APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE ACTION AND INACTION OF RESPONDENTS, VIDE WHICH THE RESPONDENTS HAVE FAILED TO GIVE PROMOTION TO THE APPELLANT BY DEFERING PROMOTION OF CLASS-IV EMPLOYEES TO THE POST OF JUNIOR CLERKS, AGAINST WHICH THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL DATED 19.12.2022 WAS INSTITUTED BEFORE RESPONDENT NO. 01, AND TILL DATE NO RESPONCE HAS BEEN GIVEN.

Prayer in Appeal: -

On acceptance of this appeal the Respondents may kindly be directed to promote the appellant along with all other consequential relief including arrears and seniority, etc.

Respectfully Submitted:

Compendium of the facts from which the present appeal arises are as under:-

- 1. That the appellant was appointed as Sweeper (BPS-3) in District Court Lakki Marwat in the year 2017. It is pertinent to mention here that the appellant has B.A Qualification: (Copies of Appointment Order and Educational Records are Annexure A & B)
- 2. That as per seniority list the appellant is on the 2nd number of the seniority list of Class-IV employees. (Copy of Seniority List is Attached as Annexure C).
- 3. That meeting of Departmental Promotion Committee was held on 26.11.2022 to consider promotion of Senior Clerks (BPS-14) on two vacant posts of Assistants (BPS-16), promotion of Junior Clerks (BPS-11) on two vacant posts of Senior Clerks (BPS-14), and promotion of Daftari & Record Lifter (BPS-5) or Class-IV (Naib Qasid, Mali, Chowkidar, Sweeper etc) (BPS-3) against the two vacant posts of Junior Clerk (BPS-11).
- 4. That the Departmental Promotion Committee has promoted the two Senior Clerks against the two vacant posts of Assistants, two Junior Clerks against two vacant posts of Senior Clerks but while considering the promotion against the three vacant posts of Junior Clerks, the Departmental Promotion Committee didn't even consider the appellant for the said post, while the other candidates/ employees were rejected due to their in-eligibility and guidance of Honorable Peshawar High Court were sought by the DPC for promotion against the posts of Junior Clerks amongst the Daftari & Class-IV. (Copy of Minutes of DPC is Annexure

- 5. That the appellant has perform his duty from his initial appointment with full devotion, zeal and zest and no complaint whatsoever regarding his performance yet by the respondents, which clearly proves that the appellant is hard working and devoted person and the appellant is well qualified for the post to be promoted but the respondents did not consider the appellant despite the fact that the appellant is in the top of the final seniority list which speaks of the Respondents' mala-fide intention, illegal, Unlawfull, without jurisdiction without law full authority, viod ab initio and ineffective upon the legal and valid rights of the appellant.
- 6. That the appellant throughout agitated the matter in department by filing application and departmental appeal, but the department remained reluctant and did not bothered to respond till the instant appeal. (Copy of Departmental Appeal is attached as annexure "E").
- 7. That feeling aggrieved form the illegal, mala-fide act of the respondents the appellant has no other option but to knock the door of this honorable Tribunal in the shape of the instant service appeal for the redressal of his grievances inter alia on the following grounds: -

Grounds of Appeal:

- A. That the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law.
- B. That the impugned minutes of meeting dated: 26.11.2022 is illegal, void abinitio, with malafide intentions, without lawful authority, jurisdiction, and ineffective upon the rights of the appellant, hence liable to be setaside.

- C. That the respondents have violate the rights guaranteed and secured to the appellant under the law by not promoting the appellant to the post of Junior Clerk despite having full qualification and eligible and fulfill all the criteria for the promotion.
- D. That no plausible reasons have been given while deferring the promotion for the post of Junior Clerks amongst the Class-IV, which the respondents are bound under the law to give reasons, hence the act of the Respondents is unwarranted under the law.
- E. That the appellant having high qualification and eligible for being well aware with the computer and typing knowledge, as compared to other candidates even compared to the candidates from the category of Daftari & Record lifter but despite of these important aspects, the appellant was ignored from promotion which is highly discriminatory and nullity-in the eye of law.
- F. That the inaction of the Respondents to give promotion to the appellant offend the provision of Article 4 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 to enjoy the protection of law and to be treated in accordance with law which is the inalienable rights of every citizen, wherever he may be, every other person for the time being within Pakistan.
- G. That the appellant has performed his duty with great zeal and devotion, hard work and till date no complaint of the appellant has registered to the respondents, in this regard guidance may be taken from the ACR's of the appellant.

