SERVICE APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBEF PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNALS ACT, 1974.

Respectfully Sheweth,

Facts giving rise to the present appeal are as under:-

- 1. That appellant joined the C&W Department as Sub-Engineer (BPS-11) on 21.10.1986 and at the moment has got about more than 37 years unblemished and outstanding service record at his credit.
- 2. That due to poor service structure and non-existent chances of promotion, the appellant and his other colleagues similarly placed were deprived of their due career progression inspite of acquiring the higher qualification of B.Tech. (Hons) Degree, therefore, the Department by means of Notifications dated 14.10.2014, 26.03.2016 (Annex;-A) allocated separate quota for B.Tech (Hons) Degree holder Sub-Engineers for promotion to the post of Sub Divisional Officer/Assistant

Engineer (BPS-17) and in pursuance of which the appellant got promoted to BPS-17 on 04.11.2016 after long 30 years of service. (Seniority Lists of the BPS-17 Officers as stood on 20.01.2022 and 01.01.2023 *Annex*;-B & B/1 and Status Sheet of existing & proposed Separate Seniority Lists for SDOs (BPS-17) B.Tech. (Hons) Graduates prepared by the appellant *Annex*;-C).

- That as no promotion quota to BPS-18 was reserved for B.Tech. (Hons) Degree holder SDOs/Assistant Engineers (BPS-17), therefore, the Provincial Government constituted a high level Committee under the chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary vide Notification dated 07.09.2021 (Annex;-D) to resolve the issue. The Committee delayed the matter, therefore, the appellant alongwith other Officers filed two Writ Petitions bearing No.1539/2021 and No.2707/2021 before the Peshawar High Court for directing the Committee to finalize the matter at the earliest in accordance with law. Both the Writ Petition were heard together and disposed of vide Judgment dated 24.03.2022 (Annex;-E).
- That it is pertinent to add that the Irrigation Department, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa vide Notification dated 24.08.2021 (Annex;-F) has reserved 12% quota for promotion of SDOs (BPS-17) holding B.Tech. (Hons) Degrees to the post of Executive Engineer (BPS-18). Similar is the case with Public Health Engineering Department vide Notification dated 31.01.2022 (Annex;-G) where initially such quota was 3% but was substituted with 8%. In the like manner, the Local Government & Rural Development Department has also earmarked 20% quota vide Notification dated 13.05.2016 (Annex;-H). The Energy & Power Department has also separated the B.Tech. (Hons) Degree holders for the purpose of promotion to BPS-18 vide Notification dated 14.09.2018 (Annex;-I). Other sister Provinces also kept such quota as is evident from the Notification dated 16.12.2013 (Annex;-J) issued by the Govt. of Sindh, Irrigation Department, Notification dated 11.01.2013 (Annex;-K) issued by the Govt. of Sindh Energy Department. Notification dated 19.03.2014 (Annex;-L) issued by the Govt. of Sindh, Works & Services Department. The Govt. of Baluchistan Services & General Department vide Notification dated 23.08.1997 (Annex;-M) has also catered for such separate quota.
- 5. That after the Judgment of the High Court ibid, the high level Committee after threadbare discussion submitted its Report (Annex;-N) vide letter dated 10.06.2022 to the Competent Authority and made favourable recommendations. Para -8 of the recommendations is reproduced herein below:-

- "8. After threadbare discussion in light of the Supreme Court Judgment referred to above, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973, APT Rules, 1989 and the Peshawar High Court Judgment dated 24.03.2022 regarding convening of SSRC meeting, it was unanimously recommended that C&W Department may review its existing service rules by providing opportunities/chances of promotion to the B.Tech (Hons) degree holders and Diploma holders Assistant Engineer's on the analogy of other technical departments i.e. Irrigation, E&P and PHE Department."
- That in the light of recommendations ibid, the matter was referred to the Standing Service Rules Committee ("SSRC") for framing/amending the existing service Rules. The C&W Department accordingly prepared Working Paper (Annex;-O) wherein instead of following the recommendations of the high level Committee ibid, two proposals were submitted to the SSRC. The first meeting of the SSRC was held on 18.08.2022 (Minutes Annex;-P) wherein the proposal was returned to the C&W Department as the same were not in accordance with the recommendations of the Committee. Subsequently, the second meeting of the SSRC was held on 16.09.2022 (Minutes Annex;-Q) wherein the SSRC in deviation of the recommendations of the high level committee approved the proposal of the C&W Department that BPS-18 posts are 100% by promotion and that there is no need of mentioning qualification in Column No.3 of the proposed Service Rules. The appellant along with others meanwhile appealed on 15.09.2022 (Annex;-R) to the Secretary Establishment, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for reserving 20% quota instead and for stopping the promotion till then, however, the same solicited no response.
- 7. That finally the impugned Notification dated 25.11.2022 (Annex;-S) was issued against which the appellant preferred a departmental appeal (Annex;-T) on 14.12.2022 which was not decided within the statutory period of 90 days, hence this appeal inter-alia on the following grounds:-

