

dated 28.05.2013 whereby he was dismissed from service on the ground of absence from duty. The appellant has also challenged the order dated 03.07.2013 whereby the departmental appeal of the appellant was rejected.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant argued that the appellant remained absent for the reasons beyond his control, as his father died and his mother and wife were seriously ill. Further argued that the respondent department on one hand regularized the absence period of the appellant as leave without pay and on the other hand, vide the same order dated 28.05.2013 also awarded major vide the same order dated 28.05.2013 also awarded major benalty of dismissal from service for remaining absent. Hence due to regularization of the absence period, awarding of the punishment of dismissal from service on

the same ground of absence is illegal.

As against that learned AAG while opposing the present appeal argued that the appellant remained absent from duty without prior application and permission and the mass dismissed from service after the fulfillment of legal

was dismissed from service after the fulfillment of legal requirements.

5. Argument heard, File perused,

It is not disputed that vide the original impugned

Khy Ser 100 makhwa

order dated 28.05.2013 the competent authority has regularized the absence period of the appellant as leave without pay and also dismissed the appellant from service on the same ground of absence from duty. This Tribunal has held in a number of judgments that once the authority has treated the absence period as leave without pay, then the awarding of punishment of dismissal from service on the same ground of absence is not tenable in the eyes of law. Reliance in this regard is also placed on judgment of the august Supreme Court of Pakistan reported in (2006 SCMR 434).

Consequently the present appeal is accepted, the impugned orders are set aside and the appellant is reinstated in service. Intervening period shall be treated as leave of the kind due. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.
