Prayer in appeal:

On acceptance of instant appeal the impugned orders dated 03/07/2015, 12/08/2015 and 21/09/2015 may kindly be cancelled, set aside and the appellant may graciously be reinstated in service with all back benefits.

Respectfully Sheweth:

The appellant respectfully submits as under:

- That the respondent No. 1 advertised various posts 1. of different categories i.e. Junior Primary Care Technician, Junior Clinical Technician etc through publication daily "THE in MASHRIO" dated 26/08/2013 and subsequently a corrigendum was published in the same newspaper 27/08/2013. (Copies of advertisement corrigendum are annexed as annexure "A" and "B").
- 2. That the appellant applied for one of the posts and was appointed as Junior Primary Health Technician (MP) in BPS-09 after fulfilling all the codal formalities and was posted at Tehsil Headquarter Hospital/ Category-C Hospital, Lahor District Swabi. (Copy of appointment letter is attached as annexure "C").

- 3. That the appellant submitted his arrival report for duty and performed his duties to the entire satisfaction of the authorities.
 - 4. That the appellant was performing his duties at his place of posting, that in the meanwhile the respondent No. 1 issued a show cause notice to the appellant. (Copy of the show cause notice is attached as annexure "D").
 - 5. That the appellant submitted detailed reply to Show Cause Notice. (Copy of reply to Show Cause Notice is annexed as annexure "E").
 - 6. That the respondent No. 1 terminated services of the appellant vide order dated 03/07/2015 impugned herein, without any cogent reason. (Copy of impugned order dated 03/07/2015 is annexed as annexure "F").
 - 7. That aggrieved from the order dated 03/07/2015 issued by respondent No. 1, the appellant submitted departmental appeal / representation before the respondent No. 2. (Copy of departmental appeal/representation is attached as annexure "G").
 - 8. That the appellant pursued followed his case at the appellate stage and whenever the appellant contacted/visited the office of respondent No. 2, the appellant was told that the result of the appeal will

be communicated to him, That on 09/09/2015 when the appellant visited the office of respondent No. 2 came to know that his appeal has been regretted vide order dated 12/08/2015 and the same has been sent to his place of duty. The appellant was directed to obtain a copy of the order from the office of respondent No. 3. The appellant visited the office of respondent No. 3, but they refused to give a copy of the letter mentioned above stating that as the appellant is no more an employee of the Health Department, he cannot be provide with a copy.

- 9. That the appellant submitted a written application to the respondent No. 2 and after along struggle and requests a copy of letter dated 21/09/2015 along with copy of order dated 12/08/2015 was handed over to the appellant on 21/09/2015. (Copy of orders dated 12/08/2015 and 21/09/2015 are attached as annexure "H" & "H-1").
- 10. That aggrieved form the impugned orders, the appellant is approaching this Hon'ble Tribunal on the following grounds amongst other:

GROUNDS:

A. That the impugned orders are against law, rules and regulations and based on malafide, hence liable to be cancelled/ set aside/ varied.

- B. That the appellant has properly been appointed on the recommendations/ approval of the Selection Committee, constituted for the purpose.
 - C. That the appellant has been appointed on the criteria of advertisement published in the newspapers.
 - D. That the appellant is having the requisite qualification of Junior Primary Health Technical and his termination is against the law, rules and regulations applicable thereto.
 - E. That the candidates having diploma from the Skill Development Council have been held qualified and entitle to be appointed as Junior Clinical Technician in their relevant field by the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Peshawar vide judgment/order 22/05/2014 passed W.P. No. in 1111/2010; wherein it has clearly been held that a candidate cannot be refused appointment on the ground that he is not having his diploma from K.P. Medical Faculty. (Copy of the judgment dated 22/05/2014 is annexed as annexure "I").
 - F. That the appellant has obtained/passed diploma of JPHC from Skill Development Council, Lahore, a registered and recognized institute, but strange enough that the diploma was sent to K.P. Medical Faculty for verification, instead it should have been



sent to the institution wherefrom the appellant has passed it.

