HIDOMENT.

appeal has been directed against the impugned notification dated 06.12.2019 by virtue of which appellant has been transferred and posted from GPS Shinwari Naryab to GPS Shams-ud-Din, Hangu, outside his Union Council in contravention of the Khyber

Pakhtunkhwa Appointment, Deputation, Posting and Transfer of Teachers Regulatory Act, 2011.

- 2. According to the averments, appellant is serving in the Education Department as SPST (Male) in BPS-14 at Government Primary School Shinwari Naryab, District Hangu, and being promoted from SPST (Male) BPS-14 to PSHT (BPS-15) in consequence of which he has been transferred to GPS Shams-ud-Din Hangu which is contrary to the law on the subject. He filed departmental appeal/representation before the District Education Officer (Male) Hangu, but with no response, necessitating the institution of present appeal.
- 3. Respondents were summoned, in compliance thereof they attended the Services Tribunal through their representative besides being represented by Mr. Muhammad Jan, learned Deputy District Attorney, contesting the appeal by submitting reply/comments wherein they have assailed it on a number of legal and factual objections, inter-alia, petitioner has no locus standi, approaching this Tribunal not with clean hands and petitioner cannot be allowed to the place of his own choice.
- 4. We have heard arguments of the learned counsel representing appellant and also the learned Deputy District Attorney and were able to go through the record on file with their assistance.

- 5. According to the learned counsel appellant has been posted and transferred outside the territorial limits of his Union Council despite the fact that there are four vacant posts at the Union Council. Appellant is still a PTC Teacher and according to Section 3 (3) of the Act a PTC Teacher has to be transferred to fill in the vacant position while referring to para-3 of comments furnished by respondents, he submitted that for a PTC Teacher no grade has been determined.
- 6. The learned counsel for private respondent No. 5 while making reference to the impugned notification dated 06.12.2019 submitted that appellant has been promoted from SPST (BPS-14) to PSHT (BPS-15) thus his transfer was legally justified. That no civil servant can remain posted at a station indefinitely which is illegal.
- 7. On the contrary, the learned Deputy District Attorney submitted that when a Primary School Teacher is promoted as Head Teacher he can be posted anywhere in the territorial limits of district. While referring to the impugned order, he submitted that it was issued solely in the public interest, the promotion order has been actualized. He referred to Sub-section 3 of Section 3 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Appointment, Deputation, Posting and Transfer of Teachers Regulatory Act, 2011. He submitted that appellant had executed an agreement with the respondents that

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on promotion he can be posted anywhere in the territorial limits of district.

It is admitted on record that the appellant acted as Senior Primary School Teacher (Male) in BPS (14) at Government Primary School Shinwari Naryab, District Hangu, by virtue of notification dated 06.12.2019, he has been promoted from Senior Primary School Teacher (BPS-14) to Primary School Head Teacher (BPS-15) and posted to GPS Shams-ud-Din Hangu falling outside the territorial limits of the Union Council where appellant was posted. It has been categorically provided by sub-section (3) of section 3 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Appointment, Deputation, Posting and Transfer of Teachers Regulatory Act, 2011, the primary school teacher shall be transferred to other school within the Union Council on completion of tenure as may be prescribed which is subject to policy of rationalization for maintaining certain students teachers ratio. There is nothing on record to show any thing in black and white with respect to rationalization at the very school or any other school falling within the territorial limits of the Union Council where appellant is rendering his duties. Appellant is still a Primary School Teacher and his cadre as such has not changed obviously he is still rendering duties as a Primary School Teacher, therefore, under the law in vogue he should have been posted to any school falling within the respective Union Council especially when there were vacant posts available in that Union Council, therefore, the impugned order dated 06.12.2019

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sustainable to the extent of appellant and is liable to be rescinded to that extent. As regard the concurrence and execution of agreement on the part of appellant, in this regard an agreement made in contravention of the Government Policy or the law is void and no sanctity can be attached to it to be sacrosanct as a civil servant cannot be precluded to approach the Service Tribunal when his respective rights are infringed.

