SERVICE APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KPK SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974, AGAINST THE LETTER BEARING NO: SO(C-1)HED/1-9/PP/Ayub Zarin (Prof: Political Science)6519-22 DATED 31-10-2022 ISSUED BY THE OFFICE OF RESSPONDENT NO: 1, WHEREBY THE DEPARTMENT HAS ORDERED FOR RECOVERY OF OVERPAYMENT FROM THE APPELLANT AND ORDER DATED 13-03-2023 PASSED BY THE RESPONDENT NO: 1 WHEREBY THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT WAS NOT CONSIDERED AND WHICH WAS COMMUNICATED TO THE APPELLANT ON 14-03-2023 THROUGH WHATSAPP.

Respectfully Sheweth:

The facts of the instant Appeal are as under:-

1) That the appellant was appointed as Lecturer Political Science BPS-17 vide order dated 08-12-1988 against the vacant post in the Higher Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa the then NWFP and later on which was regularized on 14-06-1990.

(Copies of regularization order dated 14-06-1990 and other relevant documents are attached as Annexure-"A" & "A-1")

- 2) That from the date of appointment, the appellant was performing his duties to the entire satisfaction of his superior and there was not a single complaint against the appellant in his whole career.
- That due to the unblemished service record of the appellant, it is clear that the appellant was regularly performing his duties and as such he was promoted to BPS-18, BPS-19 & BPS-20 respectively with monetary benefits/perks & privileges.
- 4) That the appellant retired from the service at the age of superannuation (60 years) on 09-05-2022. (Copy of the retirement notification dated 14-06-2022 is attached herewith as mark-"B")
- That after retirement the appellant waited and approached to the 5) concern department for the release of his pension etc. Surprisingly the present appellant on 16-11-2022 came to know that letter bearing No: SO(C-1)HED/1-9/PP/Ayub Zarin (Prof: Political Science)6519-22 dated 31-10-2022 issued by Higher Education, Archives & Libraries Department has ordered for recovery of overpayment shown in the Pay & Allowances w.e.f 01-12-2013 to 31-05-2022 and Leave encashment in lieu of LPR, which may be recovered from his commutation amounting Rs: 625,395/- which is at all incorrect and based on illegal presumptions. According to law the appellant is entitled for the payment of Rs: 4,809,652.83/- under Pension Commutation amount while he has been paid a sum of Rs: 4,645,609/deducting Rs: 164043/r. Similarly a sum of Rs: 127,720/- has been fixed/mentioned/calculated inconnection with determination of the basic pay of BPS-20 instead of Rs: 132,230/-due to which monthly pension was fixed Rs: 150,681/- instead of 156,000/- and a deduction of Rs: 5319/- per month less calculated for the payment of monthly pension, which are tabulated as under:

- 6) That the appellant filed departmental appeal before the Respondent No: 1, but the said appeal was not considered vide order dated 13-03-2023 without giving a proper opportunity of hearing, hence the appellant/petitioner was condemned unheard. (Copies of departmental appeal & order dated 13-03-2023 are attached as Annexure-"D" 4 "E")
- 7) That the appellant has no other proper remedy, except to file the instant appeal before this Hon'ble Tribunal, on the following grounds:

GROUNDS:

- A. That the action of respondent department are unlawful, against the law arbitrary, discriminatory and against the norms of justice.
- **B.** That the appellant was performing his duties as Professor very honestly, sincerely & devotedly till 09-05-2022 despite the knowledge of the facts to the respondents, furthermore demand from the appellant is against law, Shariah & rules.
- C. That the salary and other emoluments were used to receive from the Accountant General Office after their proper scrutiny and passing the same by their internal Audit mechanism, pay fixation committee and college Principal/DDO and Accounts Clerk which was never objected or questioned at the relevant time/period.
- **D.** That the appellant was declared entitled for the said allowances, other perks & privileges and thus was correctly paid accordingly since 11-06-2013, hence this objection can neither be made or questioned at this belated stage after 10 years.
- E. That no show cause notice was served upon the appellant before passing the impugned order and the same was issued at the back of the appellant, hence the said order is illegal, of no legal effect, void and liable to be cancelled/struck down.
- **F.** That the sheer abuse of the powers and consequent harassment of the appellant at the hand of the respondents department is gross violation of the fundamental rights of the appellant.
- **G.** That in light of the judgments of the Superior Courts of the country, once a benefit accrued to the appellant cannot be taken back.
- **H.** That recovery of the said amount is the violation of the Fundamental Rights of appellant as well as prevailing law on the subject.
- I. That it is a settled law that no one should be condemned unheard and in the present case the appellant has not been given opportunity of being heard, hence the impugned order dated 31-10-2022 & 09-02-2023 are liable to be struck down.