- H. That due to the inaction of Respondents, the appellant has been deprived from his promotion which is his inalienable right, attached to his service, as he completed 5 Years of continuous service in department more than required service for the promotion to the post of Junior Clerk. Hence the act of the Respondents i.e. not promoting the appellant is totally against the principle of Natural Justice.
- I. That the act of the Respondents while determining the promotion cases without adopting proper criteria and codal requirements is against the worthy ruling of the Honorable Superior Courts of Pakistan and therefore, the same is illegal practice and such practice adversely effects efficiency of incumbents and also reduces their confidence and faith in public.
- J. That the appellant had been made victim of discrimination, demerits, partiality and favoritism without any just and reasonable cause thereby offending the fundamental rights of the appellant as provided by the constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973.
- K. That the appellant was condemned unheard, his departmental appeal was not adjudicated in the manner as provided by the law. Furthermore no chance of personal hearing was given to the present appellant in order to redress his grievances, which shows the malafide of the Respondents, hence needs interference of this Honorable Tribunal.
- L. That the Respondents erroneously exercised their powers against judicial principles, hence, the promotion order issued by Respondents in gross violation of law is liable to be setaside.

M. That the other grounds will be raised, if any, at -the time of arguments, with the permission of this Honble tribunal.

It is, therefore, prayed that on acceptance of this appeal, this Honorable Tribunal may graciously be please to;

- a) Direct the respondents to give promotion to the appellant according to the seniority list.
- b) Direct the Respondents to give promotion to the appellant to the post of Junior Clerk, form 26.11.2022, along with other consequential relief including arrears, seniority, etc.
- c) Direct the Respondents to include the name of appellant in the seniority list of Junior Clerks after giving seniority to the appellant.

Any other better relief may also kindly be granted in the circumstances of the appellant's case.

Mr. Sami Ullah, Senior Clerk (BPS-14) being aggrieved filed departmental appeal against the proceedings of said DPC vide bearing No.03/2020 before the Hon,ble Peshawar High Court, Peshawar which was dismissed on 13/09/2021 and then he filed Service Appeal bearing No.7508/2021 before the learned Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar for promotion to the post of Assistant (BPS-16) being deserving and eligible cum fit official. The learned Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar disposed of the said Service Appeal on 29-06-2022 with the following observations/decision.

".......... (8). In view of the discussion, the appeal in hand is allowed by setting-aside the impugned orders and the appellant is held entitled to be promoted to the post of Assistant (BPS-16) with effect from 20-12-2019 with all consequential benefits".

In compliance with the order of the learned Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar passed on 29-06-2022 in the said Service Appeal No.7508/2021 titled "Sami Ullah Vs District & Sessions Judge, Lakki Marwat", Mr. Sami Ullah, Senior Clerk (BPS-14)) is promoted and considered as Assistant (BPS-16) w.c.f. 20-12-2019 with all back benefits.

The Committee at the very outset considered the factum of calculation of quota by promotion and through direct recruitment of the vacant posts of Junior Clerk (BPS-11). Total sanctioned strength in both the Establishments i.e. District & Sessions Judge & Senior Civil Judge (Admn), Lakki Marwat is 41, out of which 12 posts are to be filled through promotion and 29 posts through the direct recruitment/appointment. After promotion to the posts of Senior Clerks (BPS-14), total number of vacant posts of Junior Clerk (BPS-11) becomes 15 while the available working posts under the promotion quota is 09 and as per the calculation, it would be 12 posts under the promotion quota, so, 03 more posts will be filled through promotion to fulfill the requisite quota under the promotion category.

After examining the service records of prospective officials from amongst holders of the posts of Daftari/Record Lifter (BPS-05) and other Class-IV employees for promotion to the posts of Junior Clerk (BPS-11) and after perusal of the common Seniority Lists prepared for the purpose of promotion to the posts of Junior Clerks (BPS-11) (annexures "C" & "D") the senior most officials/ holders of the posts of Daftari & Record Lifter (BPS-05) and other Class-IV staff in the seniority lists as stood on 30-04-2022 for the purpose of promotion to the posts of Junior Clerk (BPS-11), were interviewed one by one and their academic/professional records were also examined, objectively.

Considering the service record and qualifications of officials as per requirement under the Peshawar High Court, Peshawar (Subordinate Court Staff) Recruitment Rules-2003, the committee found that:

- The senior most official amongst the holders of Record lifter/ Daftari (BPS-05) named Mr.Imam Ahmad does not possess the requisite qualification so he lost entitlement for promotion to the required slot of Junior Clerk.
- The next official named Mr. Rizwan Ullah, Dastari (BPS-05) being junior official
 mentioned at Serial. no. 02 does not possess the requisite requirements i.e. lack of
 required service length of 03 years as he was promoted to the present post on
 25-04-2022.