9. For what has been discussed in the foregoing paras, we accept the instant appeal by setting aside the impugned order dated 06.12.2019 to the extent of appellant, simultaneously directing respondents to make an order for the posting/transfer of appellant within the territorial limits of his respective Union Council of course subject to the policy of rationalization. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record

Counsel for the appellant present. Preliminary arguments heard and case file perused. The appellant was serving as SPST (Male) BPS-14 at GPS Shinwari Naryab, District Hangu. That the appellant along with others colleagues were promoted to the post of PSHT (BPS-15) vide notification dated 06.12.2019. That on promotion the appellant was transferred from GPS Shinwari Naryab, District Hangu to GPS Shams Ud Din, Hangu vide impugned notification dated 06.12.2019 against which he filed departmental appeal which was not responded within the stipulated period of ninety days, hence the instant service appeal. It was further argued and contended that under Section 3(3) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Appointment, Deputation, Posting and Transfer of Teachers, Lecturers, Instructors and Doctors) Regulatory Act, 2011 PST/PSHT are posted within the Union Council whereas despite ayailable posts in radian of his Union Council, he has been ignored and teachers serial No.4 and 5 of the impugned notification adjusted/posted in his Union Council. Learned counsel for the appellant contended that the appellant has not been treated according to law and rules.

Points urged need consideration. Service appeal is admitted subject to all legal objections. Appellant is directed to deposit security and process fee within 10 days, thereafter, notices be issued to the respondents for written reply/comments for

Respectfully Sheweth:-

- 1. That the appellant has been serving in the department as SPST (Male) BPS-14 and posted at Govt: Primary School Shinwari Naryab District Hangu.
- 2. That the appellant being senior alongwith other has been promoted from SPST (Male) BPs-14 to PSHT BPS-15 vide notification dated 06/12/2019. (Copy of notification is attached as annexure "A").
- 3. That by the said promotion, the appellant has been transferred to GPS Shams Ud Din Hangu from GPS Shinwari Naryab Hangu, which is against the KP

- (Appointment, Posting & Transfer of Teacher Regularity Act, 2011).
 - 4. That appellant feeling aggrieved form the said transfer and posting order filed his representation before respondent No 1 on 09/12/2019, but still has no response. (Copy of representation is attached as annexure "B").
 - 5. That the appellant feeling further aggrieved from the posting and transfer order through notification dated 06/12/2019 is fling the instant appeal inter alia on the following grounds:-

Grounds:-

- A. That the impugned notification to the extent of posting and transfer of the appellant is illegal, unlawful and against the KPK (Appointment, Deputation, Posting and Transfer of Teachers Regularity Act, 2011) hence liable to be modified. (Copy of Regularity Act, 2011 is attached as annexure "C")
- B. That according to the Section 3 sub Section 3 of the KPK (Appointment, Deputation, Posting and Transfer of Teachers Regularity Act, 2011) the Primary School Teachers shall be transferred to other schools within the union council.
- C. That the appellant is at Serial No 3 of the seniority among other teachers, moreover, in the Union Council of appellant

i.e. Naryab-II, 4 stations of PSHT BPS-15 was vacant during the said posting and transfer order and according to above rules the appellant being senior most in his Union Council based school was deserved to be appointed in nearest station i.e. GPS Soor Chaper Hangu, but the respondent No 1 without following the relevant rules and merit policy made posting and transfers of the teachers and the appellant was transferred and posted at GPS Shams Ud Din Hangu which falls under the Union Council Darband Hangu.

- D. That the appellant is HCV + patient since long as well as his left leg has been broken having steel rad inside it, which was occurred in the year, 2017 as a result of road accident due to which the appellant cannot walk for long distance i.e. 3/4 KM as no routine transport is available there on this score too the appellant is entitled to be posted and transferred in the nearest station i.e. GPS Soor Chaper in Union Council Naryab-II District to which the appellant belongs. (Copy of medical certificate is attached as annexure "D").
- E. That above posting and transfer of teachers by respondent No 1 have been made on nepotism and favoritism just to adjust the blue eyed on their favorite stations and ignored the merit policy/KPK Regularity Act, 2011.

