
1. Learned counsel for the appellant present. Mr. Muhammad Jan, District Attorney for the respondents present.

2. After arguing the matter at length, it was found that departmental appeal of the appellant was not responded besides no denial of filing of departmental representation was made. Similarly, when there are a number of applications of the appellant found placed on file with respect to some incident reported vide FIR No. 202 dated 17.08.2021 registered under sections 295 (B) of the PPC of Police Station Kookari District Swat, it was incumbent upon the departmental appellate Authority to have properly decided the representation within 90 days stipulated period, but it failed. So we deem it appropriate to remit the matter back to the appellate Authority with the direction to decide the departmental representation within 60 days of receipt of this order under intimation to the appellant as well as the Registrar of this Tribunal. The date of receipt of the order shall also be communicated to the Registrar of the Tribunal.