The committee, therefore, unanimously decided that name of official at Serial no. 01 be dropped where as the official at serial no. 02 is not eligible for promotion at this stage.

Thereafter, merits/ eligibility of officials next in the row amongst holders of the posts of Chowkidar, Naib Qasid & Sweeper etc were discussed. Although they have requisite qualification but the committee decided that their promotion could not be made due to the reason that by doing so the seniority/ right of Mr. Rizwan Ullah. Daftari (BPS-05), who was recently promoted to the present post of Daftari (BPS-05) on 25-04-2022, may be effected unjustifiably. Similarly in the same column of seniority Mr. Akbar Zaman, Sweeper (BPS-03) was found to be having no knowledge of typing. Therefore, the committee concluded that the promotions from the posts of Daftari, Chowkidar, Naib Qusid & Sweeper etc should be deferred and guidance in the matter for removal of anomaly in the seniority of officials should be sought from the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Peshawar after which the vacant posts of

Junior Clerk (BPS-11) under promotion quota will be filled in the next DPC to be conducted at proper time.



THE ORDER DATED: 26-11-2022 OF DEPARTMENAL PROMOTION COMMITTEE WHEREBY THE APPELLANT BEING, WELL QUALIFIED AND BEING ON TOP OF THE SENIORITY LIST OF CLASSIV, WAS DEFERRED / REJECTED FROM PROMOTION TO THE POST OF JUNIOR CLEK.

Through Proper Channel:-

Worthy Sir,

Most respectfully, the appellant submits his grievances being aggrieved from the above mentioned order.

- 1. That the present appellant joined the department way back in the year 2017 when the appellant was appointed as Sweeper.
- 2. That as per seniority list the appellant is on the second position in the seniority list of class-IV employees.
- 3. That meeting of Departmental Promotion Committee was held on 26-11-2022 to consider promotion of Senior Clerks (BPS-14) on two vacant posts of Assistants (BPS-16), promotion of Junior Clerks (BPS-11) on two vacant posts of Senior Clerks (BPS-14) and promotion of Daftari & Record Lifter (BPS-5) or Class-IV (Naib Qasid, Mali, Chowkidar, Sweeper etc.) (BPS-3) against the two vacant posts of Junior Clerk (BPS-11).
- 4. That the Departmental Promotion Committee has promoted the two Senior Clerks against the two vacant posts of Assistants, two Junior Clerks against two vacant posts of Senior Clerks but while considering the promotion against



the three vacant posts of Junior Clerks, the Departmental Promotion Committee rejected / deferred the appellant against the said post due to unawareness from computer. (Copies of seniority list, Minutes of DPC are attached herewith)

5. That being aggrieved from the above mentioned orders this appeal is preferred on the following grounds inter-alia:-

Grounds:-

- a. That the appellant has more than 5 years of service and being second position in the seniority list, is eligible for the promotion to the post of Junior Clerk.
- b. That the Departmental Promotion Committee has illegally deferred / rejected the appellant from considering for the promotion to the post of junior clerk, while the appellant possess all the qualifications required under the Peshawar High Court Peshawar (Subordinate Courts Staff) Rules 2003.
- c. That under the above said rules neither required nor mentioned anywhere that the class-IV must possess complete knowledge of computer for promotion to the post of Junior Clerk, otherwise the appellant fulfill all the criteria required by the law for promotion for the post of Junior Clerk including computer typing.
 - d. That, Appellant have been kept deprived of his fundamental right as he deserve promotion to the post of Junior Clerk. It is clear principal laid down by the Apex Court that if an employ is prevented to work on the higher grade despite he was eligible for that higher post then he was entitled the benefits of the said higher post.
 - e. That the DPC was concerned in respect of seniority of Daftari Rizwan Ullah (BPS-5) as he is not eligible for the promotion to the post of Junior

Clerk due to his less than 3 years of service on the post of Daftari and due to the same reason guideline were sought from Hon'ble Peshawar High Court which is against the mandate of law and policy because there are 3 posts vacant for the promotion amongst the Daftari, Record lifter (BPS-5) and class-IV, therefore promotion of eligible candidates from Class-IV could not be delayed / deferred due to in-eligibility of Daftari Rizwan Ullah etc.

f. That any other grounds which are in favour of appellant may kindly be considered for the purpose of deciding the instant appeal.

Keeping in view the dictum laid down by the Apex Courts, it is respectfully prayed that instant appeal may kindly be accepted and the appellant may graciously be granted anti-dated promotion to the post of Junior Clerk along with all back benefits.