- G. That the appellant has been appointed through proper procedure and according to the criteria laid down and advertisement published in the newspaper.
- H. That both the impugned order have been passed against the settled principles of holding proper inquiry.
- I. That it is pertinent to mention here that many of the employees/ Junior Primary Health Technician who are having their diplomas from the Skill Development Council (S.D.C) are working in the Health Department particularly in Gaju Khan Medical College, Swabi, but the services of the appellant have been done away with, without any cogent and plausible reason, rather the impugned order dated 03/07/2015 is the result of malafide and ill will.
- J. That it is also worth mentioning that the impugned order of termination of the appellant has been passed in a slipshod manner and in hurry.
- K. That any other ground will be argued at the time of arguments with the prior permission of this Hon'ble Tribunal.



It is, therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of the instant appeal, both the impugned orders dated 03/07/2015, 12/08/2015 and 21/09/2015 may kindly be cancelled/ set aside and the appellant may graciously be reinstated in service with all back benefits.

Any other remedy which this Hon'ble Tribunal deems proper, may very graciously be granted in favour of appellant.



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

the instant constitutional petition Muhammad Khalifa

petitioner has asked for issuance of appropriate, write declaring the refusal by respondents for his selection on the ground that Diploma acquired by the petitioner is not acceptable to them.

2- Briefly stated, the facts giving rise to the instant petition are that in response to the advertisement published by the respondents, the petitioner applied for the post of Junior Clinical Technician (Sterilization) through proper channel, Interview and other test of the petitioner were held

(23),

was declared successful being the sole candidate for two vacant posts but could not be appointed as an objection was made by respondent No.1 that the Diploma of the petitioner was not of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Medial Faculty.

- 2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner was awarded Diploma by Skill Development Council Lahore which is registered Institute and recognised by National Training Board, Government of Pakistan. It was further averred that on the basis of same Diploma, in the past many of the candidates were held entitled to the post of Junior Clinical Technicians' and are still in service. It was lastly argued with vehemence that a Division Bench of Lahore High Court as well of this Court under the similar situation held the Diploma of the Institution from which the petitioner was qualified, to be entitled to be appointed for appointment of Junior Clinical Technician in the relevant field.
 - 4- Conversely, learned AAG appearing on behalf of the respondents contended that since the petitioner was not

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noiding the Diploma from the recognised Institution i.e. Medical Faculty KPK, therefore, he was not considered for appointment and the post was left vecant. He further referred to the initial advertisement wherein the required qualification was that the candidate should be Matric with science and holder of Diploma from Medical Faculty KPK.

- Arguments heard and record perused.
- Perusal of record reveals that the petitioner was awarded Diploma in Operation Theater Assistant by Skill Development Council established under National Training Ordinance/Act 1980 (Amended Ordinance No.il of 2002) Sessions 2008-2009. Two posts were advertised for Junior Clinical Technician (Sterilization) and the petitioner was sule candidate who, qualified in test and interview. We have also observed that one Abdul Basit son of Gul Muhammad Khan who was holder of similar Diploina, was selected and appointed through order dated 17/12/2008 and is still in service. Similarly Sajid son of Gul Jamal who was also nolding Diploma from Skill Development Council, Lahore was also appointed vide order dated 29/05/2007 and is still in

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Sajid were sent by the concerned Executive District Officer for verification and both were verified by the Skill Development Council. Lahore, It has also been brought to our notice that in KPK Medical Faculty Peshawar only twenty technologies Diploma of two years courses are provided wherein the Diploma of the petitioner i.e. Operation Theater. Assistant (Sterilisation) is not provided thus the stand taken by the respondents Government that the petitioner should qualify from the local Medical Faculty was without any substance and mis-conceived.

To earn livelihood and get the service, being qualified.

In basic right recognised by the Constitution and no one can deny this right. It would not be out of place to mention here that the petitioner was only candidate of required qualification as advertised by the respondents. He was duty interviewed and selected in the process and could not be appointed on the observation with regard to the Diploma of the petitioner.

