PARA-WISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENTS NO.02 AND 03

Respectfully sheweth: that the respondents submits as under:-

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS

1. The appellant has no cause of action and locus standi to file instant appeal.
2. The appeal is not maintainable in its present form as it is based on malafide intentions.
3. The appellant is estopped by his own conduct, to bring the present appeal.
4. The instant appeal is bad for misjoinder and non-joinder of necessary parties.
5. That the appeal of the appellant is barred by law and limitation.
6. That the appellant has got no prima facia to file instant appeal.

ON FACTS

1. The appellant Mr. Aziz-Ur-Rehman was approached to the then Minister for Agriculture, N.W.F.P. (now Khyber Pakhtunkhwa) through an application on 15.05.1993 (**Annexure-A**) for appointment against the vacant post of Junior Clerk (BPS-05). On the recommendation of the then Minister for Agriculture, the Petitioner was appointed as Junior Clerk (BPS-05) against the vacant post of Moulder vide office order No.4881-84 dated 18.05.1993 (**Annexure-B**). The said order was substituted vide office order No.11557-59 dated 24.10.1993 (**Annexure-C**) and the appellant was appointed as Asstt: Moulder (BPS-05) with effect from 18.05.1993 as the District Accounts Officer had not entertained the pay bill of the Petitioner appointed against the post of Moulder (**Annexure-D**). The Petitioner had drawn his salary since his

Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the rules made there-under, any agreement, contract or the terms and conditions of service, a civil servant who is rendered surplus as a result of re-organization or abolition of a department, office or abolition of a post in pursuance of any Government decision may be appointed to a post, carrying basic pay scale equal to the post held by him before such appointment, if he possesses the qualifications and fulfils other conditions applicable to that post.

Provided that, where no equivalent post is available, he may be offered a lower post in such manner and subject to such conditions as may be prescribed, and where such civil servant is appointed to a lower post, the pay being drawn by him in the higher post immediately preceding his appointment to a lower post shall remain protected"

And para-5 (c) (iv-b) of the Policy for declaring government servant as surplus and their subsequent absorption/adjustment circulated dated 08.06.2001 which is reproduced below:

(b) Where no equivalent post is available the civil servant may be offered a lower post in such manner, and subject to such conditions, as may be prescribed and where such civil servant is appointed to a lower post the pay being drawn by him in the post immediately preceding his appointment to a lower post shall remain protected.

As such the petitioner was adjusted against the lower post permanently with pay protection as orders mentioned above by the competent authority.

As per para-6 of the surplus pool policy for declaring of government servant as surplus and their subsequent absorption / adjustment dated 08/01/2001 and clarification issued vide Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Establishment and Admn. Department vide letter No.SOR-V(E&AD)1-2/2003 dated 05/07/2003 (Annexure-L), **"The surplus employees who have been adjusted by the relevant authorities in other department shall have no link with their parent department from where he was declared surplus"**. Moreover, as per advice of the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Establishment and Administration Department (Regulation Wing) letter No.SOR-II (E&AD)1-2/08(Agri.Deptt.) dated 28/02/2009 (Annexure-M)

"That there is no concept of re-adjustment of surplus employees which is allowed only if an employee has been adjusted in district other than his district of domicile"

2. Correct to the extent that the august Peshawar High Court, D.I.Khan Bench did not ask comments on the said Writ Petition No. 381-D of 2015 Aziz-Ur-Rehman s/o Rozi Khan from Respondent No.6 and decided the case (Annexure-N), which is reproduced below:-

"7. As a result, the writ petition is accepted, the impugned orders of respondents are declared illegal, null and void ab initio and respondent No.06 is directed to adjust the petitioner forthwith on the post of Junior Clerk, where he was initially posted. He shall be entitled to all back benefits accrued to him under the law from the post in question.


The respondents Department also filed a CPLA in the august Supreme Court of Pakistan against the judgement of the august Peshawar High Court, Dera Ismail Khan Bench dated 20.01.2016.


3. The Para is correct to the extent that the appellant has been conditionally adjusted against the post of Junior Clerk (**Annexure-O**), in light of the august Peshawar High Court, Dera Ismail Khan Bench till the final decision of the august Supreme Court of Pakistan in CPLA No. 310-P/2017. Therefore, the name of appellant has not been enlisted in the Seniority List of Junior Clerk.
4. In correct as the departmental appeal was time barred.

