APPEAL UNDER SECTION- 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA ledto-dayservice tribunal act, 1974 AGAINST THE IMPUGNED ORDER DATED 30.3.2018 COMMUNICATED TO THE APPELLANT ON 28.9.2018 THROUGH RTI WHEREBY THE PRIVATE RESPONDENT HAS BEEN APPOINTED TO THE POST OF SUB ENGINEER ON ACTING CHARGE BASIS ILLEGALLY AND AGAINST THE RULES AND AGAINST THE INACTION OF THE RESPONDENTS BY NOT CONSIDERING THE APPELLANT FOR REGULAR PROMOTION TO THE CADRE/ POST OF SUB ENGINEER (BPS-12) AND AGAINST NOT TAKING ACTION ON THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT WITHIN THE STATUTORY PERIOD OF NINETY DAYS

PRAYER:

That on acceptance of this appeal the impugned order dated 30.3.2018 communicated to the appellant on 28.9.2018 through RTI may very kindly be set aside and the respondents may kindly be directed to consider the appellant for regular promotion to the post of Sub Engineer (BPS-12)

from the date when the appellant completed five years service as Surveyor i.e. w.e.f. 26.6.2018 with all consequential back benefits. Any other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit may also be awarded in favor of the appellant.

R/SHEWETH: ON FACTS:

- 1- That the appellant was appointed as surveyor (BPS-11) in the respondents Department on the proper recommendation of the Public service commission vide order dated 26-06-2013. That in light of the above mentioned order dated 26.6.2013 the appellant submitted his arrival report before the respondent No.5 on 04-07-2013 and started his duty as surveyor quite efficiently and up to the entire satisfaction of his superiors. (Copies of the appointment order and arrival report are attached as annexure
- 2-That as per service Rules of the respondent Department Notified on 25.3.2010 five percent promotion quota has been reserved for the cadres of Work Superintendants, Work Supervisors and Surveyors on the basis of seniority cum fitness with five years service as such, having three years Diploma of Associate Engineering in Civil Technology from a recognized Board. Copy of the service rules are attached as annexure
- 3-That according to the working papers (item-I) placed before the Departmental committee vide office letter dated 26-03-2018 against 422 numbers of total sanctioned posts of sub Engineer in which 5% have been reserved for the Departmental promotion for the cadre of Work superintendents, Work supervisors and surveyors which comes out as 21 number of posts. That in light of above mentioned working paper dated 26.3.2018 thirteen (13) posts were already filled up by the respondents by way of regular promotion on the basis of joint seniority lists from amongst Work Superintendents, work Supervisor and Surveyors while from the remaining eight posts one post has left vacant due to deferment of one employee. Copies of the working papers, order and DPC minutes are attached as annexure
- **4-**That as per the above mentioned service Rules, 2010 two point five percent (2.5%) transfer quota to the post of Sub Engineer have been reserved for the cadre of Draftsman with seven years service as such, having Diploma in Civil/Electrical/Mechanical Technology from

- 5- That according to the joint seniority list of Work Superintendents, Work supervisors, Surveyors the appellant stood at serial No.8 of the seniority list was quite hopeful for his promotion to the post of sub Engineer (BPS-12) as one post remain vacant in his own quota while eight number of posts are vacant in the draftsman quota but inspite of that the respondents are not willing to promote the appellant to the post of Sub Engineer (BPS-12). Copy of the seniority list is attached as annexure.

- 8- That the appellant is having no other remedy but to file the instant appeal on the following grounds amongst the others.

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GROUNDS:

A- That the impugned order dated 30:3:2018 regarding acting charge appointment of the private respondent is against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and materials on the record hence not tenable and liable to be set aside.

