-W.F.P. 2006 SCMR 1938, several school teachers were allowed pro forma promotion well the date when the substantive vacancies were available but they were not considered on account of, "the usual apathy, negligence and bureaucratic red-tapism which had deprived the petitioners of the fruits that they deserved. The petitioners could not be permitted to be punished for the faults and inaction of others."

13. In Ch. Muhammad Siddique v. Director, Special Education 1998 SCMR 88, the civil servant who was a lady teacher was granted proforma promotion because her case was not considered when the substantive post was available for no fault of her own. The Court held as follows:—

"It has not been denied that the case of the respondent was placed before the D.P.C. on 23-7-1987 and was deferred due to certain deficiencies but she was later promoted on 15-5-1988. That being so, she was entitled to ask for promotion with effect from the date the post became available and/or the date when her case was deferred by D.P.C. The judgment of the Service

Tribunal, in our view, is quite just and fair and does not suffe from any illegality."

- 14. Considering the case of the respondent in the light of th judgments of this Court, to which reference has been made above, w find that it is nobody's case that respondent was not eligible to t considered for promotion when substantive vacancy in the promotic quota was available. That being so, the impugned judgment directing the appellants to consider the case of respondent's promotion to the post i Associate Professor in BPS-19 w.e.f. the date when the vacancy in h quota was available is unexceptionable.
- 15. So far as the argument of learned Additional Advocate-Gener with reference to section 8 of the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974 (VI of 1974) which was amended in terms of Act III of 2005 is considered the same would be of no avail to the appellants because there is nothing in the amended provisions which makes it retrospective in effec Reference to the amended provision would be in order which reads under:-
  - Promotion!--- (1) A civil servant shall be eligible considered for appointment by promotion in the service or cad to which he belongs in a manner as may be prescribed; provide that he possesses the prescribed qualifications.
  - Promotion including pro forma promotion shall not be claim by any civil servant as of right.
  - Promotion shall be granted with immediate effect and actualized from the date of assumption of charge of the high post, and shall in no case be granted from the date of availabili of post reserved for promotion.
  - A civil servant shall not be entitled to promotion from an earli date except in the case of pro forma promotion.
  - A retired civil servant shall not be eligible for grant promotion or pro forma promotion.
  - A post referred to in subsection (1) may either be a selection (6) post or a non-selection post to which promotion shall be made follows:--

amendment of a statute will not affect its previous operation unless the amended provision provides otherwise. The said section reads as under:--

- "6. Effect of repeal .- Where this Act, or any (Central Act) or Regulation made after the commencement of this Act, repeals any enactment hitherto made or hereafter to be made, then, unless a different intention appears, the repeal shall not:
- (a) revive anything not in force of existing at the time at which the repeal takes effect; or
- affect the previous operation of any enactment so repealed of anything duly done or suffered thereunder; or
- affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under any enactment so repealed; or
- affect any penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed against any enactment so repealed; of
- affect any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty. forfeiture, or punishment as aforesaid;
  - and any such investigation, legal proceeding or remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced and any penalty, forfeiture or punishment may be imposed as if the repealing Act or Regulation had not been passed.
- In Idrees Ahmed v. Hafiz Fida Khan PLD 1985 SC 376, the import of section 6 of the General Clauses Act came under consideration and the Court held as follows:--

"Unless different intention appears from repealing enactment, repeal ipso facto not to affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under any enactment so repealed; nor to influence any investigation, legal proceedings of remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeitures or punishment to be imposed as if repealing enactment having not been passed."

18. For what has been discussed above, we do not find any merit in these appeals which are dismissed, with to order as to costs.
