**PRAYER:**

On acceptance of this service appeal, the condition mentioned in the impugned order No. 3945-47/E Dated: 27/03/2019 of Respondents be rescinded, and the Appellant may be considered to have joined the service from the date, without conditions.

Any other relief, deemed fit in the given circumstances of the case may also be awarded in favor of appellant against respondents.

**Respectfully Sheweth:**

The appellant submits as under;

1. That the appellant was appointed in the police department on 08/07/1991, and is presently serving as Assistant Sub Inspector at Dir Lower.
2. That the appellant while serving as ASI in District Dir Lower Police after qualifying 25 years service due to some domestic affairs on written request was granted LPR with effect from 01/09/2016 vide Region Office, Swat Endst No. 7052-53/E, Dated: 24/08/2016.
3. That the appellant being a senior member of Police at Regional level, also on list "E" as name mentioned at S/No. 60 in the seniority list of ASIs during LPR Period was called with colleagues to attend meeting on 30/08/2016 vide Region Office, Swat 7246-62/E, Dated: 29/08/2016 in connection with promotion as officiating Sub Inspector for which the appellant was entitled under the rules vide Section Officer (Reg-VI), Government of

KPK, Establishment Department Regulation Wing letter No. SOR-VI/E&AD/1-6/2011, Dated: 17/03/2014, but name of the appellant was ignored from promotion as officiating Sub Inspector and subsequently applicant colleagues were promoted vide order Dated: 7674-90/E, Dated: 09/09/2016.

4. That on getting free from the domestic affairs the appellant submitted application Dated: 29/12/2016 under the rules vide Section Officer (RA-4), Government of Pakistan, Finance Division (Regulations Wing) Islamabad, letter No. F.1(1)R-4/2007-Vol-II(PI, Dated: 06/10/2016 later-on also notified by Section Officer (SR-II), Government of KPK, Finance Department vide letter No. FD(SOSR-II)/4-36/2016, Dated: 05/09/2018 for withdrawal of remaining portion of LPR and counting of period of 3 months and 28 days spent on LPR as Earned Leave with request to rejoin service again as routine, but request of the appellant was turned down vide Region Office, Swat Order/ Memo No. 2124/E, Dated: 28/02/2017.
5. That the appellant filed Service Appeal No. 507/2017 before Honorable Service Tribunal, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for rejoining the service again as routine and status quo was also issued on 11/08/2017 and earnestly allowed the appellant to re-join the service as routine, therefore the appellant submitted application Dated: 15/08/2017 duly forwarded by DPO Dir Lower vide his office Memo No. 25103/EC, Dated: 17/08/2017 accordingly in the light of judgment with the request to allow the appellant for Ex-Pakistan Leave to perform "Hajj", but the same was also

not considered vide Region Office order No. 5309/E, Dated: 07/09/2017, therefore the appellant also submitted application Dated: 12/07/2018 through TCS to worthy Regional Police Officer, Malakand, at Saidu Sharif Swat (Competent Authority) to permit the appellant to re-join service as routine in light of August Court judgment Dated: 05/07/2018, but was also turned down again.

6. That this Honorable Tribunal, while deciding the Service Appeal No. 507/2017 of the appellant, allowed the appellant to join the service as routine vide judgment Dated: 05/07/2018, therefore, in light of approval accorded by CPO Peshawar vide Memo: No. 839/Legal, Dated: 21/02/2019 the worthy Regional Police Officer, Malakand at Saidu Sharif Swat vide his office order No. 3945-47/E, Dated: 27/03/2019 allowed the appellant to rejoin service conditionally and provisionally with the directions to the appellant that he will not claim his seniority with colleagues and back benefits until / unless the decision of Honorable Supreme Court in the CPLA.
7. That the Appellant then preferred a Departmental Appeal against the impugned order No. 3945-47/E, Dated: 27/03/2019 on 09/07/2019, which has not yet been decided, hence the instant appeal is being filed against the impugned order inter alia on the following grounds. (Copy of Departmental Appeal along with all annexures including the impugned order Dated: 27/03/2019 is attached herewith as annexure "A").




## GROUNDS

- i) That the impugned order Dated: 27/03/2019 is illegal, unlawful and unconstitutional to the extent of the conditionality.
  - ii) That the impugned portion of the order Dated: 27/03/2019 is against Article 4, 25, 38 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973.
  - iii) That the appellant has not been dealt with in accordance with law and rules regulating service of the appellant.
  - iv) That the entire proceeding has been conducted in derogation of law and rules.
  - v) That other grounds not specifically raised will be argued with the permission of this Honorable Court at the time of arguments.
8. That this service appeal is being filed before this Honorable Tribunal, because the Respondents have not decided the departmental appeal of the appellant Dated: 09/07/2019 uptill now, hence this appeal is within time and this Honorable Tribunal has got the jurisdiction.