Grounds:

- A. Because Respondents have not treated appellant in accordance with law, rules and policy on subject and acted in violation of Article 4 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 and unlawfully issued the impugned Notification, which is unjust, unfair and hence not sustainable in the eye of law.
- B. Because the appellant has been meted out a discriminatory treatment in violation of Article 25 & 27 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 inas much as other similarly placed Officers counterparts of the appellant serving in

identical circumstances in other Departments of the Provincial Government have been earmarked specific quota for their career progression which has been denied to the appellant without any justification muchless lawful. The classification made by the Respondents is not based on any intelligible differentia and therefore ultra vires and thus liable to be struck down.

- Because in view of the judgments of the superior fora and the anomalous state of affairs, the Provincial Government constituted a high level committee to resolve the issue. The committee was comprising of the high-ranking Officers of the Provincial Government under the chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The committee so constituted after thoroughly investigating the issue and after long threadbare discussion reached to the conclusion that the C&W Department should also reserve separate quota for B.Tech. (Hons) Degree holder SDOs in the light of the judgments of the superior fora on the analogy of other Departments. Inspite of clear recommendations, the SSRC was misled into concurring with the C&W Department's Proposal and thus did not reserve separate quota as per recommendations of the high level committee. Thus the impugned Notification is unlawful, arbitrary, unreasonable, discriminatory and hence not sustainable in the eye of law and liable to be set aside.
- D. Because the appellant has suffered a lot as he has served the Department for long 37 years and remained deprived of career advancement and it was lately when the Department realized the Rules were amended and appellant got the first opportunity of promotion to the next higher grade in 2016. In case the impugned Notification is maintained, the appellant will never get a second chance of promotion to the next higher grade as he is at the twilight of his service career. The other counterparts of the appellant serving in other Departments have got numerous opportunities of promotion to BPS-18 and even BPS-19 but the appellant has been deprived of it in violation of law. Thus the impugned Notification is arbitrary, unfair, unjust and thus not maintainable under any canons of law, justice and fair-play.
- E. **Because** the Provincial Government has adopted a highly discriminatory attitude, in respect of its officers as on the one hand the appellant and his other colleagues have been refused the channel of promotion to the next higher grade by means of the impugned Notification whereas other Officers serving in other Departments of the Provincial Government have been provided such opportunity which is against the law of the land and thus not maintainable.

G. That appellant would like to offer some other grounds during the course of arguments.

It is therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of this appeal, the impugned Notification dated 25.11.2022 may graciously be struck down being ultra vires, discriminatory, unreasonable and this Tribunal may further be pleased to direct the Respondents to act in the matter in accordance with law and to amend the impugned Notification dated 25.11.2022 in line with the recommendations of the high level committee and reserve separate promotion quota of 20% to the B.Tech. (Hons) Degree holder SDOs/Assistant Engineers (BPS-17) to the post of Executive Engineer (BPS-18) in the C&W Department.

Any other relief as deemed appropriate in the circumstances of case not specifically asked for, may also be granted to appellant.