- B- That the inaction of the respondents by not promoting the appellant to the post of Sub Engineer (BPS-12) on the vacant posts available for the promotion on regular basis is against the law, facts and norms of natural justice.
- C- That the appellant has not been treated by the respondent Department in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- D-That the appellant has served the respondents department for more than five years, so as per law, rules and regulations the appellant is perfectly eligible for promotion to the post of Sub Engineer on regular basis against the vacant post.
- E- That the act of the respondents by not promoting the appellant on the vacant posts reserved for the promotion is clear violation of the Fundamental Rights as enshrined in the constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- F- That the respondents are acted in arbitrary and malafide manner by not considering the appellant for regular promotion to the post of Sub Engineer against the vacant post.
- G-That not promoting the appellant to the post of Sub Engineer (BPS-12) the respondents violated section-9 of the Civil Servant Act, 1973 read with Rule-7 of the Appointment, promotion and transfer Rules, 1989.
- H-That the respondents acted in arbitrary and malafide manner by appointing the private respondent on acting charge basis vide impugned order dated 30.3.2018.
- I- That as per C&W Department service Rules, 2010 the appellant is perfectly eligible and entitle for regular promotion to the post of Sub Engineer (BPS-12) w.e.f the date when the appellant completed five years service.
- J- That appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.







Statutory provision regarding Appointment.

Section 5 of Civil Servants Act, 1973 - Appointment to a civil service of the Province or to a civil post in connection with the affairs of the Province shall be made in the prescribed manner by the Governor or by a person authorised by the Governor in that behalf.

THE NORTH-WEST FRONTIER PROVINCE CIVIL SERVANTS (APPOINTMENT, PROMOTION & TRANSFER) RULES, 1989.

PART-I

GENERAL

- 1. Short title and commencement: (1) These rules may be called the North-West Frontier Province Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989.
 - (2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. **Definitions:-**(1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-
 - (a) "Appointing Authority" in relation to a post, means the persons authorized under rule 4 to make appointment to that post;
 - (b) "Basic Pay Scale" means the Basic Pay Scale for the time being sanctioned by Government, in which a post or a group of posts is placed;
 - (c) "Commission" means the North West Frontier Province Public Service Commission;
 - ²⁹ (d) "Departmental Promotion Committee" means a committee constituted for making selection for promotion or transfer to such posts under a Department, or offices of Government, which do not fall within the purview of the Provincial Selection Board;
- 30 (dd)"Departmental Selection Board" means a Board constituted for the purpose of making selection for initial recruitment /appointment to posts under a Department or office of Government in Basic Pay Scale 17 not falling within the purview of the Commission:

Provided that more than one such committees may be constituted for civil servants holding different scales of pay".

- (e) "Departmental Selection Committee" means a committee constituted for the purpose of making selection for initial appointment to posts under a department, or office of Government [in Basic Pay Scale 17 and below not falling within the purview of the Commission];
- (f) "Post" means a post sanctioned in connection with the affairs of the Province, but not allocated to all Pakistan Unified Grades; and
- ³¹(g) "Provincial Selection Board" means the Board constituted by Government for the purpose of selection of civil servants for promotion or transfer to posts in respect

- (3) It will be the sole discretion of the appointing authority to accept or refuse a request for transfer under this rule and any decision made in this behalf shall be final and shall not be quoted as precedence in any other case.
- 9. Appointment on Acting Charge or current Charge Basis. (1) Where the appointing authority considered it to be in the public interest to fill a post reserved under the rules for departmental promotion and the most senior civil servant belonging to the cadre or service concerned, who is otherwise eligible for promotion, does not possess the specified length of service the authority may appoint him to that post on acting charge basis;

³⁷Provided that no such appointment shall be made, if the prescribed length of service is short by more than ³⁸[three years].

- (2) So long as a civil servant holds the acting charge appointment, a civil servant junior to him shall not be considered for regular promotion but may be appointed on acting charge basis to a higher post.
- (3) In the case of a post in Basic Pay Scale 17 and above, reserved under the rules to be filled in by initial recruitment, where the appointing authority is satisfied that no suitable officer drawing pay in the basic scale in which the post exists is available in that category to fill the post and it is expedient to fill the post, it may appoint to that post on acting charge basis the most senior officer otherwise eligible for promotion in the organization, cadre or service, as the case may be, in excess of the promotion quota.
- (4) Acting charge appointment shall be made against posts which are likely to fall vacant for period of six months or more. Against vacancies occurring for less than six months, current charge appointment may be made according to the orders issued from time to time.
- (5) Appointment on acting charge basis shall be made on the recommendations of the Departmental Promotion Committee or the Provincial Selection Board, as the case may be.
- (6) Acting charge appointment shall not confer any vested right for regular promotion to the post held on acting charge basis.

