#### Prayer:

On acceptance of this appeal the regularization of appellant: in BPS-16 instead of BPS-17 as Research Assistant as illegal, unlawful, against the spirit of fair play, equity and principle of poenitentiae, expectancy, locus **legitimate** therefore such relegation to BPS-16 in the Regularization Notification is not sustainable and ineffective upon the rights of appellant for regularization in BPS-17. Direct the respondents to rissue amended / corrected regularization notification of appellant as BPS-17 and change their designation as Research Officer or Assistant Director Planning with all back and consequential benefits. Any other remedy which this august court deems appropriate may also be awarded in favour of the appellant

#### Respectfully Sheweth,

Brief facts of the instant appeal are as under:

- 1) That the appellant is a law abiding citizen of Pakistan and has every legal or constitutional right of duly protected under the Law of the Land.
- 2) That the Provincial Govt. had started a project namely, Urban Policy Unit under the control of P&D Department various posts were advertised with certain qualifications for the said posts, including the posts of Research Assistant in BPS-17. The petitioner also applied for the

posts of Research Assistant (BPS-17) and for that the Govt. constituted Project Selection Committee for BPS 17 & 18 recommended the appellant for the post of Research Assistant vide recommendation dated 07.05.2014. (Copy of the recommendation of Selection Committee is attached as Annexure A)

- 3) That then a proper summary was moved to the competent authority for the approval of appointment as recommended by the Project Selection Committee. It is worth to mention here that even in that summary the appellant were shown as BPS-17 selected person. (Copy of the summary is attached as Annexure B)
- That thereafter, the appellant was appointed as Research Assistant in the Urban Policy Unit Project, vide order dated 22.05.2014 and since then the appellant is performing their duty upto the entire satisfaction of their superiors. (Copy of appointment order is attached as Annexure C

- 5) That the Provincial Govt: promulgated Regularization Act in 2018 for regularizing various project employees and in the schedule the project of the appellant is also included at Serial No. 4. The Finance Department after the promulgation of Act, also created the posts of appellant in BPS-17 vide Memo dated 11.06.2018 Even in the Budget Book (2017-18 & 2018-19) for P&D Department (UPU) the posts of Research Assistant have been shown in BPS-17. More so, in undertaking, taken from the appellant has been shown as BPS-17 employeer. (Copies of the Act, F.D. memo, Budget Book and under taking are attached as Annexure D, E, F & G)
- 6) That the petitioner was astonished to see their regularization in BPS-16 instead of BPS-17 in the





Regularization Notification dated 14.03.2019, therefore they filed an appeal for redressal of their grievances, but no heed was paid. (Copies of regularization notification and appeal are attached as Annexure H & I)

- That earlier appellant approach to the hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Peshawar wherein the Writ Petition No. 3292-P/2019 come up for hearing before the hon'ble bench on 18.03.2021 and it was disposed of upon the observations "that the representation of petitioner: submitted before the respondents / competent authority shall be positively decided within 45 days after providing them opportunity of hearing. (Copy of judgment is attached as Annexure J)
- 8) That a series of scrutiny committee meetings were held to examine / check anomalies and the committee cleared all the anomalies concerning scale of the appellant and agreed upon the SNEs created by Finance Department. The department accept the Scrutiny Committee decision for all the other employees and have been discriminated and effected their service progression. (Copy of scrutiny committee meetings are attached as Annexure K)
- 9) That the respondents upon the directions of the hon'ble High Court Peshawar decided the representation i.e. turned down the representation / appeal of the appellant vide Order No. SO(E)P&D/3-1/Reg/Projects/2021 dated 21.05.2021. (Copy of the order is attached as Annexure L)

10) That the extension for BPS-17 & above of the project employees required to obtained from Secretary P&DD or competent authority. In the appellant case the extension also got from Secretary P&D Department which shows the scale BPS-17. (Copy of contract extension is attached as Annexure M)

11) That aggrieved of the impugned notification upto the extent of not regularization of appellant. in BPS-17 as well as order dated 21.05.2021 whereby the appeal of the appellant. was turned down, the appellant approach this hon'ble tribunal upon the following reasons and grounds.

