WRITTEN REPLY FOR AND ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENT NO. 04

Respectfully Sheweth:

PRELIMINARY OBJECTION:

1. The appeal of the present appellant is badly time barred, as such he has challenged the seniority list which was issued on 07-01-2022 and the appellant signed the same on 08-01-2022. The appellant filed departmental appeal on 04-10-2022 which is hopelessly time barred.
2. The appellant wants to challenge order dated: 20-05-2014 in the year 2023, after almost more than 07 years of passing of said order, which is also time barred.
3. The Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Peshawar vide letter No. 9616/Admn dated: 13-06-2022 and letter No. 6341/SDJ/HRW/ADMIN dated: 27-04-2021 decided the matter and decided that the post of Budget & Account Assistant is not included for the purpose of promotion to the post of Superintendent.
4. The issue of seniority between appellant and replying respondent No. 4 was previously decided by Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Swabi vide meeting dated: 14-04-2017, issued on 02-05-2017, in which it was decided that replying respondent No. 4 be deemed to be senior to the appellant.
5. The replying respondent as evident from record was appointed as Junior Clerk in District Judiciary on 21-11-2001 and Computer Operator on 20-12-2003 and on 10-02-2013, he moved an application for his appointment to the post of Assistant by Transfer (appointment by transfer) which was ultimately accepted and his appointment to the post of Assistant was made from the date of his application i.e. 10-02-2013 while appellant was appointed on 14-03-2013, almost one (01) month later to the appointment of respondent.
6. The appellant has got no cause of action.
7. The appellant is estopped to file the present appeal.
8. The appeal is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties and mis-joinder of unnecessary parties.
9. That this Honourable Tribunal has got no jurisdiction to entertain the present appeal.
10. That the appeal is incompetent in its present form.

11. That the appellant has not come to this Honourable Tribunal with clean hands and has with mala-fide intentions concealed/distorted material facts in the appeal and on this score alone the appeal is liable to be dismissed in limine.

ON FACTS:

1. That para No.1 pertains to record of the respondent No. 2. However, it would be relevant to mention that originally the post was sanctioned and created as "Budget & Accounts Assistant" vide Peshawar High Court, Peshawar order No. 1992-/B & A dated: 30-03-2010 and subsequently vide advertisement dated: 04-08-2010 post of Budget & Accounts Assistant was advertised. The appellant's appointment was made in pursuance of the creation of post and advertisement.
2. That para No. 2 pertains to the record of the respondent No. 1 and the relevant rules on the subject of Recruitment of Subordinate courts staff. It would be noteworthy that post of Budget & Accounts Assistant was upgraded and not Accounts Assistant which is evident from the office order dated: 23-11-2018. The Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Peshawar vide letter No. 9616/Admn dated: 13-06-2022 and letter No. 6341/SDJ/HRW/ADMIN dated: 27-04-2021 decided the matter and decided that the post of Budget & Account Assistant is not included for the purpose of promotion to the post of Superintendent.
3. Para No. 3 also pertains to the rules on subject of Recruitment. However, it would be relevant to mention that the rules are subject to the main parent law i.e. Civil Servant Act wherein procedure for appointment is given.
4. Para No. 4 is correct.
5. Para No.5 pertains to record of the respondent No. 2. However, later on, when the respondent No. 4 filed departmental appeal to the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Peshawar, the same was entertained and respondent No. 4 was appointed on the post of Assistant / Reader retrospectively i.e. 10-02-2013.
6. Para No. 6 is correct to the extent that upon departmental appeal, competent authority was pleased to refer the representation filed by the answering respondent to the DPC for reconsideration. The rest of the para needs no comments.
7. Para No. 7 is correct to the extent that the answering respondent was appointed as assistant/reader. Rest of the para is denied being incorrect. It is however, added that the answering respondent has been appointed by the order of competent authority in due course of law complying all the legal and procedural formalities provided under the law and rules on the subject after the acceptance of representation of the answering respondent. It is further added that the word "**Influenced**" used in the para in relations to the honourable Registrar of the august Peshawar High Court Peshawar and the honourable District & Sessions Judge Swabi, is particularly in bad taste and strict action be taken against the appellant for disregarding / disrespecting the Higher /Subordinate Judiciary.
8. Para No. 8 as drafted is incorrect; hence denied. Vide minutes dated: 28-03-2017 matter of ante date of appointment was referred by the committee to the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Swabi who after perusing the record was pleased to pass an order dated: 02-05-2017 vide which it was decided that appointment of respondent No. 4 to the post of Assistant/Reader be deemed from 10-02-2013.

Here it would be imperative to state that order dated: 02-05-2017 has not been challenged by the appellant in any forum, hence the same attained finality.

