2. On 10.04.2018, this Tribunal passed the judgment, accepting the appeal of the petitioner that the petitioner be placed at his due seniority. The petitioner filed this implementation application to seek implementation of the above judgment of the Tribunal. During the pendency of this implementation application the Secretary to Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Establishment Department submitted an implementation report which reads as under:-

“It is submitted that in light of the Service Tribunal Judgment dated 10.04.2018 passed in Service Appeal No. 877/2014 and the Supreme Court of Pakistan Judgment dated 26.02.2020, seniority of the appellant as Personal Assistant (BPS-16) was antedated. Subsequently to antedated seniority he was promoted to the post of Private Secretary (BPS-17). As far as seniority list dated 17.05.2021 produced before the Hon’ble Tribunal by the learned counsel of the appellant is concerned, the same is pertaining to the Private Secretaries (BS-17) on 31.05.2021, therefore, it was impossible to place a junior cadre official in the seniority list of BS-17 officers. Moreover, upon promotion as Private Secretary (BS-17) the appellant has retained his seniority over to his erstwhile junior and is on the top of the seniority list of BS-17 officers. His case for promotion to BS-18 was considered by the PSB on 31.07.2021 and deferred due to his probation period in BS-17 in terms of Section 6(2) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989 and Para-IV(f) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Promotion Policy. However, on successful completion of his one year probation period



w.e.f. 31.05.2021 the appellant will be promoted to the next scale as per ibid Act/Rules.”


3. The petitioner contends that in the seniority list of Personal Assistants (BPS-16) issued vide No. SOE-IV(E&AD)1-13/2021, dated 17.05.2021, his name did figure at the top whereas according to him his name should also be there in the final seniority list of Private Secretary BPS-17 notified vide Notification No. SOE-IV(E&AD)1-13/2021 on 17.05.2021. Annexure-B of the reply/implementation report is a copy of Notification of promotion notified on 31.05.2021 from Personal Assistants (BPS-16) to Private Secretary (BPS-17) on regular basis and name of the petitioner is on the top of the promotees. The notification requires that promotees should remain on probation for a period of one year in terms of Section 6(2) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973 read with Rule 15(1) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1989 and extendable for another year with the specific orders of appointing authority within two months of the expiry of first year of probation period as specified in Rule 15(2) of Rules ibid. The petitioner contended before the Tribunal that his name was also to be on the top of seniority list of 17.05.2021 of the Private Secretaries BPS-17. He further contends that in the meeting of PSB held on 31.07.2021 his case for further promotion to BPS-18 was considered but was deferred because of the reason that he had not yet completed probation period and also the prescribed length of service for promotion. Hence, the implementation report, reproduced above, clearly undertakes that on successful completion of one year probation period w.e.f. 31.05.2021, the petitioner would be promoted to the

next scale as per rules, therefore, in the light of the judgment of the Tribunal dated 10.04.2018 he has to regain original seniority once he is promoted to BS-18. As regard this petition, it is observed that it cannot further run in view of the above observations. The petitioner will be, however, at liberty to seek redressal of his grievance, if any, he feels after his promotion to BPS-18 but in accordance with law. Disposed of accordingly.

Arguments of the learned

counsel for the parties heard and record perused.

FACTS

2. The appellant was originally appointed as Steno typist in BPS-08 in the Directorate of Education, Peshawar on 06.10.1982. Later on he was promoted in BPS-15 on 29.12.1994 and was granted move-over to BPS-16 w.e.f. 01.12.1995. Then he was declared surplus on 03.09.2001 and was then adjusted in the Establishment Department on 06.08.2003 in BPS-12 under the surplus policy. A

seniority list was issued on 01.07.2006 in which the appellant was shown at the bottom of seniority list of BPS-12. The appellant then filed a representation on 12.08.2006 against this seniority list which was rejected on 09.05.2014 received by the appellant on 13.5.2014 and thereafter, he filed the present service appeal on 12.6.2014.

ARGUMENTS.


3. The learned counsel for the appellant argued that as per the surplus policy, the appellant was to be placed at the top of the seniority list of BPS-12 as he was serving in BPS-15 at that time. In this regard he relied upon judgment of this Tribunal dated 15.8.2016 in service appeal No. 831/2015 entitled "Muhammad Naveed Vs. Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa through Secretary Establishment & Administration Department, Peshawar and another" and another judgment dated 08.02.2018 in service appeal No. 340/2017 entitled "Noor Khan Vs. Director Food, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar and two others".