NOTE:

A fresh Combined Seniority List is issued by C&W Department on January 01, 2023. The instant Seniority list shows Officers at Sl. No 2, 6, 7, 9, 11 & 17, who got retired. The officers at Sl. No 2 & 7., Mr. Niamat Gul* and Mr. Shaukat Ullah Khan had filed Writ Petitions titled "Niamat Gul SDO & Others" WP No. 1539-P/2021 & Mr. Shaukat Ullah & others had also filed separate WP No. 2707-P/2021 in PHC for providing 20% quota for promotion to B.Tech graduates to BS-18 ad above. However both retired, although decision of PHC and The Special Committee recommended promotion quota on analogy of sister Engineering Departments. Both these cases were decided on 24/03/2022, with direction by PHC to the "Special Committee" (constituted by CS KP on 07.09.2021), to resolve the matter of promotion of B.Tech Graduates within 60 days. The "Special Committee" decided the matter on 20.04.2022 and asked C&W Department to forward the case to SSRC for according the quota. C&W department vide No. SOE/C&WD/8-12/2020, dtd June 27, 2022 submitted 1st proposal to Secretary Establishment Department for SSRC(Annex-A) giving 2 proposals, to which the SSRC forum objected and deferred the agenda item on request of DS C&W. C&W again forwarded 2nd proposal to SSRC forum vide No. SOE/C&WD/13-10/2021 on September 13, 2022. The Respondents again voiced their concern and forwarded their grievances to Secretary SSRC and Chief Secretary KP on 15/09/2022. However, no heed was given to the directions of the Honorable PHC or to the decisions of the "Special Committee" has clearly asked C&W department to provide Separate Quota on the analogy of other Engineering Departments.

The intent of C&W Department is based on malafide intention by disallowing separate seniority for B-Tech for promotion to BS-18, at this time is to press the matter for certain time so that the Senior B.Tech graduates may retire and then to re-convene SSRC meeting to remove B.Tech being fit for BS-18. In case it provides for a separate quota at this time, then B.Tech graduates will be promoted and the chain for promotion will then keep continuing.



JUDGEMENT

IJAZ ANWAR. J:- By this single Judgement, we propose to decide this as well as the connected Writ Petition No.1539-P/2021 "Niamat Gul and others Vs Govt: of KPK through Chief Secretary and others" as both these petitions have been filed under Article 199 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 involving similar controversy. The following prayer has been made in the instant writ petition.



- 2. In essence, petitioners holding B.Tech (Hons) Degree and serving the respondent department as Sub Divisional Officers (BPS-17) seek issuance of direction to the respondents for reservation of 20 % quota for promotion of B.Tech (Hons) Degree holder SDOs (BPS-17) to the post of XEN BPS-18.
- 3. Comments were called from the respondents which were accordingly submitted



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wherein they have opposed the issuance of the desired writ.

- 4. Arguments of counsel for the parties heard and record perused.
- The main emphasis of the learned counsel for petitioners is that earlier the respondents have initiated process for amendment in the recruitment rules for providing specific quota to the B.Tech Degree Holders, however, no progress is made so far and his only prayer is that the Standing Service Rules Committee shall convene its meeting to decide this issue once for all.
- on an earlier date, the learned AAG had produced a Notification dated 07.9.2021 whereby a Committee was constituted by the Provincial Government in order to address the issue pertaining to the B.Ss/B.Tech Engineering




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Degree Holders and their respective promotion quota. This Court vide order dated 18.11.2021 directed the learned AAG to provide the outcome of the meeting of the said Committee.

- 7. Today, learned AAG produced the relevant minutes of the meeting wherein this issue has been discussed with detail, however, it was decided that certain record be obtained from the associations of both the categories so that the same could be further discussed in the forthcoming meeting of the Committee.
- 8. Learned AAG as well as learned counsel for the added respondents have objected on the maintainability of this writ petition on the ground the issue in hand relates to the terms and conditions of service and as such, this issue can only be adjudicated by the Provincial Service Tribunal. We are in complete agreement with the learned AAG and learned counsel representing



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matter relates to the terms and conditions of service of a civil servant, the Service Tribunal has the exclusive jurisdiction and the jurisdiction of this Court is barred under Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, however, in the instant mater, petitioners have merely sought direction of this Court for expediting the matter pending with the Standing Service Rules Committee, because presently the matter in hand is premature particularly for the purpose of filing appeal before the Service Tribunal.

9. We have noted that vide







MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE MEETING CONSTITUTED UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF ADDITIOANL CHIEF SECRETARY, P&D DEPARTMENT.

In order to discuss the issues pertaining to the BSc/B.Tech Engineers second meeting of the Committee was held on 20.04.2022 at 1000 hrs under the chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary. List of participants is attached.