PART-III

INITIAL APPOINTMENT

- 10. Appointment by Initial Recruitment:-(1) Initial appointment to posts ³⁹[in various basic pay scales] shall be made-
 - (a) if the post falls within the purview of the Commission, on the basis of Examination or test to be conducted by the Commission; or

- 4. The Appellant has concealed material facts from this Honorable Tribunal.
- 5. The Appellant has not come to this Tribunal with clean hands.

ON FACTS

- 1. Pertains to record, maintained in the O/O Chief Engineer (CDO) (Respondent No.5).
- 2. Correct.
- 3. Incorrectly assumed, in fact the share for this Class @ 5% comes to 21-Nos against 422 posts, while 13-Nos, already had been promoted. For the remaining, 08-Posts the DPC in its meeting dated 27/03/2018, declared 07-officials on regular basis, whereas one post was kept open for one Senior Work Supervisor (BS-11) whose Confidential Reports and other documents were not received. It may further be noted that the Appellant name was also available at Sl-15 of the very said Working Paper, which has annexed by the appellant Annexed-D (Page-12).
- 4. Correct to the extent that according to share i.e 2.5% as reserved for Draftsmen, by Transfer to Sub-Engineer, the share becomes 11-Nos against 422-Posts, while two officials were already promoted and there were remaining 09-Posts for such Class and as such Two Officials one on regular base and the other (Mr. Liaqat Shah Pvt Respondent-6) was appointed on Acting Charge due to less length of required service i.e 05-years at the then under the APT Rules, 1989.
- 5. Incorrect, the very said one post in his own quota as assumed by the Appellant in fact was reserved for one Senior Official as expressed in para-3 above, being original incumbent, while for the 08-Posts falling to the incumbents of Draftsman (2.5%) Two Officials, one on regular, and the other on Acting Charge have been promoted/appointed and thus there remain only SIX Posts for Draftsman to be elevated to the post of Sub-Engineers for which their seniority is Annexed-I for perusal of this Honorable Tribunal.
- 6. Incorrect assumption. Rule-9 of APT Rules, 1989 as annexed at-I (Pages-21/22) the citation of which is as under: -

Appointment on Acting Charge or Current Charge Basis

"While the appointing authority considered it to be in the public interest to fill a post reserved under the rules



for departmental promotion and most senior Civil Servant belonging to the Cadre or Service concerned, who is otherwise eligible for promotion, does not possess the specified length of service, the authority may appoint him to that post on acting charge basis.

"Provided that no such appointment shall be made if the prescribed length of service is short by more than three years".

So, the contention of appellant, "such practice is not permissible" is superfluous, Pvt Respondent-6 (Mr. Liaqat Shah) is correctly elevated to the post of Sub-Engineer on Acting Charge as he was having, 05-years' service at the then against the specified service of 07-years and that was also not short by 03-years.

- 7. Incorrect, the Departmental Appeal of both Appellants, have been replied vide memo No.52-E/367/CEC/C&WD dated 22/11/2018 (Annexed-II), hence untenable.
- 8. The Appellant has not come to this Tribunal with clean hand hence his appeal is liable to dismissal in limine.

ON GROUNDS

- A. Incorrect, the factual position of official appointed on Acting Charge basis is fully expressed in above paras of reply.
- B. Incorrect, the appellant fall at SI-8 of the Class/ Cadre and would be promoted on his turn, subject to relevant conditions and requirement.
- C. Incorrect and mis-stated.
- D. Correct to the extent that when post position allows, Appellant would then be considered for promotion, on his turn, subject to fulfillment of the requisites.
- E. Mis-conceiving, Appellant shall wait for promotion on his turn.
- F. Incorrect, Mis-conceiving.