#### **GROUNDS**

- a) That regularization of appellant in BPS-16 instead of BPS-17 and not taking action on the appeal of the appellant is against the law, norms of justice, fairy play and equity.
- b) That the appellant was interviewed by the Project Selection Committee meant for the appointment in BPS-17 & 18 as evident from Annexures A&B with the service appeal, the appellant was selected for the post of Research Assistant in BPS-17, therefore their regularization in BPS-16 is not maintainable under the law and rules.
- c) That even after the promulgation of Regularization Act, 2018, the Finance Department; has created the post of the appellant in BPS-17 and also has been shown in the budget book for the year 2017-18 & 2018-19 in BPS-17, therefore the regularization of appellant in BPS-16 is against the norms of justice and principle of fair play.
- d) That even all other employees of the UPU Project have been regularized without demoting them or relegating them to lower BPS, therefore, the appellant has been discriminated by relegating them to BPS-16 in the regularization notification.

- e) That the conduct and inaction of the respondents is against the principle of legitimate expectancy & locus poenitentiae as valuable rights has been created in favour of appellant, under the law by participating in the process of selection in BPS-17 and creation of posts as well in BPS-17. Therefore, the appellant, cannot be relegated to a lower scale / BSP for unknown reasons.
- f) That the appellant has been downgraded to BPS-16 without any approval of Finance Department and competent authority (P&D Department) which is against the principle of Natural Justice which amount to condemnation unheard. Therefore impugned relegation is not sustainable in the eyes of law.
- g) That the acts and omission of the respondents are against the norms of justice, fair play and also against the spit of Article 2A, 4, 9 and 25 of the Constitution.
- h) That the appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proof at the time of hearing.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this appeal the regularization of appellant in BPS-16 instead of BPS-17 Research Assistant as illegal, unlawful, against the spirit of fair play, equity and principle of poenitentiae, expectancy, locus legitimate therefore such relegation to BPS-16 in the Regularization Notification is not sustainable and ineffective upon the right of appellant for regularization in BPS-17. Direct the respondents to issue amended / corrected regularization notification of appellant. as BPS-17 and change their designation as Research Officer or Assistant

Director Planning with all back and consequential benefits. Any other remedy which this august court deems appropriate may also be awarded in favour of the appellants.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the appointment and regularization of services of certain employees appointed on adhoc basis against civil posts and contract basis against project posts in the Province of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa;

It is hereby enacted as follows:

I Short title, application and commencement -- (1) This Act may be called the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2018.

- (2) It shall apply to all the employees as defined in clause (e) of subsection (1) of section 2 of this Act.
  - (3) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Definitions. (1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires;
  - (a) "Commission" means the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Scivice Commission;
  - (b) "contract appointment" means the appointment of a duly qualified person, for a specific period, made against project posts, in a prescribed manner.
  - (c) "Departmental Selection Committee" means a
    Departmental Selection Committee, constituted for the
    purpose of making selection for initial recruitment to civil
    post under a Government Department or office of
    Government
  - (d) "Government "means the Government of the Khyber Pakhunkhya;
  - (e) "employees" mean duly qualified,-
    - (i) one hundred and fifty-eight (158) District Specialists of Health Department, who are appointed on adhoc basis against civil posts w.e.f. 4th July, 2017 and holding such civil posts till the commencement of this Act; and
    - (ii) persons, who are appointed in the projects oncontract basis in accordance with the project : policy;

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- "Government Department" means a Government **(f)** Department, as defined in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Rules of Business, 1985;
- "law or rule" means the law or rule, for the time being inforce governing the selection and appointment of civil servanis;
- "project" means a perpetual nature project, the (h) continuation of which and conversion to regular budget is essential for service delivery duly identified by the Departments and reflected in the Schedule;
  - "civil post" means a civil post under Government or in connection with the affairs of Government to be filled in on the recommendation of the Commission;
  - "project post" means a post in the project; and
- "Schedule" means a Schedule appended to this Act. (k)
- The expression adhoc appointment shall have the same meaning as is assigned to it in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XVIII of 1973).
- Regularization of services of adhoc employees .-- Notwithstanding anything contained in any law or rules, the employees at sub-clause (i) of clause (e) of sub-section (1) of section 2 of this Act, appointed on adhoc basis clause (e) of sup-section (1) of section 2) of section 2 of this dependence of the section of th Act, shall be deemed to have been validly appointed on regular basis, from the date of commencement of this Act, subject to verification of their qualifications and other credentials by the concerned Government Department.

