JUDGMENT:

SALAH-UD-DIN, MEMBER:- Precise averments as raised by the appellant in his appeal are that he was appointed as Monitoring Coordinator in GAVI Project on contract basis vide appointment order dated 05.12.2008. During the course of his service, some of his colleagues filed Writ Petition including Writ Petition No. 1670/2010 before Honourable Peshawar High Court, Peshawar, which were allowed and consequently, vide order dated 12.02.2015 passed by Director General Health Services Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, the service

of the appellant was regularized with immediate effect. The appellant then submitted departmental appeal requesting therein that the period of his contract service with effect from 05.12.2008 to 11.02.2015 may be counted for service benefits, however the same was dismissed vide order dated 29.01.2019, hence the instant service appeal.

- 2. Notices were issued to the respondents, who submitted their comments, wherein they refuted the assertions raised by the appellant in his appeal.
- 3. Learned counsel for the appellant has addressed his arguments supporting the grounds agitated by the appellant in his service appeal. On the other hand, learned Additional Advocate General has controverted the arguments of learned counsel for the appellant and has supported the comments submitted by the respondents.
- 4. Arguments of learned counsel for the parties have already been heard and record perused.
- 5. A perusal of the record would show that the appellant was initially appointed as Monitoring Coordinator on contract basis vide appointment order dated 05.12.2008 and subsequently, his service was regularized with immediate effect vide order dated 12.02.2015 in pursuance of order/judgment dated 05.07.2012 passed by Honourable Peshawar High Court, Peshawar in Writ Petition No. 1670/2010. While going through the prayer of the appellant as made in the appeal, it can be observed that in essence the appellant is



seeking regularization of his services with effect from the date of his initial appointment i.e 05.12.2008. In support of his stance, appellant has placed reliance mainly on Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Appointment of GAVI, JICA, Adhoc and Contract Employees Act, 2016, which is misconceived for the reason that according to para-d of Section-2 of the ibid Act, the same was applicable to those employees of GAVI Project, who were appointed by the Government on contract basis during the period from the year 2012 to 30th June 2015. The appellant was appointed on contract basis in the year 2008 and his services were already regularized vide office order dated 12.02.2015, which was issued prior to enactment of the Appointment of GAVI, JICA, Adhoc and Contract Employees Act, 2016. The appellant thus could not claim any benefit on the basis of ibid Act. Even otherwise too, the period of contract service of the appellant could not be counted as regular service.

6. Consequently, the appeal in hand being devoid of any merit stands dismissed. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.

Respectfully Sheweth,

Brief but relevant facts of the case are as follows:

- 1. That the appellant was appointed as Monitoring Coordinator (BPS-16) in the GAVI Project under the respondent Department on contract basis by the competent authority in the prescribed manner after fulfilling all the codal edito-day formalities vide appointment order dated 05-12-2008. (Copy of the appointment order is filed herewith and attached as Annex-A)
 - 2. That the appellant was performing his duties against the aforesaid post to the entire satisfaction of his seniors. Meanwhile some of the colleagues of the appellant filed various Writ Petitions including Writ Petition No 1670/2010 before the Honorable Peshawar High Court, Peshawar, which was allowed.
 - 3. That consequently, the respondents regularized the service of the appellant but with immediate effect vide Office Order dated 12-02-2015. (Copy of the office order is filed herewith and annexed as **Annex-B**)
 - 4. That the Appellant approached the respondents by filling of Departmental Appeal for redress of his grievance i.e., considering his contract service from

05-12-2008 to 11-02-2015 for service benefits, which is dismissed vide impugned order dated 29-01-2019. (Copy of Departmental Appeal and Order is filed herewith and annexed as **Annex-C & D**)

5. That it is pertinent to mention here that the provincial government has promulgated Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Appointment of GAVI, JICA, Adhoc and Contract Employees Act, 2016, whereby the employees of projects namely GAVI, JICA and employees on adhoc and contract basis are regularized, wherein the services of the appellant squarely falls. The respondents have failed to implement the Act ibid in its letter and spirits.