The respondents should not have come to the Court with such allegation because the Institution from where the

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petitioner secured Diploma was duly recognized by Ministry of Labour, Manpower and Overseas Pakistanis, Government of Pakistan and so for no action has taken by the Federal Government as well as by Provincial Government against the institution if they had any grievance or objections. On one hand the Provincial Government failed to provide the facility of education of Diplorna in Clinical Technician (Sterilization) and on the other hand a duly qualified candidate was refused job, thus not only depriving the petitioner but the patients of the concerned area for tipking benefit of health facilities. Once it was brought into the notice of the respondents that there is a consistent view of a Division Bench of Lahore High Court as well of this Court, then it was bounden duty of the respondents to honour the same. Writ Petition No.4146 of 2010 Muslah-ud-Din and another....Vs...The Executive District Officer (E&SE) Charsadda and others" decided on, 25/04/2013 by this Court and Writ Petition No.11272 of 2012 , "Muhammad Akhtar etc....Vs...E.D.O.(Health)" allowed on 24/09/2012 of a Division Bench of Lahore High Court are

8- For what has been observed above, this will publicate allowed and the respondents are directed to process/consider the case of the petitioner for appointment on the post left vacant through order of this Court dated 26/10/2010and his appointment shall not be refused on the only ground that the Diploma acquired by him is not from KPK Medical Faculty.

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
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

And at last the exam is conducted by medical faculties on semester basis and the final results is declared by medical faculty. According to rules the duration of diploma in health and other relevant fields technology is half of the MBBS which cannot be issued without approval/authorization of the health department concerned.

It is therefore humbly prayed that the present appeal being meritless, baseless against facts and law may kindly be dismissed with special cost throughout.

As the diploma was returned unverified and guidance of health directorate also supported the decision of medical faculty (Annex-C), therefore his services were terminated.

Whereas the appellant are not of the same technology and there were multiple other candidates having diplomas recognized by medical faculty Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Medical faulty Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has also quoted the decision of Honorable High Court in which it is mentioned that all diplomas should be issued by medical faculty. (Annex-E)
- F. Incorrect as all the diplomas must be verified by Medical Faculty Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar as mentioned in the appointment order. As per provincial health department rules all the diplomas obtained from different institutes have to be verified from medical faculty Khyber Pakhtunkhwa like any candidate passing SSC from any private or public sector school their certificates are sent to board of intermediate and secondary education for verification.
- G. Pertains to record.
- H. Incorrect. As the diploma of the appellant was sent for verification to Medical Faculty Peshawar as according to Clause-09 of the appointment order, no inquiry was required.

- I. Incorrect. The termination has been done as per Govt: Rules and Policy.

 Diplomas of all the technicians in all institutions of health department are sent for verification to Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Medical Faculty. The appellant failed to provide any documentary proof in his support.
- J. Incorrect. The orders of termination have been issued after fulfilling all the procedures as per Govt: Rules.
- K. The respondents also seek permission to raise additional grounds at the time of arguments.

- rules shows that it is the domain of the Medical Faculty to issue degrees, diplomas licenses, certificates or other documents stating or implying that the holders, grantees or recipients are qualified to practice western medical science, or to perform duties of the respective category. Since it is a special field and requiring a specialized training, it alone has the power to confer, grant or issue diplomas etc.
- 14. Skill Development Council in view of the rules quoted above has the power to arrange courses for technical and professional

skills and knowledge based on employment in industry and market but it under no stretch of interpretation has the power to issue diplomas, certificates, licenses etc. to enable any one to perform duties of medical technicians, health assistants and health auxiliaries, dispensers or dressers. We, therefore, do not agree with the learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are eligible on the strength of diplomas issued by an Institution affiliated with the Skill Development Council to participate in the test and interviews for the appointment of junior clinical surgery technicians. The case of Muhammad Kasif-Vs-E.D.O. Health and others (Supra) is not relevant to the case hand, firstly because distinguishable on facts and secondly because it is sub silentio as the entire legal spectrum of the controversy was not brought before Hon'ble Judge of the Lahore High Court. Therefore, the writ asked for cannot be issued.



