ORDER

Syed Mansoor Ali Shah, J.-

C.Ps. 528-P/2019

This petition is barred by 18 days. The application for condonation of delay (C.M.A.No. 1160-P/2018) does not disclose sufficient cause for condonation of delay, hence dismissed. The main petition is, therefore, dismissed being barred by time.


C.Ps. 469-P/2019

2. The petitioner, present in person, states that after her reinstatement into service, she was entitled to be paid back benefits for the period during which she remained out of service, which is approximately three years. However, the said relief has been denied by the Tribunal in the impugned judgment. Mr. Babar Shahzad, the learned Additional Advocate General, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and seeks time to further prepare the case. Relist after two weeks.
