


Mr. Noor Muhammad Khattak, Advocate for the appellant present. Preliminary arguments heard.

In continuation of order sheet dated 22.11.2021 as well as order sheet dated 28.09.2022, learned counsel for the appellant further argued the case on the question of void order and maintainability of the instant service appeal before the Service Tribunal. In support of his arguments, he relied on 1985 SCMR 1178, 1996 SCMR 856, PLD 2002 Supreme Court 101 & 2007 SCMR 262.