Hence, the instant Service Appeal on the following amongst other grounds:

Grounds:

- a. That the impugned Notification of respondent Department is against the law, illegal, unlawful and without lawful authority.
- b. That the impugned Notification is against the provisions of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Appointment of GAVI, JICA, Adhoc and Contract Employees Act, 2016.
- c. That Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Appointment of GAVI, JICA, Adhoc and Contract Employees Act, 2016 is a regularization law whereby the service of the contract employees are regularized, the Act has not made *de novo* appointments or creating a new job on regular basis of contract employees. The Act ibid is promulgated for an uninterrupted continuation of the service of the previous contract employees till the completion of their normal tenure and making their employment status equal to their contemporaries appointed on regular basis and as such the respondents are duty bound to regularize the service of the Appellant with effect from initial date of appointment by issuing amended regularization Notification.
- d. That Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Appointment of GAVI, JICA, Adhoc and Contract Employees Act, 2016 is a beneficial legislation as it had regularized the services of all the contract employees falling in its ambit. The said Act has a deeming clause and has created a legal fiction by laying down that those who are appointed on contract basis shall be deemed to have been appointed on regular basis. It is a well settled principle of interpretation of statutes, that the interpretation of statute should be beneficial, and one which would advance the object of legislation, suppress the mischief and advance the remedy and not one which would lead to its frustration. The respondents are under legal obligation to implement the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Appointment of GAVI, JICA, Adhoc and Contract Employees Act, 2016 in its letter and spirits and issue revised regularization orders of the Appellant.

- e. That under the rule 2.3 of West Pakistan Civil Services Pension Rules, 1963, the service of the Appellant with effect from dates of appointment till date of regularization i.e., 05-12-2008 to 11-02-2015 shall be counted for pension or gratuity.
- f. That the treatment met to the Appellant is against the dictums of August Supreme Court of Pakistan and this Honorable Court.
- g. That the treatment met to the Appellant is not only based on discrimination but also the same is based on colorful exercise of powers which is not warranted under law.
- h. That the treatment met to the Appellant is not only against the principles of natural justice but also against the settled principles of administrative law.
- i. That the Appellant crave permission of this Honorable Tribunal to rely on other grounds at the time of arguments and produce any additional document if required in support of his Service Appeal.

It is, therefore, prayed that on acceptance of the title Service Appeal, the impugned office order dated 29-01-2019 may kindly be declared as unfair, illegal, unlawful and without lawful authority, the respondents may kindly be directed to count/consider the service of the appellant with effect from initial date of appointment till regularization i.e., 05-12-2008 to 11-02-2015 for the purpose of granting pension, graded pay, arears, seniority and other service benefits and respondents be directed to issue revise regularization office order of the appellant.

Any other relief, which has not been prayed for, deemed fit and appropriate by this Honorable Tribunal, in the circumstances of the service appeal, may graciously be granted.



- Propose the corrective measures to streamline the activities
- Assist different review of the project(mid term and end project review etc.)
- Any other duty assigned to him by the Deputy Director EPI from time to time.

- 1. He will be working under the direct supervision of Deputy Director EPI.
- 2. He will perform duties according to the above mentioned TORs.
- 3. His contract will stand cancelled on the completion of the project life on 30th June 2009.
- 4. He will neither be liable any pensionery benefits nor after service benefits after termination of this contract.

DOST MUHAMMAD KHAN, C.J.- As the petitioners have made representations before D.G. Health Services, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for the redressal of their grievance and for the same, the D.G. Health Services and the Secretary Health are not only competent but under legal obligation to comply with the statutory law and rules and also make use of the previous judgment of this Court on the issue and in any case if the petitioners are found entitled to the prayed relief then there should be no impediments in the way of regularization of their contractual services. However, the case of the petitioners should not be killed on the basis of mere technicalities and substantial justice be done to them. In the whole process, the petitioners or their representatives be given full participation and right of hearing. However, the same must be completed positively within thirty days. In this regard, strong assurance was given for early disposal of

representations within thirty days by the D.G. Health Services by Mr. Naveed Akhtar, learned Additional Advocate General. The Federal Government has supported the case of the petitioners because of the policy already formulated, approved and acted upon. Therefore, this may be taken seriously and not lightly.

This petition is disposed of in the above terms.