9. Para No. 9 is incorrect and denied. The appellant not only received the final seniority list as well as tentative seniority list but also signed the same without any objection over the same, which is evident from the latest seniority list of 2022 which is signed by the appellant on 08-01-2022 without any objection. So far guidance on the issue of common seniority list it is submitted that the honourable Peshawar High Court, Peshawar in its letter bearing No. 6341/SDJ/HRW/Admin dated 27/04/2021 addressed to District & sessions Judge Kohat, clearly stated that "the post of Budge & Accounts Assistant is not included for the purpose of promotion to the post of Superintendent;" and similarly, in another letter bearing No. 9616/Admn dated 13/06/2022 the working paper for appointment of Superintendent was returned for correction to the District & Sessions Judge South Waziristan being found contrary to rules as the appendix to Peshawar High Court (Subordinate Courts Staff) Recruitment Rules, 2003 with the observation that there is no room for Budget & Account Assistant in the said seniority list. It is further added that the appellant repeatedly is referring to himself as an Assistant/Accountant in his appeal is an attempt to conceal the real facts on record and deviate the attention of the honourable Tribunal from his actual designation i.e. Budget & Accounts Assistant, as per sanction order regarding creation of post as well as his pay slip. **(Copy of pay slip, letters dated: 27-04-2021 & 13-06-2022 are attached as annexure "RA", "RB", "RC")**
10. Para No. 10 pertains to the record, however, it is submitted that allegations of *manipulation* of the official record of the respondent No.2 is nothing but to pressurize the Hon'ble Subordinate Judiciary. Here it would be relevant to state that final seniority list was also signed by the appellant on 25-01-2022 without any objection.
(Copy of seniority lists are attached as annexure "RD")
11. In reply to Para No. 11, it is submitted that the appellant through subject representation challenged the seniority list which was issued on 07-01-2022 (tentative) and 21-01-2022 (final) but he filed departmental appeal/ representation on 04-10-2022 which is hopelessly time barred. Moreover, instead of pursuing the matter in accordance with law, appellant previously engaged himself in writ petition No. 1688-P/2022 which was dismissed vide order dated: 28-09-2022. Relevant to state that no room/space was given to the appellant to file departmental appeal at belated stage.
12. Para No.12 is incorrect and denied.

GROUND:

A. B. C & D:

That grounds A, B, C & D as drafted are incorrect; hence, denied. The appellant through grounds under reply wants to challenge the appointment order dated: 20-05-2014 at such a belated stage which under the service law, is not permissible

under the Service Tribunal Act. As per law and rules in vogue, respondent No. 4 was appointed in accordance with law, as appointments are always made by Promotion or by Transfer or by Initial Recruitment process. The replying respondent No. 4 through proper channel applied for his appointment to the post of Key Punch Operator/Computer Operator and later on applied for his appointment by transfer to the post of Assistant/Reader, which was ultimately ordered and respondent No. 4 was appointed as such. The appellant failed to challenge order dated: 02-05-2017 (passed by Hon'ble Muhammad Adil Khan, District & Sessions Judge, Swabi) vide which seniority issue was decided in favour of replying respondent No. 4 which attained finality.

(Copy of order dated: 02-05-2017 is attached, as Annex "RE")

It is however, very humbly submitted that this honourable Tribunal has got no jurisdiction to adjudicate upon the issues as raised in the said paragraphs. It is further added that albeit the answering respondent was appointed by the competent authority after the compliance of all the formalities as provided under the relevant law and rules, the appellant has got no *locus standi* to challenge the orders pertaining to the appointment of the answering respondent on whatever grounds.

E.

Ground E as drafted is incorrect; hence, denied. When no one from the Assistants/Readers challenged the appointment order of replying respondent No. 4 nor made any representation over the placement in seniority list then how the appellant pleaded on their behalf. Malafide of appellant is apparent.

F & G.

Grounds F & G as drafted are incorrect, therefore, denied. It is added that not only the appellant initially did not raise any objections on the tentative seniority list maintained for promotion to the post of Superintendent (BPS-17), but has also never challenged the orders of the District & Sessions Judge Swabi (Competent Authority) dated 02/05/2017 on the basis of the minutes of the meeting of Management Committee held on 21/03/2017 whereby the seniority of answering respondent was considered from the date of application i.e. 10/02/2013. Hence, the appellant is estopped to challenge the seniority of answering respondent by his own conduct. It is further submitted that though the post of Budget & Accounts Assistant is a sanctioned post in the District Judiciary; however, as per the Judicial Esta Code 2011 and Revised Judicial Esta Code 2021, no such rules have so far been formulated for the purpose of promotion of the post of appellant and as submitted above in reply to the para No. 9, the status of the holders of post of Budget & Accounts Assistant has already been replied by the august Peshawar High Court Peshawar in its letters No. 6341/SDJ/HRW/Admin dated 27/04/2021 addressed to District & sessions Judge Kohat and letter bearing No. 9616/Admn dated 13/06/2022 addressed to District & Sessions Judge South Waziristan. The appellant consistently trying to thrown rubbish over the Hon'ble Judges of Sub-Ordinate Judiciary but also upon the worthy Peshawar High Court, Peshawar.

H.

Ground H as drafted is incorrect; hence, denied.

I.

Ground I as drafted is incorrect; hence, denied.

Ground J is incorrect and denied. It also submitted that any grounds raised during hearing are subject to notice to the respondents and appellant cannot be allowed to lead the proceedings according to his whims and wishes and wasting the precious time of this honourable Tribunal.

PRAYER:

In light of the above legal and factual objections, the appeal of the appellant being meritless is liable to dismissed with order of costs.