4. On the other hand, the learned District Attorney argued that the present service appeal was time barred as the representation was filed on 12.08.2006 and the appellant was bound to have approached this Tribunal within 120 days from the date of representation but he filed the present service appeal after eight years. He further argued that the surplus policy was amended in the year, 2006 and the appellant wants to take benefit of amendment introduced in 2006. That the appellant was adjusted in the year, 2003 and the amendment ^{could} ~~can~~ not be given retrospective effect.

CONCLUSION.

5. This Tribunal is first to decide the issue of limitation. The seniority list was issued on 01.07.2006 and the appellant filed representation on 12.08.2006. The

appellant either could have approached this Tribunal within 120 days from the date of filing of representation or he could have waited for the decision of the appellate authority and thereafter could have approached this Tribunal within 30 days. He opted for the second option and his service appeal is therefore, within time. So far as the retrospectivity of the amendment introduced in the year, 2006 is concerned, this Tribunal in its judgment in *Muhammad Naveed's* case referred to above had already decided this issue by holding that in the year, 2006 no amendment was made but only a clarification was issued which was to take effect from the date when the policy was issued.

6. In view of the judgment referred to above, the present appellant is also entitled for the seniority as per policy. His appeal is, therefore, accepted and it is ordered that he be placed at his due seniority as observed above. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.

TRIBUNAL ACT 1974, AGAINST OFFICE ORDER NO.
SOE-IV (E&AD)9(271/2012), DATED 09.5.2014
OF R. NO. 1 WHEREBY REPRESENTATION AGAINST
FINAL SENIORITY LIST DATED 01.07.2006 BY
PLACING APPELLANT AT IMPROPER POSITION WAS
REGRETTEED FOR NO LEGAL REASON.**

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Respectfully Sheweth:

Short facts giving rise to the present appeal are as under :-

1. That appellant was initially appointed as Steno Typist in NPS-8 on 6.10.1982 and was posted in Directorate of Education (Schools), Peshawar as such. Later on these posts were up-gradated as Junior Scale Stenographer (BPS-12) in July, 1983, however, on 29.12.1994, he was promoted to the post of Senior Scale Stenographer, BPS-15. On 27.11.1996, he was allowed Move Over to B-16 with effect from 1.12.1995. (Copies as Annex "A" "B" & "C" respectively).
2. That due to the Financial constraints over the Government, Departments, Federal & Provincial, restructuring / downsizing policy was launched known as "Policy for declaring Govt: Servants as Surplus and their subsequent Absorption / Adjustment", wherein in all most all the Departments, such policy was carried out by declaring the employees as surplus vide Letter dated 8th June, 2001. Appellant also became victim of the said policy. (Copy as Annex "D")

3. That on 03.9.2001, appellant along-with others was declared as surplus by the Director of Education Peshawar / Surplus Pool of Establishment Department. (Copy as Annex "E")
4. That on 06.8.2003, appellant was adjusted against the post of Junior Scale Stenographer (B-12) by the Establishment Department in Civil Secretariat, Home & Tribal Affairs Department. (Copy as Annex "F")
5. That in the Surplus Pool Policy dated 08.6.2001, for re-adjustment / absorption, some conditions have been laid down. In condition No.6 of the policy, regarding Fixation of Seniority, the criteria was as under :-
 - (a) In case a surplus employee could be adjusted in the respective cadre of his parent department, he shall regain his original seniority in that cadre.
 - (b) In case, however, he is adjusted in his respective cadre but in a Department other than his parent Department, he shall be placed at the bottom of seniority list of that cadre.
 - (c) In case of his adjustment against a post in a corresponding basic pay scale with different designation / nomenclature of the post, either in his parent department or in any other department, he will be placed at the bottom of seniority.
6. That on 15.2.2006, the Government of NWFP, Establishment & Admn: Deptt: (Regulation Wing) Peshawar introduced amendments in Surplus Pool Policy, in which clause (d) was inserted as under :-
 - (d) "In case of adjustment against a post lower than his original scale, he shall be placed at the top of seniority list of that cadre, so as to save him from being rendered surplus again & becoming junior to his juniors". (Copy as Annex "G")
7. That on 01.07.2006, final Seniority List of Stenographer B-12 of Civil Secretariat KP was notified by on R.No.1.wherein appellant was placed at Serial No.161 instead of 19, over and above the name of Usman Ghani. (Copy as Annex "H")

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8. That on 23.8.2006, appellant submitted representation before the authority to deal him as per the Surplus Pool Policy and to place him on proper position in the seniority list which was regretted on 09.05.2014 which copy was received by appellant on 13.05.2014. (Copy as Annex "I" & "J")

Hence this appeal, inter alia, on the following grounds:-

GROUNDS:

- a. That as is evident from the date of appointment to the post of Junior Scale Stenographer B-12 of appellant viz-z-viz respondent he was appointed to the said grade in July, 1983 while the contesting respondents were in the said grade on 05.01.1988 and so on.
- b. That as per the amendments made in the surplus policy vide letter dated 15.02.2006, appellant regained his seniority position and he should have been placed at serial No.19 over and above the name of Usman Ghani and other respondents.
- c. That the representation of appellant was turned down without support of any cogent reason which order is neither legal nor speaking one, so is liable to interference by this Hon'ble Tribunal.
- d. That appellant was put to great loss as numerous respondents being most juniors, were promoted to the next higher grade/post of Personal Assistants, B-16.
- e. That at the time of declaring appellant as surplus, he was serving in the Directorate of Education as Senior Scale Stenographer BPS-15 w.e.f 09.01.1994 and was granted move-over to BPS-16 on 27.11.1996 w.e.f 01.12.1995.
- f. That by keeping in view the aforesaid position, service career of appellant spread over decades was ruined and he was made junior to most juniors for no legal reason.

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- g. That the authority miserably failed to appreciate the surplus policy as well as service record of appellant viz-a-viz respondents, so such action was based on ulterior motive.
- h. That order of rejection is neither supported by reason nor a speaking one, so is liable to set aside. The same is based on malafide..

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of the appeal, the Impugned order dated 09.05.2014 and impugned Seniority List dated 01.07.2006 of the respondents to be set aside and the name of appellant be placed at Serial No.19, over and above the name of Usman Ghani etc: In the impugned Seniority List as well as subsequent seniority lists, appellant be placed on proper position as stated above, with such other relief as may be deemed proper and just in circumstances of the case.

Most respectfully I beg to submit the following few lines for your kind & sympathetic consideration and it is beseech to benevolently refer to the Judgment / order dated 10.04.2018 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar passed in Appeal No. 877/2014 (Certified copies attached for ready reference-Flag-A). The detailed history of my appeal is that I was adjusted against a post of Junior Scale Stenographer (B-12) by the Establishment Department in Civil Secretariat & posted in Home & Tribal Affairs Deptt: vide Order No.SOE.IV(E&AD)1-10/2003 dated 6.8.2003 (Flag-B). Prior to my adjustment here, I was a regular employee of Education Department & working as Senior Scale Stenographer (BPS-15) w.e.from 29.12.1994 (Flag-C). Unluckily, due to re-organization of Edu: Department, I along-with some other employees, was rendered surplus and later on adjusted here as Stenographer (B-12) with pay protection, but my name was placed at the bottom of seniority list of Junior Scale Stenographers (B-12) of the Civil Secretariat, Peshawar (Flag - B - para-4).

Cherished Sir / Madam,

2. At that time, I was the only one effected employee / Senior Scale Stenographer (B-15) in KPK: who was adjusted in such like manner & placed at the bottom of seniority list of Junior Scale Stenographers (B-12) & deprived of such like **kismet**. I was crooked down to the bottom of Junior Scale Stenographer (BPS-12) & placed at **Sr. No.168** of seniority list of Stenos (B-12) issued on 1st December, 2005, merely due to the reason that I was declared Surplus and afterward adjusted in Civil Secretariat **and** for no superfluous fault / blunder or penalty at my part which greatly harmed & injured me at every aspect.
3. No doubt my pay was protected but such like adjustment caused a great losses to me because in spite of **35 years & 6 months service at my credit** (w.e.f. 5.10.1982 e.g. date of my appointment), I am still at the bottom of seniority list of PAs BPS-16 and placed below the name of **Mr. Redi Khan, PA (B-16) who was appointed on 17.04.2000 as Stenographer (BPS-12) in Establishment Deptt: while I was working as Steno (BPS-12) from the month of July 1983, even so he has been confirmed senior to me.**
4. It is therefore, very humbly & earnestly prayed that keeping in view my genuine request, my legitimate future career, promotion prospects & length of service, the


5. As indicated in Tentative Seniority List of Senior Scale Stenographers (BPS-15) of Civil Secretariat as stood on 31.12.2005, serial No.62 and Final Seniority List of Senior Scale Stenographers (BPS-15) as stood on 1st July, 2006, S.No.53 (Flags-D & E), the last Stenographer (B-12), who was promoted to Senior Scale Stenographer (BS-15) prior to my adjustment (i.e. August, 2003), was Mr.Khalid Pervez, S.No.53, promoted on 28.04.2001 whereas all the remaining Stenographers i.e. Mr.Raees Ahmad, S.No.54, Mr. Noor Hussain, S.No.55, Mr. Muhammad Hayat, S.No.56, Mr.Sajjad Ahmad Jan, S.No.63 and likewise, a number of other Stenos were working in BPS-12 at that time. 6. As I was adjusted in Establishment Department in August, 2003, hence I justify for placing my name below & after the name of Mr. Khalid Parvez, S.No.53 of the above mentioned seniority list and fixing my seniority / name, over & above the names of Mr.Raees Ahmad, S.No.54, Mr.Noor Hussain, S.No.55, Mr. Muhammad Hayat, S.No.56 Mr.Sajjad Ahmad Jan, S.No.63 and similarly a number of other Senior Scale Stenographers (B-15), whose were promoted afterwards in the above mentioned seniority list on 31.05.2004, 13.01.2005 & 30.5.2006, as such they were promoted to Senior Scale Stenographer (BPS-15) after the date of my adjustment i.e. August, 2003.