NATIONAL TRAINING ORDINANCE 1980 AMENDED VIDE NATIONAL TRAINING AMENDMENT ORDINANCE 2002

No.F.17(1)/80-Pub.-- The following Ordinance made by the President is hereby published for general information:--

ORDINANCE NO.IX OF 1980

AN

ORDINANCE

to constitute Training Boards to regulate and promote vocational training facilities in various fields

WHEREAS it is expedient to constitute Training Boards to regulate and promote vocational training facilities in various fields and to provide for the financing of training programmes and for matters ancillary or incidental thereto;

AND WHEREAS the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, read with the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order, 1977 (C.M.L.A. Order No.1 of 1977), and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:--

- 1. Short title, extent, commencement and application.—
 - (1) This Ordinance may be called the National Training Ordinance, 1980.

- (2) It extends to the whole of Pakistan.
- (3) It shall come into force at once.
- (4) It applied to all establishments and institutions engaged in imparting vocational training
- 2. **Definitions.** -- In this Ordinance, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context.-
 - a) "establishment" means any office, firm, industrial unit, undertaking, shop or premises in which workmen are employed for the purpose of carrying on any industry;
 - b) "industry" means any business, trade, manufacture, calling, service, employment or occupation;
 - c) "institution" means a school, college or institute, by whatever name called, imparting vocational training;
 - d) "National Board" means the National Training Board constituted under section 3;
 - (da) "National Trade Testing Board" means National Trade Testing Board constituted by the National Training Board under subsection (2) of section 4;
 - e) "prescribed" means prescribed by regulations made under this Ordinance;
 - f) "Provincial Board" means a Provincial Training Boards constituted under sub-section (2) of section 5;
 - (fa) "Provincial Trade Testing Board" means provincial Trade Testing Board constituted by the Provincial Training Board;
 - (fb) "Skill Development Council" means the Skill Development Council, constituted by the National Training Board under sub-section(2) of section 4."
 - (fc) "Technical Education and Vocational Training Authority" means the Technical Education and Vocational Training Authority constituted by the Provincial Government;
 - g) "vocational training" means training in any physical and professional skill, trade, calling or occupation.

- **Constitution of the National Training Board.--** (1) As soon as may be after the commencement of this Ordinance, the Federal Government shall constitute and shall by the said name sue and be sued.
- (2) The National Board shall be a body corporate by the name of the National Training Board, having perpetual succession and a common seal, with power to acquire, hold and dispose of property, both movable or immovable, and shall by the said name sue and be sued.
- (3) The National Board shall consist of the following members, namely:-
 - a) the Minister for Labour and Manpower, who shall be Chairman of the National Board;
 - b) the Secretary to the Government of Pakistan in the Ministry of Labour and Manpower and Overseas Pakistanis, who shall be Vice-Chairman of the National Board;
 - c) a representative of the Planning Commission;
 - d) a representative of the Ministry of Education;
 - e) a representative of the Ministry of Finance;
 - f) a representative of the Ministry of Science and Technology;
 - g) four representatives from employers or Chairman Skill. Development Councils, each province having one representative, to be appointed by the Chairman National Board on the recommendation of Employers' Federation of Pakistan;
 - h) one women representative of employers' to be appointed by the Chairman National Board, on the recommendation of Employers' Federation of Pakistan;
 - i) four representatives from workers, each province having one representative, to be appointed by the Chairman, National Board on the recommendations of National Workers' Organizations;
 - j) one women representative of workers, to be appointed by the Chairman on the recommendation of the National Workers Organization;
 - k) Chairman of the Provincial Training Board from each province; and
 - l) Director of the office of the National Board, who shall also be the Secretary of the Board".

(4) Members of the National Board shall hold office for such term as may be prescribed.