That the appellant has treated unequally against the law and has been deprived of equal protection of law.

That any other grounds will be raised at the time of G. with kind permission of this Honourable arguments Tribunal

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of this Service Appeal, the impugned Notification dated 06/12/2019 to the extent of posting and transfer of the appellant may kindly be modified and the appellant may kindly be transferred from GPS Shams Ud Din Union Council Darband Hangu and posted at his Union Council Naryab-II in GPS Soor Chapper Hangu according to the Regularity Act, 2011.

Any other remedy which deems fit by this Honourable Tribunal may also be granted in favour of appellant.



AN ACT

to regulate by law appointments, postings and transfers of teachers serving in primary, middle, secondary and higher secondary schools, lecturers in colleges and instructors in technical institutions and doctors in health facilities.

<u>Preamble.---</u>WHEREAS it is expedient to regulate by law appointments, postings and transfers at local level, of teachers serving in primary, middle, secondary and higher secondary schools, lecturers in colleges and instructors in technical institutions and doctors in health facilities and to ensure the availability of teachers in schools, lecturers in colleges and instructors in technical institutions and the doctors in health facilities, and to regulate deputation of doctors abroad, and to provide for matters connected therewith or ancillary thereto;


It is hereby enacted as follows:

- 1. <u>Short title, application and commencement.</u>——(1) This Act may be called the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Appointment, Deputation, Posting and Transfer of Teachers, Lecturers, Instructors and Doctors) Regulatory Act, 2011.
- (2) It shall apply to teachers serving in primary, middle, secondary and higher secondary schools, lecturers in colleges as well as commerce colleges and instructors serving in technical institutions and doctors serving in the health facilities in the Province of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
 - (3) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. <u>Definitions.</u>—(1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them that is to say,—
 - (a) "Commission" means the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission;





- (b) "doctor" means a doctor serving in the health facility;
- (c) "Government" means the Government of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa;
- (d) "health facilities" mean all health facilities established and managed by the Government to provide medical facilities to general public;
- (e) "lecturer" and "instructor" respectively means a lecturer or an instructor serving in a Technical Institution as the case may be;
- (f) "prescribed" means prescribed by rules made under this Act;
- (g) "rules" mean the rules made under this Act;
- (h) "school" means school in the public sector including primary, middle, secondary school, higher secondary school or an institution of equivalent level imparting education through any system or medium of instruction in the public sector;
- (i) "teacher" means a teacher of primary, middle, secondary or higher secondary school; and
- (j) "technical institution" means and includes a Commerce College or Government College of Management Sciences or Technical Institute or Technical and Vocational Training Center or Skill Development Center in the public sector imparting technical education to students leading to the award of a degree or a diploma or a certificate.
- (2) Words and phrases used in this Act, but not defined, shall have the same meanings as respectively assigned to them under the relevant federal law or provincial law or any other statutory order or rules for the time being in force.
- 3. Appointment, posting and transfer of primary school teachers.——(1) The vacancy of primary school teacher shall be filled in from the candidates belonging to the Union Council of their permanent residence mentioned in their Computerized National Identity Card and domicile, on merit and if no eligible candidate in that Union Council is available where the school is situate, such appointment shall be made on merit from amongst eligible candidates belonging to the adjacent Union Councils:






Provided that on availability of a vacancy, a primary school teacher, appointed from adjacent Union Council, as referred to in this sub-section, shall be transferred against a vacant post in a school of the Union Council of his residence within a period of fifteen days.

