

**ORDER**

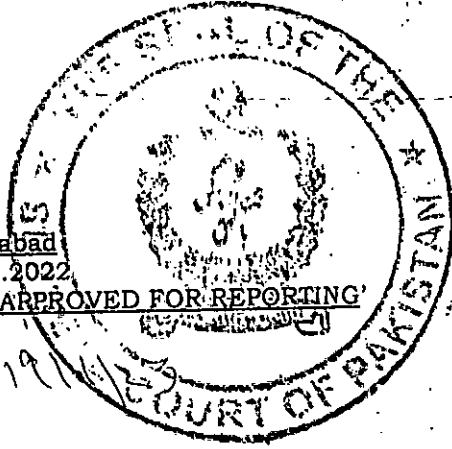
**Umar Ata Bandial, CJ.-** This Petition is barred by 21 days. The application for condonation of delay (C.M.A. No.1119-P of 2018) states that the late supply of documents and the process of securing attested copies of the judgments of the learned Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar and lengthy correspondence between the various tiers of the Petitioner Department led to delay in the filing of this petition. The internal management issues of the Petitioner departments are not grounds constituting sufficient cause for condoning the delay. Consequently, no sufficient cause is made out in the application for condonation of delay.