- 2. At the outset, the Chair directed the representative of P&D Department to brief/update the meeting. Representative of P&D informed the meeting that the issues were discussed in the previous meeting as per TORs of the Committee and it was decided that necessary documents may be obtained from both the associations of Engineers. The same have been obtained and shared with the P&D Department by Establishment Department. Representative of Establishment Department may therefore, brief the meeting regarding stance of both the Associations of Engineers in support of their demand.
- 3. Representative of Establishment Department informed the meeting that that B.E/BSc Degree holder Engineers are relying on Pakistan Engineering Council Act, 1976 and operative part of the Supreme Court Judgment dated 24.04.2018 passed in C.P No.78-K of 2015 Maula Bux Shaikh VS Chief Minister Government of Sindh and others which stipulates that "the net result of above discussion is that this petition fails. It is dismissed and leave refused, however, with note of caution that government shall not allow or permit any person to perform professional engineering work as defined in the PEC Act, who does not possess accredited engineering qualification from the accredited engineering institution and his name is not registered as a register engineer or professional engineer under the PEC Act." While stance of the B.Tech (Hons) and Diploma Holders Engineers is that the notified service rules may be implemented by considering their promotion cases under the ibid rules.
- 4. Highlighting Maula Bux case, representative of Establishment Department informed the forum that as per the Supreme Court of Pakistan Judgment the petitioner



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(Maula Bux) was B.Sc Engineer appointed as Sub Engineer in the year 1985 in Works and Service Department, Government of Sindh Karachi and subsequently promoted to the post of Assistant Engineer (BS-17) in the year 1997. Plea of the petitioner was that he was a qualified Engineer holding degree of Bachelor of Engineering and his promotion to BS-18 was affected due to 13% and 07% quotas reserved to B.Tech (Hons) Degree holders and Diploma holders Assistant Engineers respectively for promotion to the post of Executive Engineers BS-18. Moreover, Para-16 of the ibid Judgment stipulates that it is the domain of the government concerned to decide whether a particular academic qualification of a civil servant/employee is sufficient for promotion from one Grade to another higher Grade and whereas it is the domain of the Pakistan Engineering Council to decide, as to whether a particular academic qualification can be equated with another academic qualification, but it has no power to say that the civil servants/employees holding particular academic qualifications cannot be promoted from a particular Grade to a higher Grade. The main object of the Act is to regulate the working of professional engineers and consulting engineers and not to regulate the qualifications or the working of the engineers in the government or semi-government departments.

- Representative of Establishment Department further informed that terms and conditions of service of civil servants are managed and regulated under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989. Rule-3(2) of the ibid rules provides that the method of appointment, qualifications and other conditions applicable to a post shall be such as laid down by the Department concerned in consultation with the Establishment and Finance Departments. Service Rules are framed/amended after convening meeting of the SSRC presently centralized in the Establishment Department. He pointed out that Irrigation and Public Health Engineering Departments have provided career progression/promotion chances to the B.Tech (Hons) Degree holders and Diploma holders by amending their relevant service rules.
- 6. During discussion it was noted that as per existing service rules of C&W Department the requisite qualification for the post SDO/Assistant Engineer (BS-17) is

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Degree in B.E/BSc Engineering (Civil/Mechanical/Electrical) from a recognized University and the post is to be filled as per following method of recruitment:-