1. ... Regularization of services of project employees. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law or rules, the employees at sub-clause (ii) of clause (e) of sub-section (1) of section 2 of this Act, appointed on contract basis against project posts and holding such project posts till the commencement of this Act, shall be deemed to have been validly appointed on regular basis from the date of commencement of this Act, subject to verification of their qualifications and other credentials by the concerned «Government Department:


Provided that the terms and conditions of services of employees reflected at S.No.5 of the Schedule shall further be governed under the National Disaster Management Authority Act, 2010 (Act No. XXIV of 2010)and Regulations made thereunder; and the terms and conditions of services of employees reflected at S.No.6 & 7 of the Schedule shall be governed under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Emergency Rescue Services Act, 2012 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XV of 2012).

General conditions for regularization .--- For the purpose of regularization of the employees under this Act, the following general conditions shall be observed:



Section Officer (7:4)

- the service promotion quota of all service cadres shall not be affected;
- (ii) the employees shall possess the same qualification and experience as required for a regular post;
- (iii) the employees have not resigned from their services or . terminated from service on account of misconduct, inefficiency or any other grounds before the commencement of this Act; and

- Seniority. (1) Except the employees mentioned in the proviso to section 4 of this Act, whose services are to be regulated by their respective laws and rules, all other employees whose services are regularized under this Action in the process of attaining service at the commencement of this Act shall rank junior to all civil servants belonging to the same service or cadre, as the case may be, who are in service on regular basis on the commencement of this Act, and shall also rank junior to such other persons, if any, who, in pursuance of the recommendation of the Commission or Departmental Selection Committee, as the case may be, made before the commencement of ( \* 1) this Act, are to be appointed to the respective service or cadre, irrespective of 11 Section Filecar? their actual date of appointment.



Provided that if the date of continuous officiation in the case of two or more employees is the same, the employee older in age shall rank senior to the younger one,

Removal of difficulties .-- If any difficulty arises in giving effect to any of the provisions of this Act, the Chief Minister may make such order not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act as may appear to it to be necessary for the purpose of removing such difficulty:

Provided that no such powers shall be exercised after the expiry of one year from the coming into force of this Act.

Overriding effect .-- Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any other law or rule for the time being in force, the provisions of this Act shall have an overriding effect and the provisions of any such law or rule to the extent of inconsistency to this Act shall cease to have effect.





The project was regularized under (Regularization of Services), Act, 2018. Authorities have issued our regularization notification on dated 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2019. Since these were PC-1 positions and for hiring employees second option was followed, therefore, they were allowed to draw salaries as per approved PC-1 and not a stipend as they were directly recruited following the direct hiring analogy P&D Department has also forwarded the SNE to Finance Department designated them as BS-17 and subsequently, the Finance department has created their positions. - (1) Declare the regularization of petitioners in BPS-16 instead of BPS-17 as Research Assistant as illegal, unlawful against the spirit of fair play, equity and principle of legitimate expectancy, locus poenitentiae, therefore, such relegation to BPS-16 in the Regularization Notification is not sustainable and ineffective upon the rights of petitioners for regularization in BPS-17.
- Direct the respondents to issue amended/corrected Regularization Notification of

petitioners as Research Assistant in BPS-17 with all back and consequential benefits.

- (3) Any other remedy which this august Court deems appropriate may also be awarded in favour of petitioners.
- 2. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and learned AAG for the respondents at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that regarding the grievance raised in the instant writ petition, the petitioners have also submitted representation before the competent authority and he may be directed to pass an appropriate order on the same within 45 days.
- 3. The learned AAG also agreed to the said request, hence, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction that the representation of petitioners submitted before the respondents/Competent Authority shall be positively decided within 45 days after providing them opportunity of hearing.





The Provincial Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa regularized the services of project employees of 58\*projects, including Urban Policy Unit, P&D Department, through The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2018, duly passed from the provincial assembly in March 2018.

In compliance of the ibid Act the project employees fulfilling the following criteria shall be regularized;

- 1. That the employees are occupying a project post,
- That the employees have been recruited as per project policy,
- 3. That the employees neither terminated nor resigned till the commencement of the ibid Act.
- 4. That the employees possess qualification & experience as required for a regular post and this to be verify by the concern administrative department.

in compliance of the ibid Act, a committee was constituted comprising of the following to check, scrutinize and assess credentials of the employees of Projects of P&D Department in `accordance with Section 4 & 5 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2018:-

Since the employees of the Urban Policy Unit were also regularized under the ibid Act, therefore, P&D department is mandated to verify the above four points and notify regularization of services of the employees.

The Unit was established to work as a research and policy making to be manned with the highly qualified and experience professionals to lead and come up with new concepts and innovative ideas to improve the urban cities.