GROUNDS

- a. The Para is incorrect, as the same is mentioned in Para-03 of the facts above.
- b. The Para is denied as the respondents Department always acted according to law as explained in Para-03 of the facts above.
- c. That the respondents may be allowed to raise and submit additional grounds during the course of arguments.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of the para-wise comments, the appeal being devoid of merits may graciously be dismissed with cost.

appointment i.e. 29.05.1993 till 30.06.2001 against the post of Assistant Moulder (BPS-05) (Copies of some Pay Bills are attached as **(Annexure-E)**). Moreover the Petitioner had not drawn salary as Junior Clerk (BPS-05) even for a single day since his appointment.

The appellant Mr. Aziz-Ur-Rehman was surplus due to abolition/re-structuring of Agricultural Engineering Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and placed at the disposal of Assistant Agricultural Engineer, D.I.Khan vide Director, Agricultural Engineering, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Tarnab Peshawar letter No.5293-5309 dated 07.07.2001 **(Annexure-F)**. All the surplus employees of Agricultural Engineering Department were remained in this department upto 30.06.2008.

As per orders/instructions of the Finance Department, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa **"the Administrative Department may transfer all surplus employees to their respective Districts with effect from 01.07.2008"**. As such, the services of all the surplus employees (BPS-01 to BPS-15) of District D.I.Khan including the above named official was placed at the disposal of the then District Coordination Officer (now Deputy Commissioner) D.I.Khan with effect from 01.07.2008, the service record of the above named official was furnished to the then DCO (now DC), D.I.Khan vide Assistant Agricultural Engineer, D.I.Khan letter No.923 dated 16.07.2008 **(Annexure-H)**.

The Petitioner was adjusted/posted against a lower post with pay protection by the Deputy Commissioner, D.I.Khan (competent authority) vide his office order No.856-76 dated 19.02.2014 and District Education Officer (Male) D.I.Khan office order No.2609-15 dated 27.02.2014 **(Annexure-J & K)** as per Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant Act, 1973 and Policy for declaring Government Servant as surplus and their subsequent absorption/adjustment circulated dated 08.06.2001.

The District Education Officer (Male) D.I.Khan did not defend the above orders in the August Peshawar High Court D.I.Khan Bench. He stated in his comments on behalf of Respondents No.8 & 9 that in para-3 of the object on Facts **"The respondent No.9 the then DCO DIKhan has adjusted the petitioner in Education Department for the purpose of salary. The petitioner was adjusted in BPS-1 against the post of Naib Qasid. This adjustment of the petitioner was on temporary basis"** and **Para ii. of Objection on ground' Incorrect/ not admitted. The adjustment of petitioner as Naib Qasid (BPS-1) was not on permanent bases but on temporary bases for salary as the petitioner was regular employee of Agricultural Engineering Wing. So petitioner should be referred to his parent department or the claim of promotion from BPS-5 to BPS-11"**

Para-11(A) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant Act, 1973 is reproduced below:

"11-A. Absorption of civil servants rendered surplus.

Dear Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to say that there is a general misconception about the Administrative Department of the staff of the offices of the defunct commissioners, Deputy Commissioners & Magistracy etc. The correct position is that once a Government servant is declared surplus, he severs all his links with the Department in which he was working before his becoming surplus. On re-adjustment he becomes member of the new Department.

2. The Establishment Department Circular No. SO (O&M) E&AD/33/2002 dated 11-01-2003 is not being interpreted properly. The aforesaid circular clearly states that BOR will be the Administrative Department for those employees of the offices of the Commissioners, Deputy Commissioners, Additional Deputy Commissioners and Assistant Commissioners etc. in BS-15 and below who became surplus and were subsequently adjusted in the offices of the DCOS, ACOS, EDOS and P/R DROS in the District Government. Those employees of the defunct Commissioners, Deputy Commissioners, Additional Deputy Commissioners, Assistant Commissioners and Magistracy who have been adjusted by the relevant authorities in other departments have no link with the Revenue & Establishment Department. Their Administrative Department will be the department in which they stood adjusted. For example a surplus Junior Clerk of the defunct Magistracy Office on adjustment in the Agriculture

