- Learned counsel for the appellant has been heard at length similarly learned Additional Advocate General has also been heard. At the end of arguments, the learned counsel for the appellant has very fairly submitted that the appellant intended to challenge the Service Rules of 2018 in order to include all the Class-IV employees in the ladder of promotion to the post of Junior Clerk and similarly he intended to seek promotion to the post of Junior Clerk, whereas the persons, who were not eligible to be promoted being Matriculate, were promoted ignoring the appellant, who was duly qualified and eligible for promotion and for the purpose he had already made a representation which remained un-responded. He also wants to file a promotion appeal. The appellant is always at liberty to seek any legal remedy provided under the law be that challenging the rules or seeking promotion or any other, which if filed, has to be decided in accordance with law and merits. As regard this appeal, he does not press it. Disposed of accordingly. Consign.
