JUDGMENTHAMID FAROOQ DURRANI, CHAIRMAN:-

1. The appellant is aggrieved of order dated 19.06.2018, passed by respondent No. 3, whereby she was posted/adjusted as PST at Government Girls Primary School, Bab-e-Qadeem with immediate effect. She is also aggrieved of order dated 19.08.2019, passed by District Education Officer (F) Nowshera. In the order the leave of appellant for 69 days has been considered against full pay, whereas 6129 days have been declared as E.O. Leave without pay.
2. Arguments of learned counsel heard and available record gone through.
3. The appellant had earlier submitted Service Appeal No. 1298/2012 which was decided on 16.02.2018. Through the decision, this Tribunal had remitted the case of appellant to the appellate authority with the



direction to examine the case and decide her departmental appeal with speaking order. The order dated 19.06.2018 was issued by respondent No. 3 in compliance with the decision of this Tribunal.

In the departmental representation/appeal submitted on 15.07.2019, it was stated by the appellant that in the year 2001 she shifted to Sargodah due to family feud and returned back in the year 2010. She preferred an application for her adjustment/posting which was not considered and, on 19.06.2018, she was adjusted in pursuance to the decision of her appeal by this Tribunal.

4. It is a matter of record that during the long period of 17 years the appellant was not proceeded against departmentally and her service was not dispensed with. It is also an admitted fact that the appellant was not performing her duty from the year 2001 up till 19.06.2018. She was posted/adjusted at GGPS Bab-e-Qadeem and the period during which she stayed away from duty on account of personal reasons, was counted towards leave, both earned as well as extraordinary. The impugned order, also in view of admissions through the contents of departmental appeal, submitted by the appellant on 15.07.2019, are not exceptionable.

5. The appeal in hand is, therefore, found meritless for admission to regular hearing, hence is dismissed in limine.



**SERVICE APPEAL U/S 4 OF SERVICE
TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST
IMPUGNED ORDER DATED 19.08.2019.**

PRAYER

***On acceptance of the instant appeal,
the impugned order dated
19.08.2019 be set-aside and grant/
extended the back benefits in shape
of arrears, salaries and all other***

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dues due to the appellant including her seniority, without any further delay, reason and justification.

Respectfully Sheweth:-

Appellant humbly submits as under:-

- 1) That initially the appellant filed a Service Appeal No.1298/2012 (brief mentioned therein), before this hon'ble Tribunal in respect of release of salaries alongwith adjustment against the post of PST, which was disposed-off vide order dated 16.02.2018. (Copy of memo of appeal and judgment dated 16.02.2018 are Annex "A")
- 2) That in compliance, the respondent No.3 vide his office order dated 19.06.2018, readjusted/ posted the appellant in GGPS Babi Qadeem with immediate effect. (Copy of letter dated 19.06.2018 is Annex "B")
- 3) That the appellant was deprived from her due service benefits/ back benefits including seniority, thus applied through proper channel by filing a departmental appeal on 15.07.2019, which was processed and disposed-off vide impugned order dated 19.08.2019 and the same was communicated to the appellant on her own struggle on 28.08.2019. (Copy of departmental appeal and impugned order dated 19.08.2019 are Annex "C")
- 4) That being aggrieved of the impugned order, the appellant approaches this Hon'ble Tribunal on the following grounds:-

GROUNDS

- A. Because the impugned order dated 19.08.2019 passed by respondent No.1 is patently illegal, unlawful, without lawful authority, against the facts and circumstances of the case, hence liable to be set-aside and the respondents may kindly be directed to act in accordance with law and to release all the due outstanding back benefits to the appellant by proper calculating the same, without any further delay, reason and justification.
- B. Because the withholding of the due benefits accrued to the appellant since 2001, by which the appellant has not only been deprived from her monthly salaries, but even also deprived from other service benefits including her seniority etc.
- C. Because the respondent/ department is bound down under the law to abide the law, rules and regulations and not to victimize the appellant being lady, but in the present case, the impugned order is passed for nothing, but just to kept the appellant in circle.
- D. Because there is / was no any inquiry whatsoever been pending nor the absence from duty is hereby established on the part of appellant, thus the withholding of salaries and depriving the appellant from her due financial right is amounts of abuse of law.
- E. Because there is no termination order for the alleged period, thus the appellant regularly performed her duties from the year 2001 to 2018.

F. That any other ground, which has not specifically been mentioned may also be permitted to raise at the of hearing.

It is therefore, humbly prayed, on acceptance of the instant appeal, impugned order dated 19.08.2019 be set-aside and grant/ extended the back benefits in shape of arrears, salaries and all other dues due to the appellant including her seniority, without any further delay, reason and justification.

Any other relief which this hon'ble Tribunal deems appropriate in the circumstances of the case though not specifically asked for may kindly also be granted.