- That the respondents had not provided opportunity of hearing to the appellant, while deciding the matter hence, violated the principle of natural justice whereby the appellant may not be deprived to defense a case against it and impugned order in violation of right to a fair trial as envisage and granted under 10-A of the Constitution of Pakistan.
- Respondents are against the law and facts of the case, furthermore the impugned orders of the respondents is against the law and without authority.
- L) That the appellant have been condemned unheard throughod the impugned proceedings/order, as the impugned orders were made unilaterally and without any notice being served on the appellant.
- M) That the impugned orders passed by the Respondents in hasty and slip shod manner and without going into merits of the case.
- W) That the respondents while passing the impugned orders did not considered the legal status of appellant, and passed the impugned order in mechanical manner, violating all the norms of justice and law.
- (D) That the vested rights of the appellant as guaranteed and enshrined in the Constitutional of Pakistan have been violated while recovering the amount after retirement.

- P) That no reason for the alleged recovery was ever mentioned in the said order/letter.
- (2) That impugned letter and order of recovery is based on surmises, conjectures and beyond the limitation.
- That said disbursement was regularly made to appellant during Service period after proper Audit by the Account Office as well college and as such same recovery cannot be ordered/made at the belated stage of retirement.
- 5) That appellant has already done/worked/performed duties against the receipt of said payment which cannot be taken back.
- T) That awarding of financial benefits to the appellant is the exclusive prerogative to the appellant, and the present appellant was not at fault, thus the appellant cannot be punished for the same.
- (4) That Supreme Court has time and again held that Pension benefits be released to the Retired Employee within a month but the same was not only been delayed but deducted which too is illegal and same amounts to violation of law and judgments of the Apex Court of the country.
- V) That further grounds, with leave of this Honorable Court, would be raised at the time of arguments before this Honorable Court.

PRAYER

It is therefore humbly prayed that on acceptance of this appeal, to issue directions to the respondent department.

- The impugned letter bearing No. SO(C-1) HED/1-9/6519-22 dated 31-10-2022 of the respondent No. 1 and order of the rejection of the department appeal vide letter dated 09-02-2023, may kindly declared as illegal, without lawful authority, void ab-initio, null & void and no legal effect and to be set aside.
- ii) That the respondents further be directed, to refund / repay all amount to the appellant, which the respondents have deducted as over payment from the appellant.
- iii) To direct the respondent department of Appellunt (BS-20) to issue correct pension and already deducted amount may kindly be released / adjusted and pension amount which is still outstanding may kindly be released.
- iv) Any other relief which this Honorable
 Court deems fit and proper in the
 circumstances may also be very
 kindly granted.



- **1.** That the appellant was appointed as Lecturer Political Science BPS-17 vide order dated 08.12.1988 against the vacant post in Higher Education Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa the than NWFP.
- **2.** That from the date of appointment, the appellant was performing his duties to the entire satisfaction of his superior and there was not a single complaint against the appellant in his whole career.
- **3.** That due to the unblemished Service record of the appellant, it is clear that the appellant was regularly performing his duties and as such he was promoted to BPS-18, BPS-19 & BPS-20 respectively with monetary benefits/Perks and Privileges.
- **4.** That the appellant retired from the service at the age of superannuation (60 years) on 09.06.2022.

(Copy of retirement notification dated 09.05.2022 is attached herewith as mark-"A")

5. That after retirement the appellant waited and approached to the concern department for release of his pension. Surprisingly the present appellant on 16-11-2022 came to know that letter bearing No: SO(C-1) HED/1-9/PP/Ayub Zarin (Prof: Political Science) 6519-22 dated 31.10.2022 issued by Higher Education, Archives & Libraries Department has order for recovery of overpayment shown in the Pay & Allowances w.e.f 01/12/2013 to 31/05/2022 and Leave encashment in lieu of LPR, may be recovered from his commutation amounting Rs: 625,395/-.