- (i) 65% by initial recruitment.
- (ii) 16.50 % from amongst the Sub Engineers who hold a diploma of (Civil Mechanical or Electrical) and have passed departmental professional examination with 10 years service as such.
- (iii) 5% by promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the Sub Engineers who possess Degree of B.E or BSc Engineering (Civil Mechanical or Electrical) at the time of their joining service and have passed Departmental Professional Examination with 03 years service as such.
- (iv) 3.5% by promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the Sub Engineers who acquired Degree of B.E or BSc Engineering (Civil Mechanical or Electrical) during service and have passed Departmental Professional Examination with 03 years service as such.
- (v) 10% by promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness, from amongst the Sub Engineers having Degree of B.Tech (Hons) and have passed Departmental Professional Examination with 05 years service as such.
- 7. It is worth mentioning that career progression for promotion to the Diploma Holder Engineers and B.Tech (Hons) Degree Holders Engineers has already been agreed/provided in BS-17, while it is being refused for their further promotion to BS-18 irrespective of the fact that a joint seniority list of Assistant Engineers (BS-17) is being maintained for the purpose of further career progression. Moreover, promotion chances to (BPS-18) for B.Tech (Hons) and Diploma Holder Assistant Engineers have been provided in Irrigation, PHE, LG&RD and Energy and Power Departments.
- After threadbare discussion in light of Supreme Court Judgment referred to above, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973, APT Rules, 1989 and the Peshawar High Court Judgment dated 24.03.2022 regarding convening of SSRC meeting, it was unanimously recommended that C&W Department may review its existing service rules by providing opportunities/chances of promotion to the B.Tech (Hons) degree holders and Diploma holders Assistant Engineers on the analogy of other technical departments i.e Irrigation, E&P and PHE Departments.

The B-Toch (Hons) holder Assistant Engineers (BS-17) C&WD filed writ petition No 2707-P/2021 & writ polition No 1539 P/2021 in Peshawar High Court Peshawar with the pray to create/reserve 20% quota in the posts of BS-18 & above for the employees naving B-Toch (Hons) degree serving as Sub Divisional Officers/Assistant Engineers (BS-17) in respondent Department (C&WD) Annex-1 in the meanwhile, a high level committee was constituted under the chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in light of Competent Authority (Chief Secretary) directions to be based the TORs mentioned in the referred Notification (Annex-II).

- 2. In the afore-referred wnt petitions, Peshawar High Court Peshawar has passed the orders on 24.03.2022 (Annex-III) with the verdicts "The committee is directed to finalize its recommendations within 60 days positively".
- 3. Now in this regard Establishment & Admin: Department has forwarded minutes of the meeting held on 20.04.2022 for further necessary action (Annex-IV). In the minutes, the committee has referred the operative part of the Supreme Court of Pakistan judgment dated 24.04 2018 (Annex-V), which stipulates that "the net result of above discussion is that this potition fails. It is dismissed and leave refused, however, with note of caution that Government shall not allow or permit any person to perform professional engineering work as defined in the PEC Act, who does not possess accordited engineering qualification from the accredited engineering institutions and this name is not registered as a register engineer or professional engineer under the PEC Act."
- 4. In the concluding para, the committee has mentioned that after thread bare discussion, in light of Supreme Court Judgment, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973, APT Rules, 1989 and the Peshawar High Court Judgment dated 24.03-2022 regarding convening of SSRC meeting, it was unanimously recommended that C&W Department may review its existing service rules by providing opportunity/ chances of promotion to the B-Tech (Hons) Degree holders and Diploma Holders. Assistant Engineers on the analogy of other technical departments i.e. Irrigation, Energy

& Power and PHE Departments (Annex-VI)

In this connection, C&W Department is of view in light of operative part of Supreme Court of Pakistan judgment dated 24.05.2018 that non-professional posts not exist in C&W Department to consider the promotion of Assistant Engineers (BS-17) helding the B-Tech (Hons) and Diploma Holders, except two (02) Nos post of Deputy Director Technical (BS-18) and one number post of the Senior Engineer (Survey/ RMU) (BS-18) are available against which the promotion of the referred cadras can be considered under the referred Supreme Court of Pakistan Judgment. Moreover, as per 10% quota under the existing Service Rules of C&W Department, 23 Nos posts of Assistant Engineers/SDOs (BS-17) are filled by way of promotion from amongst B-Tech (Hons) Sub Engineers.

- 6. In order to implement the court directions as well as High Level Committee recommendations, C&W Department suggest the following two proposals for placing bottom SSRC committee for deliberation and decision:
 - Standing Service Rules Committee (SSRC) is requested to consider the oriendment in the unisting Service Rules of C&W Department, 2010 for promotion of Assistant Engineers (BS-17) holding the B-Tech (Hons) and Diploma Holders against non-professional posts in the department according to the judgment of Supreme Count of Pakistan and for this purpose a subcommittee may be constituted to analyze and differentiate the existing posts in C&W department in BS-18, 19 & 20 into purely professional and non-professional posts and accordingly submit proposal for amendment in promotion rules of BS-18 in C&W Department.