- (2) Upon marriage, the primary school teacher on request may be transferred to the school in the Union Council, where his spouse, ordinarily resides, subject to the availability of vacancy.
- (3) The primary school teacher shall be transferred to other school within the Union Council on completion of tenure as may be prescribed subject to the policy of rationalization for maintaining certain student teachers ratio, if any.
- (4) Government shall, within a period not exceeding one year of the commencement of this Act, make arrangement for posting of all the primary school teachers appointed prior to coming into force of this Act, to the schools of their respective Union Councils or adjacent Union Councils, as the case may be.
- 4. Appointment of doctors, lecturers, instructors, subject specialists and teachers on adhoc basis.——(1) Government may, through the competent authorities make adhoc appointment on merit against the vacant posts of doctors, lecturers, instructors, subject specialists and teachers, falling within the purview of Commission, in a district concerned from the domicile holders of that district for a period of one year or till the arrival of recommendees of Commission, whichever is earlier after fulfilling the pre-requisites of giving wide publicity in the press. On assumption of charge of post by recommendee of the Commission, the services of such ad hoc appointee shall stand automatically terminated:

Provided that if no suitable and eligible candidate is available in the district concerned for appointment, then the candidates belonging to the neighbouring districts shall be considered for appointment in the order of their merit.

- (2) Save as the appointment made under proviso of this section, "ad hoc appointee" shall serve in the district of his domicile.
- (3) The post of a doctor, lecturer, instructor, subject specialist or secondary school teacher who proceeds on training or long leave may be treated as vacant post for the purpose of contract or contingent appointment till the return of such employee from training or long leave and assumption of charge of the post:

Provided that the period of such training or long leave shall not be less than one year and no appointment on contract or contingent shall be made on the post which may fall vacant for a period less than one year.





- 5. <u>Initial posting.</u>—(1) The doctors, the teachers and the lecturers and instructors upon their appointment shall be first posted in the periphery of the zone against whose quota they have been recruited, and they shall not be transferred for a period of at least three years.
- (2) Upon expiry of the tenure as referred to in sub-section (1), transfer shall be made only upon the availability of substitute.
- 6. <u>Deputation of Doctors.</u>—(1) Government may allow deputation abroad for all categories of doctors only once in their entire service, for a period not exceeding three years.
- (2) Deputation to "Foreign Service" within Pakistan shall be permissible only in respect of medical officers for a period not exceeding three years:

Provided that no further extension, on expiry of agreed tenure shall be given to the doctors who are already on deputation abroad or within Pakistan.

- 7. Postgraduate Medical Education.—(1) The Health Department, on the basis of objective need assessment and analysis, shall determine the intake number of Trainee Medical Officers (TMOs) in Postgraduate Medical Institute (PGMI) and Junior Registrars in Tertiary Care Hospitals every year. This stipulated number shall not exceed in any case.
- (2) Any doctor selected or permitted for postgraduate medical training shall be treated on leave without pay and may be entitled only for stipend fixed by Government from time to time for such training.
- (3) A doctor selected or permitted for postgraduate medical training shall provide surety bond prescribed by Government ensuring that upon completion of his studies for which he was initially selected, shall compulsorily serve for three years in the district of his domicile and in case of non-availability of a post in the district of domicile, he shall serve for three years in the rural area.
- (4) For the purpose of sub-section (3), the doctor shall also provide guarantee of two government officers.
- (5) In case of violation of sub-section (3), Government shall serve one month notice upon the doctor for resumption of duty, failing which the amount shall be recovered from him or from the guarantor, as the case may be.
- 8. <u>Provisions relating to doctors apply to lecturers and instructors.</u>—The provisions relating to doctors in section 7 of this Act shall *mutatis mutandis* apply to lecturers and instructors.

- 9. <u>Act to over-ride other laws.</u>—The provisions of this Act shall have effect notwithstanding anything contained in any other law for the time being in force.

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

- 5. Para No.5 is incorrect. The act of the respondent is lawful, correct and according to the policy and not against the (APT Regularity Act 2011).

GROUNDS.

- A. Para A is incorrect, the act of the respondent is lawful as per policy of promotion. All are equal in the eyes of law.
- B. Para No. B is false, according to the section 3. Sub: section 3 states that the primary school teacher BPS-12 to other school within U/Council. But the instant case is not related to PST (BPS-12). The same is the promotion from SPST(B-14) to PSHT(B-15) which can be made any where in the District as per policy as already stated in Para No.3.