4. Functions of the National Board.--(1) The National Board shall--

- i. collaborate with the source of labour market information as determined from a survey of establishments with a view to assessing on a continuing basis existing and future training needs, both local and foreign;
- ii. systematically study existing training programmes with respect to their relevance, duration and size and recommend such measures to be taken as seem desirable to improve the quality of training;
- iii establish criteria for evaluating and determining training programmes and facilities;
- iv. develop training syllabi and establish and specify national training standards' and trade testing rules to ensure horizontal and vertical mobility;
- v supervise such training programmes are funded from the Federal budget;
- vi. prepare national training plan, programs and projects in view of local as well as foreign requirements and monitor their implementation;
- vii. recommend to the Federal Government means for financing training programmes;
- viii. promote and finance training of establishment based or institution-based training officials and instructor's:
- ix. organize and conduct seminars and work-shops for various types of personnel associated with training activities'
- x. collect and compile statistics related to training;
- xi. co-ordinate the working of Provincial Boards and Technical Education and Vocational Training Authority;
- xii. review existing and propose legislation on vocational training and recommend necessary legislative provisions with the concurrence of the Provincial Boards and Technical Education and Vocational Training Authority;

- xiii. issue to establishments, Provincial Boards, Technical Education and Vocational Training Authority or institutions for compliance directives within the framework of the approved plans and projects;
- xiiia) assist and establish institutions in collaboration with private sector to promote technical, vocational and in-plant training and skill development;
- xiiib) undertake registration and licensing of all establishment, organizations or institutions which are offering or providing vocational training;
- xiiic) develop system and conduct trade testing and certification of skilled workers who have received vocational training through any source or acquired skills through experience or informal system;
- (xiv) do all other acts necessary for carrying out the purposes of this Ordinance.
- (2) The National Board may set up such administrative and technical committees, skill development councils, authorities, trade testing boards or other such bodies for the efficient performance of its functions, and entrust to such committees, skill development councils, authorities, trade testing boards or other such bodies such functions as it may consider necessary.

5. Functions of the Provincial Board, etc. (1) Each Provincial Board shall-

- i. publish an annual forecast of provincial skilled manpower requirements;
- ii. identify and inspect vocational training schemes;
- iii. maintain a register of approved training schemes;
- iv. ensure uniformity of training standards;
- v. approve training schemes and recommend them to the National Board for funding;
- vi. supplement or provide advisory services to establishments and schemes offering vocational training;
- vii. prepare an annual provincial training plan for meeting skilled manpower requirements;

- viii. register and license all establishment, organizations or institutions which are offering vocational training; and
- ix. conduct trade tests and certify the skilled persons and trainers who may have received vocational training through any source or acquired the skill through experience or informal system.
- (2) Each Provincial Government may establish a Provincial Training Board consisting of such number of members, including its Chairman, as the Provincial Government may appoint.
- 6. Meetings and Procedure.-- (1) The meetings of the National Board and a Provincial Board shall be held, as and when required but at least once in six months, at such time and place as Chairman of the respective Board may determine;
- (2) Meetings of the National Board and the Provincial Boards shall be conducted in accordance with such procedure as may be prescribed.
- (3) The powers and functions of the Chairman of the National Board shall, during the absence of the Chairman, be performed by the Vice-Chairman of the National Board and during the absence of both the Chairman and the Vice Chairman, by such member of the National Training Board as the Chairman may, by order in writing, direct and
- (4) In case of a Provincial Board, the powers and functions of the Chairman shall, during the absence of the Chairman, be performed by such member of the Provincial Board as its Chairman may, by order in writing, direct.
- 7. Officers and servants of the Boards.-- (1) The National Board and a Provincial Board may appoint such officers and servants including advisors as it may consider necessary for the efficient performance of its functions.
- (2) The terms and conditions of the officers and servants of each Board shall be such as may be prescribed.
- 8. Funds.-- (1) All receipts of the National Board from any source whatsoever shall be credited to a Fund to be called the National Training Board

Fund which shall vest in the National Board and from which allocations shall be made to Provincial Boards, or any other organization or institution working under the board.