It is further requested that my supplementary seniorities' positions may also be fixed & carried out in accordance with the said sequence, string, chain & succession please.

ORDER

Gulzar Ahmed, ACJ Learned Additional Advocate

General, has contended that in the first place, the service appeal of the respondent was time-barred in that it was filed almost after 8 years of filing of his departmental appeal, which according to the learned AAG was rejected on 04.01.2007. He further contends that respondent admittedly being in the surplus pool and was subsequently adjusted in the Establishment Department in BS-12 could not have been given seniority for the very Policy for adjustment of surplus employee which provides that if an employee is adjusted in the parent Department he will be given inter se seniority to which he would be entitled. However, if he is adjusted in another department the seniority will be on the bottom

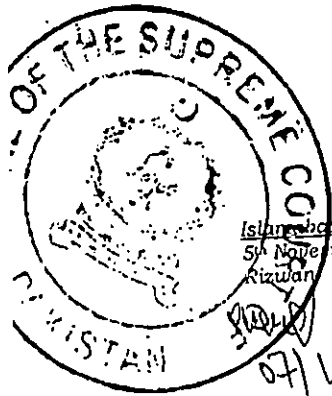

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of the seniority list. He contends that such aspect of the matter was not considered by the Service Tribunal while granting relief to the respondent. Points raised need consideration. Leave to appeal is granted to consider, *inter alia*, the same. The appeal shall be heard on the available record but the parties are allowed to file additional documents within a period of one month. As the matter relates to service, the office is directed to fix the same expeditiously preferably immediately after three months.



Respectfully Sheweth:

It is submitted that in light of the Service Tribunal Judgment dated 10.04.2018 passed in Service Appeal No. 877/2014 and the Supreme Court of Pakistan Judgment dated 26.02.2020, seniority of the appellant as Personal Assistant (BPS-16) was antedated (F/A). Subsequent to antedated seniority he was promoted to the post of Private Secretary (BS-17) (F/B). As far as seniority list dated 17.05.2021 produced before the Hon'ble Tribunal by the learned counsel of the appellant is concerned, the same is pertaining to the Private Secretaries (BS-17) (F/C). Since the petitioner was promoted to the post of Private Secretary (BS-17) on 31.05.2021, therefore, it was impossible to place a junior cadre official in the seniority list of BS-17 officers. Moreover, upon promotion as Private Secretary (BS-17) the appellant has retained his seniority over to his erstwhile junior and is on the top of the seniority list of BS-17 officers. His case for promotion to BS-18 was considered by the PSB on 31.07.2021 and deferred (F/D) due to his probation period in BS-17 in terms of Sections-6(2) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989 and Para-IV (f) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Promotion Policy (F/E & F/F). However, on successful completion of his one year probation period w.e.f 31.05.2021 the appellant will be promoted to the next scale as per ibid Act/Rules.

Foregoing in view, this department submits that orders passed in the Judgments of the Service Tribunal and the Supreme Court of Pakistan have been implemented.

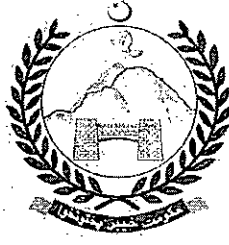

- (d) "Initial appointment" means appointment made otherwise than by promotion or transfer;
 - (e) "Pay" means the amount drawn monthly by a civil servant as pay, and includes special pay, personal pay and any other emoluments declared by the prescribed authority to be paid ;
 - (f) "Permanent post" means a post sanctioned without limit of times;
 - (g) "Prescribed" means prescribed by rules;
 - (h) "Province "means the North West Frontier Province;
 - (i) "rules" means rules made or deemed to have been made under this Act ;
 - (j) "Selection authority" means the North-West Frontier Province Public Service Commission, a departmental selection board, departmental selection committee or other authority or body on the recommendations of, or in consultation with which any appointment or promotion, as may be prescribed, is made;
 - (k) "temporary post" means a post other than a permanent post.
- (2) For the purpose of this Act, an appointment, whether by promotion or otherwise, shall be deemed to have been made on regular basis if it is made in the prescribed manner.

