APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 FOR PAY FIXATION FROM BPS 12 TO BPS 14 AND THEN TO BPS 15 AND AGAINST THE INACTION OF THE RESPONDENTS BY NOT DECIDING THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT WITHIN THE STATUTORY PERIOD OF NINETY DAYS

PRAYER:

That on acceptance of this appeal the respondent may kindly be directed to fixed pay of the appellant from BPS-12 to BPS-14 and then to BPS-15 instead of from BPS-12 to BPS-15 with all back benefits. Any other remedy which this august Service Tribunal deems fit that may also be awarded in favor of the appellant.

R/SHEWETH:

ON FACTS:

Brief facts giving rise to the present appeal are as under:

1- That the appellant was the employee of the respondent Department and has served the respondent Department as PST (BPS-12) for a quite considerable period quite efficiently and upto the entire satisfaction of her superiors.

2- That vide notification dated 08.02.2013 the appellant was promoted to the post of Senior Primary School teacher (BPS-14) on the basis of seniority cum fitness and on the proper recommendation of departmental promotion committee. Copy of

- 3- That latter on the appellant was further allowed promotion to the post of Primary School Head teacher (BPS-15) on the proper recommendation of departmental promotion committee vide Notification dated 21.02.2013. That astonishingly the respondent No.4 fixed the pay of appellant from BPS-12 to BPS-15 instead of from BPS-12 to BPS-14 and then to BPS-15. Copies of the notification dated 21.02.2013 and service book are attached as annexure **B and C.**
- 4- That due to the above mention malafide and arbitrary action of the respondents the appellant has received great financial loss by decreasing her pay instead of increasing. That it is pertinent to mention here that one employee of the respondent department namely Alam khan has also filed service appeal No.97/2016 on the same footing but during the pendency of the said service appeal the respondents redressed the grievance of the above mentioned employee through order dated 18.4.2016. Copies of the pay slip, service appeal and order dated 18.4.2016 are attached as annexure **D, E and F.**
- 5- That appellant feeling aggrieved, preferred departmental appeal but no response has been given by the department till date. Copy of departmental appeal is attached as annexure..... **G.**
- 6- That appellant, having no other remedy, prefer the instant appeal on the following grounds amongst the others.

GROUND:

- A- That the inaction of the respondents by not fixing the of the appellant from BPS-12 to 14 and then to 15 is against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and materials on the record.
- B- That appellant has not been treated in accordance with law and rules by the respondent Department on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- C- That the respondents acted in arbitrary and mala fide manner while fixing the pay of the appellant from bps 12 to bps 15 directly instead of from bps 12 to bps 14 and then to bps 15.
- D- That no notice has been issued to the appellant before fixation of his pay from BPS-12 to BPS-15.

- E- That no chance of personal hearing/defense has been provided to the appellant and as such the respondents violated the principle of audi altrem partum.
- F- That according Article 38(e) of the Constitution of Pakistan, 1973 state is bound to reduce disparity in the income and earning of the individuals including persons in the various classes of the service of Pakistan.
- G- That appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.

- 2- That vide Notification dated 9.2.2013 the appellant was promoted to the post of Senior Primary School Teacher (BPS-14) on seniority cum fitness basis and on the proper recommendation of Departmental promotion committee. That in response the appellant submitted his charge report and started performing his duty with utmost satisfaction of

his superiors. **Copy of the service book is already attached as annexure A.**

- 3- That later on the appellant was promoted to the post of Certified teacher (BPS-15) on the recommendation of departmental promotion committee vide Notification dated 27.7.2015. That astonishingly the respondent No.3 fixed the pay of the appellant from BPS-12 to BPS-15 instead of from BPS-14 to BPS-15. Copies of the promotion Notification and pay slip are attached as annexure **B and C.**
- 4- That due to the above mentioned action of the respondents the appellant has receive great financial loss by decreasing his pay instead of increasing. That appellant feeling aggrieved filed Departmental appeal but no reply has been received so far. Copies of the Departmental appeal and letter are attached as annexure **D and E.**
- 5- That appellant having no other remedy filed the instant appeal on the following grounds amongst the others.

GROUND:

- D- That no notice has been issued to the appellant before fixation of his pay from BPs-12 to BPS-15.
- E- That no chance of personal hearing/ defense has been given to the appellant and as such the respondents violated the principle of Audi Altrem Partum.
- F- That according to Article 38(e) of the Constitution of Pakistan 1973 the state is bound to reduce disparity in the income and earnings of individuals including persons in the various classes of the service of Pakistan but in this case the respondents totally violated Article 38(e) of the Constitution of Pakistan 1973.