- (2) All receipts of the Provincial Board from the National Board or any source whatsoever shall be credited to a Fund to be called the Provincial Training Board Fund of the Province concerned.
- (3) A Fund under sub-section (1) or sub-section (2) shall be administered in such manner as may be prescribed and, until such manner is prescribed by the Chairman of the National Board or the Provincial Board, as the case may be, and shall be applied to meet all expenditure connected with the execution of the schemes and measures for which the Board concerned is responsible and all charges necessary for the discharge of the functions of such Board under this Ordinance.
- **9.** Audit and account.-- (1) The National Board and the Provincial Board shall maintain their accounts of receipts and expenditure in such manner as may be prescribed by the Auditor-General.
- (2) The accounts of the National Board and the Provincial Boards shall be audited by the Auditor-General or any officer authorized by him in such manner as the Auditor-General may think fit.
- (3) The Auditor-General shall, as soon as possible after completion of the audit, send to the National Board or the Provincial Board a report on the said accounts and the Board shall, with its comments thereon, forward it to the Federal Government or the Provincial Government, as the case may be.
- 10. Servants of the Boards, etc., to be public servant.— Every servant of the National Board and the provincial Boards and every person acting or purporting to act under this Ordinance shall be deemed to be a public servant within the meaning of section 21 of the Pakistan Penal Code (Act XLV of 1860).
- 11. Indemnity.-- No suit, prosecution or other legal proceeding shall lie against any person for anything in good faith done or intended to be done under this Ordinance.

- 12. Delegation of powers.— The National Board, with the approval of the Federal Government, and a Provincial Board, with the approval of the Provincial Government concerned, may delegate all or any of its powers to its Chairman, any of its committees or an officer of the Federal Government or a Provincial Government, as the case may be.
- 13. Penalty for non-compliance with directives.— If an establishment or institution does not comply with any directive given by the National Board or a Provincial Board which is in accordance with its functions set out under this Ordinance the head of the establishment or the institution, as the case may be, shall be punishable with fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees and, in the case of a continuing non-compliance with the directive, with an additional fine which may extend to two hundred rupees for every day during which the non-compliance continues after conviction for the first such non-compliance.
- 14. Cognizance of offences.-- (1) No court shall take cognizance of any offence punishable under this Ordinance save on a complaint made by the National Board or a Provincial Board or an officer authorized on behalf of either of the Boards.
- (2) No court inferior to that of a Magistrate of the first class shall try any offence punishable under this Ordinance.
- 15. Power to exempt.— The Federal Government or a Provincial Government may, by Notification in the official Gazette, exempt either conditionally or unconditionally and establishment on class of establishments or any institution imparting vocational training from all or any of the provisions of this Ordinance.
- **16.** Power to make regulations.-- The National Board, in consultation with the Federal Government, and each Provincial Government, may make regulations for carrying out the purposes of this Ordinance.

Note: The amendments in Sub-Section (2) of Section 2, Sub-Section (3) of Section-3, Sub-Section(1) and (2) of Section 4, Sub-Section(1) and (3) of Section 5, Sub-Section (1) and (3) of Section 6 and Sub-Section (1) of Section 8 are made vide National Training (Amendments) Ordinance, 2002 dated 12th January, 2002.

14.07.2015 whereby the appellant was terminated from service and against the order dated 23.07.2015 through which his departmental appeal was regretted.

- 3. Arguments of learned counsel for the appellant and learned Deputy District Attorney heard. File perused.
- 4. The appellant was appointed as Junior Primary [Jealth Care/Clinical Technician (M.P) in BPS-09 vide order dated 02.04.2015, however after a few months of his appointment his services were terminated vide impugned order dated 14.07.2015 simply for the reason, that he obtained diploma from Skill Development Council Lahore which was not a recognized institution.
 - 5. Admittedly the appellant did not possess diploma from the recognized institution when he was appointed as Junior Primary Health Care/Clinical Technician (M.P) vide order dated 02.04.2015 and there is also no dispute that the appellant obtained the requisite diploma from the recognized institution i.e. the institution affiliated with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Medical Faculty Peshawar in the year 2016 after his termination vide impugned order. In these circumstances the appellant is not found entitled for reinstatement from the back date however while keeping in view the peculiar circumstances of the case and gaining wisdom from the judgment of august Supreme Court reported in 2016 SCMR page 1228 and common judgment dated 20.03.2018 passed in Writ Petition No.470-40 M of Hon'ble Peshawar High Court Peshawar, this Tribunal hereby issues direction to the respondent department to appoint and adjust