CHAPTER-II

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE OF CIVIL SERVANTS

3. **Terms and Conditions:-** The terms and conditions of service of a civil servant shall be as provided in this Act and the rules.

4. **Tenure of office of civil servants:-** Every civil servant shall hold office during the pleasure of the Governor.

5. **Appointment:-** Appointment to a civil service of the Province or to a civil post in connection with the affairs of the Province shall be made in the prescribed manner by the Governor or by a person authorized by the Governor in that behalf.

6. **Probation:-** (1) An initial appointment to a service or post referred to in section 5, not being an ad hoc appointment, shall be on probation as may be prescribed.

(2) Any appointment of a civil servant by promotion or transfer to a service or post may also be made on probation as may be prescribed.

(3) Where, in respect of any service or post, the satisfactory completion of probation includes the passing of a prescribed examination, test or course or successful completion of any training, a person appointed on probation to such service or post who,

before the expiry of the original or extended period of his probation, has failed to pass such examination or test or to successfully complete course or the training shall, except as may be prescribed otherwise-

- (a) if he was appointed to such service or post by initial recruitment, be discharged; or
- (b) if he was appointed to such service or post by promotion or transfer, be reverted to the service or post from which he was promoted or transferred and against which he holds a lien or, if there be no such service or post, be discharged:

Provided that in the case of initial appointment to a service or post, a civil servant shall not be deemed to have completed his period of probation satisfactorily until his character and antecedents have been verified as satisfactory in the opinion of the appointing authority.

7. Confirmation :- (1) A person appointed on probation shall, on satisfactory completion of his probation, be eligible for confirmation in a service or, as the case may be, a post as may be prescribed.

(2) A civil servant promoted to a post ²[] on regular basis shall be eligible for confirmation after rendering satisfactory service for the period prescribed for confirmation therein.

(3) There shall be no confirmation against any temporary post.

(4) A civil servant who, during the period of his service, was eligible to be confirmed in any service or against any post retires from service before being confirmed shall not, merely by reason of such retirement, be refused confirmation in such service or post or any benefits accruing there-from.

(5) Confirmation of a civil servant in a service or post shall take effect from the date of occurrence of permanent vacancy in that service or post or from the date of continuous officiation, in such service or post, whichever is later.

8. Seniority:- (1) For proper administration of a service, cadre or ³[post], the appointing authority shall cause a seniority list of the members for the time being of such service, cadre or ⁴[post] to be prepared, but nothing herein contained shall be construed to confer any vested right to a particular seniority in such service, cadre or ⁵[post] as the case may be.

(2) Subject to the provisions of sub-section (1), the seniority of a civil servant shall be reckoned in relation to other civil servants belonging to the same service or ⁶[cadre] whether serving the same department or office or not, as may be prescribed.

PART-IV

AD HOC APPOINTMENT

13. **Requisition to Commission:-**When under any rule for the time being in force, a post is required to be filled in through the Commission, the appointing authority shall forward a requisition on the prescribed form to the Commission immediately after it is decided to fill in the post, or if that is not practicable and the post is filled on ad hoc basis as provided in rule 14, within two months of the filling of the post.

14. **Ad hoc Appointment:-**(1) When the appointing authority considers it to be in the public interest to fill in a post falling within the purview of the Commission urgently, it may, pending nomination of a candidate by the Commission, proceed to fill in such post on ad hoc basis for a period not exceeding ³⁹[one year] by advertising the same in accordance with the procedure laid down for initial appointment in Part-III of these rules.

(2) Short term vacancies in the posts falling within the purview of the Commission and vacancies occurring as a result of creation of temporary posts for a period not exceeding ⁴⁰[one year], may be filled in by appointing authority otherwise than through the Commission on a purely temporary basis after advertising the vacancy.

PART-V

PROBATION AND CONFIRMATION

⁴¹**15. Probation.** ----- (1) Persons appointed to posts by initial recruitment, promotion or transfer shall be on probation for a period of one year.

(2) On the successful completion of probation period, prescribed in sub-rule (1), the appointing authority may extend the probation for another year by specific order within two months of the expiry of first year of probation period.

(3) In case no specific order of extension of probation period under sub-rule (2), is issued on the expiry of one year within two months, the probation shall stand automatically terminated

(4) In case of extension of probation period, through specific order for another year, under sub-rule (2), the probation shall stand automatically terminated on the completion of extended period."