APPEAL FOR FIXATION OF 20% QUOTA IN BS-18 IN C&W

H/Sir.

We, the B.Tech (Hons) Engineers working in BS-17 in C&W Department would like to draw your esteemed attention to the following points:

- 1. For promotion to BPS-17 in C&W Department, the Honorable Peshawar High Court, Peshawar approved 10% Separate quota for B.Tech graduates, which was adopted and in practice, since 2018.
- 2. In light of the W.P. No. 1539-P/2020-21 & in light of the directions of the Special Committee, the C&W Department, while submitting the earlier Working Paper to SSRC Meeting held on 18-08-2022, it proposed for a separate quota for B. Tech (Hons) in BS-18, 19 and BS 20, in 1st part of the proposal. In working paper, at item II (after OR), it was proposed to provide quota, on the analogy of other Engineering Department as recommended by the Special committee.
- 3. In the recently submitted 2nd proposed Working Paper by C&W Department, it is now proposing a combined Seniority List of B.Sc and B.Tech. The C&W Department had earlier on denied even allowing Technical Allowance not permissible to B.Tech, then why it is now going for a combined Seniority List if even Technical Allowance was denied earlier on in the same grade (BS-17).
- 4. It is a known fact that B.Tech graduates (now in BS-17 and down) are initially inducted as Sub-Engineer in BS-12 in C&W Department. During Service, they improve their educational qualification and get a H.E.C recognized degree. At a very belated stage they are promoted to BS-17 through 10% quota. There is no special quota for direct induction of B.Tech degree holders in BS-17 (presently) to give them an equal footing in BS-17. Had there been equality during induction to BS-17 for B.Sc/B.Tech, then common Seniority List would not be an issue.
- 5. Court Cases WP No 1539/P & WP No 2707/P 2020-21 were filled in PHC, Peshawar for allowing 20% quota in BS-18, which allowed the same and directed the Special Committee accordingly. Later, the Special Committee also directed C&W Department to submit Working Paper for SSRC on the analogy of quota approved/in practice in other sister engineering departments.
- 6. All sister engineering departments have provided special quota for promotion of B.Tech graduates from BS-17 to BS-18 (and promotions made accordingly), then why C&W is proving itself as a special case.
- 7. As requested in various appeals previously, the promotions cases of PEC Engineers shall be put on hold/stopped, till 20% quota as allowed by Peshawar High Court, Peshawar/Special Committee is provided to B.Tech Engineers.

SUBJECT: APPEAL / OBSERVATIONS ON THE NOTIFICATION NO. SOE/C&WD/8-12/2022
NOTIFIED BY C&W DEPTT ON NOV. 25, 2022. (ANNEX-L.)

Reference: Application submitted by the U/signed to the Honbl'e Chief Secretary, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Dtd. 11 / 10 / 2022, which was forwarded to Office of Secretary C&W office for review, vide CS. Diary No.3329/ (WC), dated 12.10.2022 (before issuance of the instant malafide Notification), regarding the observations over the Working Papers submitted by C&W Deptt. to the SSRC forum, meetings held on 18-08-2022 & 16-09-2022 (Annex-A).

Most Honorable Sir,

We would like to draw your esteemed attention to the following pivotal points regarding the subject matter;

- 1). In order to address the issues of B.Sc/B.Tech Engineers, the competent authority, ordered for a Committee, constituted by your good office along with its TOR's, under the Chairmanship of ACS P&D Dept. with members, (a) Principal Secretary Chief Minister KP, (b) Secretary Establishment Dept. (c) Secretary Law Dept. and (d) a co-opted member, Notification issued vide, No.SOR-V(E&AD)7-1/2021 Dtd. 07.09.2021, with mandate to finalize its recommendations within 30 days (Annex-B).
- 2). As the Special Committee did not resolve the issue within a viable time period, we, the u/signed filled Writ Petition No. 1539-P/2021 "Niamat Gul & others Vs. Govt of KPK" in the Honorable PHC for provision of 20% separate promotion quota to BS-18 and above, for B.Tech Graduates of C&W Dept.(Annex-C). Replying in the court, the respondent C&W Deptt. through the AAG had put forward the aforesaid Notification dated 07.09.2021 and submitted that, in order to resolve the issue, for providing promotion quota to the Petitioners, a Special Committee was already constituted by the Provincial Government. During proceedings, the Court directed the AAG on 18.11.2021 to put forward the outcome of the Committee. However, by that time the Committee had not decided the matter as tasked. The Honorable PHC, while disposing the case on 24.03.2022, had directed The Special Committee to finalize its recommendations with viable proposals regarding the matter of promotion of the petitioners within 60 days (Annex-D).Accordingly, the Special Committee decided the matter on 20.04.2022 and the decision thereof conveyed to Secretary C&W and others, through letter No. SOR-V(E&AD)7-1/Irrig:

Dtd: June 10th, 2022 (Annex-E). The Committee had noted that service progression was already ensured to C&W SDO's in BS-17 but they were denied onward promotion in BS-18 and above. The Committee noted that (in Para's 5, 6, 7 & 8), service progression was already ensured in irrigation, PHED, Energy & Power and LG&RD departments in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, whereas the same was denied to B.Tech graduates of C&W Department. After threadbare analysis of the Judgment of the August Court, KP Civil Servants Act 1973 and APT Rules 1989, the Committee directed C&W Department to amend its service rules on the analogy of other Engineering departments and to provide quota to it's B.Tech (Hons) employees. (N.B): All sister Engineering Departments in KP have made regular promotions of their B.Tech Employees through separate quotas allowed for their promotion to BS-18 and BS-19. (Annex-E1, E2, E3, & E4).

- 3). Responding to the Establishment Department earlier Notification (Annex-F), the C&W Dept. submitted it's 1st Working Paper on June 27,2022 (Annex-G) to the SSRC Meeting, that was held on 18-08-2022, wherein it had proposed, in item 6 (i) for creation of separate stream for promotion of B.Tech (Hons) and to analyze & differentiate posts in BS-I8, BS-19 and BS-20. Further, (after OR) in Para (b), C&W had proposed to provide a quota for promotion to B.Tech graduates in BS-18 on the analogy of other Engineering Departments as recommended by the Special Committee. During discussion over agenda item No.2, the Establishment Dept. conveyed that the working paper was not submitted in light of instructions conveyed to all departments on June 10, 2022. The forum did not agree to the recommendations put forward by C&W Dept. in the instant working paper and directed C&W Deptt. to resubmit the working paper within a week time, in light of recommendations of the Special Committee headed by ACS P&D Dept. Moreover, the representative, Dy. Secretary C&W Department, also requested the forum to defer the items so that they may resubmit the working paper. Minutes of Meeting were issued duly signed by participants and Spl. Secy. Reg. Estab Deptt. (Annex-H).
- 4). C&W Dept. in response to directions of meeting held on 18.08.2022 (1st SSRC), submitted a revised Working Paper to the Secretary Establishment Dept. on Sept. 13, 2022, vide No.SOE/C&WD/13-10/2021(quota)(Annex-I), mentioning therein, that the revised working paper was being submitted to the SSRC forum in light of directions conveyed during 1st SSRC meeting and in light of directions of the special committee. However, it was a total malafide cover-up. In the annexed Draft Working Paper, C&W Dept. had proposed for promotion of B.Tech graduates from BPS-17 to BPS-18, on the basis of Inter-Se Seniority from amongst joint seniority list of B.Sc. & B.Tech graduates. The C&W dept., under Reason column, referred to (i) the judgment of PHC dtd.24.03.2022 and (ii) decision of the Special Committee, directing it to act on the analogy of other Engineering Departments. Preempting this injustice and the coated malafide intentions in the proposal, we approached the Secretary Estab. Dept. with a joint application, on 15-09-2022, Diary No.7433/WE (Annex-J), with an appeal for fixation of a separate quota on analogy of other Engineering depts. as directed by the Special Committee. We clearly mentioned therein that B.Tech (Hons) graduates (now in BS-17 and down) are initially inducted as Sub-Engineers in BS-12, having DAE. During Service, they had improved their educational qualification and at a very belated stage, they were promoted to BS-17. Had there been equal opportunities for direct induction for both B.Sc. & B.Tech in BPS-17, then a common Seniority List would not have been an issue. We also mentioned that the instant proposal of C&W was in total contrast with the directions of the Special Committee and C&W's earlier proposal at item 2 (ii) of the 1st Working Paper. After 1st SSRC, C&W department had itself committed at the