The Unit appointed the current professionals as per guidelines of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Project Policy 2008, except the pay package for which a waiver from project policy pay to a higher side was obtained through special summary duly approved by Honorable Chief Minister of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Now these employees have been

regularized through ibid Act and the higher pay will be reduced to regular side.

# (Refer Para-c of the W/P):

The existing staff was hired on higher packages as approved by Chief Minister through Summary (a waiver of higher pay from project policy) and complete recruitment process was processed as per the provisions of Project Policy 2008 (approval note of ACS at F/A). The shortlisting and selection committees under Project Policy minutes (F/B) and offer letter (F/C) justifies that these employees were recruited as per Project Policy. Therefore, these employees fulfill the definition of the 'employee' given in Section 2 (e)(ii) and general conditions for regularization given in section 5(ii) of the Act ibid.

Basic Pay Scale (BPS) of the employees is mentioned in the PC-1 of the project (F/D), in the minutes of shortlisting and selection committees (F/B ibid), ACS & Secretary P&DD approval Note sheets (F/A ibid), and appointment order (F/C ibid). Except for advertisement, in all the aforementioned documents, BPS of the employees is mentioned, refuting the assumption that there is no BPS of these employees.

#### (Refer Para-d of the W/P):

The criteria for all the posts given in the PC-1 of the project do match the responding criteria of the posts given in the Project Policy, except the higher pay package for which the approval & waiver was obtained from Chief Minister through special summary.

# (Refer Para-e of the W/P):

As per approved PC-1 of the UPU, Salaries of the staff of the UPU are not in accordance with the pay scale of the Project Policy because the provincial government through special summary approved special allowance as mentioned above therefore, they have been given special pay package, but the project was governed under the rules of project policy.

# (Refer Para-f of the W/P):

The approved PC-I of the project reflects that Research Analysts, Associates and Assistants (BS-17) will be fresh graduates recommended by the Vice Chancellors of Public Sector Universities or to go for direct hiring (F/E). There were two options for these positions, but the Unit went for direct recruitments as per project policy and as a result these employees were recruited from open market. Further, as per PC-I, distribution of seats among the Universities was to be decided by the ACS P&D in case of hiring from universities but as mentioned, the second option of direct hiring was preferred.

Since these were PC-I positions and for hiring employees second

option was followed, therefore, they were allowed to draw salaries as per approved PC-I and not a stipend as they were directly recruited following the direct hiring analogy. P&D Department has also forwarded the SNE to Finance Department designated them as BS-17 and subsequently, the Finance Department has created their positions (F/F).

#### (Refer Para-geof the W/P):

Moreover as per the Working Paper submitted by the UPU which stipulates that, the Provincial Project Selection Committee, without having any authority, appointed few specialists on less than the approved pay package because they didn't possess the required qualification/experience. It is obvious that the employees were meeting the advertised criteria for the qualification & experience as the shortlisting committee do not deviate from the advertisement and provisions of PC-I. Hence it was approved by the ACS that their pay package shall be annually increased in three years span with an equal increment (F/G). Therefore, the employees could not be held liable for the wrong decisions on the administration side.

During discussion, it was revealed that out of those, 02 employees (Sr. No. 6&7 of Annex-I) have either crossed the superannuation or on the verge of their respective ages of retirement; hence, cannot be considered for regularization. 02 employees (Sr.No. 2&3 of Annex-I) were found having experience less than advertised for their specific posts at the time of their appointment due to which they were appointed on reduced pay package. Credentials of others were found in order.
- 3. The issue of special pay package of the above employees was also discussed at length. It was found that although there was no mention of Basic Pay Scales in the offers of appointment of the above UPU employees; yet, the PC-I document contained proper reference of Basic Scales to these posts if offered to the corresponding deputationists from the government departments (Annex-II). This could be a valid and strong justification for considering their cases for regularization in a particular basic scale. It was however unanimously agreed, that prior to regularizing the above project employees in a specific scale under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Regularization of Services) Act 2018, all of these employees should

submit an undertaking categorically declaring their willingness to agree to the terms & conditions of regular service which might drastically reduce their pay packages. In such condition, they would neither claim protection of their special pay package & other emoluments nor would claim any anti-date seniority after regularization at any forum or any stage of their service.

