



**APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE IMPUGNED APPELLATE ORDER DATED 31.01.2023 AND AGAINST THE SUBSEQUENT ORDER DATED 21.02.2023 WHEREBY THE TRANSFER ORDER DATED 21.01.2023 HAS BEEN CANCELLED.**

**PRAYERS:**

That on acceptance of this appeal the impugned appellate order dated 31.01.2023 and subsequent order dated 21.02.2023 may very kindly be set aside and the respondents may be directed not to transfer the appellant from GGMS Kandaro. Any other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit, may also be awarded in favor of the appellant.

**R/SHEWETH:**

**ON FACTS:**

Brief facts giving rise to the present appeal are as under:-

- 1- That appellant is the employee of the respondent Department and was appointed as DM (BPS-15) vide order dated 31.12.2018 and in pursuance to which the appellant took over the charge of her post and since then appellant is performing her duty with full zeal & zest. Copies of the appointment order and charge report are attached as annexure ..... **A&B.**

- 2- That it is pertinent to mention here that the post of the appellant was non-transferable post, however relaxation in ban was allowed in favour of the appellant along with other teachers of the District Swabi by the Ministry concerned and in pursuance to which the order dated 21.01.2023 was issued whereby the appellant was transferred from GGMS Aladher to GGMS Kandaro and the private respondent No. 5 was transferred from GGHS Kandaro to GGHS Maneri Bala. Copy of the order dated 21.01.2023 is attached as annexure.....C.
- 3- That in compliance to the transfer order dated 21.01.2023 the appellant took over the charge of her post at GGMS Kandaro on 23.01.2023. Copy of the charge report is attached as annexure ..... D.
- 4- That it is important to mention here that private respondent No. 4 was transferred from GGHS Lahor Shari to GGHS Maneri Bala vide order dated 12.01.2023, however, the said order was withdrawn vide order dated 16.01.2023 and on 21.01.2023 the post at GGHS Maneri was vacant. Copy of the order dated 16.01.2023 is attached as annexure..... E.
- 5- That private respondent No. 4 assailed the order dated 16.01.2023 before the appellate authority and the appellate authority while accepting the departmental appeal through appellate order dated 31.01.2023 had set aside the order dated 16.01.2023 and in pursuance to which the transferred order dated 21.01.2023 was cancelled to the extent of appellant and the private respondent No. 5 by disturbing position of the both. Copies of the appellate order dated 31.01.2023 and subsequent order dated 21.02.2023 are attached as annexure ..... F&G.
- 6- That the order dated 31.01.2023 being appellate order and having no other remedy but to file the instant appeal on the following grounds amongst the others.

**GROUND:**

- A- That the impugned appellate order dated 31.01.2023 and the subsequent order dated 21.02.2023 whereby the transfer order dated 21.01.2023 has been cancelled are against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and materials on the record hence not tenable and is liable to be set aside.
- B- That appellant has not been treated by the respondent Department in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.

- C-** That the respondents acted in arbitrary and mala fide manner by issuing impugned appellate order dated 31.01.2023 and the subsequent order dated 21.02.2023 whereby the transfer order dated 21.01.2023 has been cancelled to the extent of appellant and private respondent No. 5 by disturbing both of them.
- D-** That the impugned appellate order dated 31.01.2023 and the subsequent order dated 21.02.2023 whereby the transfer order dated 21.01.2023 has been cancelled to the extent of appellant and private respondent No. 5 is prematurely issued by the respondents as the appellant has not yet completed her normal tenure on the post in question which is against clause-IV of the Posting Transfer Policy of 2009. Copy of the Policy is attached as annexure ..... **H.**
- E-** That impugned appellate order dated 31.01.2023 and the subsequent order dated 21.02.2023 whereby the transfer order dated 21.01.2023 has been cancelled to the extent of appellant and private respondent No. 5 is no issued in the best public interest and thus is against the transfer posting policy.
- F-** That appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.



**POSTING / TRANSFER POLICY OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT**

- i) All the posting/transfers shall be strictly in public interest and shall not be abused/misused to victimize the Government servants
- ii) All Government servants are prohibited to exert political, Administrative or any other pressures upon the posting/transfer authorities for seeking posing/transfers of their choice and against the public interest.
- iii) All contract Government employees appointed against specific posts, can not be posted against any other post.
- iv) The normal tenure of posting shall be three years subject to the condition that for the officers/officials posted in unattractive areas the tenure shall be two years and for the hard areas the tenure shall be one year. The unattractive and hard areas will be notified by the Government.
- v) While making postings/transfer from settled areas to FATA and vice-versa, specific approval of Governor, NWFP needs to be obtained
- vi) While making postings/transfers of officers/officials up to BS-17, from settled areas to FATA and vice-versa approval of the Chief Secretary NWFP needs to be obtained. Whereas, in case of posting/transfer of officers in BS-18 and above, from settled areas to FATA and vice-versa, specific approval of the Governor NWFP shall be obtained.
- vi (a) All Officers/officials selected against Zone-I/FATA quota in the Provincial Services should compulsorily serve in FATA for at least eighteen months in each grade. This should start from senior most scales/grades downwards in each scale/grade of each cadre.
- vii) Officers may be posted on executive/administrative posts in the Districts of their domicile except District Coordination Officers (D.C.Os) and DPOs/Superintendent of Police (SP). Similarly Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) shall not be posted at a place where the Police Station (Thaana) of his area/residence is situated.
- viii) No posting/transfers of the officer's/officials on detailment basis shall be made.
- ix) Regarding the posting of husband/wife, both in Provincial services, efforts where possible would be made to post such persons at one station subject to the public interest.
- x) All the posting/transferring authorities may facilitate the posting/transfer of the unmarried female government Servants at the station of the residence of their parents.

xiii) While considering posting/transfer proposals all the concerned authorities shall keep in mind the following:

- a) To ensure the posting of proper persons on proper posts, the Performance Evaluation Report/annual confidential reports, past and present record of service, performance on post held presently and in the past and general reputation with focus on the integrity of the concerned officers/officials be considered.
- b) Tenure on present post shall also be taken into consideration and the posting/transfers shall be in the best public interest.

xiv) Government-servants including District Govt. employees feeling aggrieved due to the orders of posting/transfer authorities may seek remedy from the next higher authority / the appointing authority as the case may be through an appeal to be submitted within seven days of the receipt of such orders. Such appeal shall be disposed of within fifteen days. The option of appeal against posting/ transfer orders could be exercised only in the following cases.

- i) Pre-mature posing/transfer or posting transfer in violation of the provisions of this policy.
- ii) Serious and grave personal (humanitarian) grounds.

2. To streamline the postings/transfers in the District Government and to remove any irritant/confusions in this regard the provision of Rule 25 of the North West Frontier Province District Government Rules of Business 2001 read with schedule - IV thereof is referred. As per schedule-IV the posting/transferring authorities for the officers/officials shown against each are as under:-

1.	Posting of District Coordination Officer and Executive District Officer in a District.	Provincial Government.
2.	Posting of District Police Officer.	Provincial Government
3.	Other Officers in BPS-17 and above posted in the District.	Provincial Government

3. As per Rule 25(2) of the Rules mentioned above the District Coordination Department shall consult the Government if it is proposed to:

- a) Transfer the holder of a tenure post before the completion of his tenure or extend the period of his tenure.
- b) Require an-officer to hold charge of more than one post for a period exceeding two months.

4. I am further directed to request that the above noted policy may be strictly observed /implemented.

All concerned are requested to ensure that tenures of the concerned officers/officials are invariably mentioned in summaries submitted to the Competent Authorities for Posting/Transfer.