(Copy of letter dated 31.10.2022 is attached herewith as mark-"B")

- **6.** That in light of the judgments of the Superior Courts of the country, once a benefit accrued to the appellant cannot be taken back. That recovery of the said amount is the violation of the Fundamental Rights of appellant as well prevailing law on the subject.
- 7. That no show-cause notice was served upon the appellant before passing the impugned order and same was issued at the back of the appellant, hence the said order is illegal, of no legal effect, void and liable to be cancelled/struck down.
- **8.** That it is a settled law that no one should be condemned unheard and in the present case the appellant has not been given opportunity of being heard, hence the impugned letter dated 31-10-2022 is liable to be struck down/cancelled.

10. That no reason for the alleged recovery was ever mentioned in the said order/letter.

- **11.** That impugned letter and order of recovery is based on surmises, conjectures and beyond the limitation.
- **12.** That said disbursement was regularly made to appellant during Service period after proper Audit by the Account Office as well college and as such same recovery cannot be ordered/made at the belated stage of retirement.
- **13.** That appellant has already done/worked/performed duties against the receipt of said payment which cannot be taken back.
- **14.** That awarding of financial benefits to the appellant is the exclusive prerogative to the appellant, and the present appellant was not at fault, thus the appellant cannot be punished for the same.
- **15.** That Supreme Court has time and again held that Pension benefits be released to the Retired Employee within a month but the same was not only been delayed but deducted which too is illegal and same amounts to violation of law and judgments of the Apex Court of the country.

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of this appeal, the impugned letter bearing No SO(C-1) HED/1-9/PP/6519-22 dated 31.10.2022 may very kindly be set aside/recalled/cancelled and direct the District Accounts Officer to issue correct pension and already deducted amount of the appellant may kindly be released/adjusted and all the pension amounts which are still outstanding may kindly be released forthwith along with compensations.

The views/comments of this office, in the instant case, as under:

- 1. According to Section 17 of KPK Civil Servant Act, a Civil Servant shall be entitled to pay sanctioned for the post in accordance with Rules.
- 2. Vide Rule 7 of KPK Pay Revision Rule 1978, the Annual Increment shall be allowed to a Civil Servant in 1st December of a year after completion of at least six months service at a stage of Pay.
- 3. Vide Rule 10 (1) (I) Pay of Pay Revision Rule 1978, Civil Servant on his promotion from lower to higher post shall be fixed at next higher stage of the higher Post and a premature increment shall be allowed therein.
- 4. Vide Rule 10 (3) of the above Rules, a Civil Servant shall opt for re-fixation of pay on his promotion, from lower to higher post, after availing annual increment in lower post on 1st December if his promotion is made during 2st June to 30st November of a year.
- 5. Mr. Ayub Zarin was promoted to the cost of Associate Professor (B-19) on 11-06-2013

- 6. The said Professor was drawing Basic Ray in 8-18.@ Rs.47000/P M on 01-12-2012. The pay of Professor was fixed @Rs.50200/P M in 8-19 on 11-06-2013 after allowing next stage plus one premature increment.

In the light of above quoted Rules the Professor is entitled to Basic Pay @ Rs.50200/P.M on 11-06-2013 & 01.12.2013, but due to computer mistake one additional increment added in his Basic Pay on 01-12-2013 raising Basic Pay from Rs 50200/P.M to Rs.51800/P.M resulting an over payment of one increment.
- 10. The overpayment made to the Professor, as highlighted at para 8 and 9 above, could not be detected/pointed out by Drawing and Disbursing officer up till his retirement.
- 11. On receipt of Notification of retirement of the Professor, this office issued him Last Pay Certificate for the purpose calculation of pension after overhauling of his Service record I.e Service Statement and History of Service for which this office is fully responsible under the Rules. Hence, overpaid amount was calculated carefully and intimated to the Pension Sanctioning authoring and the Professor accordingly