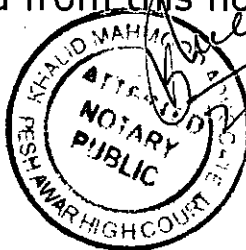

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RESPECTFULLY SUBMITTED:

1. That the appellant was initially appointed as Primary School Teacher by the District Education Officer Nowshera vide order dated 16.04.1995. (Copy of the order dated is attached as Annexure A)
2. That the appellant after medical examination was found fit and thereafter she was handed over the charge of her Post and she started performing her duties. (Copy of the Medical Certificate and charge report and pay slips are attached as Annexure B, C & D)
3. That ever since her appointment the appellant performed her duties as assigned to her with zeal and devotions and there was no complaint whatsoever regarding her performance. (Copies of the attendance register are attached as Annexure D)
4. That while serving in the said capacity, the appellant due to family dispute had to shift to Sargodha along with her family she duly informed the department and also applied for 2 years earned leave (Copy of application is attached as Annexure E).
5. That it is pertinent to mention that the appellant was neither proceeded against nor she was ever served with any charge sheet / show cause notice or any absence notice was ever served upon her.
6. That thereafter when the situation normalized the appellant came back to join her duty, however she was not allowed to join. The department also illegally withheld the monthly salary of the appellant.
7. That the appellant throughout agitated the matter of grant of monthly salary and for her adjustment, however no positive response was given.

8. That as a last resort the appellant submitted her departmental appeal dated 30.7.2012. The departmental appeal was not replied despite the lapse of 90 days. (Copy of the departmental appeal is attached as Annexure F)
9. That the non-grant of salary and non adjustment of the appellant is illegal, unlawful, and discriminatory, in violation of rules inter alia on the following grounds.

Grounds of Appeal:

- A. That the Appellant has not been treated in accordance with law, she has been denied her right to life/livelihood, which is violation of article 4 read with article 9 of the constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973.
- B. That the order of appointment is issued by the competent authority, the appellant has took over the charge of her post and started performing duties, thus valuable rights have been created in her favour the same cannot be snatched or with held. Hence the respondents are under obligation to release the salary to the appellant and her adjustment.
- C. That while withholding the pay of the appellant no right of hearing has been provided to her and thus virtually the appellant is condemned unheard.
- D. That appellant has never been proceeded against nor she was ever served with any charge sheet / show cause notice or any absence notice was ever served upon her. She was never terminated from service thus is entitled to the monthly salary w-e-f 15.07.2001 and her adjustment.
- E. That withholding of salary amount to punishment, albeit with out holding any enquiry or proceeding against the appellant the salary of the appellant is withheld which is unlawful.


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F. That since the appellant has not been terminated from service and is performing his duties hence on no excuse her salary could be withheld or denied.

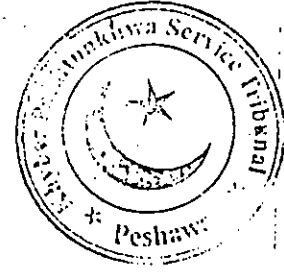

JUDGMENT

GUL ZEB KHAN, MEMBER. The aforesaid appeal dated 28.11.2012 has been lodged by Ms Robeena Begum hereinafter referred to as the appellant, under Section-4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act 1974, against non-payment of salary and non adjustment. The appellant preferred departmental appeal on 30.7.2012, which was not responded.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant argued that the appellant was initially appointed as PST by the District Education Officer Nowshera vide order dated 16.04.1995. That due to some family dispute the appellant shifted to Sargodha alongwith family and informed the department accordingly. That simultaneously the appellant also applied for 2 years earned leave. That on return for duty, the

appellant has neither been adjusted for duty nor paid her monthly salary. That the appellant was neither proceeded against nor even served with any charge sheet / show cause notice. That neither any absence notice was ever served. That the appellant was never terminated from service, thus she is fully entitled for adjustment posting and payment of regular monthly salary.

4. On the other hand learned Deputy District Attorney while opposing the present appeal stated that the appellant quit her service in the year 2003 and submitted departmental appeal on 30.07.2012 for her adjustment and starting of her monthly salary, hence the present appeal is devoid of any substance.

5. We have heard arguments of the learned counsel for the appellant and the learned DDA for the respondents and have gone through the case file.

6. Nothing is found on the record that the departmental appeal of the appellant has been examined by the respondent department as on record there is no order of the appellate authority. In the present case the respondent department has also not filed comments. In the stated circumstances this Tribunal is of the considered view to remit the case of appellant to the appellate authority with the direction to examine the case of the appellant and to decide her appeal with speaking order within a period of three (03) months of the receipt of this judgment. The present appeal is disposed of accordingly. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.