(k) ⁵⁰ All kinds of exemptions from mandatory training on the basis of age are hereby withdrawn w.e.f 31.10.2016 viz (a) Mid Carrere Management Course (MCMC) (b) Senior Management Course (SMC) (c) National Management Course (NMC) (d) National Defense Course (NDC) to ensure merit based promotion in the best public interest. However, the exemption extended already to professional and technical cadres will continue as the professionals/technocrats undertake their specialized training separately.

IV. Promotion of officers who are on deputation, long leave, foreign training:

- a) The civil servants who are on long leave i.e. one year or more, whether within or outside Pakistan, may be considered for promotion on their return from leave after earning one calendar PER. ⁵¹The requirement of earning one calendar year report will start from the date the officer joins back and the training period will also be included for completion of the requirement of such PER. Their seniority shall, however, remain intact.
- b) The civil servants, who are on deputation abroad or working with international agencies within Pakistan or abroad, will be asked to return before their cases come up for consideration. If they fail to return, they will not be considered for promotion. They will be considered for promotion after earning one calendar PER and their seniority shall remain intact.
- c) ⁵²In case of projects partially or fully funded by the Federal or Provincial Government, where PERs are written by officers of Provincial Government, the condition of earning one calendar PER shall not be applicable. The officers on deputation to projects shall be considered for promotion. However, after promotion they will have to actualize their promotion within their cadre.
- d) The civil servants on deputation to Federal Government, Provincial Government, autonomous/semi-autonomous organization shall be considered for promotion and informed to actualize their promotion within their cadres. They shall have to stay and not be allowed to go back immediately after promotion. Such stay shall be not less than a minimum of two years. If he/she declines his/her actual promotion will take place only when he/she returns to his/her parent cadre. His/her seniority in the higher post shall, however, stand protected.
- dd) ⁵³If a civil servant is nominated by the Provincial Government for higher studies or training abroad, and his turn for promotion arrives in his parent department or cadre in Pakistan, he should be considered for promotion along with other officers, and if he is approved for promotion in accordance with the relevant rules, he should be appointed formally (not actually) to the post in the higher grade. This would

enable him to occupy on his return to Pakistan the position which he would have occupied had he not gone abroad on training. No financial benefit of the next below rule should be allowed to him in respect of his promotion. He should be allowed to count seniority and increment from the date of such promotion, but the actual pay of the higher post should be given to him only when he resumes the duties of higher post on his return from training.

e) The cases of promotion of civil servants who have not successfully completed the prescribed mandatory training (MCMC, SMC & NMC) or have not passed the departmental examination for reasons beyond control, shall be deferred.

f) Promotion of officers still on probation after their promotion in their existing Basic Scales shall not be considered.

g) A civil servant initially appointed to a post in a Government Department but retaining lien in a department shall not be considered for promotion in his parent department. However, in case he returns to parent department, he would be considered for promotion only after he earns PER for one calendar year.

h) A civil servant who has resigned shall not be considered for promotion no matter the resignation has yet to be accepted.

i) ⁵⁴The mere fact that the seniority is sub-judiced will not debar the competent forum to make recommendation. However, in such cases following shall be applicable:

- i. All promotion based on sub-judice seniority will be conditional i.e. subject to final outcome of Court cases.
- ii. An officer who gets his seniority restored and becomes senior to already promoted officers in the cadre will be considered for promotion by the relevant board from the date when his junior got promoted.
- iii. In case, the officer expires or retires from service and subsequently, his seniority is restored his case will be considered for proforma promotion alongwith all financial benefits.
- iv. Juniors promoted on sub-judice seniority list will be assigned seniority as per final Court Orders and will be reverted in case there is no vacancy.

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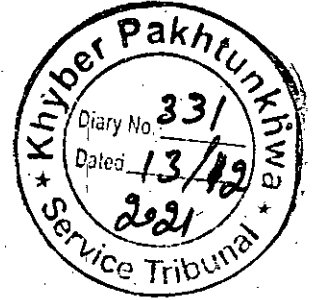

**REAPPLICATION TO THE IMPLEMENTATION
REPORT SUBMITTED BY THE RESPONDENT.**

Respectfully Sheweth,

1. That the captioned case is pending adjudication before this Hon'ble Tribunal which is fixed for 14.12.2021.
2. That this Hon'ble Tribunal has pleased to passed order judgment dated 10.04.2018 in Service Appeal No.877/2014, in view of the judgment dated 15.08.2016 in SA No. 831/2005 titled "Muhammad Naveed Vs Govt of KPK, wherein it was held;
"According to the notification dated 08.06.2001 issued by Establishment and Administration Department of the provincial government policy for declaring government servants as supless and their subsequent absorption/adjustment was laid down which

②

was further amended vide circular letter dated 15.02.2006 wherein the following sub-para (d) added to para-(6) of the original policy issued vide notification dated 08.06.2001."