No. SO(E)P&D/3-1/Reg/Projects/2021: The applicants M/S Mr. Sami ur Rehman and Mr. Sahib Sardar (BPS-16), Research Assistant, Urban Policy Unit, P&D Department filed a Writ Petition No. 3292-P of 2019 in the Peshawar High Court, Peshawar wherein they have prayed for:

- Declaring the regularization of petitioners in BPS-16 instead of BPS-17 as a) illegal, unlawful against the spirit of fair play, equity and principal of legitimate expectancy, locus poenitentiae, therefore, such relegation to BPS-16 in the regularization notification is not sustainable and ineffective upon the rights of petitioners for regularization in BPS-17.
- Directing the respondents to issue amended/ corrected regularization b) notification of petitioners as Research Assistant in BPS-17 with all back and consequential benefits.
- Any other remedy which the august Court deems appropriate may also be c) awarded in favour of petitioners.
- Hon'ble Peshawar High Court vide its judgment dated 18,03.2021 disposed of 2. the petition with the directions that the representation of petitioners submitted before the respondents/competent authority shall be positively decided within 45 days after providing them an opportunity of hearing.
- Both the petitioners were appointed as Research Assistant against project 3. posts in Urban Policy Unit, P&D Department without mentioning the BPS.
- Upon promulgation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Employees (Regularization of

  5. 

- 1- That the appeal is not maintainable in its present form.
- 2- That the appellant has got no locus standi to file the instant appeal.
- 3- That the appellant did not come to the Tribunal with clean hands.
- 4- That the applicant is not maintainable due to Mis-Joinder and Non-Joinder of necessary parties.
  - 5- That the appellant concealed the material fact from the Honorable Tribunal.

# JOINT PARA-WISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENTS NO. 01 TO 04.

## **RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:**

- 1) Needs no comments.
- 2) Pertains to record. The BPS of the Research Assistant was neither existed in project PC-1 nor mentioned in the advertisement. (Annex-I&II).
- Ocrrect to the extent that a Note for Secretary (not summary) in light of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Project Policy, 2008 for appointment of all recommended incumbents, mentioning no BPS specifically against positions/incumbents was processed for necessary approval of the competent authority (Annex-III).
- 4) Pertains to record, hence needs no comments.
- 5) Correct to the extent that reflecting BPS -17 of the appellant in the documents was a clerical error and the same was rectified later on in light of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Employees (Regularization of Services) Act 2018. (Annex-IV).
- 6) That the appellant was regularized in BPS-16 in light of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Employees (Regularization of Services) Act 2018, Project Policy 2008 as well as in pursuance of existing pay scale for the same post in government

departments on regular side. The relevant grounds for allotting BPS-16 are as under:-

- i. Under Section-4 of ibid Act 2018 the employees holding project posts shall be validly appointed on regular basis subject to verification of their qualification and other credentials by the concerned Government Department (Annex-V).
- ii. The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Project Policy 2008 under sub-section-VI of Section-10 as well states that in case the project posts are converted into regular budgetary posts, the posts shall be filled in according to the rules prescribed for the post through the Public Service Commission or the Departmental Selection Committee, as the case may be (Annex-VI).
- iii. As per standard practices & budget book of government departments, the Research Assistant/Assistant Research positions/nomenclatures are being reflected in BPS-16. Keeping in view the above the credentials of the appellant were thoroughly scrutinized and hence regularized in BPS-16. (Annex-VII).
- 7). Correct and pertains to record.

- 8). incorrect. As per Section-3 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2018, a scrutiny committee was constituted in the department for verification of qualification and other credentials of the employees regularized under Act ibid along-with the appellant (Annex-VIII). The Committee thoroughly examined qualification and credentials of every employee and found since the BPS of the appellant was neither mentioned in the PC-I nor advertisement, therefore, on the documents i.e. list of employees provided by the Urban Policy Unit (Annex-IX), the Scrutiny Committee recommended their regularization in BPS-16. Therefore, their departmental appeal was thoroughly examined/ deliberated and regretted/ filed on the abovementioned grounds.
- 9). Correct. As explained in preceeding paras. Moreover, the competent authority gave the appellant an opportunity to bring any documentary proof regarding pay scale (BS-17) of his post on regular side in any Administrative Department/Attached Department for decision in the Departmental Appeal. However, the appellant failed to produce the same. Therefore, the Departmental Appeal was regretted/rejected and a Speaking Order was issued as per directions of Peshawar High Court, Peshawar (Annex-X).