forum, to resubmit the revised working paper as directed by Establishment department during 1st SSRC meeting held on 18.08.2022. In present scenario, it will finish all prospects of B.Tech graduate's further promotions. However, members of both Establishment & Law departments, (Secretaries of Law & Establishment depts. both being members of The Special Committee constituted by CS KPK), did not object to C&W Dept.'s 2nd SSRC proposal and had approved the proposal of 2nd working paper and accordingly minutes were issued on Sept 19, 2022, vide No.SO(POLICY)/E&AD/2-69/2022(Annex-K).

- 5). In light of the fore mentioned and before issuance of the Notification of 25.11.2022, we approached your good office and submitted a detailed self-explanatory application on 12.10.2022 Diary No. 3329(W/C) (Annex-A). This application was sent to the office of Secy C&W for comments / remarks. Accordingly, we had a meeting with Secretary C&W in his PHED office. During this meeting it was conveyed that under his very own able guidance, the PHE Deptt had issued Notification No.SO(Estt)/PHED/1-17/2022 under which B-Tech Graduates were promoted as regular XEN / D.D and T.O's from BPS-17 to BPS-18 on July 27, 2022 (Annex-M), in accordance with the direction of The Special Committee. It is also worth mentioning that PHE dept. by amending its service rules has created separate seniority list for promotion of B.Tech & Diploma holders from BPS-17 to BPS-18. However, while amending service rules for C&W department, we had been denied our just right of promotion.
- 6). It is also sadly noted that C&W department has malafidely and collectively prevailed to diminish the prospects of further promotion of B.Tech graduates and is still trying to promote the services of only PEC registered B.Sc / BE engineers in the forthcoming PSB meetings so as to permanently close the vacant seats in BS-18. Hence, as previously appealed in our applications, the promotions cases of PEC Engineers shall be put on hold / stopped, till the 20% quota, as allowed by the Peshawar High Court, Peshawar and The Special Committee is provided to B.Tech Engineers, promotions are made accordingly and Separate seniority shall be immediately notified on the analogy of other Engineering Departments.
- 7). Here it would also not be out of place to mention that Secretaries of both the Establishment and Law Departments, initially being co-members of the Special Committee, had, agreed for provision of separate quota for promotion of B.Tech graduates through separate quota. However, we feel it unjust and biased that although timely notice of Establishment and C&W departments was drawn to the decision of the P.H.C. Peshawar and the Special Committee, but in vain

Sir, lastly as you may know, the Special Committee's stance on the fate of much hyped, Maula Bakhash Case, CP No. 78-K, contested a lot by PEC graduates, (status recorded in the Minutes Dtd. 20.04.2022, Para 4 of minutes). It is further to bring into your esteemed notice, that other similar nature case filled by PEC Engineers against promotions of B.Tech Graduates in the August Court in CP No 3455 of 2020 has also been dismissed by Justice Gulzar Ahmad, Chief Justice on December 01, 2021 and "leave refused" (Annex-N). Also, in a review case filled in the Supreme Court of Pakistan, CP No. 21 of 2022, to review the aforementioned CP No 3455 of 2020, too has been "dismissed" on 13.06.2022 (Annex-O). Moreover, your just esteemed attention is also drawn to the fact that C&W department, Govt of Sindh had earlier on sought clarification from Law Department, Sindh, regarding promotion of B.Tech (Hons) graduates against the posts of Executive Engineers. In this regard C&W Sindh was conveyed vide letter, dated 06th July, 2019, that there was no bar on posting B.Tech (Hons) graduates on field postings and that they can be posted as Executive Engineers (Annex-P).

In light of the fore mentioned facts, we request your just honour to order withdrawing of the instant malafide Notification issued on 25.11.2022 and by considering this application, in light of the afore mentioned Court's Decisions and the recommendations of the Special Committee, orders for separate quota for B.Tech graduates be issued to ensure timely promotions of B.Tech Graduates of C&W dept. in the upcoming PSB. We also earnestly request your esteemed direction that all cases of promotion to BS-18 of PEC Engineers be stopped till the instant issue is amicably resolved by providing us our due share for promotion to BS-18 and above.