"Sub para-(d) added to para (6)

- (d) In case of adjustment against a post lower than his original scale, he shall be placed at the top of seniority list of that cadre, so as to save him from being rendered surplus again and becoming junior to his juniors.

"A careful perusal of para-6 of the policy letter dated 08.06.2001 would suggest that in case of adjustment of a surplus employee against a post in corresponding basic pay scale with different designation/nomenclature of the post, was to be placed at the bottom, of the seniority. It is nowhere mentioned in the said circular that an employee is to be placed at the bottom of the seniority list even if he is adjusted against a post lower than his original scale. The subsequent circular dated 15.02.2006 is in fact a clarification of the policy earlier issued by the provincial government vide letter dated 08.06.2001 within object to remove the anomaly and as such the appellant can not be deprived of his right to claim seniority position at the top of the seniority list of the cadre in which he was adjusted against a post lower than his original scale. It is not worthy that an employee otherwise junior to appellant but if adjusted against a lower post after the amended policy letter dated 15.02.2006 at the top of seniority list would rank senior to

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appellant. Therefore depriving the appellant from seniority may ^{not} ~~that~~ be in accordance with mandate of service structure/laws. We therefore hold that the appellant was entitled to be placed at the top of seniority list at the relevant time after the clarification of policy as he was adjusted against a post lower than his original scale. The appeal is accepted in the above terms".

3. That against the order judgment dated 10.04.2018 CPLA was filed which was dismissed vide order dated 26.02.2020.
4. That now, during the proceeding of the implementation of the judgment dated 10.04.2018, on the previous date implementation report was submitted by the respondent which needs reapplication which as under:-

REAPPLICATION:

1. As per judgment dated 10.04.2018, the petitioner is entitled to placed on the top of (above the name of Raees Ahmad) in the seniority list issued on 20.02.2003 where in the name of the petitioner was omitted (considered him on its bottom). (Copy of seniority list is attached as annexure "A").
2. After promoting 22 stenographer to, BPS-15 vide order dated 18.02.2004, seniority list vide notification dated 01.07.2006 was issued wherein the petitioner was placed on S# 161 (Copy of seniority list is attached as annexure "B").

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3. That later on the proceedings of promotion was divided into two categories i.e. one as promotion to the Private Secretaries (BPS-17) and the other, on the basis of option promotion to Section Officer (BPS-17).
 4. That the promotion to the post of Private Secretaries were made vide Notifications dated 13.01.2012, 28.05.2013, 23.06.2014, 26.02.2015, 28.01.2016, 22.12.2016, 20.10.2017, 22.01.2019, 08.11.2019, 22.01.2021, wherein, all the juniors from the appellant / petitioner were promoted to BPS-17. (copies of the same are Annexed-*c*).
 5. That promotion of Section Officers, who opted for the same were issued, vide Notification dated 18.11.2015, 27.05.2016, 02.09.2016, November, 2017, 18.05.2018, 16.01.2019, 09.05.2019, 06.08.2021, who were junior to the appellant / petitioner. (copies of the same are Annexed -*D*).
 6. That with the implementation report 02 seniority lists of the even date i.e. 17.05.2021 were produced by the Respondent, wherein the name of the appellant / petitioner were omitted from the one and place on the top of the other.
 7. That astonishingly promotion notification dated 31.05.2021 of the petitioner was produced as Flag-B and Item No. 09 regarding case for promotion to BPS-18 as Flag-D, wherein, it is clear that Mr. Habib Ahmad Shakir and Mr. Rehmat Ullah are junior to the Petitioner whose promotion has been

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shown since 2012 and 2013 respectively and promotion of the petitioner has been shown on 31.05.2021, it mean that the promotion of the petitioner / appellant was made on the basis of that wrong seniority list, wherein the petitioner was placed at the bottom.

8. That further stated that: -

- (i) No reasonable antedated seniority of appellant as Personal Assistant (BS-16) was issued. In fact, Final Seniority list of Personal Assistants (BPS-16) of Civil Secretariat, Peshawar was issued on 20.02.2020 on the basis of previous seniority list, wherein the name of appellant stood at Sr.No.11. Amongst this seniority, three Nos. of PAs (B-16) namely Mr.Rahid Ullah Sr.No.1, Mr.Sajjad Qaiser S.No.2 and Mr. Naveed Khan S.No.3 were promoted to the posts of Private Secretary (BPS-17) on regular basis on 22.01.2021 and one Mr.Lal Bahadur Khan, PA (B-16) retired from service w.e.from 21.3.2020. Thus due to the promotion of 3 PAs & the retirement of one PA (B-16), four PAs (B-16) were quieted from the said seniority list. Hence the name of appellant automatically stood at S.No.07 of that seniority list. Meanwhile, 07 posts of Private Secretary (B-17) were lying vacant, thus it was necessary to promote 07 PAs (B-16) to the posts of P.S (B-17) alongwith appellant. So the respondent thought a plan to misguide the Hon'ble Service Tribunal, so