- C. Para C is incorrect, all the SPST(B-14) have been extended equal facility as per policy. All are equal in the eyes of law. No discrimination has been made by the respondent department. As detail stated in Para B. The instant case not related to appointment in BPS-12 but is of promotion from SPST BPS-14 to PSHT BPS-15. The case clearly false in promotion/Posting not in appointment /Transfer.
 - D. Incorrect. The appellant has been treated as per law and policy.
 - E. Para D is incorrect. No nepotism/favoritism has been made. Further added all the SPSTs seeking promotion to the PSHT Posts have submitted as judicial stamp paper that in result of this Promotion, the appellant will not approach to the Honorable Service Tribunal. (Copy Attached).

- (3) The post of a doctor, lecturer, instructor, subject specialist or secondary school teacher who proceeds on training or long leave may be treated as vacant post for the purpose of contract or contingent appointment till the return of such employee from training or long leave and assumption of charge of the post:

Provided that the period of such training or long leave shall not be less than one year and no appointment on contract or contingent shall be made on the post which may fall vacant for a period less than one year.


- 5. <u>Initial posting.</u>—(1) The doctors, the teachers and the lecturers and instructors upon their appointment shall be first posted in the periphery of the zone against whose quota they have been recruited, and they shall not be transferred for a period of at least three years.
- (2) Upon expiry of the tenure as referred to in sub-section (1), transfer shall be made only upon the availability of substitute.
- 6. <u>Deputation of Doctors.</u>—(1) Government may allow deputation abroad for all categories of doctors only once in their entire service, for a period not exceeding three years.
- (2) Deputation to "Foreign Service" within Pakistan shall be permissible only in respect of medical officers for a period not exceeding three years:

Provided that no further extension, on expiry of agreed tenure shall be given to the doctors who are already on deputation abroad or within Pakistan.

- 7. Postgraduate Medical Education.——(1) The Health Department, on the basis of objective need assessment and analysis, shall determine the intake number of Trainee Medical Officers (TMOs) in Postgraduate Medical Institute (PGMI) and Junior Registrars in Tertiary Care Hospitals every year. This stipulated number shall not exceed in any case.
- (2) Any doctor selected or permitted for postgraduate medical training shall be treated on leave without pay and may be entitled only for stipend fixed by Government from time to time for such training.
- (3) A doctor selected or permitted for postgraduate medical training shall provide surety bond prescribed by Government ensuring that upon completion of his studies for which he was initially selected, shall compulsorily serve for three years in the district of his domicile and in case of non-availability of a post in the district of domicile, he shall serve for three years in the rural area.
- (4) For the purpose of sub-section (3), the doctor shall also provide guarantee of two government officers.
- (5) In case of violation of sub-section (3), Government shall serve one month notice upon the doctor for resumption of duty, failing which the amount shall be recovered from him or from the guarantor, as the case may be.
- 8. Provisions relating to doctors apply to lecturers and instructors.—The provisions relating to doctors in section 7 of this Act shall mutatis mutandis apply to lecturers and instructors.

- 9. Act to over-ride other laws.—The provisions of this Act shall have effect notwithstanding anything contained in any other law for the time being in force.
- 10. <u>Jurisdiction barred.</u>—Save as provided under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XVIII of 1973), the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appeal) Rules, 1986 and the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. I of 1974), no order made or proceedings undertaken under this Act, or the rules made there under or any officer authorized by it shall be called into question in any Court, and no injunction shall be granted by any Court in respect of any decision made, or proceedings taken in pursuance or by any power conferred by or under this Act or the rules.
- 11. Removal of difficulties.—Government may, by order, provide for the removal of any difficulty which may arise in giving effect to the provisions of this Act.
- 12. <u>Power to make rules.</u>—Government may make rules for carrying out the purposes of this Act.