It is therefore humbly prayed that on acceptance of this service appeal, the condition mentioned in the impugned order No. 3945-47/E Dated: 27/03/2019 of Respondents be rescinded,

and the Appellant may be considered to have joined the service from the date, without conditions.

Any other remedy which is just, appropriate and efficacious may also be awarded in favor of the appellant, please.

Dear Sir,

In pursuance of Finance Division Government of Pakistan O.M No.F.1(1)R-4/2007-Vol-II(P1) dated 6.10.2015, the Competent Authority has been pleased to approve / adopt the Federal Government Policy with regard to the subject issue as envisaged in the O.M cited above which provides that a Government servant can withdraw option of voluntary retirement during the period for which encashment has been applied / granted subject to the following conditions:-

- i. He/She may withdraw his/her option of voluntary retirement before retirement matures;
- ii. It is binding on a government servant to return any amount of leave pay received by him/her, in lieu of encashment of LPR for that period;
- iii. Later on, on attaining the age of superannuation, if he / she again opts for 365 days leave encashment in lieu of 365 days LPR, such option of an individual may be treated as a fresh case and he / she will be allowed encashment of LPR in toto.

This supersedes Finance Department, letter No.SOSR-III/4-92/81 dated: 01.10.1981 and the cases already decided thereunder shall not be reopened / reconsidered.

Short facts relevant for disposal of the appeal in hand as narrated in the appeal are, that the appellant Bakht Naeem joined the Police Department as Constable and during this period, he got promotion to the rank of ASI. In the meanwhile, on completion of service of 25 years, he submitted an application on 14.07.2016 asking therein L.P.R and wished to avail the benefit of pension w.e.f. 01.09.2016 which was forwarded to the R.P.O Malakand Region. In short, it was allowed to the extent of 365 days L.P.R w.e.f 01.09.2016 but no formal order of his retirement was issued. After lapse of about 3 months, the appellant changed

his mind and wished to resume his duty. So he submitted a proper application to the authority on 29.12.2016. Once again it was forwarded to the competent authority i.e R.P.O Malakand but it was not entertained. So being aggrieved of the said order, the appellant approached this Tribunal, through the instant appeal.

Arguments heard and file perused.

Mr. Muhammad Javed Advocate, learned counsel for the appellant contended that before issuance of formal order of retirement, the appellant can withdraw his request for L.P.R and joined his duty as there was no bar on his resumption of duty during the period of LPR and in this respect he referred to a latest notification No. SOR-VI/E&AD/1-16/2011, dated 17.3.2014, issued by the (Provincial Government), (According to the said notification "LPR is one of the types of leave to which a government servant is entitled. As he continues to be government servant and can be called even for duty, he can, therefore, be considered for promotion a higher post during LPR.") At the end, he requested that on acceptance of this appeal, the appellant may be allowed to resume his remaining duty as regular employee. He placed reliance on 2011-PLC(C.S)546.

Mr. Muhammad Jan, Deputy District Attorney, assisted by Mr. Fazle Mabood, Inspector (Legal) rebutted the arguments of the learned counsel for the appellant and stated that once L.P.R is sanctioned in respect of an civil servant/appellant, it cannot be withdrawn and so he cannot be allowed to resume his remaining service as a regular employee. Lastly he requested this Tribunal to dismiss the appeal. He placed reliance on 2005-SCMR-1928.

With the assistance of the learned counsel for the parties, record was consulted which transpired that from bare reading of the notification dated 17.03.2014, mentioned above, three things become crystal clear which cannot be denied. Firstly, L.P.R is one of types of leave to which a government servant is

entitled. Secondly, the Government can call any government servant during L.P.R even for duty and thirdly, the government servant during period of L.P.R will be entitled for promotion against a higher post. So as per clarification given in the above mentioned notification, the appellant was on leave for all practical purposes and he can cancel his remaining leave and can join his service again.

When learned Deputy District Attorney was asked whether there was any bar on the appellant to revoke his previous request of LPR, he could not cited any law except the above mentioned judgment of the august Supreme Court of Pakistan. But on perusal of the said judgment, factual position was found different in the sense that in that very judgment while granting LPR to the government servant, order of retirement was issued at the same time, whereas in the case of present appellant, no formal order of retirement has yet been issued by the respondents. In the instant case, the judgment reported in 2011-PLC(C.S) 546 as referred to by the learned counsel for the appellant is relevant, wherein the government servant during LPR, even his retirement order was issued, but even then, the Punjab Service Tribunal was pleased to allow him to resume his duty. Even otherwise, when there is no express bar on a thing to be done, then it is presumed to permissible under the law.


The crux of the foregoing limited discussion is that after hearing the arguments of the learned counsel for the parties, consulted the record and taking guidance from the worthy rulings referred to above, and particularly the notification issued by the Provincial Government, this Tribunal reached to the conclusion that the appellant has still the right to move application for cancellation of his LPR and join his service as routine. As such, on acceptance of this appeal, the impugned order dated 28.02.2017 passed by respondent No. 2 is set aside and




