Preliminary arguments heard.

Learned counsel for the appellant addressed the objection raised by the office of Registrar and contended that the seniority list of the Sub Inspectors issued by the respondent department which was assailed through departmental appeal but the same was not responded within the statutory period and this Tribunal has been approached on 15.12.2022. It was further contested that private respondents are not required to be included in the list as private respondents mainly on the ground that the Service Tribunal judgement rendered in the first round of litigation on 18.03.2019 with the direction that the case of appellant be considered for "confirmation as S.I from the due date". The respondent department vide Notification dated 27.09.2021 placed the name of appellant above the name of Inspector Zar Wali No. P/225 and below the name of Inspector Sadat Khan No. MR/98 in the seniority list of Inspector and Sub Inspector on list 'F', as stood on 10.07.2020 conditionally and provisionally subject to the outcome of CPLA lodged by Police department before august Supreme Court of Pakistan. Now name of the appellant was required to have been placed/reflected at serial No. 70 after the name of Mr. Sadat Khan (No. MR/98) instead of 216 whereas Mr. Zar Wali Khan (No.P/225) has by now retired on attaining the age of superannuation and is therefore, no longer in service to be impleaded as private respondent.