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they issued, malafidely, another seniority list on 17.5.2021. In the said seniority list, they placed the name of appellant at Sr.No.1. The responded else named these alterations as antedated seniority list. If the changed seniority list was not issued excessively due to some reasons and the appellant was not brought to Sr.No.1 & kept at S.No.07 consequently, it was compulsorily binding to promote him to the post of Private Secretary (B-17) on 31.5.2021 on his turn basis according to the wrong seniority list as all the required criteria for his promotion was completed.

The case of appellant was filed in the Hon'ble Service Tribunal with the prayer to place his name at proper place of seniority list of 2003 and 2006 and not from 17.05.2021, which was allowed. (copy of s/list Annaldas E)

- (ii) Final seniority list of Private Secretaries (BS-17) was issued on 17.5.2021, on the basis of which 09 PS (B-17) were promoted to posts of Senior Private Secretaries (BS-18). While, another seniority list of the said candidates, issued on the same date was presented to the court, wherein the name of appellant was shown at Sr.No.1. It is astonishing to say that the appellant was promoted to PS on 31.5.2021, while his name was included in the seniority list of PS(B-17) on 17.5.2021 e.g. 15 days before his promotion. Is it possible to issue two seniority lists on same date? If it

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was correct, then how two PS, junior to appellant were formerly promoted.

- (iii) No doubt my promotion was deferred due to probation period in BS-17, but in fact, it is worth seeing that the candidate at Sr.No.7 (Khalid Parvez) senior to me was appointed on 30.6.1985 and promoted to the post of Private Secretary BS-17 on 13.01.2012. As such the candidate at S.No.09 Habib Ahmad Shakir (junior to me) was appointed on 18.6.1985 and promoted to the post of Private Secretary BS-17 on 13.01.2012 and also the candidate at Sr.No.10 Mr.Rehmat Ullah junior to the appellant was appointed on 15.6.1985 and promoted to the post of Private Secretary BS-17 on 28.05.2013. All of these 03 candidates (1 senior and 2 junior to me) have completed prescribed length of service for promotion because their seniority was fixed in right position. However, the appellant (Khan Muhammad at Sr.No.8 of the same list) was the only one candidate who was appointed on 05.10.1982, but his length of service was less than the prescribed limit. In this connection, it is prayed that if the seniority of appellant was corrected at due time & place from beginning or after the decision of Service Tribunal in 2018, he would have surely completed the prescribed length of service in time.

(iv) In the judgment dated 10.04.2018 of this Hon'ble Tribunal reference was made to the judgment in Mr. Muhammad Naveed's case, wherein it was held "as such the appellant cannot be deprived of his right to claim senior position at the top of the seniority list of the cadre in which he was adjusted against a post lower than his original scale. It is noteworthy that an employee otherwise junior to the appellant but if adjusted against a lower post after the amended policy letter dated 15.02.2006 at the top of seniority list would rank senior to appellant. Therefore depriving the appellant from seniority may not be in accordance with mandate of service structure/laws. We therefore hold that the appellant was entitled to be placed at the top of seniority list at the relevant time after the clarification of policy as he was adjusted against a post lower than his original scale. The appeal is accepted in the above terms".

9. That the implementation report submitted by the Respondent is not according to spirit of Judgment of this Hon'ble Tribunal and amounts to deprive the appellant from his legal right and promotion of the appellant to the post of Private Secretary (BS-17) is made merely on the basis of date of his adjustment against the post of Steno BPS-12 on 8/2003 and also on the basis of wrong seniority list of Stenographer (BS-12) at the bottom at Sr.No.161, issued in the year 2005-6.

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Thus no implementation of orders passed in the above mentioned judgments, was carried out.

10. That identical case 26 persons were promoted from BPS-16 to BPS-17 with retrospective effect i.e. 19.03.2013 vide judgement in Writ Petition No. 4692/2018, dated 07.10.2020. Petitioner is also entitled for the same. (copy of the same is Annexed-).

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that the Respondent may be directed to produce Implementation Report according to the spirit of the judgment of this Hon'ble Tribunal.

It is further prayed that the Petitioner may be placed at the seniority list of Section Officer (BS-17) with due date, who opted for the same.