- 10). Merely submission of case of appellant to Secretary, P&D for extension may not confer any right to be in BPS-17. The project document (PC-1) mentions Pay Scale of the posts, however, in the case of the appellant, the PC-1 only allowed 20,000/- rupees per month salary as he was trainee staff, therefore, no BPS was mentioned against his nomenclature (Annex–XI).
- 11). Needs no comments. The appellant was provided with all opportunities in written as well as in personal hearing and he has no valid grounds/justification to approach the Hon'able Tribunal.

# **GROUNDS:**

- a. Incorrect. Regularization of the appellant in BS-16 instead of BS-17 is according to law/norms of justice, fare play and equity.
- Correct to the extent that merely being interviewed by Project Selection Committee may not confer any right to be in BPS-17. The project document (PC-1) mentions Pay Scale of posts, however, in the case of the appellant, the PC-1 only allowed 20,000/- rupees per month salary as these were trainee staff, therefore, no BPS was mentioned against their nomenclature.
- c. Incorrect. As per Section-3 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2018, a Scrutiny Committee was constituted in the department for verification of qualification and other credentials of the employees regularized under Act ibid along-with the appellant. The Committee thoroughly examined qualification and credentials of every employee and found since the BPS of the appellant was neither mentioned in the PC-I nor advertisement, therefore, on the documents i.e. list of employees provided by the UPU (Annex-IX), the Scrutiny Committee recommended their regularization in BPS-16. Therefore, their departmental appeal was thoroughly examined/deliberated and regretted/ filed on the above-mentioned grounds.
- d. Correct to the extent that creation of posts in BPS 17 was a clerical error and rectified during the process of regularization. It was observed that in the entire Province, the posts of Research Assistant or Assistant Research are reflected in BPS–16, therefore, the rectification was required to avoid any future anomaly.
- e. As explained in preceeding paras of facts and grounds, the employees as well as appellant were regularized in BPS either mentioned in PC-I or as

- per BPS of the posts on regular side in case of not mentioning of the BPS of the post in PC-I.
- f. Incorrect. As explained in preceeding paras. The appellant was regularized in BS-16 with the approval of competent authority in P&D Department as well as Finance Department after rectification in the creation of post of appellant in BS-16.
- Incorrect as explained in the above paras. Moreover, the act of the g. respondents is as per law/rules/ policy.
- h. The respondents also seek leave of this honorable Court to raise further points at any time during arguments before this honorable Court.



#### ORDER:

No. SO(E)P&D/3-1/Reg/Projects/2021: The applicants M/S Mr. Sami ur Rehman and Mr. Sahib Sardar (BPS-16), Research Assistant, Urban Policy Unit, P&D Department filed a Writ Petition No. 3292-P of 2019 in the Peshawar High Court, Peshawar wherein they have prayed for:

- a) Declaring the regularization of petitioners in BPS-16 instead of BPS-17 as illegal, unlawful against the spirit of fair play, equity and principal of legitimate expectancy, locus poenitentiae, therefore, such relegation to BPS-16 in the regularization notification is not sustainable and ineffective upon the rights of petitioners for regularization in BPS-17
- b) Directing the respondents to issue-gamended/scorrected regularization notification of petitioners as Research Assistant in BRS-17 with all back and consequential benefits.
- c). Any other remedy which the august Court deems appropriate may also be awarded in favour of petitioners.
- 2. Hon'ble Peshawar High Court vide its judgment dated, [8 03.2021 disposed of the petition with the directions that the representation of petitioners submitted before the respondents/competent authority shall be positively decided within 45 days after providing them an opportunity of hearing.
- 3. Both the petitioners were appointed as Research Assistant against project posts in Urban Policy Unit, P&D Department without mentioning the BPS.
- 4. Upon promulgation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2018, their services were regularized as Research Assistant in BPS-16 as the credentials for the post of Research Assistant were searched in the Provincial Budget Book and it was found that all Research Assistant sposts are in BPS-16, therefore, their regularization in BPS-16 is in accordance with the provisions of the Actibid.
- The regularization of their services in BRS-16 was also in accordance with the recommendations of the Scrutiny Committee of Urban Policy Unit (UPU) whereby it was mentioned that credentials of both the petitioners were verified and found that PC-I did not mention their pay scale, and in order to award a proper scale in line with regular side, they may be given BPS-16 as the Research Assistant positions in all Covt Departments are in BPS-16.

6. The patitioners were afforded the opportunity of personal hearing held on 28.04.2021 at 1300 parts and they were asked to provide any documentary proof regarding
