

2. When confronted with situation that vide judgment dated 27.06.2022, it was directed by the Tribunal that enquiry be conducted within a period of sixty days from the date of receipt of judgment. The learned Law Officer has produced copy of covering letter issued by the Registrar of this Tribunal on 10.01.2023 which shows that before 10.01.2023 the order was not sent to the respondents for compliance of the judgment. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner though stated at the bar that the petitioner had taken the copy of the order to the respondents for implementation but there is nothing in black and white, therefore, he is fair enough to say that he would get copy of the inquiry and advise his client for further course of action to get redressal of her grievances if any.