- G. Incorrectly assumed. Section-9 of Civil Servant Act, 1973 and Rule-7 of APT Rules, 1989 provides guiding principal dealing with the cases of promotion of Civil Servants for which such rules are available.
- H. Incorrect. Private Respondent-6 has rightly been appointed on Acting Charge basis under the Govt Rules as described in above paras of reply.
- I. No doubt not only the Appellant even others, who are senior to him, according to eligibility and post position would be considered for promotion at appropriate time subject to the condition that the requisite are fulfilled.
- J. The Replying Respondent(s) also seeks permission of this Honorable Tribunal to place additional documents/ grounds before the Tribunal at the time of Arguments.

In the wake of above submission, it is humbly prayed that there is no merit in the instant Service Appeal, devoid of material facts, may please be Dismissed in limine.

It is therefore crystal clear, that if an eligible person as per clause (e) amongst the Draftsman "By Transfer' is not available, then the vacancy occurring as such shall be filled from amongst the Work Superintendents/ Work Supervisors/Surveyors having 3-years Diploma in Civil with others requisites as described in subclause (b).

The contention of the applicants is not worth consideration, under the approved Rules as described at (b) & (c) it is sufficio, no promotion "By Transfer" is available to the Work Superintendents/ Work Supervisors/ Surveyors and the vacancy shall ever be filled-in "By Promotion" on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness. Relevant position of the rules, are therefore cleared for further needful please.

R/SHEWETH: PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS: 1 TO 5:

All the preliminary objections raised by the respondents are incorrect, baseless and not in accordance with law and rules rather the respondents are stopped due to their own conduct to raise any objection at this stage of the appeal.

ON FACTS:

- 1- Admitted correct hence need no comments.
- 2- Admitted correct hence need no comments.
- 3- Incorrect and not replied accordingly. That against the total 21 numbers reserved posts of Sub Engineer for Works Superintendants/ Work Supervisors/ Surveyors, the total 20 numbers of posts are filled by the way of regular promotion from amongst the Works Superintendants/ Work Supervisors/ Surveyors on the basis of joint seniority and only ONE post was left vacant due to deferment of one official of the mentioned Class for regular promotion.
- 4- Incorrect and not replied accordingly. That against the total 11 numbers reserved posts of Sub Engineer for Draftsman, the total 3 posts are filled regularly from amongst the Draftsman, while in the remaining EIGHT posts vacant for regular transfer, on one post the private Respondent No. 6 (Mr. Liaqat shah) has been appointed by the Respondent No.4 on acting charge basis as a Sub-Engineer illegally, against the rules vide the impugned order dated 30-03-2018 communicated to the appellant on 28-09-2018 through RTI, which is liable to be set aside.
- 5- Incorrect and not replied accordingly. That reply of the respondents is the misrepresentation, concealment of facts and fictive calculation because it is clearly been stated in para No.3 above that in Appellants own quota i.e. Works Superintendants/

Work Supervisors/ Surveyors ONE post is vacant which is not filled regularly, while in Draftsman quota EIGHT numbers of posts are vacant which are not filled regularly. Against these total NINE numbers of vacant posts the Appellant stood at serial No.8 of the joint seniority, so the appellant being at serial No. 8 is entitled to be promoted on the vacant post as eligible in all respect.

- Incorrect and not replied accordingly. That appointment on acting 6charge bases is not permissible under the rules for the officials of the private respondent cadre as they are suppose to be transferred to the cadre of sub engineer and not to be promoted, therefore, the impugned order dated 30-3-2018 is against the law and rules on the subject as rule 9 of A.P.T Rules, 1989 is not applicable to the Private respondent No.6.
- Incorrect and not replied accordingly. The reply has not been 7served on the appellant till the filing of the instant appeal.
- 8-Incorrect hence denied.

GROUNDS: (A to J):

All the grounds of main appeal are correct and in accordance with law and prevailing rules and that of the respondents are incorrect, baseless and not in accordance with law and Rules hence denied.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this rejoinder the appeal of the appellant may be accepted in favor of the appellant.