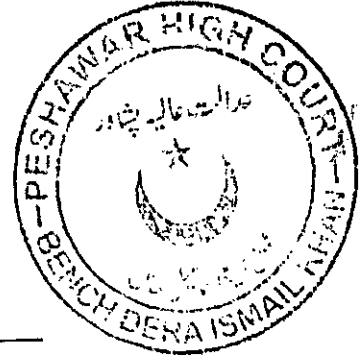



petitioner, namely, Aziz-ur-Rahman, son of Rozi Khan, through the instant Constitutional petition under Article 199 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973, seeks issuance of directions to the respondents/department, i.e. respondent No.6 (Director Agriculture Engineering Department Tarnab Peshawar) to adjust him on the post of Junior Clerk with all back benefits in view of the order bearing No.4881-84/DAE/Estt., dated Tarnab the 18/5/1993.

2. In essence, the grievance of the petitioner is that vide order dated 18/5/1993, referred to above, he was initially appointed as a Junior Clerk (BPS-5) and he was working

satisfactorily in the same capacity when vide order bearing No.557-59/DAE/Estt:/dated Tarnab the 24/10/1993, his designation was changed to that of Assistant Moulder in BPS-5 which was unjustified. Thereafter, in view of circular bearing No.SOR-1(S&GAD)1-200/98 dated 08-06-2001 issued by the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Establishment & Administration Department, the Deputy Commissioner D.I.Khan, respondent No.9 herein, vide order bearing No.856-76/DC(S.Pool) dated D.I.Khan the 19/02/2014, adjusted him against the post of Naib Qasid (BPS-1) in Government Middle School Wanda Umar Khan, followed by order bearing No.2609-15 dated D.I.Khan the 27/02/2014 issued by the District Education Officer (Male) D.I.Khan, respondent No.8 herein. The petitioner has thus prayed that the aforesaid acts of the respondents are in sheer violation of the provisions contained under Chapter-II and Section 11-A of Civil Servants Act 1973 coupled with fundamental rights guaranteed to him by the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.


2. Confronted with the above situation, Mr. Adnan Ali Khan, the learned

Assistant Advocate General appearing on behalf of the respondents failed to controvert the same, rather he candidly conceded that the petitioner has unlawfully been deprived of his valuable rights accrued to him under the law.

3. We have carefully gone through the record of the case and considered the submissions of learned counsel for the parties.


4. Admittedly the petitioner was appointed as a Junior Clerk in BPS-5 by respondent No.6 vide order dated 18/05/1993, whereafter he was satisfactorily performing duties in the same capacity when his designation was unlawfully and against his determent changed to that of Assistant Moulder though in the same pay scale of BPS-5 by the same authority vide order dated 24/10/1993. Then when the petitioner became surplus in the department in view of the Circular of the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa dated 08-06-2001 mentioned above, he was again made a rolling stone and male treated by the Deputy Commissioner D.I.Khan, respondent No.9 herein, by adjusting

him against the post of Naib Qasid (BPS-1) in Government Middle School Wanda Umar Khan.

5. When the petitioner was initially recruited against a permanent vacant post of Junior Clerk in BPS-5 by respondent No.6 after fulfilling all the codal formalities on the subject and when he satisfactorily performed duties as such for five months, then the change of his designation to that of Assistant Moulder by the same authority though in the same scale was a glaring irregularity and illegality committed by him (respondent No.6). Thereafter, when the petitioner became surplus in the department in view of the aforesaid Circular of the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, though he was not legally entitled for such male treatment as he was a permanent employec, then at least he was required to had been adjusted against the post of Junior Clerk and not the post of Naib Qasid in BPS-1, which is nothing but a sheer example of discrimination and illegality committed by the respondents concerned which merits outrightly to be set at naught.

6. Under the law, once a civil servant is appointed on a post, then in view of the provisions contained under Section 3(2) of Civil Servants Act 1973, the same holds out a guarantee to him and on absorption, the terms and conditions of his service which could adversely affect cannot be changed. The employee who is declared surplus would be entitled for appointment on post carrying the basis pay scale equal to the post held by him prior to being rendered surplus. Wisdom in this respect is derived from the case law reported as Mrs. Farkhanda Talat...Vs...Federation of Pakistan through Secretary Establishment Division, Islamabad and others (2007 SCMR 886).

7. As a result, the writ petition is accepted, the impugned orders of respondents are declared illegal, null and void ab initio and respondent No.6 is directed to adjust the petitioner forthwith on the post of Junior Clerk where he was initially posted. He shall be
